THE LATEST ON THE SUN STORY LINES

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST LOS ANGELES

Last time out against the Sparks on Sunday July 13, the Sun fell in a close game, 92-88, in Los Angeles. Bria Hartley led the Sun with 25 points, one rebound, a season-high six assists and one steal in 32 minutes played. It marked her first 20+ points outing since August 21, 2020 and her seventh 20+ performance of her career. Saniya Rivers recorded a career-high 20 points, along with six rebounds, one assist, three steals and one block in the game. The rookie guard made a career-high three three-point field goals and recorded her fifth game of the season with 3+ steals. The loss marked the Sun's first regular season loss to the Sparks since August 28, 2020, after winning 13 straight. Connecticut holds a 31-29 all-time regular season record against Los Angeles, including an 18-11 record when playing at home.

BOSTON RECAP

In their final game prior to the WNBA All-Star Break on Tuesday, July 15, the Sun hosted their second-annual "Boston Game" at the historic TD Garden against the Indiana Fever. Connecticut fell in a close contest with Indiana, 85-77. The two teams played in front of a sold-out crowd, with 19,156 tickets sold, marking the third sell out of the 2025 season for the Sun, the third highest attendance to a WNBA game this season to date, and the second largest number of tickets sold to a Connecticut Sun game in the franchise's history. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts officially proclaimed July 15, 2025 to be 'WNBA Day in Boston' with Massachusetts Governor Maura Healey signing the official proclamation.

BRIA STEPPING UP

Veteran guard Bria Hartley has been stepping up offensively for the Sun in the month of July. Hartley went for a season-high 25 points against the Sparks on July 13. She finished 7/17 from the floor and hit four threes in the effort. It marks her first 20+ points outing since August 21, 2020 and her seventh 20+ performance of her career. In the month of July, Hartley has averaged 13.0 points per game, good for second on the team behind Tina Charles. She is also leading the team in assists per game in July at 3.4 per contest and has finished with 10+ points in three of the Sun's last five games.

MAKING STRIDES IN YEAR FOUR

Olivia Nelson-Ododa is making strides during her fourth year in the WNBA as one of two returners from the Sun's 2024 season squad. The 6-4 forward-center has started in 19 of her 21 contests played and is averaging career-bests of 8.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 0.9 assists and a team-best 1.3 blocks per game.

She also reached a new career-high with five blocks on 6/22 vs. Golden State. On June 29 at Minnesota, Nelson-Ododa eclipsed 100 blocks in her WNBA career, achieving the milestone in just 122 regular season games. She has also finished in double-digit scoring in eight games this season.

MISSING MABREY

Sixth-year guard **Marina Mabrey** returned this year for her second season in a Sun uniform. Mabrey has appeared and started in 13 games for Connecticut in 2025 prior to injuring her left knee against Dallas on June 20. The 5-11 guard has missed the Sun's last nine games with the injury, having a projected return timeline of 2 to 4 weeks. Prior to her injury, Mabrey was averaging a career-high 15.2 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. She also is leading the Sun in assists per game (4.1), three-point field goals made per game (2.3) and minutes played per game (31.6).

WELCOME TO CT, MIGNA

On Monday, July 21, the Sun signed Mamignan "Migna" Touré to a seven-day contract. Touré, a native of Nevers, France, joins Connecticut after most recently competing alongside Sun rookie guard Leïla Lacan at the 2025 FIBA Women's EuroBasket for the French Women's National Team. The 6-0 shooting guard averaged 9.7 points and 2.8 assists over six games during the tournament. Prior to the 2025 WNBA season, Touré signed a training camp contract with the Golden State Valkyries where she appeared in two preseason contests before being waived prior to the start of the regular season.

TINA LEADING THE WAY

14-year league veteran center Tina Charles is hitting major milestones and making her presence known this season for the Sun. Charles hit 8,000 points in her WNBA career on Friday, July 11 against Seattle. Charles is just one of two players in WNBA history to achieve the feat (Diana Taurasi). In addition to the 8,000-point club, Charles has many other milestones on the horizon this season. She is currently:

- 5 assists away from 1,000 career assists
- 113 field goals from 1st all-time in WNBA history
- 99 rebounds from 3rd all-time in Sun history
- 2 offensive rebounds from 1st all-time in WNBA history

Charles has led the Sun in scoring in 11 of their 22 games this regular season, going for 20+ points eight times this year. She has also reclaimed the spot for most double-doubles in Connecticut Sun franchise history, after Alyssa Thomas surpassed her original tally a season-ago. She now has 84 double-doubles in a Sun uniform and a league-best 198 in her career.

THE LATEST ON THE SUN STORY LINES

ROOKIES HEATING UP

Rookie forward and the Sun's 2025 No. 7 overall draft pick **Aneesah Morrow** has seen much improvement from the beginning of the 2025 season. Morrow has finished in double-digits seven times, led the team in scoring on five occasions and has averaged 7.2 points and 4.8 rebounds in 15.2 minutes per game this season. She notched a career-high 20 points and 11 rebounds against Seattle on June 27 and followed up that performance with 16 points and 11 rebounds against Minnesota on June 29, recording her first two double-doubles in the WNBA. In the Sun's game against the Indiana Fever on July 15, Morrow grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds, going for her third game this season with 10+ rebounds.

