SERIES NOTES

- Tonight's game is the second of 2020 against a team that the Sky has already played this season.
- Last year, Sky won two of three meetings against the Sun.
- Chicago has won three of its last four against Connecticut.
- Sky is 25-28 all-time vs. the Sun. Diamond DeShields scored 30 points during an overtime game against Connecticut on September 6, 2019. It was the highest scoring total by a Sky player in 2019.

LAST GAME VS. Connecticut

- Sky won the first meeting of the two teams this season 100-93 on Aug. 8, 2020.
- Chicago was led by **Allie Quigley and Cheyenne Parker**, who scored 42 points total (22 & 20 respectively) on a combined 12-20 (60%) shooting.
- Sky shot 90.6% (29-32) from the free throw line compared to a 76.2% (16-21) clip from the Sun.
- Chicago scored 100 points for the first time this season, and it remains the only game to this point where it has reached that total.

CONNECTICUT OVER LAST FOUR GAMES

- Averaging 84 PPG, nearly nine points higher than average from first five games (75.4).
- Shooting 48.5% from the floor compared to a 38.9% clip in first five games.
- Has earned all of its wins (3) in the four game stretch.

NEWS AND NOTES

LASTGAME: The Sky responded from Monday's loss to Seattle by defeating Phoenix for the fourth time in its last five games against each other on Wednesday. Chicago shot 54.5% (34-66) from the floor, including 38 rebounds, 26 of which were defensive. The Sky's starting five accounted for 65 of the team's 89 points, with center Stefanie Dolson coming off the bench in her first game since the opener against Las Vegas. She made an immediate impact, shooting a perfect 4-4 with eight points and tying for the team-high in rebounds with Cheyenne Parker (9).

OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION: Chicago ranks first in both field goal percentage (49.0%) and in assists per game (21.1). It is also fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (36.8%). Only the Seattle Storm and Los Angeles Sparks rank among the top-four in those respective categories throughout the rest of the league.

TURNOVERWOES: Chicago ranks 11th in TPG (17.7) and is last in the league in opponent points off turnovers (20.9). Despite limiting the Mercury to just 71 points during Wednesday's game, Chicago still committed 15 turnovers. The Sky has yet to have a game this season where it records fewer than 13 turnovers (Dallas, August 4).

BACK TO SCHOOL: Courtney Vandersloot announced on August 12 that she will be donating \$20 for each assist she records this season to DonorsChoose, an organization that helps cover the cost of classroom supplies for teachers across the country. She has contributed \$810 through her first nine games this season, roughly a fifth of her \$5000 goal. Wednesday's game against Phoenix was the third time this season where she recorded one assist or fewer in the first half (0 vs. Minnesota on July 30, 1 vs. Washington on August 1).

1000CLUB OPENING UP (WITH PROPER SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES): Kahleah Copper reached 1,000 career points during Wednesday's game against Phoenix, reaching the milestone on her seventh of 15 points. It was the second consecutive game where a Sky player reached 1,000 career points, as Cheyenne Parker recorded the milestone during Monday's game against Seattle.

COPPER'S CONSISTENCY: Copper has been a cornerstone to the Sky's 6-3 start, as she has gone six straight games with a double-digit scoring total and also has played at least 30 minutes in four straight games (and five of her last six). She currently just edges out Allie Quigley for the team lead in PPG (14.6), which is more than double her career average of 7.2 PPG.

SCORINGSTREAK FOR A CAUSE: Allie Quigley continues to hold her own as well, as she has reached a double-digit scoring total in every game this season and is the only Sky player who has done so. Over the course of her last six games, she is averaging 16.3 PPG and has played in at least 25 minutes in each of those outings.

WILLIAMS' SHOOTING IMPORTANCE: When Gabby Williams has shot 50% or better from the floor this season, Chicago is 6-0. Williams has shot 24-40 (60%) from the field and 10-17 (58.8%) from the three while averaging 10.3 PPG in those games.

WORKPAYINGOFFFOR STEVENS: Azurá Stevens is averaging career-highs in almost every major statistical category, including minutes (27.1), field goal percentage (51.3%), 3-point field goal percentage (44.2%, shot 11.1% last season), rebounds (5.8), assists (1.7), blocks (1.6) and points (11.4). Her 10-point performance against Phoenix on Wednesday marked the sixth time this season where she recorded a double-digit scoring total, and her second straight game with 10 points.

RECENT CAREER ACHIEVEMENTS

- Cheyenne Parker marked 1,000 career points vs. Seattle on Monday.
- Kahleah Copper reached 100 career assists vs. Seattle and scored her 1,000 point on Wednesday against Phoenix.

COLSON ON THE SOCIAL JUSTICE COUNCIL

"That fueled me to want to even come into the bubble because I knew that the WNBA, the Players Association, would be giving us an opportunity to make our voices be heard and to let us speak on an issue that affects us, and affect our intersectionality. So, it's been big. I can't wait to actually meet the council and be around the rest of the league. I think that people will enjoy and learn from a lot of the things that we'll present to everyone. It's an awesome opportunity and I hope that people will help us amplify our message and people feel like they are gaining something from it and then that they take action and change things in their lives and in the lives of their family and friends."

She has played at least 25 minutes in six consecutive games, averaging 16.3 PPG in that stretch. The veteran has scored at least 20 points in two of her last three games, shooting a combined 56.7% (21-37) from the floor in those outings.

On #SkyTakesAction-Stevens has donated \$1,030 (103 points) this season.

"When they did the 26 seconds for Breonna Taylor before the game I took a minute just to talk to myself like, 'I'm going to go out here and just play as hard as I can for that.' It's just crazy still that honestly like that happened and these cops haven't been arrested and people are just walking around like that's OK. And so I'm praying and hoping that they finally get the justice that they deserve. But yeah, I mean I think it motivates especially our team a little bit more because we're dedicating a season just to raise awareness and to make actual change. I don't know, like we've been talking about this for a long time before we even came here. Personal experiences we've all had just with racism and social injustice. YOU GO WE GO: On July 30 against Minnesota, Vandersloot passed Becky Hammon for fifth all-time on the WNBA's assist list.

The veteran guard continues to play heavy minutes despite being in her 10th season. Vandersloot leads the team in minutes played (30.6), nearly two more minutes than Kahleah Copper who ranks second (29.4).

Vandersloot has contributed \$1,030 (103 points) to the #SkyTakesAction campaign throughout the course of the first nine games this season. In addition, she announced on August 12 that for each assist she records this season, Vandersloot will donate \$20 to DonorsChoose, an organization that helps provide classroom supplies for teachers. Through the first nine games this season, she has contributed \$810 to the initiative, nearly 20% of her \$5000 goal.

Chicago is 5-2 when Vandersloot records eight or more assists this season. She leads the league in assists per game (8.4), nearly four more than second-place Diana Taurasi of Phoenix (5.9).
