KEY RUNS

- The Sky opened the first three minutes of the game on a 9-3 run. Chicago continued to push its lead late in the first, going up 19-11 at the 3:20 mark in the quarter.
- After leading by one at the end of the first, Chicago began the second frame on a 13-5 run, extending its lead to nine during the first three minutes. Chicago led for the entire first half.
- Connecticut tied the game at 66 with just under three minutes to play in the third quarter, followed by a 15-5 run from the Sky to close out the frame.

KEY STATS

- Chicago outscored Connecticut 26-18 in the paint during the first half and shot 65% (19-29) from the floor.
- The Sky shot 29-32 (90.6%) from the free throw line, including a perfect 12-12 mark from Cheyenne Parker.
- Connecticut's bench outscored Chicago's 31-25. a

CHICAGO NOTES

- This was the 6th consecutive game where the Sky's starting five featured Courtney Vandersloot, Kahleah Copper, Allie Quigley, Azurá Stevens and Cheyenne Parker.
- Chicago has recorded at least 20 assists as a team in 5 of its first 7 games this season.
- The Sky is now 5-1 when **Courtney Vandersloot** records at least eight assists this season.
- Chicago began the game making seven of its first nine shots (77.8%), shooting a 3-3 from distance. **Quigley** scored 12 of the Sky's first 19 points, shooting a perfect 7-7 from the floor with two three-point field goals.
- Quigleyand Diamond DeShields shot combined 14-20 (70%), with Quigley going 3-4 from distance
- **DeShields** scored season-high 14 points as she plays her way back to recovery.
- Sky's 52-point total through 2 quarters was its highest of the season (1st half) and 1st time the team hit 50-points in the 1st half.
- **Copper** recorded career-high steals (4). Her previous mark had been set at 2 vs. Los Angeles Sparks on July 28. In addition, her 17 pts tonight made it 6 of 7 games for the 5th-year player where she has reached a double-figure scoring total.

CONNECTICUT NOTES

- Jasmine Thomas (12), Kalia Charles (11) and DeWanna Bonner (8) scored 31 of the Sun's first 37 points.
- The aforementioned trio all reached a double-digit scoring total by the end of the first half, with **Charles** shooting 80% (4-5) from the floor.
- Connecticut began the second half making six of its first shots, including two three-point field goals.
- The Sun had six players post a double-digit scoring total, three of which scored 15 or more.
