RECENT MEETINGS VS. MYSTICS

July 11, 2018 at Washington

WASHINGTON (AP) Angel McCoughtry scored 24 points and Jessica Breland added a season-high 23 points and 10 rebounds to help the Atlanta Dream beat the Washington Mystics 106-89 on Wednesday.

Renee Montgomery and Tiffany Hayes scored 21 points apiece, finishing a combined 9 of 13 from 3-point range for the Dream (10-9). Breland added a career-high seven assists and blocked three shots.

Natasha Cloud led the Mystics (12-8) with 17 points and Elena Delle Donne added 16 points and nine rebounds.

Breland and Hayes scored five points each during a 10-0 run that gave the Dream a 44-34 lead midway through the second quarter.

Atlanta, which made 11 of 18 3-pointers and shot 60 percent from the field, led 59-50 at halftime before a day game youth crowd of 11,354.

The Mystics pulled within seven points after Delle Donne's layup to open the fourth quarter, but McCoughtry scored six straight points for a 65-52 lead with eight minutes left.

July 30, 2017 at Atlanta

ATLANTA (AP) Emma Meesseman scored a career-high 30 points, Kristi Toliver added 19 and the Washington Mystics held on for a 77-70 win over the Atlanta Dream on Sunday.

Elena Delle Donne had 10 points and Krystal Thomas grabbed 15 rebounds for Washington (14-9), which has won three in a row and four of its last five.

Toliver hit two 3-pointers and Meesseman scored four points during an 11-0 run that gave the Mystics a 13-4 lead midway through the first quarter and Atlanta trailed the rest of the way. A 14-4 spurt, including two more 3s by Toliver, gave Washington a 44-28 lead, its biggest of the game, with 17 seconds left in the first half.

Sancho Lyttle's jumper trimmed the Dream's deficit to 74-68 with 5:09 to play, but Atlanta (10-13) scored just two points, on 1-of-10 shooting, from there.

Elizabeth Williams led five Dream players in double figures with 18 points. Layshia Clarendon had 11 points and 10 assists.

July 19, 2017 at Washington

WASHINGTON (AP) Kristi Toliver scored 29 points, hitting seven 3-pointers, and the Washington Mystics rallied from a 21-point deficit to beat the Atlanta Dream 100-96 in overtime on Wednesday.

Natasha Cloud's corner 3-pointer with 2:31 left in overtime gave Washington its first lead of the game at 94-92. After Atlanta pulled to 96-95 on Tiffany Hayes' 3-pointer in transition, Emma Meesseman beat the shot clock buzzer with a bank shot. Atlanta went 1 for 2 at the line and the Mystics' Tianna Hawkins made two free throws with 8.9 seconds left to seal it.

Ivory Latta and Meesseman each scored 18 points for Washington (12-9), which was without Elena Delle Donne because of an ankle injury.

At the end of regulation, Meesseman was left alone under the basket on an inbound play to tie it at 89 with 30.5 seconds to go. Layshia Clarendon had it stripped in the lane and Toliver was off on a heave at the buzzer.

Rookie Brittney Sykes scored a season-high 27 points for Atlanta (9-11).

Collen Takes Defensive Approach

Head Coach Nicki Collen has preached defense since she took over the Dream this offseason. Her approach is starting to show as Atlanta is allowing 79.6 per game and are recording 7.7 steals and 5.1 blocks per contest.

Dream Setting Offensive Records

The Dream was only the second team in WNBA history to finish with four players with 20+ points (24-Angel McCoughtry, 23-Jessica Breland, 21-Tiffany Hayes, 21-Renee Montgomery) when they did it against the Washington Mystics on July 11, 2018. The last time was Phoenix in a 2OT game vs Minnesota on July 24, 2010.

Atlanta also recorded a season-high 31 assists against the Mystics, good for second all-time in franchise history (32 - at Sacramento, Sept. 4, 2009).

Against the Indiana Fever on July 13, 2018, the Dream saw seven players score at least 10+ points in the same game for the first time in franchise history.

Angel Creeping Up Career Scoring List

Angel McCoughtry now ranks 15th overall among WNBA career scoring leaders at 5,328 career points- She became the second fastest in league history to 5,000 points to reach the 5,000 point total behind Diana Taurasi. The star continues to break records, including setting a new high of 39 points in a game against the New York Liberty (6/19).

