LAST GAME: Chicago's 88-86 win over Washington on Saturday, Aug. 1 was the Mystics' first loss of the season, and officially put an end to their standing as only remaining undefeated team of 2020 season.

- Sky beat the Mystics on a game winning shot by Cheyenne Parker with 5.9 seconds remaining.
- The Sky held a 9-point lead with 4:57 left in the 4th.
- Washington fought back to tie the score with 13.8 seconds left before Parker's game winning shot.
- It was the 2nd time this season a Sky player hit the winning shot under 10 seconds, the last being Allie Quigley's three-pointer vs. Las Vegas.
- Chicago was led by Cheyenne Parker and Gabby Williams with 16 points each.

SKY WINS THIS SEASON: The Sky's three wins this season came against three of the top four teams in the WNBA last season. In 2019, the teams finished...

CHICAGO VS. DALLAS



- The Sky finished 2019 with a 2-1 record vs. Dallas, splitting 2 games at home (winning 78-66 on July 7, 2019 and losing 88-83 on Aug. 29, 2019) while winning the only game in Dallas 89-79 on July 14, 2019.
- Chicago is 8-4 all-time vs. Dallas.
- The Sky had 5 players average double-figures vs. Dallas in 2019:
 - ❖ Led by **Jantel Lavender** (18 PPG in 2 games, + team-leading 8.5 RPG)
 - ❖ Followed by **Diamond DeShields** (17.7 PPG)
 - ❖ **Allie Quigley** (12 PPG)
 - ❖ **Courtney Vandersloot** (11.3 PPG)
 - ❖ **Stefanie Dolson** (10.3 PPG)
- Wings were led in 2019 vs. Sky by Arike Ogunbowale, who averaged 25.7 PPG, including a career-high 35 in the lone Wings win against the Sky.
- Dallas is the current home of two members of the 2019 Sky team:
 - **Katie Lou Samuelson** was traded to Dallas for **Azura Stevens** during the off-season. Samuelson is averaging 5.5 PPG, including a career-high 12 vs .the Liberty on July 29, 2020.
 - **Astou Ndour** was acquired by the Wings in the offseason by a sign-and trade-deal with the Sky. Ndour averaged 16.5 PPG and 8.5 RPG during the Sky playoff run in 2019. She is currently averaging 6 PPG on 40% shooting for the Wings.

COLSON ON THE SOCIAL JUSTICE COUNCIL

"That fueled me to want to even come into the bubble because I knew that the WNBA, the Players Association, would be giving us an opportunity to make our voices be heard and to let us speak on an issue that affects us, and affect our intersectionality. So, it's been big. I can't wait to actually meet the council and be around the rest of the league. I think that people will enjoy and learn from a lot of the things that we'll present to everyone. It's an awesome opportunity and I hope that people will help us amplify our message and people feel like they are gaining something from it and then that they take action and change things in their lives and in the lives of their family and friends."

EXCELLING IN HER ROLE: Copper has had the best start to a season of her career, posting a double-digit scoring total in three of her first four games. In addition, she has shot north of 50% from the floor in every game this season. Her 14.8 PPG is nearly nine points higher than her career average throughout her first four seasons in the WNBA (6.7).

Head Coach and GM James Wade on Copper:

"I'm trying to diversify her game and making her a more complete player, but where we're satisfied with her progress. So we're just going to keep going."

LEADING AT ALL COSTS: Despite the COVID-19 Pandemic, Copper is still looking to use her organization 2K Skills and Drills to help provide opportunities for young girls to play basketball in Philadelphia. She has donated \$590 (59 points) to #SkyTakes Action this season through four games.

GAINING MOMENTUM: DeShields played her best game of the season Saturday against Washington, scoring 10 points off the bench while shooting four of six from the floor. Despite her limited playing time, she continues to be incredibly efficient when in the game. Over the course of her first four games, DeShields has a plus-minus of 24.

TAKING ACTION: DeShields joins teammate Gabby Williams as serving as the face and leader of the Sky's #SkyTakesAction campaign for this season. She and Williams worked alongside former Chicago Bears linebacker Sam Acho to develop the campaign in partnership with Athletes for Justice. Through her scoring so far, DeShields has contributed \$320 (32 points).

DeShields on how #SkyTakesAction has motivated her: "It's everything. It's literally the reason why I put my jersey, it's the reason why I came out here. There was no way I was going to come out here and just dismiss myself from what's going on in the world right now. So, to have partnered up with Athletes For Justice and my teammates and everybody else, our sponsors to be on board with this, it's all the motivation that any of us needs on game days."

A RETURN TO NORMALCY: After failing to play in at least 33 games for the first time in her career in 2018, Dolson responded in 2019 by starting and appearing in all 34 games. She continued to be one of the most efficient options on the floor for the Sky, as she finished fourth in the league in field goal percentage (51.9%). Dolson also made at least 30 three-point field goals for the second time in three years, shooting 36.1% from distance.

AN ACTIVE LEADER: Dolson will be working with the Brave Space Alliance, which is a black and trans-led organization that supports and educates the LGBTQ community, as part of her work toward social justice this season. She has contributed \$80 (8 points) toward the #SkyTakesAction campaign thus far.

She followed up her strong season debut with another impressive performance, scoring 12 points on four of five shooting while again leading the team in plus-minus (33). Parker has contributed \$530 (53 points) to the #SkyTakesAction campaign this season. Parker has led or tied the Sky in scoring in back-to-back games (16).

Parker on the #SkyTakesAction campaign: "The fact that we are doing something, and we're taking action as a team, as a program, representing the Chicago Sky I think it's really dope that we are taking initiative and trying to just raise awareness and get other people to take action.
