THE LATEST ON THE SUN STORY LINES

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST LAS VEGAS

The Connecticut Sun fell to the Las Vegas Aces in their second meeting of 2025, 85-59, on June 25 the road in Las Vegas. Tina Charles led the Sun with 18 points, three rebounds, two assists and one steal in the game. She finished 7/17 from the floor and 4/4 from the free-throw line. The outing marks the eighth time the 14-year league veteran has led Connecticut in scoring this season. Olivia Nelson-Ododa notched 12 points, five rebounds and one block in the game, while rookie guard Saniya Rivers rounded out the Sun's double-digit scorers with 10 points, two rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks on the night. Connecticut will look to pick up their first regular season win over Las Vegas since June 8, 2023.

LEILA LACAN JOINS THE SUN

The Sun's 10th overall pick in the 2024 WNBA Draft, 21-year old French guard **Leila Lacan**, officially joined the Sun after being set active by the team on July 2, with the corresponding waive of rookie center Kariata Diaby. Lacan has spent the last few seasons playing overseas in France, most recently helping the French National Team to a fourth-place finish at the 2025 FIBA EuroBasket Tournament in June, averaging 5.5 points, 2.8 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.0 steals and 0.5 blocks over six games.

MISSING MABREY

Sixth-year guard **Marina Mabrey** returned this year for her second season in a Sun uniform. Mabrey has appeared and started in 13 games for Connecticut in 2025 prior to injuring her left knee against Dallas on June 20. The 5-11 guard has missed the Sun's last four games with the injury, having a projected return timeline of 2 to 4 weeks. Prior to her injury, Mabrey was averaging a career-high 15.2 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. She also is leading the Sun in assists per game (4.1), three-point field goals made per game (2.3) and minutes played per game (31.6).

MAKING STRIDES IN YEAR FOUR

Olivia Nelson-Ododa is making strides during her fourth year in the WNBA as one of two returners from the Sun's 2024 season squad. The 6-4 forward-center has started in 14 of her 16 contests played and is averaging career-bests of 8.9 points, 6.1 rebounds, 1.0 assists and a team-best 1.4 blocks per game. She also reached a new career-high with five blocks on 6/22 vs. Golden State. On June 29 at Minnesota, Nelson-Ododa eclipsed 100 blocks in her WNBA career, achieving the milestone in just 122 regular season games. She has also finished in double-digit scoring in eight games this season, including the last three contests.

EYES ON 8,000 POINT CLUB

Sun center Tina Charles enters the next contest just **50 points shy off 8,000 points** for her WNBA career. If she hits the mark, Charles would just be one of two players in league history to achieve the feat (Diana Taurasi). In addition to the 8,000-point club, Charles has many other milestones on the horizon this season. She is currently:

- 16 assists away from 1,000 career assists
- 144 field goals from 1st all-time in WNBA history
- 142 rebounds from 3rd all-time in Sun history

ROOKIES HEATING UP

Rookie forward **Aneesah Morrow** has seen much improvement from the beginning of the 2025 season. Through her first eight games played, the 6-1 forward out of LSU averaged just 2.6 points in about 8.8 minutes played per game off the bench. Over Connecticut's last six games, Morrow has finished in double-digits five times, led the team in scoring on four occasions and has averaged 12.7 points in 20.3 minutes played. She notched a career-high 20 points and 11 rebounds against Seattle on June 27 and followed up that performance with 16 points and 11 rebounds against Minnesota on June 29, recording her first two double-doubles in the WNBA.

Rookie guard **Saniya Rivers** has also been making strides through her first year in the pros. The 6-1 guard out of NC State has appeared in 15 contests for the Sun, starting in 12. Out of WNBA rookies this seasons, Rivers is currently 8th in points per game (6.9) and second in both assists per game (3.0) and steals per game (1.5). She currently leads the team in steals per game and has led (or co-led) the Sun in steals and blocks eight times this season and assists four times. On May 24 against Minnesota, Rivers became the first rookie to record at least 11 points, 3 offensive rebounds, 3 assists, 3 steals and 2 blocks in a regular season contest since Nicky Anosike on July 24, 2008.

JAELYN BROWN JOINS THE TEAM

On June 2, 2025, the Sun signed second-year player **Jaelyn Brown** to a rest of season contract. The 6-1 guard-forward originally signed with the Dallas Wings during the 2024 regular season, averaging 2.6 points and 1.5 rebounds over 14 games played. Brown was then traded to the Indiana Fever in February 2025, where she attended training camp, but was ultimately waived prior to start of the regular season. The University of California, Berkley standout has enjoyed a successful overseas career, competing in numerous countries including Turkey, Hungary and Sweden.



THE LATEST ON THE SUN STORY LINES

TC IS BACK IN CT

The WNBA's All-Time Rebounds Leader and eight-time WNBA All-Star **Tina Charles** signed with Connecticut as a free agent on February 2, 2025. Originally drafted with the No. 1 overall pick by the Sun in the 2010 WNBA Draft, Charles has achieved an impressive resume of accolades throughout her 13-year professional career with additional stops in New York (2014-19), Washington (2021), Phoenix (2022), and Seattle (2022).

Charles returns to Connecticut after playing the 2024 season with the Atlanta Dream. The 6-4 veteran center appeared and started in 39 regular season contests for the Dream, averaging 14.9 points and 9.6 rebounds per game, good for fourth in the WNBA.

