

TOYOTA HALF COURT SHOT OFFICIAL PROMOTION RULES

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR TO WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR ODDS OF WINNING. ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.
2. ELIGIBILITY. Promotion is open to persons 21 years of age or older at time of entry who reside within the state of Oregon and Southwest Washington (ZIP codes of eligibility include 98601, 98604, 98606, 98607, 98629, 98639, 98642, 98648, 98660, 98661, 98662, 98663, 98664, 98665, 98671, 98675, 98682, 98683, 98684, 98685, and 98686), except employees (former and current), agents, successors and assignees of the Portland Fire, Pacific Northwest Toyota Dealers Association ("Prize Provider"), the Women's National Basketball Association ("WNBA") and its Member Teams, WNBA Properties Inc., and each of their respective affiliated companies, subsidiaries, and advertising or promotional agencies, and the family members of, agents, successors, or assigns of, and any persons domiciled with such persons, all of whom are not eligible for entry. The following are also not eligible to enter: (a) current or former professional or semi-professional basketball players or coaches; (b) current or former high school or collegiate basketball players or coaches who have played or coached at that level anywhere in the world within the past five (5) years (includes freshmen, junior varsity and varsity); and (c) persons who have been chosen as a previous contestant/winner in this promotion during the past twelve (12) months.
3. ENTRY. The Portland Fire Toyota Half Court Shot promotion (the "Promotion") will begin at 12:01 a.m. Pacific Prevailing Time ("PPT") on May 22, 2026 and will end at 11:59 p.m. PPT on September 18, 2026 ("Entry Period"). LIMIT OF ONE (1) ENTRY PER PERSON PER EMAIL ADDRESS DURING THE ENTRY PERIOD, REGARDLESS OF METHOD OF ENTRY. Enter by visiting the Portland Fire Toyota Half Court Shot official registration page on https://portlandfire.formstack.com/forms/toyota_half_court_shot, completing all required information, and following all instructions. Submit your entry by clicking on the "SUBMIT" button. You must complete the entire form to enter the Promotion. By entering, each entrant further agrees to be bound by the terms relating to the use of the website, including its Privacy Policy. All entries must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. PPT on September 18, 2026. No mechanical reproductions permitted. The Portland Fire ("Sponsor") will not be responsible for incomplete, lost, late, postage-due, misdirected or illegible entries, or for failure to receive entries due to transmission failures or technical failures of any kind, including, without limitation, malfunctioning of any network, hardware or software, whether originating with sender or Sponsor. In the event of a dispute, all electronic entries will be deemed to have been submitted by the owner of the electronic account from which they were sent. For these purposes, an electronic account holder shall mean the natural person assigned to such account by the Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning electronic addresses for the domain associated with such electronic account. Any questions regarding the number of entries submitted or the owner of an electronic account shall be determined by Sponsor in its reasonable discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entries by persons determined to be tampering with or abusing any aspect of the Promotion as solely determined by Sponsor. In the event any aspect of the Promotion is compromised by a virus, non-authorized human intervention, tampering or other causes beyond the reasonable control of Sponsor which corrupts or impairs the administration, security, fairness or proper operation of the Promotion, Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to suspend, modify or terminate the Promotion.
4. PRIZES. During the Entry Period, Sponsor will choose at random one (1) entrant/contestant from all eligible entries received up to seventy-two (72) hours prior to each of the following thirteen (13) Portland Fire home games: 5/27/26; 5/30/26; 6/11/26; 6/13/26; 6/17/26; 7/9/26; 7/22/26; 7/31/26; 8/2/26; 8/6/26; 8/12/26; 8/23/26; 9/22/26. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to change this schedule. Each of the thirteen (13) contestants randomly selected among the entrants will receive two (2) tickets (seat selection determined in Sponsor's sole discretion) to attend the Fire home game at which their respective attempt (described below) will take place. Total approximate retail value of the two (2) tickets is \$160. Odds of being chosen as a contestant for the Promotion depend on the number of eligible entries up to the date of each random drawing. No contestant shall be permitted any practice, warm up or qualifying shots at any time after his/her notification of participation in the contest, nor will any contestant be selected to participate in this promotion on more than one occasion during the past twelve (12) months. The confirmed contestant may not choose another person to participate on his/her behalf in the Promotion attempt.

During the game for which the contestant has been chosen to participate in the contest, contestant will have one (1) attempt to make a ½-court shot in compliance with the provisions of these Official Promotion Rules to win a new Pacific Northwest Toyota Dealers Association-provided Toyota branded vehicle (specific make and model of vehicle to randomly be determined as described below). The vehicles on the wheel and their manufacturer's suggested retail value ("MSRP") will be as follows: 2026 Corolla Cross XLE - \$31,410, 2026 Corolla Cross XLE - \$31,410, 2026 Camry XSE - \$37,225, 2026 Camry XSE - \$37,225, 2026 RAV4 XLE - \$37,500, 2026 RAV4 XLE - \$37,500, 2026 Tacoma SR5 - \$40,605, 2026 Tacoma SR5 - \$40,605, 2026 4Runner SR5 - \$43,870, 2026 4Runner SR5 - \$43,870, 2026 Grand Highlander XLE AWD - \$46,030, 2026 Grand Highlander XLE AWD - \$46,030, and 2026 Tundra SR5 - \$51,510. Details and amenities included with each vehicle subject to Sponsor's sole discretion.

To determine which Pacific Northwest Toyota Dealers Association-provided Toyota branded vehicle the contestant will be attempting the shot for, The Portland Fire will randomly select one (1) of the thirteen (13) available vehicles. Once a vehicle has been selected, it will not be available to be selected for subsequent ½-court shot attempts.

