QUICK HITS

The Washington Mystics earned their first win of the season in the inaugural Mystics-Tempo matchup with a 68-65 road victory on May 8.

In that May 8 contest, **Sonia Citron** led the Mystics with 26 points on 9-of-12 shooting, including 3-of-6 from beyond the arc. She added to her performance with two steals and two blocks. She is now the only Mystics player to rack up four 25+ point performances before turning 23 years old.

Kiki Iriafen opened her 2026 campaign with a 12 point-16 rebound showing, the 17th double-double of her career and a career-best rebounding mark. Now with two 10+ point/15+ rebound performances to her name, she is the only Mystics player to record multiple qualifying games before her 23rd birthday.

Shakira Austin marked her return with 18 points on 6-of-13 shooting, 11 rebounds, two steals, and two blocks, which marked the 15th double-double of her career.

The Washington Mystics totaled 44 rebounds on May 8, tied for the most boards (July 26, 2025 vs. Seattle) in Head Coach Sydney Johnson's tenure (2025-now). This is also eighth time they have reached the 40 boards mark in that span, tied for the fourth-most such games in the WNBA in that time period.

(AP) Emma Meesseman scored 19 points and Breanna Stewart added 14 to help the New York Liberty beat the Washington Mystics 75-66 on Tuesday night. For the first time since early in the season, New York had its entire roster available. Sabrina Ionescu returned after missing a few games with a toe injury. Nyara Sabally played in her first game since July 16 as she recovered from a knee issue.

The Liberty (26-17), who have locked up the No. 5 seed in the playoffs, are confident they can repeat as champions now that they are healthy. They finish off the regular season in Chicago on Thursday before most likely heading to Phoenix to open the playoffs on Sunday.

Jonquel Jones added 12 points and 11 rebounds as New York improved to 34-0 when she gets a double-double in the regular season over her time with the Liberty. New York jumped out early behind Stewart and Meesseman to take a 19-12 lead after one quarter and extended it to 41-26 at the half.

Washington (16-28) got within seven in the third quarter, but could get no closer. This was the final game of the season for the Mystics, who lost their last 10. There were a lot of positives for the franchise this year, especially rookies Sonia Citron and Kiki Iriafen.

Georgia Amoore, who the team drafted sixth, missed the entire season with a torn ACL. That trio are great pieces to build around for the future. Iriafen scored 16 points and Citron added 13 against New York.

(AP) Natasha Howard scored 17 points and the Indiana Fever beat the Washington Mystics 94-65 on Sunday to clinch a spot in the 2025 WNBA playoffs. The Fever (23-20) advance to the postseason for the second consecutive year, despite losing five players - including the 2024 WNBA rookie of the year Caitlin Clark (groin) - to season-ending injuries.

Aliyah Boston had 12 points, 11 rebounds and five assists. Aerial Powers finished with 15 points and Shey Peddy had 13. Sonia Citron led Washington (16-27) with 17 points. Shakira Austin and Kiki Iriafen scored 11 apiece.

Citron set Washington's single-season scoring record with 644 points. Brittney Sykes set the previous mark of 636 points in 2023. There were six lead changes and seven ties before Peddy hit a 3-pointer with 3:21 left in the first half that made it 37-34 and gave the Fever the lead for good. Kelsey Mitchell made a driving layup about four minutes into the third quarter that pushed lead to 11 points. Peddy made another 3 with 3:33 to play that made it 88-58 and matched Indiana's largest lead of the game.

The Fever, who committed just turnovers, scored 27 points off 21 Washington miscues. The Mystics have sold out 43 consecutive home games, dating to the 2023 season. The Fever host Minnesota and the Mystics visit New York to wrap up the regular season on Tuesday.

