SERIES NOTES

- & The Mystics swept the Wings during 2024 season series (3-0), marking the first time since 2019 that Washington has won the season series. Dallas was the only team the Mystics swept last season.
- & Last year, Washington's 28-point win vs. the Wings on 6/22 marked the largest margin of victory by the Mystics in series history.
- & Washington averaged 93.0 points versus Dallas during the 2024 season, their highest scoring average verse an opponent. The Wings averaged 79.7 points per game against the Mystics one of four teams to average 80.0 or fewer points during the 2024 season.
- & The Mystics averaged 25.0 assists per game, their highest average against an opponent during the 2024 season.
- & On Sept. 3, Washington's bench scored 50 points, outscoring the Wings 50-13. Washington was led by Emily Engstler's 19 points.

AP -- Emily Engstler had a career-high 19 points to lead a dominant performance by the Washington Mystics' bench in a critical 90-86 win over the Dallas Wings on Tuesday night. Both teams started the night 9-23 and coming off losses after three straight wins had reignited their playoff hopes. They began two games behind Chicago and Atlanta in the battle for the final playoff berth. Both have seven games remaining. Ariel Atkins added 14 points and Julie Vanloo and reserve Shatori Walker-Kimbrough had 11 each for the Mystics, who started the season 0-12. Washington's bench scored 50 points to 13 for the Wings, who were down 16 with less than five minutes to go and missed three shots in the closing seconds. The Mystics missed their last nine shots. Arike Ogunbowale had 21 points to lead Dallas, three in the first half and 11 in the final five minutes. Teaira McCowan had 20 points and 13 rebounds, Natasha Howard had 14 points, Satou Sabally 12 and Kalani Brown 10. Ogunbowale had 34 points on a league record-tying nine 3-pointers on Sunday but Dallas was 4 of 18 in this one, pounding the ball inside for 48 points. The Mystics, who never trailed after breaking a 5-5 tie on Vanloo's 3-pointer, were 9 of 16 behind the arc in the first half when they took a 51-39 lead. They finished 12 of 30. Washington swept the season series 3-0.

Team:

- The Mystics are set to play 44 regular season games for the first time in league history. The 44-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 40-game season the past two years.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ESPN3, CBSSN, ION, NBA TV) 17 times this season.
- Washington has 10 afternoon games this season, with seven of the 10 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- The Mystics will play four games away from CareFirst Arena this season. Washington's annual Camp Day game will be played on Tuesday, July 8 at Eagle Bank Arena in Fairfax, VA.
 The Mystics will also play two games at CRF Bank Arena in Baltimore, MD.
- Washington's opening night roster has four rookies, the most since 2011 (four rookies).
- Washington holds four international players on their opening night roster (Australia, Mali/Spain, Canada), the second consecutive season the Mystics have held four or more players on their opening night roster.
 - This marks the fourth consecutive year (2022-25) Washington's opening night roster has held an international player.
- The Mystics' opening night roster had an average age of 24-348 which ranked as the youngest in the WNBA. This marked the youngest roster Washington has had on opening night since 2016 (24-183).
- All but two of Washington's players have three or fewer years of experience. Veterans Stefanie Dolson (11 seasons) and Brittney Sykes (8 seasons) are the only players on the roster with four-plus years of service.
- The Mystics aim to average 20+ assists per game for the fourth time in franchise history, having previously accomplished the feat in 2024, 2022, and 2019. Washington averaged 21.6 assists per game in 2023.
- The Mystics averaged 7.3 steals per game in 2024 and will look to record seven or more steals per game for the 20th time in franchise history and for the fifth time since 2020.
- Washington is targeting a top-five finish in pace for the first time since the 2013 season, when they ranked fourth (93.29; 4th).
- The Mystics are looking to average 20.0 free throw attempts per game, the first time since the 2017 season (21.4).

Individual:

- Veteran center Stefanie Dolson looks to build on her three-point success from last season.
 Dolson shot 46.5% from beyond the arc in 2024, the third-highest percentage in the league, and the second consecutive season she has shot at least 40.0% from three-point territory.
 - o Her 72 three-point makes in 2024 were the most by any center.
 - Dolson totaled at least 300 points, 150 rebounds, 100 assists, and 50 three-pointers last season, joining T. Catchings (2012) and J. Loyd (2024) as the only players to amass those benchmarks in the 10th or later season of their career.
 - At the age of 33, Dolson would become the oldest player in WNBA history to record those totals in a single season.
- Veteran guard **Brittney Sykes** aims to finish top five in steals per game. Sykes has averaged at least 1.5 steals per game in four seasons.



