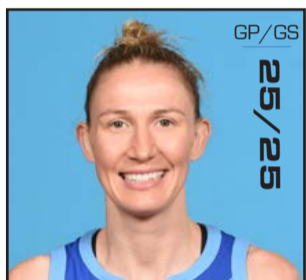

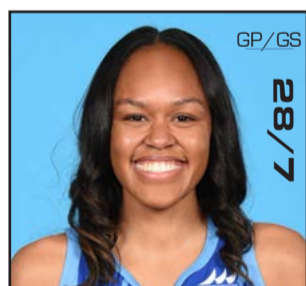

2021 SEASON NOTES

The Sky won the first championship in its 16-year history after winning in four games against the Phoenix Mercury in the WNBA Finals

The Sky finished the regular season with a 16-16 (.500) record

Finished 7th offensive rating (100.9) and 6th in defensive rating (99.4).

During the regular season, the Sky were 1-8 in the nine games that Candace Parker missed due to an ankle injury. They won 13 of their final 19 games to avoid their first losing record in three seasons under GM/Head Coach James Wade.

2021 PLAYOFF TURNAROUND

The Sky carried its late-season momentum into the playoffs where they defeated the Dallas Wings and Minnesota Lynx in consecutive knockout games and then surprised the top-seeded Connecticut Sun in the second round en route to the Finals.

The Sky went 8-2 for their entire 2021 playoff run

In ten playoff games, their offensive rating was 105.0 and defensive rating was 94.2, which would have both ranked second in the regular season

Entering the playoffs as a sixth seed, the Sky became the lowest seed to ever win a WNBA championship

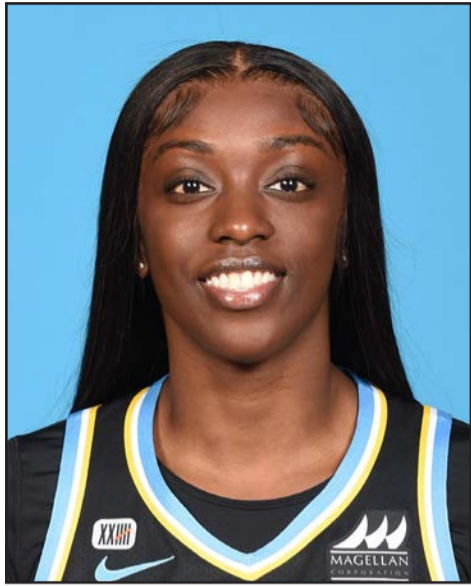

James Wade is in his fourth season as the General Manager and Head Coach of the Chicago Sky. He was hired as the team's sixth head coach in November of 2018. Last season, Wade became the first coach to deliver the franchise a WNBA Championship. He is also the only Sky coach to ever win Coach of the Year after a 20-14 season during his first year at the helm.

Wade has the highest winning percentage of any coach in franchise history (.545) and the team has never finished with a losing record in any of his first three seasons. In 2021, he turned the sixth-seeded Sky into the lowest playoff seed to ever win a WNBA title. In 2020, he led the team to a historic offensive season, breaking the all-time record for highest field goal percentage in a single season.

Wade spent two seasons as an assistant under Head Coach Cheryl Reeve of the Minnesota Lynx before joining the Sky. He was a part of the staff that brought home a fourth WNBA championship to Minneapolis in 2017. Prior to his time with the Lynx, Wade worked with current Seattle Storm coach Dan Hughes' staff with the San Antonio Stars from 2012-16.

Prior to becoming a coach, Wade played across Europe for 13 seasons with stops in the United Kingdom, France, Russia, Spain, the Czech Republic and Belgium. He is a dual citizen of the United States and France. Wade played collegiately at Middle Tennessee State, Chattanooga State and Kennesaw State University, where he graduated in 1998. Wade is married to former San Antonio Stars guard Edwige Lawson-Wade. They have one son, James III.

TONIGHT'S SKYLINES

THE "ACE" PARKER

- » The Sky was 15-8 (.652) in games with Parker in the lineup in 2021
- » 9th in all-time in points: 6344— needs 109 points to overtake Katie Smith for 8th all-time (6452)
- » 4th all-time in total rebounds: 3,327 — needs 30 total rebounds to pass Rebekkah Brunson (3,356) for 3rd
- » 2nd all-time in defensive rebounds: 2,724 — 107 defensive rebounds behind all-time No. 1 leader Sylvia Fowles [2,831]
- » 8th all-time in assists: 1,540— needs 39 assists to pass Cappie Pondexter for No. 7 [1,578]
- » 5th all-time in Blocks: 599 — needs 114 blocked shots to pass Sylvia Fowles for No.4 (712)

- » Field Goals Made (FGM) — 2,382 (No. 10, three behind No. 9 Tamika Catchings)

