



SKY IN CLOSE GAMES

- Sky is 5-1 in games decided by 3 or fewer points.
- In 2019, the team was 2-3 in games decided by 3 or fewer points.

BEST START

- The Sky's 8-4 record ties its best for 12 games in team history. The 2013 team also started 8-4 on their way to a 24-10 record.

RECAP OF LAST GAME

- Sky outscore Aces 25-12 in the 3rd quarter
- Sky held an 11-point lead in the 4th with 2:30 remaining before an 11-0 Aces run tied the game at 82 with :13.6 seconds to go.
- Sky held A'ja Wilson, the 2nd leading scorer in the WNBA entering the game, to 11 points and 3 for 12 shooting- her worst shooting performance against a Sky team (previously 4 for 12)
- Sky held Aces to 38.2% shooting for the game- the 3rd consecutive game they have held an opponent under 40% shooting
- Sky limited the Aces to 36 points in the paint (on 18 for 41 shooting- 43.9%) after allowing them 46 points (on 23 for 44-52.3%) in their first meeting
- Sky's 10 blocked shots in the game was the team's most since 8/5/17 when they had 11 vs Atlanta

#2 KAHLEAH COPPER

- **Sky leading scorer: 14.3 PPG**
- Season high 17 shots vs Las Vegas
- Double-figure scoring in all but one game this year. The 11 double-figure scoring games are more than any other season in her career (7 in 2019 & 18, 6 in 2017 & 16)

#14 ALLIE QUIGLEY

- No. 2 scorer on Sky: 13.9 PPG
- Vs. Las Vegas- 1st game this season not in double figures
- Shooting 25% from three over the last 4 games (4-16). Had shot 51.7% from three the previous 5 games while hitting three 3-pointers in each of the 5 games
- 1st time since 2016 she is averaging below 40% three-point shooting

#32 CHEYENNE PARKER

- No. 3 scorer on Sky: 13.7 PPG
- Missed her 1st game of 2020 vs. Las Vegas. Last game she missed 7/30/17. Had played in 79 consecutive games.
- Vs. Atlanta: Second game of the season coming off the bench for the Sky. Sky is 2-0 in those games.
- Sky with Parker not starting is averaging 37.5 bench points. In the games she starts, the team is averaging 19.9 bench points per game
- Shooting career high 54.2% from the field in 2020



#22 COURTNEY VANDERSLOOT

- No. 4 scorer on Sky: 12.2 PPG
- Career-high 15 assists vs. Las Vegas (3rd time in her career- previous 7/20/18 vs Dallas and 8/10/18 vs Connecticut)
- One off WNBA record of 16 held by Ticha Penichiero (6/29/98 Sac @ Cle and 8/3/02 Sac vs LA). 15 assists have been achieved 6 times in WNBA history, Penichiero twice, Cappie Pondexter once and Vandersloot three times)
- In the Las Vegas game, Vandersloot also tied the Sky record for assists in a half (10) and assists in a quarter (7)
- In the Las Vegas game, Vandersloot recorded her 32nd career double-double and 50th game of 10 or more assists
- Over last two games, she is averaging 67% from the field and 60%from three
- Needs 12 assists to reach 1800 for her career (only 4 other players have reached that number in their career- Bird, Penichiero, Whalen and Taurasi)
- Needs eight minutes of play to reach 8000 for her career

#30 AZURÁ STEVENS

- No. 5 scorer on Sky: 10.4 PPG
- 14 points vs Las Vegas was most since 15 vs Dallas 8/4/20
- Five blocks vs Las Vegas tied her career high
- Has not hit a 3-point FG in last 4 games (0-7)
- 30 minutes played vs Las Vegas was most since playing 35 @ Min 7/30/20

OTHER PLAYERS

- **Stefanie Dolson:** 28 minutes vs Las Vegas is most for the season
- Dolson: 11 points vs Las Vegas is her season-high
- Dolson: Sky is 2-0 when she starts
- **Diamond DeShields:** Shooting 50% or better for the last two games
- **Gabby Williams :** Played under six minutes vs Las Vegas, lowest of any game in her career
- Williams: Zero points and zero shots vs Las Vegas. Last time she went without scoring in a game was 8/29/19 vs Dal. She has never previously had a game in the WNBA where she failed to attempt a shot.

⇒ Both **Allie Quigley** and **Courtney Vandersloot** are getting close to overtaking **Sylvia Fowles** for career scoring leadership (2,927 points).

- Liberty is last in the WNBA in FG%: 36.4%- the only team under 40%
- Liberty is last in the WNBA in 3FG%: 28.9%- the only team under 30%
- Liberty is last in the WNBA in Turnovers: 18.6 per game
