- & Aaliyah Edwards (154) needs four rebounds to pass Shalonda Enis (157) for fourth-most rebounds in a rookie season in franchise history

SERIES NOTES

- In the first meeting between the Mystics and Sky this season on 6/6, rookie Aaliyah Edwards had a career-high 23 points and 14 rebounds
- 13 of the last 15 meetings between these teams have been decided by 10-or-fewer points, including their last meeting on June 14 (83-81).
- Since the 2016 season, the Mystics have won the season series five of seven seasons, falling to the Sky in 2022 and tying the series in 2020.
- Washington went on a nine-game winning streak against the Sky from Sep. 7. 2016 to Jun. 26, 2019. The Mystics are 9-12 since then.
- Last season on June 22, 2023, the Mystics held Chicago to 59 points, the second-least points the Mystics have allowed in series history, and the least points since June 13, 2008.

AP -- Ariel Atkins scored a season-high 29 points on 9-of-13 shooting to help the Washington Mystics hold on to beat the Chicago Sky 83-81 on Friday night for their second consecutive win after 12 straight losses to open the season. Julie Vanloo hit a 3-pointer with 2:49 to play that ended a scoring drought of 5-plus minutes for the Mystics (2-12) and stretched their lead to 79-71. Lindsay Allen answered with a layup, Chennedy Carter added a three-point play and Angel Reese was fouled as she made a layup and hit the and-1 free throw to cap an 8-1 spurt and trim Chicago's deficit to 81-79 with 1:12 left. Atkins responded with two free throws before Allen made a driving layup that made it a one-possession game with 50 seconds to go. The teams exchanged empty possessions before Allen missed a potential winning corner 3-point shot in the closing seconds. Stefanie Dolson of the Mystics fouled out when she dived for the loose ball with 0.2 seconds left. Marina Mabrey — who went into the game shooting 83% from the line this season — missed thenfree throws and the Mystics held on. Aaliyah Edwards, the No. 6 overall selection in the 2024 draft, fouled out with 16 points on 6-of-7 shooting. The Sky (4-8) have lost three games in a row and five of their last six. Carter led Chicago with 16 points and Reese had 10 points and 14 rebounds, the rookie's fifth consecutive double-double. Dana Evans scored 14, Kamilla Cardoso 12 and Allen finished with 10. Washington led by as many as 15 points. Chicago went scoreless for the first 4-plus minutes of the game, missing its first eight shots before Mabrey hit a 3-pointer to make it 9-3. Myisha Hines-Allen made a free throw to give the Mystics a 23-8 lead with a minute left in the first quarter. Washington took a 47-36 lead into halftime but Evans scored eight points — including two 3-pointers — in a 14-6 run that made it 56-all with 2:56 left in the third quarter. Karlie Samuelsson scored 12 points for Washington.

Team

- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the second-straight season. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season in 2022.
- Washington has 10 afternoon games this season, with eight of the 10 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time and two games with a 2:00 p.m. tip time.
- The Mystics will play their 900th regular season game on Sunday, September 8, 2024, vs. Minnesota.
- The Mystics look to average the most assists and most made threes per game in franchise history after averaging a franchise high 22.1 assists and 9.8 made threes per game prior to the Olympic break. The current end-of-season highs are 21.9 assists per game (2019) and 9.3 made threes per game (2019).
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the eighth time over the last nine seasons. The team averaged 80.5 points per game in 2023 and 79.3 points per game prior to the Olympic break.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019). The team averaged 19.2 assists per game in 2023 and 22.1 assists per game prior to the Olympic break.
- Washington will look to average 25+ defensive rebounds per game after the team has averaged 25+
 defensive rebounds per game for the past three seasons. The team averaged 24.8 defensive rebounds
 per game prior to the Olympic Break in 2024.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ 3-pointers per game for the eighth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 23.1 3-pointers per game and had a franchise-high 27.4 3-point attempts per game in 2021. Prior to the Olympic Break, the team averaged 26.6 3-pt attempts per game.
- A Mystics player has been named to the WNBA All-Defensive team for six-straight seasons, including five-time All-Defensive Ariel Atkins and four-time All-Defensive Brittney Sykes.
- The Mystics have had a player named to the WNBA All-Rookie team for back-to-back seasons (2022: Shakira Austin, 2023: Li Meng). The team currently has two rookies, Aaliyah Edwards and Julie Vanloo, on the 2024 roster.
- The 2024 WNBA season marks the 27th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the
 Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Players