It was a historic year for Charles as she moved into first all-time in rebounds (4,014) and second all-time in scoring (7,698) in league history. She has been named WNBA MVP (2012), WNBA Rookie of the Year (2010), All-WNBA First Team (2011, 2012, 2015-2017), All-WNBA Second Team (2010, 2013, 2014, 2021), WNBA All-Defensive First Team (2017), WNBA All-Defensive Second Team (2011, 2012, 2015) and WNBA All-Star (2011, 2013-2015, 2017-2019, 2021). Charles has also led the WNBA in rebounding four times (2010-2012, 2016) and scoring two times (2016, 2021) during her career.

BIENVENUE RACHID MEZIANE

On December 4, 2024, the Connecticut Sun announced **Rachid Meziane** as the franchise's seventh head coach. Meziane, a native of Clermont-Ferrand, France, brings a wealth of basketball knowledge to Connecticut, having enjoyed great success as a head coach in the French women's basketball sphere, as well as a head coach for Belgium Women's Basketball in FIBA competition. Prior to joining the Sun, Meziane was the head coach for successful French women's basketball club, Villeneuve d'Ascq, where he most recently led the team to a Ligue Feminine de Basketball (LFB) Championship and a EuroLeague runner up finish during the 2023-24 season.

Meziane has also found immense achievement on the international basketball stage, having served as the Belgium Women's Basketball National Team Head Coach since November 2022. Meziane led Belgium to it's first-ever FIBA European Women's Championship (EuroBasket) Gold Medal in 2023. Meziane also led the Belgian Women's National team to an impressive fourth place finish at the 2024 Paris Olympics, falling just short to Australia in the bronze medal game.

COMEBACK SEASON

Bria Hartley returns to the Connecticut Sun/WNBA for the first time since the 2022 regular season. The 5-9 guard last played in the league for the Sun in July 2022. but suffered a season-ending ACL injury after just three contests. Hartley signed a training camp contract with Connecticut on May 11 and finds herself on the team's opening day roster. Most recently, Hartley competed in the 2025 Athletes Unlimited season, where she averaged 15.1 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.3 assists per game and finished tenth overall on the league's leader board. She is a two-time NCAA national champion with the University of Connecticut (2013, 2014) and was selected to the 2011-12 WBCA/State Farm All-America Team, becoming the 15th Husky all-time to receive the honor and only the fourth UConn sophomore to be recognized.

BACK IN BOSTON

After a historic sell-out a season ago, the Connecticut Sun will return to TD Garden, home of the Boston Celtics and Boston Bruins, to host the Indiana Fever on Tuesday, July 15. In 2024, the Sun made WNBA history, playing the first-ever WNBA regular season contest in Boston, Massachusetts, selling out the storied arena with an attendance of 19,156, the highest in franchise history. Connecticut defeated the Los Angeles Sparks, 69-61, in the game and will look to stay undefeated in Boston in 2025.

DRAFT DAY SUCCESS

Connecticut enjoyed a successful WNBA Draft ahead of the 2025 season, as it marked the first time the team held multiple first round draft picks since the 2016 WNBA Draft. The No. 7 overall pick also marked the Sun's highest draft position since 2016. With their picks, the Sun selected 6-1 forward **Aneesah Morrow** out of Louisiana State University (No. 7), 6-1 guard Saniya Rivers out of North Carolina State University (No. 8) and 6-4 forward **Rayah Marshall** out of the University of Southern California (No. 25).

COACHING STAFF





RACHID MEZIANE HEAD COACH

On December 4, 2024, the Connecticut Sun announced Rachid Meziane as the franchise's seventh head coach. Meziane, a native of Clermont-Ferrand, France, brings a wealth of basketball knowledge to Connecticut, having enjoyed great success as a head coach in the French women's basketball sphere, as well as a head coach for Belgium Women's Basketball in FIBA competition.

Since the 2019 season, Meziane has served at the head coach of successful French women's basketball club, Villeneuve d'Ascq, where he most recently led the team to a Ligue Feminine de Basketball (LFB) Championship and a EuroLeague runner up finish during the 2023-24 season. The squad finished with a 19-3 record during the regular season and a 6-0 playoff run in LFB competition, with an average margin of victory of 17.7 points per game. Villeneuve also led the league in points per game (86.0), 2FG% (55.0), 3FG% (38.6), and rebounds (36.2), and were second in assists (20.9) and opponent 2FG% (43.9). With the team, he's coached the likes of New York Liberty's Kennedy Burke, former WNBA Most Improved Player and WNBA Champion Shavonte Zellous, and the ninth overall pick of the 2024 WNBA Draft, Carla Leite. Prior to Villeneuve d'Ascq, Meziane served as the head coach for French clubs, Basket Lattes Montpellier Agglomération (BLMA) (2017-2018) and Cavigal Nice Basket (2012-2017).

Meziane has also found immense achievement on the international basketball stage, having served as the Belgium Women's Basketball National Team Head Coach since November 2022. Meziane led Belgium to it's first-ever FIBA European Women's Championship (EuroBasket) Gold Medal in 2023, with an undefeated 6-0 record in the tournament, knocking off France in the semifinals and defeating Spain in the championship matchup. The team's average margin of victory during their EuroBasket run was 25.0 points per game; the dominating success earning Meziane the Belgian Sports Coach of the Year honor in 2023.

Meziane also led the Belgian Women's National team, which included the talents of WNBA Champion and two-time WNBA All-Star Emma Meesseman and Washington Mystics rookie guard Julie Vanloo, to an impressive fourth place finish at the 2024 Paris Olympics, falling just short to Australia in the bronze medal game. Prior to his time with the Belgian team, Meziane was an assistant coach with the France Women's Basketball National Team from 2014-2021 and helped guide the French to silver medals at the 2015, 2017, 2019 and 2021 European Championships and a bronze medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.