5. The contestant must attempt to make one untimed ½-court shot using a Sponsor provided WNBA-regulation basketball (or one of equivalent specifications) through the WNBA-regulation basketball hoop of the target goal. The rim of the target hoop will be not less than ten (10) feet above the floor. The contestant must attempt the ½-court shot from behind the demarcation line measured forty-three (43) feet from the backboard of the target goal. The contestant will have only one (1) attempt to make the ½-court shot in compliance with all provisions of these Official Promotion Rules. An attempt will be deemed to have occurred when the basketball has been released by the contestant. No part of the contestant's body or clothing may come in contact with or cross the demarcation line prior to releasing the ball. In order to be counted as a successful ½-court shot, the basketball must pass completely through the target hoop on the fly, from the point of release from the contestant's hand(s), without coming in contact with the ground, any person, or any surface other than the backboard or hoop, and would otherwise constitute a successful shot scoring a goal under WNBA regulations.
6. **CONTESTANT/WINNER NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE.** Each contestant who is chosen to receive/win game tickets will be notified by phone within seventy-two (72) hours before the start of the game at which he/she will be given the opportunity to attempt the ½-court shot. In the event contact with the chosen contestant is not confirmed within the allotted time, or if contestant declines to participate as a contestant, another contestant will be randomly chosen. If a contestant who is chosen to receive game tickets is disqualified, a new contestant will be selected in a random drawing. The contestant may waive their right to receive a prize. Prizes are nonassignable and nontransferable. No substitutions allowed, except that prizes and individual components of prize packages are subject to availability and Sponsor and/or Prize Provider, as applicable, reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. Each contestant is solely responsible for reporting and payment of any federal, state, local, and municipal taxes on any prize and for payment of all expenses associated with the Promotion other than game tickets, such as, but not limited to, parking. Each contestant chosen to attempt the ½-court shot will be required to complete an affidavit of eligibility, and a liability and publicity release (except where prohibited by law) before attempting the ½-court shot. Each contestant will also be required to complete the "Contestant Agreement to Participate" provided by Sponsor's prize indemnifier before attempting the ½-court shot. Failure to sign and return the affidavit, release or the Contestant Agreement to Participate, or to comply with any term or condition of these Official Promotion Rules, may, at the sole discretion of Sponsor, result in disqualification and the forfeiture of his or her interest in the prize. Except where prohibited, participation in the Promotion constitutes the contestant's consent to the publication, dissemination and use of his or her name, photograph, image, likeness and voice by Sponsor, Prize Provider, their designees, the WNBA and its Member Teams, and/or WNBA Properties, Inc., in any media at any time for any purpose without any additional compensation to, permission from or inspection by such contestant. If any contestant makes the ½-court shot, such contestant agrees to execute all necessary and requested documents, including without limitation the "Winner's Affidavit and Release", as requested by Sponsor and Sponsor's prize indemnifier and agree to provide a copy of a government issued identification card containing a photo of the contestant/winner.
7. **PARTICIPATION.** By entering into the promotion, participating in the ½-court shot contest and/or accepting any prize, the entrant/contestant/winner agrees to be bound by these Official Promotion Rules and the decisions of

Sponsor. Should the Promotion be terminated prior to the stated expiration date, Sponsor reserves the right to award any prize based on the entries received before the termination date.

8. **CONTESTANT/WINNER RELEASES.** By entering the Promotion and accepting any prize, such entrant/contestant/winner releases the Portland Fire, Pacific Northwest Toyota Dealers Association, Toyota Motor Sales, U.S.A., Inc. ("TMS/USA"), the WNBA and its Member Teams, WNBA Properties Inc., any other promotional sponsors, and each of their respective affiliated companies, and subsidiaries, directors, officers, employees, representatives, partners and agents from any liability whatsoever for any claims, costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind arising out of or in connection with the Promotion or with the acceptance, possession or use of any prize (including, without limitation, any claim, cost, injury, loss or damage related to any personal injury, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, right of publicity or privacy, defamation or portrayal in a false light).
9. **LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY.** By entering the Promotion and accepting any prize, each entrant/contestant/winner agrees that (1) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with the Promotion, or any prize awarded, shall be resolved individually without resort to any form of class action; (2) any claim, judgment or award shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering the Promotion, but in no event attorney's fees; and (3) under no circumstances will any entrant/contestant/winner be permitted to obtain any award for, and each contestant/winner hereby waives any and all rights to claim, punitive, incidental or consequential damages and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased and any other damages, other than damages for actual out-of-pocket expenses.
10. **CONSTRUCTION.** All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Promotion Rules, or the rights and obligations of any entrant/contestant/winner and/or Sponsor and/or Prize Provider, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions (whether of Oregon, or any other jurisdiction) that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than Oregon. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Official Promotion Rules shall not affect the invalidity or unenforceability of any other provision. In the event that any such provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable, these Official Promotion Rules shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or unenforceable provision was not contained therein. Each entrant/contestant/winner agrees that should any dispute arise between such entrant/contestant and Sponsor's prize indemnifier, such dispute must be submitted to binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association. The venue for such arbitration shall be Portland, Oregon.
11. **SPONSOR.** The ½ Court Shot promotion is sponsored by the Portland Fire. Sponsor's decisions regarding the selection of any contestant/winner and any other aspect of the Promotion shall be final and binding in all respects. Sponsor will not be responsible for any typographical, printing or other inadvertent errors in these Official Promotion Rules or in any other materials relating to the Promotion.