- » During the 6/29/22 game vs. Connecticut, Parker became the 1st WNBA player in history to total 6,000 career points, 3,000 career rebounds and 1,500 career assists
- » Parker has scored 20 or more points in a game 125 times — 8th all-time. Needs three more 20+ point games to move into 7th place ahead of Lisa Leslie
- » Parker is No. 8 all-time in games of 30 or more points — 18 including one with the Sky in 2022
- » Parker is No. 4 all-time in double-doubles with 152 on 7/23/22 vs New York. Parker had eight double-doubles with the Sky in 2021 over 23 games
- » In 2021, the Sky was:
 - 4-2 when Parker scored 20 or more points
 - 12-5 when Parker scored double-figure points
 - 5-3 when Parker had double-digit rebounds
- » Finished with 10 points, 14 rebounds and 10 assists @ LAS on 6/23/22 to become the first player in WNBA history with at least three career triple-doubles. Her first triple-double was on July 28, 2017 when she finished with 11 points, 17 rebounds and 11 assists, and her second triple-double was on May 22, 2022 when she finished with 16 points, 13 rebounds, and 10 assists
- » Became the first WNBA player with 6000 points/3000 rebounds/1500 assists against Connecticut

AZURÁ'S READY FOR A BIGGER ROLE

- » As a starter in 2021— 9.0 points per game, 61.1% field goal percentage in 11 games
- » Off the bench for the Sky in 2021 — 6.4 points per game, 42.6% field goal percentage in 19 games
- » In her two years with the Sky, she averaged 10.4 points per game and 54.2% field goal percentage as a starter (24 games)

NEW YEAR, NEW DANA

- » In the season opener vs Sparks, Evans recorded career highs in points [24], assists [5], steals [4], field goals made [7] and minutes played [35]
- » Has already scored more points this season [134] as she did last season [95]

GARDNER'S IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- » Recorded career-highs with four steals and three blocks last game @ New York 7/23/22
- » Throughout Rebekkah Gardner's first 25 WNBA games, she is currently averaging 9.1 points on 54.6% shooting from the field, 3.2 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.4 steals per game in 21.9 minutes per game
- » Made her WNBA debut at 31 years old on 5/11/22 vs. New York, where she scored 14 points, four rebounds and two steals.

"THE GENERAL" VANDERSLOOT

- » Won her 5th consecutive assist crown (6th in 7 years) in 2021. If she wins the title this year, she will tie Ticha Penicheiro, who won six consecutive seasons (1998-2003) and seven total (2,010) in her career. Sue Bird (Seattle) has three career titles (2005, 2009, 2016)
- » Set WNBA record for assists in a playoff season (2021) with 102, breaking Nikki Teasley's record set in 2003 (71)
- » Set WNBA playoff record for assists in a playoff game (18) breaking Sue Bird's record of 16 set in 2020
- » Holds WNBA record for points/assists double-doubles — 50 (Sue Bird is 2nd with 28)
- » Holds WNBA record for games with double figure assists — 71 (Ticha Penicheiro is 2nd with 64)
- » Ranks No. 4 all-time in career assists — 2,338 - Needs 11 to pass Lindsay Whalen (2,348) to move into No. 3 all-time
- » Current WNBA career leader in assists per game (6.69). She is the only WNBA player with more than six per game in her career. Only four others have reached five or more per game — Ticha Penicheiro (5.73), Sue Bird (5.56), Teresa Weatherspoon (5.27) and Dawn Staley (5.08)
- » Became the 2nd WNBA player to record two triple doubles in her career when she recorded a 12/10/18 game against Connecticut in the WNBA semi-finals. Sheryl Swoopes also recorded two triple doubles in her career (one in regular season and one in playoffs)

OUR 4X ALL-STAR 3-PT CHAMPION

- » Quigley scored a season-high 19 points on 7/2/22 vs Phoenix
- » Shot a career high 45.4% shooting from three-point range in 2021— the 2nd best in WNBA behind Epiphanny Prince (50.0%)
- » Led the WNBA in free throw percentage (95.9%) in 2021 for players with 40 or more attempts
- » Finished the 2021 season with 39 consecutive regular season made free throws. Followed that up with 25 more in post season. Set a WNBA record streak of 69 consecutive made free throws over two seasons. The previous record over two seasons was 66 set by Eva Nemasova (1999-2000). Quigley missed her fourth free throw attempt vs. Indiana to end the streak before making her final free throw attempt of the night
- » Passed Shekinna Stricklen for 14th on the all-time three-point list @ Connecticut

WHAT A YEAR FOR COPPER

- » Fresh off her 2021 WNBA Finals MVP award and most recently her 2022 Spanish League Championship MVP award, Copper has played in two games with the Sky in the 2022 season
- » Had 12 points, four rebounds and one assist in 27 minutes in her season debut
- » Had 12 points, five rebounds and three assists in 35 minutes in her 2022 home debut
- » Recorded a career-high 28 points on 6/19/22 @ Indiana

MEESSEMAN'S RETURN TO THE W

- » In the season opener vs Sparks, Emma Meeseman recorded 12 points, 8 rebounds, 5 assists and 1 steal in 36 minutes in her Sky Debut. This was Meeseman's first WNBA game since 9/15/2020 in the WNBA bubble when she was a member of the Washington Mystics
- » In the Sky's win @ Lynx, Meeseman recorded a career-high 7 steals
- » Scored a season high 26 points on 6/10/22 @ Connecticut