Rookie guard and the Sun's 2025 No. 8 overall pick Saniya Rivers has also been making strides through her first year in the pros. The 6-1 guard out of NC State has appeared in 20 contests for the Sun, starting in 17. Out of WNBA rookies this seasons, Rivers is currently 7th in points per game (8.3) and second in assists per game (3.0) and first in steals per game (1.8). She currently leads the team in steals per game and has led the team in steals on 12 occasions, blocks on nine occasions and assists six times. On May 24 against Minnesota, Rivers became the first rookie to record at least 11 points, 3 offensive rebounds, 3 assists, 3 steals and 2 blocks in a regular season contest since Nicky Anosike on July 24, 2008. Rivers has recorded a steal in 16 games this season, including five games with 3+ steals.

The Sun's 10th overall pick in the 2024 WNBA Draft, 21-year old French guard **Leila Lacan**, officially joined the Sun after being set active by the team on July 2, with the corresponding waive of rookie center Kariata Diaby. Lacan has spent the last few seasons playing overseas in France, most recently helping the French National Team to a fourth-place finish at the 2025 FIBA EuroBasket Tournament in June, averaging 5.5 points, 2.8 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.0 steals and 0.5 blocks over six games. She made her WNBA debut on 7/6 vs. Las Vegas finishing with five points and one assist. Most recently she notched a career-high 19 points, along with one rebound, one assist and a career-high three steals in 24 minutes played off the bench in the Sun's 85-77 loss to the Fever on July 15.

SHELDON'S SOPHOMORE SEASON

Second-year guard Jacy Sheldon joins the Sun first the first time this season, after being acquired by the team via trade in February. The 5-10 guard out of Ohio State is averaging career-highs in points, minutes played, steals, field goals made and three-point field goals

made this season. Sheldon has started in 17 of the Sun's 22 regular season games and has finished in double-digit scoring on ten occasions. She finished one-point shy of her career-high with a 16-point performance in the Sun's win over Seattle on July 9. Sheldon also recorded a new career-high with four steals against the Dallas Wings on May 27.

THEME NIGHTS AHEAD

The Sun have a plethora of themed games following the WNBA All-Star Break, beginning with the organization's annual Indigenous Peoples' Game on Sunday, July 27 against the Golden State Valkyries presented by Yale New Haven Health. Tribal leadership will perform a blessing and welcome the newest WNBA expansion team to Mohegan Sun Arena for the first time ever. On August 1 against the New York Liberty, the Sun will host Wicked Night, where former Broadway Wicked cast members will perform the national anthem, and one lucky fan will win two tickets to see Wicked on Broadway, along with round trip limo transportation to/from Mohegan Sun. RACHID MEZIANE HEAD COACH

On December 4, 2024, the Connecticut Sun announced Rachid Meziane as the franchise's seventh head coach. Meziane, a native of Clermont-Ferrand, France, brings a wealth of basketball knowledge to Connecticut, having enjoyed great success as a head coach in the French women's basketball sphere, as well as a head coach for Belgium Women's Basketball in FIBA competition.

Since the 2019 season, Meziane has served at the head coach of successful French women's basketball club, Villeneuve d'Ascq, where he most recently led the team to a Ligue Feminine de Basketball (LFB) Championship and a EuroLeague runner up finish during the 2023-24 season. The squad finished with a 19-3 record during the regular season and a 6-0 playoff run in LFB competition, with an average margin of victory of 17.7 points per game. Villeneuve also led the league in points per game (86.0), 2FG% (55.0), 3FG% (38.6), and rebounds (36.2), and were second in assists (20.9) and opponent 2FG% (43.9). With the team, he's coached the likes of New York Liberty's Kennedy Burke, former WNBA Most Improved Player and WNBA Champion Shavonte Zellous, and the ninth overall pick of the 2024 WNBA Draft, Carla Leite. Prior to Villeneuve d'Ascq, Meziane served as the head coach for French clubs, Basket Lattes Montpellier Agglomération (BLMA) (2017-2018) and Cavigal Nice Basket (2012-2017).

Meziane has also found immense achievement on the international basketball stage, having served as the Belgium Women's Basketball National Team Head Coach since November 2022. Meziane led Belgium to it's first-ever FIBA European Women's Championship (EuroBasket) Gold Medal in 2023, with an undefeated 6-0 record in the tournament, knocking off France in the semifinals and defeating Spain in the championship matchup. The team's average margin of victory during their EuroBasket run was 25.0 points per game; the dominating success earning Meziane the Belgian Sports Coach of the Year honor in 2023.

Meziane also led the Belgian Women's National team, which included the talents of WNBA Champion and two-time WNBA All-Star Emma Meesseman and Washington Mystics rookie guard Julie Vanloo, to an impressive fourth place finish at the 2024 Paris Olympics, falling just short to Australia in the bronze medal game. Prior to his time with the Belgian team, Meziane was an assistant coach with the France Women's Basketball National Team from 2014-2021 and helped guide the French to silver medals at the 2015, 2017, 2019 and 2021 European Championships and a bronze medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.


