RECAP OF LAST GAME

- Sky was beaten by Seattle 88-74
- Seattle defense held Sky to 42.6% shooting (were leading the league with 49.5% shooting entering the game) and 19% from three (were averaging 37.1% going into the game, 3rd best in the league)
- Sky played it third consecutive game with only eight players available

LAST GAME VS. INDIANA

- Sky defeated the Fever 87-76 on 8/22
- Sky took a 17-point lead in the first quarter and the Fever could get no closer than seven points for the rest of the game
- Kahleah Copper scored a career-high 26 points
- Fever shot a season high 53.7% from the field, but were hurt by the 22 turnovers it committed
- Both teams played the game with only eiight players each due to injuries

TWO STRAIGHT LOSSES

- Sky suffered back-to-back losses for the first time this season
- 15 games without back-to-back losses to start a season is the longest stretch by a Sky team in its history. The longest streaks prior to this season were 10 in 2019 and nine in 2012
- Last time the Sky lost back to back games was 8/27 and 8/29/19

#2 KAHLEAH COPPER

- Leads the Sky in scoring: 15.4 PPG
- Has scored in double figures in all but one game this season including last 13 in a row
- Scored a career-high 26 points vs Indiana last meeting
- Tied her career-high with 36 minutes vs Indiana
- Other career-high sets vs Indiana: Offensive Rebounds (3) and FG Attempts (19)
- 2nd 20-point scoring game of the season and 4th of her career
- Averaging 33.3 MPG, 20 PPG, 47.9% FG shooting and 6.3 RPG over last three games

AZURÁ STEVENS AND DIAMOND DESHIELDS

- The pair was averaging 18.3 PPG and 7.7 RPG
- Stevens was averaging career highs in PPG, FG%, 3FG%, RPG, APG and SPG
- Stevens had a season high 25 points in her last outing
- Stevens is currently tied for league in blocks (1.8 per game) with Brittney Griner

#14 ALLIE QUIGLEY

- 2nd on Sky in scoring: 15.1 PPG
- Tied career-high with 29 points vs NY on 8/25
- Has scored in double figures in all but one game this season
- Held to 11 points vs Seattle. Took only 8 shots, tied for fewest in a game this season
- Needs 40 points to reach 3000 points for her career