HALL OF FAME NAMES

- On April 4, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced that among their Class of 2026 would be former Mystics players **Elena Delle Donne**, **Chamique Holdsclaw** and **Nikki McCray-Penson** (1996 United States Women's National Team). Their induction will take place on Aug. 15.
- Of **Delle Donne's** 10-year career, six of them were with Washington. The seven-time All-Star became the first WNBA player to earn MVP honors with two franchises (2015 Chicago Sky, 2019 Washington Mystics). The 2019 season also saw **Delle Donne** become the first WNBA player to achieve a 50-40-90 season as she helped lead the Mystics to organization's first championship.
- **Delle Donne** was named to the All-Rookie Team and All-WNBA Second Team in her 2013 debut. From 2015-18, she had a four year run of earning All-WNBA First Team placements. She was also a member of the 2016 USA Women's National Team that won a gold medal at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro.
- Following her retirement announcement in April 2025, **Delle Donne** has served as a special advisor to Monumental Basketball and the first managing director of the USA Basketball 3x3 Women's National Team.
- The 1999 WNBA Draft began with the Washington Mystics selecting **Chamique Holdsclaw**, a three-time NCAA champion with the University of Tennessee (1996-98). She later won the 1999 WNBA Rookie of the Year title. In her 11-year career, **Holdsclaw** earned All-Star honors six times (1999-2003, 2005) and All-WNBA Second Team placements three times (1999, 2001, 2002). She was a member of the 2000 USA Women's National Team that won a gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney. In 2010, she received the Dawn Staley Community Leadership Award.
- The first six years of **Holdsclaw's** career were spent in Washington (1999-2004), during which she set the franchise record for total rebounds (1,459) and now ranks second in total points scored (2,960). In 2002 and 2003, she led the WNBA in rebounding, averaging 11.6 and 10.9 rebounds per game, respectively.
- The 1996 United States Women's National Team will be enshrined in the Hall of Fame, a roster that includes former Mystics legend **Nikki McCray-Penson**. They went undefeated (8-0) at the 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta on their way to a gold medal, beginning an era of Team USA dominance at the Olympics that has continued through the most recent 2024 Summer Olympics.
- **McCray-Penson** was selected by Washington in the 1998 WNBA Allocation Draft for the inaugural Washington Mystics roster. The three-time All-Star (1999-2001) was a member of the Mystics from 1998-2001.



BIG-TIME KIRA

- The summer of 2025 saw **Shakira Austin** reach new heights. She appeared in a personal best 38 games (30 starts), averaging career-highs in scoring (12.7 points), shooting (5.0 made field goals), assists (1.8), and blocks (1.1).
- **Austin** set a career scoring high when she racked up 30 points on Aug. 24, 2025 against the Seattle Storm, becoming the 15th player in franchise history to record a 30-point game.
- With 13 boards in a June 26 win over the Las Vegas Aces, she matched her career high.
- **Austin** racked up 185 defensive rebounds and 43 blocks in 2025, joining the top-six in both categories for single-season highs in Mystics history. Her blocking total is the Mystics' highest mark since 2015.
- With **Austin** and **Kiki Iriafen's** performance on the defensive glass in 2025, they became the first Mystics duo to record 180+ defensive rebounds each in the same season.

- Last season, **Austin** was one of just five WNBA centers to end the year averaging 12+ points on at least .450 shooting, five or more rebounds, and at least one block per game.

- In 26 showings, **Austin** scored at least 10 points, almost doubling her previous career-high of 14 such performances in 2022. This was the sixth-highest total among centers in 2025.
- **Austin** shot over .500 on 10 or more attempts from the field on a career-best eight occasions in 2025. This total ranked eighth best among her fellow bigs last year.
- Upon the conclusion of the regular season, **Austin** had her work recognized on the biggest stage, being named the Associated Press' 2025 Comeback Player of the Year. She is the first player in franchise history to earn this title.

A PERFECT PAIR

- At the close of their rookie campaign, **Sonia Citron** and **Kiki Iriafen** averaged 14.9 and 13.3 points per game, respectively.
- They are the first pair of rookies to average 10.0+ points through a season in Mystics history and the first to do so league-wide since Alyssa Thomas (10.1 ppg) and Chiney Ogwumike (15.5 ppg) did so for the 2014 Connecticut Sun.
- Between Washington's third and fourth overall draft picks, they combined for 72 10+ point games in 2025 (**Citron: 38, Iriafen: 34**), the most qualifying performances from a team's rookies in franchise history. This also marked the most in the WNBA since the 1998 Detroit Shock (now Dallas Wings).

- Over the course of her rookie campaign, **Kiki Iriafen** racked up 584 points, 376 rebounds and 26 steals. She is the only player in WNBA-history to total 550+ points, 350+ boards and 25+ steals in their debut season.

- Iriafen** immediately made her impact known, earning the WNBA's Rookie of the Month for games played in May 2025. In seven outings, she averaged 13.9 points and 10.1 rebounds per game, the only first-year player to average a double-double that month. This win marked the first such award for a Mystics rookie.

OUR OFFSEASON WAS UNRIVALED

- Shakira Austin** returned to Unrivaled, this time suiting up for Rose BC. In 15 games (nine starts), she averaged 15.0 points on 54.6% shooting and 8.6 rebounds. **Austin's** season was highlighted with an 18-rebound performance, tied for Unrivaled's highest mark of the season, and had five blocks, tied for the second-most in league history in a Feb. 7 matchup against Vinyl BC.

