## **CHICAGO SKY TALKING POINTS**

GAME DAY VS. CONNECTICUT SUN FRIDAY, AUGUST. 14, 2020



### SKY AT "HOME"

- $\rightarrow$  Sky is 4-0 as the home team in 2020
- → Chicago was 12-5 at home in 2019
- → Sky's best record at home in a season is 14-3 in 2013

## **LAST GAME**

- Chicago outscored the Mercury 52-28 in the paint. The Sky hit 26 of their 42 attempts (62%) in the lane to overcome their worst performance of the season beyond the 3-point line (1-11: 9.1%). Their performance was against the team leading the league in blocks.
- ♦ Last time a Sky team only made 1 3PT FG was 5/14/17 @ Minnesota.
- The 52 points in the paint was the 5th highest total in Sky history (58 is the team record).
- Sky grabbed 12 offensive rebounds in the game (tied for the team's most in a game this season also against Phoenix) and scored 19 2<sup>nd</sup>-chance points in the game (their high for the season).

### SKY VS. SUN - GAME 1

- Sky scored 100 points in a game for the first time this season, winning 100-93.
- ◆ Chicago has scored 100 or more points in each of the last 2 games against Connecticut, winning their last game on 2019 against the Sun 109–104 in OT.
- Sky shot 55.2% from the field vs. the Sun in their last game, their best shooting performance of the year.
- Chicago drew 25 Sun fouls and shot 32 free throws in their last game both highs for the season.
  - $\Rightarrow$  The 32 FTs were the most by a Sky team since 6/3/18 when they shot 38 vs. Las Vegas.

## CHICAGO VS. CONNECTICUT - ALL-TIME

- ♦ Sky is 1-0 this season vs. Connecticut.
- Chicago took the season series in 2019, winning 2 of the 3 games.
  - $\Rightarrow$  6/23/19: SKY 93 Sun 75 (@ CHI)
  - ⇒ 7/30/19: SUN 100 Sky 94 (@ CON)
  - $\Rightarrow~9/6/19$ : SKY 109 Sun 104 OT (@ CON) \*Sky's only OT game of the season
- ♦ Chicago is 25-28 all-time vs the Sun
- The last time Sky swept the season series from Sun was 2013 when they won all 4 games played.

## **SKY SHOOTING**

- → Every Sky player is shooting over 40% from the field this season.
- ightarrow All but DeShields are shooting above 45% and 6 players are shooting above 50%.
- $\rightarrow$  5 Sky players are averaging in double-figures.
- ightarrow No Sky team has ever finished a season with more than 4 players averaging in double-figures.

### **#2 KAHLEAH COPPER**



- ♦ Leads Sky in scoring (14.4 PPG)
- Double-figure scoring in 6 straight games and 8 of 9 for the season.
  - → Prior to 2020, Copper had never had double-figure scoring in more than 7 games in a season nor more than 3 games in a row.
- Her 10th start of the season for the Sky will tie her career-high for most starts in a season.
- $\rightarrow$  She had 10 in 2017 for the Sky.
- ♦ Averaging career-highs in PPG (more than 2x any other year of her career), MPG, FG%, RPG, APG, SPG.

# **#14 ALLIE QUIGLEY**

- ♦ 2<sup>ND</sup> on Sky in scoring (14.2 PPG)
- Did not make a 3-point FG in last game vs Phoenix.
  - → Her first game this year without a 3 FGM. Had made a 3 FGM in 14 straight games.
  - → In 2019 when she had most 3 PT FGM in WNBA, she made 3-pointers in 31 of 34 games.
- Against Phoenix, Quigley scored 20 PTS or more without a 3-point FGM for the first time in her career.
  - → For her career, Quigley has scored 20 or more points in 33 games.
  - → Three times she had only 1 three-pointer in the game. Every other time she had 2 or more.
- Prior to the Phoenix game, Quigley has made at least 1 three-point FG in each game she had scored 17 or more points (a total of 61 games in her career).
- When you get down to 16 points scored in a game, she scored that twice without a 3-point FG:
  - $\rightarrow$  6/24/15 vs. Atlanta
  - → 5/26/16 @ San Antonio

### **#32 CHEYENNE PARKER**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> on the Sky in scoring (13.0 PPG)
- Enters today's game having made 19 consecutive free throws.
- ♦ Scored season-high 20 points (in 23 minutes) in last game vs. Connecticut.

### **#22 COURTNEY VANDERSLOOT**

- ◆ Tied for 4<sup>th</sup> on the Sky in scoring (11.4 PPG).
- ♦ Held under 8 assists in a game for only the 2<sup>nd</sup> time this season vs. Phoenix.
- Reached double-figures in scoring for the 5<sup>th</sup> time this season vs. Phoenix.
- Averaging 2.3 turnovers per game, which is 2nd lowest of her career.
  - $\rightarrow$  Lowest is 1.6 per game in 2016.

## **#30 AZURÁ STEVENS**

- ◆ Tied for 4<sup>th</sup> on the Sky in scoring (11.4 PPG)
- Averaging career-highs in every offensive category.
- ♦ Had blocks in 7 straight games before being shutout vs Phoenix.
  - → Career high in blocks is 9 straight games in 2018.

## **#15 GABBY WILLIAMS**

- ♦ Averaging a career-high 8.6 PPG.
- Needs 8 more steals to reach 100 for her career.
- ♦ When Williams shoots 50% or better from the field, Sky is 6-0.
- After averaging 2 3PT FGM per game over the first 5 games, has gone 0-7 over the last 4 games.
- After averaging 24 MPG over the first 7 games of the season and not playing less than 20 in any game, has averaged only 17.5 MPG over the last two games.

### **#31 STEFANIE DOLSON**

- In her first game back from injury, scored 8 points and had 9 rebounds in only 15 minutes of play.
- Shot 4-4 from the field vs. Phoenix.
- ♦ In 2019 and 2020, Chicago is 6-2 in games that Dolson has 8 or more rebounds.



- Needs 1 more 3 PT FGM to reach 100 for her career.
- Needs 46 points to reach 2,000 for her career.
- Needs 2 games played to reach 200 for her career.

### **SKY CAREER SCORING**

⇒ Both Allie Quigley and Courtney Vandersloot are getting close to overtaking Sylvia Fowles for career scoring leadership.

## **SKY TURNOVERS**

- Chicago continues to have issues with protecting the ball; they have had 16 or more turnovers in each of the last 4 games (including 20 or more in 3 of the 4).
- Sky has allowed 20 or more points off TOs in each of the last 4 games (and 6 of the 9 games this season).
- The last time a Sky team allowed 20 or more points off turnovers in 4 straight games was Jun 27, 2009 –Jul 7, 2009.
- Chicago ranks 11<sup>th</sup> in TPG (17.7) and last in opponent points off turnovers per game (20.9) in 2020.
