#### KEY RUNS

- Minnesota opened the first two minutes of the game on an 8-0 run.
- The Lynx continued their strong first half by going on a 9-2 run within the first four minutes of the second quarter.
- During the first two minutes of the third quarter, Minnesota opened it up on a 9-2 run to give it its biggest lead at the time (17).
- The Sky went on a 13-2 run midway through the third quarter to cut the Lynx's lead to seven (64-57).
- Minnesota ended the third quarter on a 8-2 run, pushing its lead back to eight.

#### KEY STATS

- The Sky committed 15 team turnovers in the first half, which also produced 15 points for the Lynx.
- Chicago shot better than Minnesota in the first half (50% to 48.8%), but with Minnesota forcing as many turnovers as it did it was able to build a 10-point lead.
- Both teams scored 36 points in the paint. Chicago came into tonight's game second in the league in that category (38.2) while Minnesota was seventh (34.4).

#### CHICAGO NOTES

- Sky's bench scored 13 of its first 17 points, including a quick 10 from **Cheyenne Parker**. She finished with 20 points on 9-15 (60%) shooting and a career-high 15 rebounds, scoring in double figures for the first time since August 16 against the Atlanta Dream (17 points), and posting her second double-double this season (first was also against Minnesota on July 30).
- **Gabby Williams** swiped her 100th career steal during the second quarter. She finished tonight's game logging 36.6 minutes, three points, two steals, four assists and six rebounds. Over the course of Williams' last 18 games (including three starts) this season, she has averaged 7.7 points, 1.2 steals, 2.2 assists, and 4.2 rebounds across 24.2 minutes per game.
- **Allie Quigley** extended her double-digit points streak to six games tonight off her 23 point-performance. She has reached a double figure scoring total in 17 of 18 games this season.
- The Sky's 15 turnovers in the first half was the most it had through the first two quarters this season (previously set at 12 on August 4 vs. Connecticut). In addition, its 23 turnovers was the most in a single game in franchise history.
- **Courtney Vandersloot's** eight turnovers tied her career-high (previously set at eight twice on August 9, 2012 and June, 1 2018, both against the Connecticut Sun). It was her seventh straight game with at least nine assists, her 53rd game with a double-digit assist total and 35th career double-double.
- **Kahleah Copper** scored 10 points, which extended her double-digit scoring streak to 15 games.

#### MINNESOTA NOTES

- **Crystal Dangerfield** scored six of the Lynx's first eight points, where Minnesota made three of its first four shots.
- Tonight's game was the first that center **Sylvia Fowles** missed against the Sky since she was traded to the Lynx prior to the 2015 season.
- Minnesota has won six of its last eight games, and has swept the Sky in the regular season for the second straight year.