- **Ariel Atkins** looks to increase her franchise record in career threes made and to exceed her single-season career high made after setting a season-high 70 made threes in 2022.
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging a career-best 2.4 defensive rebounds and 3.1 total rebounds per game in 2023, her second-straight season averaging at least three rebounds per game
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a fourth season in her career after achiveing the feat in 2019, 2021, and 2022.
- **Shakira Austin** looks to improve upon her career-high five double-doubles in a season after recording all five of them in the first seven games of the 2023 season
- Austin looks to average 10+ points for the second-straight season after finishing the season with a career-high 10.0 points per game
- **Brittney Sykes** looks to average 2+ steals per game for the third-straight season after setting a new career-high 2.1 steals per game in 2023
- Sykes looks to continue to improve upon her career-high marks set last season in points (15.9), rebounds (5.9), and assists (3.8) per game
- **Karlie Samuelson** looks to continue to be a top shooter in the league after finishing sixth in the WNBA in 2023 in three-point percentage, shooting .426 percent from three
- Samuelson looks to continue to be a top-contributer to her team after a breakout season in 2023 with career-highs in points (7.7), rebounds (3.0), assists (2.0) and three-point attempts (3.4) per game
- **Stefanie Dolson** looks to average the most made threes, three-point attempts, and highest three-point percentage of her career after averaging career-highs in all three categories prior to the Olympic break.
- Dolson looks to finish the season averaging at least one made three per game for the first time in her career. Prior to the Olympic break, Dolson was averaging 2.0 made threes per game. Her previous career-high was 0.9 made threes per game in 2017 and 2019.
- **Julie Vanloo** looks to be among the top facilitators for 2024 rookies and in franchise history, steadily averaging the second-most assists per game (5.1) among rookies behind Caitlin Clark in 2024 and the franchise's second-most assists per game among rookies behind Temeka Johnson prior to the Olympic break.
- Aaliyah Edwards looks to be among the top rookies in the historic 2024 WNBA Draft class, after ranking 4th in points per game (8.7) and 3rd in rebounds per game (5.9) among rookies prior to the Olympic break
- **Shatori Walker-Kimbrough** looks to average the most points per game in a season of her career, after averaging a career high 8.0 points per game prior to the Olympic break. Her previous high was 7.3 points per game in 2020.



AFTER THE BREAK

- After missing much of the regular season before the Olympic break, Brittney Sykes and Shakira Austin returned to the starting lineup accouting for nearly 40% of the team's points since August 15, together averaging 30.3 of the Mystics' 77.0 points per game over the last four games
- Over the last five games, Brittney Sykes has led the Mystics in assists per game (4.6) while Shakira Austin has led the team in rebounds per game (7.8) and steals per game (2.4).
- Fellow starter Ariel Atkins has been the third-highest scorer in points per game, averaging 13.0 points since returning from the break while starting center Stephanie Dolson continues her dominance from three-point range averaging 2.0 made threes per game while shooting 50.0% from beyond the arc since the break.
- Over the last five games (8/15-8/26) the Mystics have averaged nearly two more steals per game and one more block per game compared to the first 25 games of the season. Prior to the break, the Mystics averaged 6.9 steals and 2.9 blocks per game. Since returning, the team is averaging 8.8 steals and 4.2 blocks per game
- Mystics opponents are also shooting less efficiently since the break.
 Opponents averaged 45.9% from the field and 34.8% from three before the break and have since shot 41.9% from the field and 28.9 from three
- Opponents have averaged nearly 2.5 less fast break points since the return from break, averaging 10.4 fast break points per game before the break and 8.0 since returning.

BENCH MOB

- The Mystics continue to have one of the most productive benches in the WNBA this season, ranking top three in the league in all five of the main statistical categories this season.
- The Mystics have averaged 24.8 bench points per game this season, which ranks first in the WNBA.
- The Mystics have averaged 11.0 rebounds per game off the bench this season, which ranks second in the WNBA, behind the Atlanta Dream (11.8).
- The Mystics have averaged 6.8 assists per game off the bench this season, which ranks second in the WNBA, behind the Los Angeles Sparks (72).
- The Mystics have averaged 2.9 steals per game off the bench this season, which ranks first in the WNBA.
- The Mystics have averaged 12 blocks per game off the bench this season, which ranks third in the WNBA, behind the Atlanta Dream (1.3) and Phoenix Mercury (1.4).
- Among Mystics players who have played at least 15 games off the bench this season, Shatori Walker-Kimbrough leads the bench in points (7.4) and steals (1.1) while Aaliyah Edwards leads the bench in rebounds (4.2) and blocks (0.7). - Shatori Walker-Kimbrough led the Mystics in bench scoring prior to the Olympic break, averaging 8.0 points per game while appearing in all 25 games (one start).
- Among players who have played at least 15 games off the bench this season, Walker-Kimbrough currently ranks third in the WNBA in bench points per game.
- Prior to the WNBA break, in games she played off the bench, Walker-Kimbrough averaged 7.7 of the team's 25.8 bench points per game, which was nearly 30% of the team's bench points before the break (29.8%).



- AUGUST 23 VS. LOS ANGELES: Mystics legend Alana Beard was inducted into the class of 2024 Mystics Hall of Fame.
- Beard played 14 seasons in the WNBA with the Mystics (2004-2009) and Los Angeles Sparks (2012-2019)
- Beard earned nine WNBA All-Defensive team honors throughout her career, including four times with the Mystics.
- Beard also won a WNBA Championship with the Sparks in 2016 and went on to become the WNBA Defensive Player of the Year the next two seasons in 2017 and 2018.
- Beard leads the Mystics all-time in scoring and steals, with 3128 points and 364 steals in her six seasons with the team. She also ranks second all-time in Mystics history in assists (3128), and fourth all-time in three-point field goals made (220)