- Since 2020, only A. Ogunbowale (DAL), B. Stewart (NYL), and A. Thomas (PHX) have also averaged 1.5+ steals per game in four seasons.
- Sykes averaged 12.2 points per game during the 2024 season, marking her third consecutive season averaging double digits.
- She looks to become the third Mystic to average at least 10.0 points and 3.0 assists in three or more seasons, joining Alana Beard (4) and Kristi Toliver (3).
- Center **Shakira Austin** is coming off a career-best season, posting career highs in points (11.8), steals (1.3), and both free throw attempts (4.5) and makes (3.0).
 - o In 2025, she aims to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds, which would make her the seventh Mystic in franchise history to reach those averages.
- Forward Aaliyah Edwards averaged 7.6 points and 5.6 rebounds per game on .490 shooting during her rookie campaign.
 - She aims to become just the third Mystic (joining Shakira Austin, 2022-2023 and Murriel Page, 1998-1999) to average at least 7.0 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting at least 47.5% in each of her first two seasons.
 - Edwards also looks to finish among the top five rebounders in her sophomore class.
- Rookie Watch:
 - The Mystics aim to have a rookie average at least 8.0 points per game during the 2025 season. If accomplished, it would mark the 13th rookie in franchise history to do so, and the first since Shakira Austin (2022).
 - Only six rookies in Mystics history have averaged 10.0+ points per game, with the last coming in 2018 (A. Atkins).
- Washington is also targeting a rookie average 3.0 assists per game which would be just the seventh time in team history that a rookie reached that assist mark (last: Natasha Cloud, 2015).

- The Mystics made key strides toward its future in the 2025 WNBA Draft, selecting three players in the first round Sonia Citron (3rd overall), Kiki Iriafen (4th overall), and Georgia Amoore (6th overall) the most first-round selections in franchise history.
- Washington had the youngest opening night roster in the WNBA, 24-348, which marked the youngest roster Washington has had on opening night since 2016 (24-183).
- All but two players on the roster, veterans Stefanie Dolson (11 seasons) and Brittney Sykes (8 seasons), have three or fewer years of WNBA experience.
- The Mystics have an average of 3.6 years of WNBA experience on their current roster and has a total of 1,073 regular season games played among their 12 roster players, marking the fewest total regular season games played by a team this season.

A NEW ERA

On December 23, 2024, Monumental Basketball announced Jamila Wideman as the Washington Mystics' new General Manager and Sydney Johnson as Head Coach.

Wideman joins the Mystics after six years at the NBA league office, where she most recently served as Senior Vice President of Player Development. A former player herself, Wideman was selected third overall in the 1997 WNBA Draft by the Los Angeles Sparks and is now one of just three active WNBA general managers or team presidents with WNBA playing experience, along with Morgan Tuck (Connecticut) and Raegan Pebley (Los Angeles).

After her playing career, Wideman earned a law degree from New York University and spent over a decade working in civil rights and criminal defense law, including time with the Equal Justice Initiative (EJI) in Montgomery, Alabama, and the Legal Aid Society in New York City.

Johnson becomes the 15th head coach in Mystics history, bringing 25 years of basketball experience. Most recently, he served as head coach of Team USA's 3x3 Women's AmeriCup team, which won silver at the 2024 FIBA 3x3 AmeriCup in Puerto Rico. He also spent the 2024 season as an assistant coach with the Chicago Sky. Prior to that, he led the Fairfield University men's basketball program for eight years (2011–2019), earning four postseason appearances – the most in program history.

- The WNBA announced that Mystics forward Kiki Iriafen has been named the Kia WNBA Rookie of the Month for games played in May.
 Iriafen becomes the first player in Mystics history to earn this honor.
- In Iriafen's debut month, she averaged 13.9 points, 10.1 rebounds, and 1.0 assists per game while shooting .474 from the field.