- Sonia Citron** made her Unrivaled debut with Hive BC. In 13 appearances (all starts), she averaged 15.2 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 3.1 assists. Citron scored a season-high 32 points on 12-of-18 shooting, including 4-of-7 from deep on Feb. 2 against Vinyl BC.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

For the first time in franchise history, the Washington Mystics held six total picks in the WNBA Draft. The youth movement in D.C. continues with the additions of Lauren Betts (fourth pick), Angela Dugalić (ninth pick), Cotie McMahon (11th pick), Cassandre Prosper (19th overall), Darianna Littlepage-Buggs (30th overall), and Rori Harmon (34th overall). The Mystics' three picks in the first round (Betts, Dugalić and McMahon) matched the record set in the 2025 Draft for the most first round picks in team history.

Washington's training camp roster has the youngest team in the WNBA, with an average age of 23.94 (per Across The Timeline). Only two players on the roster, veterans Michaela Onyenwere (five seasons) and Shakira Austin (four seasons), have more than one year of WNBA experience. The Mystics have an average of 0.81 years of WNBA experience on their current roster.

FRESH FACES

A new presence in D.C. this season, **Michaela Onyenwere** joins the Mystics after coaching first round draft picks **Lauren Betts** and **Angela Dugalić** in the 2026 NCAA Championship. The former WNBA Rookie of the Year (2021) signed as a free agent after spending two seasons with the Chicago Sky (2024-25). She owns career averages of 6.9 points, and 2.4 rebounds in 19.1 minutes per game in her 182 appearances (97 starts).

Alex Wilson signed with the Mystics after making a WNBL Finals appearance with the Perth Lynx. A seasoned veteran in Australia, she made her professional debut at 16 years old before going on to win WNBL Rookie of the Year (2014), two championships (2015 & 2017) and earning two All-WNBL First Team placements (2025 & 2026). She has represented Australia in numerous international competitions for both the Gangurru (3x3) and the Opals (5x5). Most recently, she helped the Opals secure a spot in the 2026 FIBA World Cup as she averaged 7.2 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game in the qualifying tournament.



MYSTICS MAINSTAY

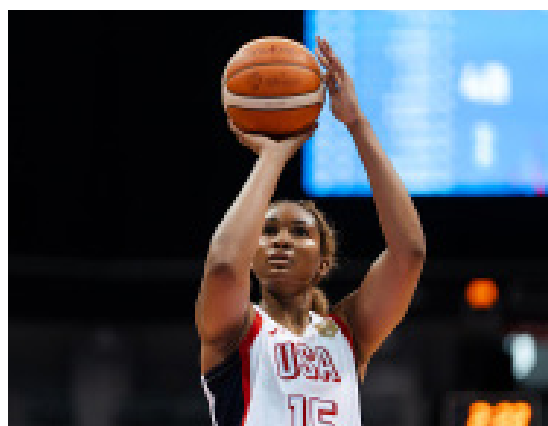
Shakira Austin re-signed with the Mystics on a multi-year deal, building on her momentum that earned her the 2025 AP Comeback Player of the Year award. Over the 2025 season, **Austin** averaged career-highs in points (12.7), assists (1.8), steals (1.1), and blocks (1.1) in a personal record 38 showings. Additionally, she scored a career-best 30 points on Aug. 24, 2025, vs. Seattle and matched her all-time high mark with 13 rebounds on June 26, 2025, vs. Las Vegas. Her 185 defensive rebounds last season matched Tina Charles' record for the sixth-highest single-season total in franchise history. Similarly, her 43 blocks in 2025 are now the Mystics' fifth-highest single-season total in team history. Last season, **Austin** was one of just five centers in the WNBA to finish the season averaging 12+ points while shooting above .450 from the floor, five or more rebounds, and at least one block per game.

STARS EARNING THEIR STRIPES

For the Team USA Women's National Team December 2025 Training Camp, **Lauren Betts**, **Sonia Citron** and **Kiki Iriafen** were among the 14 athletes chosen for the roster.

Iriafen was selected for Team USA's 2026 World Cup Qualifiers roster. In the five-game tournament run, she appeared in all five contests and averaged 5.4 points and 4.2 rebounds in 11.0 minutes per game as Team USA went undefeated and secured a place in the FIBA Women's World Cup.

Shakira Austin represented the United States on Team USA Women's 3x3 National Team for the Champions Cup in Bangkok, during which she racked up 25 points and 27 rebound en route to a 4-1 record and a bronze medal.



SOPHOMORE SURGE

Last season, the Washington Mystics led the league in rookie 10+ point games from the trio of **Sonia Citron** (38), **Kiki Iriafen** (32) and **Lucy Olsen** (three) combining for 73 qualifying games. The 2025 Mystics were the first team to rack up at least 70 double-digit scoring performances from newcomers since the 1999 Orlando Miracle (89 games).
