SKY GENERAL MANAGER & HEAD COACH JAMES WADE

On the team's defensive effort tonight:

"We got a chance to play them. We got some practice time and I appreciated the effort from all 10 players. It helped having Stefanie [Dolson], because she's a communicator, she's a talker. So it kind of gave us energy, gave us life on the defensive end. And I think we executed the game plan to where we wanted. The coaches did a good scout, and we followed the scout. We executed it and I was pleased with our effort."

On the offensive production:

"Our offense is predicated on movement so we're going to create some disadvantages whether that be at two or three. So we were able to get into the lane, and get layups. And so we figured that's what they were giving us. I mean a lot of teams are going to be on us at the three so we'll just drive it if they're going to do that. We didn't shoot the ball well from three but we shot 55% from the field. That's probably one of our most efficient games if you take the three-point line out of it. So, we're actually pleased with that part. I don't think it's too many games [that] we'll go one for 11. We'll adjust but hopefully next game they won't put that much pressure on us to drive and we can make some more shots."

On slowing Brittney Griner down:

"I mean, the thing is we have more bodies and we were fresher. To have Cheyenne [Parker] by herself that's a big load for her. To have Stefanie Dolson in there with her and then be able to throw Ruthy [Hebard] in there for a few minutes I think that helped throwing multiple bodies at her."

On what she saw from Phoenix's defense:

"I think my teammates were setting good off-ball screens and then off of pick and roll, I was just trying to be a little bit more aggressive when the shot clock was going down and just finding any way to get the shot off. Struggled a little bit in the first half but just tried to stay positive and confident and luckily it followed in the second [half]."

On what has been working for her the last few games:

"Just I think finding my rhythm the more we play games. And the more you have good games offensively you bring that confidence and aggression into the next game so I just think I've been a little bit more aggressive and shooting every single day, and just getting into a better rhythm."
