

NEWS, NOTES, TALKING POINTS

LAST GAME: The Sky lost its sixth of its last seven games on Wednesday to the Atlanta Dream, including its fourth straight. It is the longest losing streak of the season for Chicago. It had a four-game losing streak once in 2019, which was its longest. **COURTNEY VANDERSLOOT** led the Sky in scoring, dropping 22 points while dishing out in 11 assists. **KAHLEAH COPPER** and **ALLIE QUIGLEY** also each scored 17 points. The only other player for Chicago to reach a double-digit scoring total was **GABBY WILLIAMS** (12).

POSTSEASON BUBBLE BASKETBALL: Chicago clinched the postseason for the second straight year on September 1 after the Indiana Fever lost to the Atlanta Dream. It needs to win its final game of the regular season tonight to reach a winning season, which would be the fifth in franchise history. The Sky has not had back-to-back winning seasons since 2015 and 2016, going 21-13 and 18-16 respectively.

A CHANCE TO STAND ALONE (AGAIN): COURTNEY VANDERSLOOT was named the WNBA's Eastern Conference Player of the Month for August, the first time she has earned the honor. She averaged 13.6 PPG and 9.5 APG in the Sky's 14 games. During the game against Indiana on August 31, she broke Ticha Penicheiro's record for most assists in a game (18, previously set at 16). She continued her strong stretch of play on Wednesday by posting her 56th career game with a double-figure assist total, and her 37th career double-double. It was her first 20-point, 10-assist game this season and the eighth of her career. Vandersloot has gone 10 straight games with at least nine assists. She announced on August 12 that she will be donating \$10 for each assist she records this season to DonorsChoose, an organization that helps cover the cost of classroom supplies for teachers across the country. She has contributed \$2,070 through 21 games this season, and with the overwhelming support from her fans she has easily surpassed her \$5,000 goal with still a game to play. Vandersloot leads the WNBA with 9.9 APG, over four more than Jordin Canada who ranks second (5.7). She needs 13 assists against the Wings to finish the season averaging 10 APG, which would make her the first player in WNBA history to do so.

OFFENSE CLOSE TO MAKING HISTORY: Chicago ranks first in field goal percentage (48.8%) and second assists per game (21.7). If the Sky's field goal percentage keeps its pace, it will break the all-time record for highest ever in a season (Los Angeles Sparks 2016, 48.7%). Sky is fourth in blocks per game (4.0), points (86.3) and 3-pointers made (161).

TURNOVERS DICTACTING GAMES: The Sky only committed four turnovers in the first half on Wednesday against the Dream, giving itself a 10-point lead through the first two frames. However, Chicago gave the ball away seven times in the second half, causing Atlanta to score 13 points off those takeaways and come back from an 18-point deficit. Chicago ranks 10th in both TPG (15.8) and opponent points of turnovers (18.1).

MOST IMPROVED CANDIDATE: KAHLEAH COPPER is averaging 15.0 PPG, and is shooting a career-best 49.8% from the floor. She played over 30 minutes for the eighth straight occasion on Wednesday (33). Her 17-point performance against the Dream marked the 19th time this season where she reached a double-digit scoring total. In addition, her seven rebounds against Atlanta was the fourth time in her last five games where Copper pulled in seven or more boards.

CHICAGO'S ALL-TIME HOUSEHOLD: ALLIE QUIGLEY became the Sky's all-time leading scorer during the game against Minnesota on September 2, surpassing Sylvia Fowles (2,927 points). Her wife **COURTNEY VANDERSLOOT** passed Fowles for No. 2 all-time during Wednesday's game against Atlanta. Quigley has reached a double-digit scoring total in 20 of 21 games this season, including nine straight. She has attempted 52 shots over her last two games, shooting at a 28.9% clip. Quigley is shooting a career-best 91.9% from the free throw line (minimum 10 attempts). She made 26 consecutive free throws before missing one against Los Angeles on Sunday.

HEBARD'S ELITE SHOOTING PERCENTAGE: Ruthy Hebard currently ranks first in the WNBA in field goal percentage (minimum 10 attempts), with a 67.1% clip from the floor during her first 21 career games. She has shot better than 50% in 14 consecutive outings. Her double-double on August 31 was the first to be done by a Sky rookie since Diamond DeShields scored 23 points and brought in 11 rebounds against the Atlanta Dream on June 27, 2018. Hebard is the ninth rookie in Sky franchise history to record a double-double.