QUICK HITS

SKY ASSISTS

- » The Chicago Sky lead the WNBA in assists in 2022 with 23.7 APG
- » If the Sky continues its current pace of 23.7 assists per game, they will break the WNBA record for team average assists of 21.9 APG. This record was set by Washington in 2019 and tied by Seattle in 2020
- » The Sky's record for assists in a single season is 733 in 2019
- » The Sky holds three of the top five assist totals in a single season in WNBA history
 - »No. 2 — 733 in 2019
 - »No. 3 — 721 in 2018
 - »No. 5 — 718 in 2017
- » The Sky holds the WNBA record (along with Minnesota) for assists in a single game — 35
- » The Sky had a season-high 34 assists on 6/21/22 @ Las Vegas
- » The Sky has tallied 30 or more assists in a single game 11 times — the most of any WNBA team. Minnesota sits in second with eight games

BEYOND THE ARC

- » The Sky are shooting 34.8% from three-point land, No. 5 in the WNBA
- » The Sky's 7.2 three-point field goals made ranks them No. 8 in the WNBA
- » When the Sky record eight or more three-point field goals made in the 2022 season, they are 6-0

SKY SCORING

- » The Sky are 19-4 when scoring 80 or more points this season

THE WNBA ASSIST RACE

- » Since entering the Sky's game vs. Minnesota on 6/26/2022, Natasha Cloud has overtaken Courtney Vandersloot for the lead in the assist title with 7.2, while Vandersloot is at 6.3
- » Vandersloot is tied with New York's Sabrina Ionescu at the No. 2 spot
- » This is the first time since 2016 that Vandersloot has been in real jeopardy of losing the title, as she has won the assist title each of the last five seasons
 - » 2022: Cloud — 7.2 , Vandersloot — 6.3
 - » 2021: Vandersloot — 8.59 Cloud — 6.44
 - » 2020: Vandersloot — 10.00 Allemand — 5.82
 - » 2019: Vandersloot — 9.09 Tolliver — 5.96
 - » 2018: Vandersloot — 8.60 Bird — 7.13
 - » 2017: Vandersloot — 8.67 Clarendon — 6.65

SKY'S THE LIMIT

- » Sky ties the team record for road wins in a season (10) set in 2013 and tied last season
- » With the Sky's 7/20/22 win vs Seattle, it became the 4th time in team history they have reached 20 wins. The fastest they have reached 20 wins in the past was 28 games in 2013
- » Sky needs 2 more wins to tie the team record for wins in a season (24) set in 2013. The Sky has won 20 games in a season only 4 times in their 17-year history (2013-14, 2015-16 and 2019-20, 2022-23)
- » The all-time WNBA record for wins in a season is 29 by the 2014 Phoenix Mercury who went on to defeat the Sky in the WNBA Finals, 3-0)

EMMA MEESSEMAN

- » Needs 11 three-field goals made (3FGM) to reach 100 for her career
- » On 6/5/22 vs. Washington, Meesseman became the first Sky player this season to record at least 10 points, six assists and five steals in a single game
- » On 6/12/22, Meesseman had 20 points and 11 rebounds to record her first double-double since 8/19/2020

ALLIE QUIGLEY

- » Reached 3,500 career points on 6/17 vs. Atlanta
- » Needs 11 three-pointers to tie Leilani Mitchell for 14th all-time
- » Passed Tamera Young for No. 3 all-time games started for the Sky at 164 games

- » Played in her 350th career game 7/14/22 @ Los Angeles
- » Recorded her 51st double-double game at New York on 6/12/22
- » Currently sits No. 4 all-time in assists; needs 19 assists to tie Lindsay Whalen for No. 3 all-time
- » Reach 3,500 career points on 6/23 @ Los Angeles
- » Currently sits as the WNBA all-time leader in double-figure assist games at 71 games
- » Currently sits as the WNBA all-time leader in double-doubles with assists at 50 games

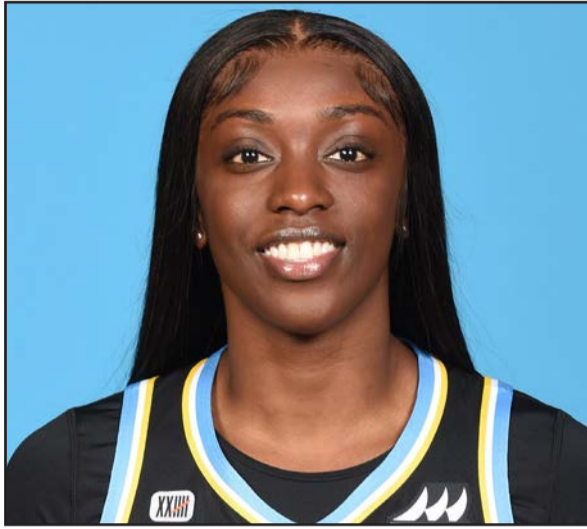