Tiffany Among League Leaders in Free Throw Attempts

Known for her ability to get to the basket, Tiffany Hayes has also shown the ability to draw fouls and get to the free throw line. She is attempting 5.5 per game, which is good for fifth most in the WNBA this season.

She tied the Atlanta Dream franchise record for attempts in one quarter when she shot 12 in the 1st Quarter against the Indiana Fever on June 14, 2018.

Tiffany Hayes Named Player of the Week

Hayes was selected Player of the Week for the first time in her seven seasons. Behind Hayes, Atlanta went 3-0 against Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle to improve its record to 5-3. She paced Eastern Conference players in points (23.0 ppg) and led all scorers in each of her three games.

Angel McCoughtry Named Player of the Week

McCoughtry was selected Player of the Week for the 16th time in her nine seasons. She averaged a WNBA-high 32.0 points per game and paced the league in minutes (35.2 mpg) last week as Atlanta went 1-1. She was also first among Eastern Conference players in rebounding (11.0 rpg), sixth in free throw percentage (83.9, 26-of-31) and 10th in assists (3.0 apg).

The Dream are well represented on the nation scene with five players - Layshia Clarendon, Tiffany Hayes, Angel McCoughtry, Brittney Sykes and Elizabeth Williams - named to the 2018-20 USA Basketball Women's National Team athlete pool. Clarendon, Hayes and Williams suited up for the national team's exhibition game against China on Thursday, April 26 in Seattle, Wash.

Dream Draft Three in 2018 WNBA Draft

The Atlanta Dream selected three standout seniors in the 2018 WNBA Draft. The team selected Monique Billings (UCLA) No. 15 overall, Kristy Wallace (Baylor) at No. 16 and Mackenzie Engram (Georgia) at No. 27 overall. Wallace will sit out the 2018 WNBA season due to an ACL tear suffered in March.

Dream Make Splash in 2018 Free Agency

Head Coach Nicki Collen wasted no time looking to improve the Dream. The first-year head coach signed two of the top free agents available in the 2018 class in guard Renee Montgomery (Minnesota) and Jessica Breland (Chicago). Both players are expected to see significant minutes for the Dream in 2018.

Tiffany Hayes-Leading Lady

Before 2017, people were questioning if Atlanta Dream guard Tiffany Hayes would become the face of the team with McCoughtry sitting out. Hayes did not disappoint, being named a starter on the Eastern Conference All-Star team and leading the Dream behind a career-high 16.3 points per game.

Nicki Collen was named head coach of the Atlanta Dream on October 30, 2017.

Earning her first head coaching position, Collen came to the Dream after pair of successful seasons as an assistant coach for the Connecticut Sun. Working for 2017 WNBA Coach of the Year Curt Miller, Collen helped the Sun compile an impressive 21-13 record and finished with the fourth-best regular season record in the WNBA, earning the franchise's first postseason appearance since 2012.

Connecticut, who lost former No. 1 pick Chiney Ogwumike to injury prior to the 2017 season, improve on a 14-20 record in 2016.

Prior to moving to Connecticut, Collen served under head coach Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Joining the staff in July of 2014, Collen helped guide the Eagles to consecutive 30-win seasons. The 2015-16 team completed a 33-6 campaign with a trip to the WNIT Championship game, where it was edged by South Dakota on April 2nd. The 2014-15 Eagles were 31-3 with a 26-game winning streak and an undefeated record in the Atlantic Sun Conference. That team also made history with its first Division I national ranking and its first NCAA Tournament victory, a 75-67 win over 10th-seeded Oklahoma State.

Before moving to FGCU, Collen enjoyed great success as an assistant coach at Arkansas, Louisville, Ball State and Colorado State. During her nine seasons as an assistant coach at the collegiate level, Collen helped teams reach three NCAA tournaments and five WNITs.

Collen played one year of professional basketball with the BCM Alexandros team in Greece.

As a player at Purdue, Collen was a member of Big 10 championship teams that advanced to the Final Four in 1994 and the Elite Eight in 1995. Collen transferred to Marquette as a junior, competing in two more NCAA tournaments while also securing a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering.

Collen and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.
