

SKY SEASON RECAP

- Sky started season 10-4. The loss of Azurá Stevens and Diamond DeShields to injury after Game 13 increased the playing time for the rest of the team. The team dropped 6 of its last 8 to finish 12-10 for the season.
- The Sky led the WNBA in shooting for the season averaging 49.1% from the field. This tops the previous WNBA record for field goal percentage by the LA Sparks (48.7%) set in 2016
- The Sky set a team record for most points per game with 86.7, topping their previous high on 86.2 set in 2016

#22 COURTNEY VANDERSLOOT

- Became the first WNBA player to average 10.0 APG. Broke her own record from 2019 of 9.1 APG.
- Broke the single game assist record previously held by Ticha Penicheiro (16) when she totaled 18 assists vs Indiana 8/31/20
- 12 games of double digit assists in 2020 (57 for her career- 2nd all-time to Penicheiro who had 64)
- 9 double doubles in 2020 (3rd in WNBA behind Candace Parker and Myisha Hines-Allen who each had 10). Her career total of 38 double doubles with assists is the most ever in WNBA.
- Finished the season with 6 consecutive games of double figure assists- averaging 14.8 per game over that stretch
- 13.6 PPG this season was her career high (Previous high 12.5 in 2018)
- Enters the game as the all-time assist leader in the playoffs (7.0 APG). Had double figure assists in her last two playoff games (2019) and has had 5 double figure assist playoff games in her career (high of 14 in 2015 vs Ind)
- Won her 4th consecutive Peak Performance Award (tied for longest streak with Diana Taurasi), 5th of her career.

#14 ALLIE QUIGLEY

- Led Sky in scoring in 2020: 15.4 PPG
- Has led the Sky in scoring 3 of the last 4 years
- Scored in double figures in 20 of the 22 games in 2020
- 15.4 PPG tied her second-best scoring season average behind the 16.4 she scored in 2017
- Tied for 4th in the league with 46 Three Pt FGM (tied with Diggins-Smith)
- Tied career high with 29 points vs NY 8/25
- Reached 20 points in a game 5 times during the 2020 season

#2 KAHLEAH COPPER

- Second on Sky in scoring in 2020: 14.8 PPG
- Scored in double figures in 20 of the 22 games in 2020
- Career-high 26 points vs Indiana 8/22
- 6.9 RPG over last 9 games (after Azurá Stevens and Diamond DeShields were injured). Averaged 4.5 RPG over first 13 games
- Set career highs in MPG (31.3), PPG (14.8), FG% (49.6%), RPG (5.5), APG (2.1) and SPG (1.0)

#32 CHEYENNE PARKER

- Fourth on Sky in scoring in 2020: 13.4 PPG
- 4 games of 20+ points in 2020
- 3 double doubles in 2020
- Set career single game highs in points (24 vs LA 9/6/20) and rebounds (15 vs Minnesota 9/2/20)
- For the season, set career highs in MPG (24.9), PPG (13.4), FG% (55.4- 5th best in the WNBA in 2020), 3 Pt FG% (46.9%), RPG (6.4), APG (1.5) and SPG (1.3)
- Made career high 15 Three Pt FG in 2020. Had entered the season with 11 Three Pt FGM in the 5 previous years of her career.

#15 GABBY WILLIAMS

- When Williams shot .500 or better in a game this season, Sky was 7-1
- Career high in PPG (7.7), MPG (24.8), 3P% (28.6),
- Made career high 20 Three Pt FG in 2020. Had entered the season with 14 Three Pt FGM in the previous 2 years of her career

#31 STEFANIE DOLSON

- Lowest scoring average (6.2 PPG) since her rookie year (6.0)
- Career lows in MPG (18.2) and RPG (3.5)

#24 RUTHY HEBARD

- Career-high 22 points and 32 minutes in the final game of the season
- Started 6 games including the last 3 of the season
- Finished season shooting 68.2% from the field on 85 shots
- Shot 50% or better from the field in 18 of the 22 games in 2020 including the last 15 in a row
- Over the last 15 games shot 71.4% from the field (50 for 70) averaging 6.6 PPG and 4.2 RPG
