RECENT MEETINGS VS. SPARKS

June 12, 2018 at Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES (AP) Candace Parker scored 18 points, Nneka Ogumike had 11 points and 10 rebounds and the Los Angeles Sparks beat the Atlanta Dream 72-64 on Tuesday night.

Odyssey Sims made a hook shot in the lane to extend Los Angeles' lead to eight points with 41.1 seconds to go and Essence Carson had a block at the other end to seal it.

Chelsea Gray added 10 points with seven assists for Los Angeles (6-2). The Sparks won four times during their five-game homestand.

Parker scored 13 points in the first half to help Los Angeles to a 43-32 lead.

Tiffany Hayes scored 16 points for Atlanta (5-4), which had its three-game winning streak snapped. Jessica Breland added 14 points and Angel McCoughtry was held to 12 points on 3-of-14 shooting. The Dream shot just 38.5 percent from the floor, including 2 of 12 from 3-point range.

September 1, 2017 at Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES (AP) Candace Parker scored 15 points and the Los Angeles Sparks built an early double-digit lead en route to an easy 81-56 victory over the Atlanta Dream on Friday night.

Los Angeles (25-8) has won six straight and is a game back of the Minnesota Lynx (26-7) for the No. 1 seed into the playoffs. The Sparks host the Connecticut Sun while the Lynx face the Washington Mystics at home to conclude the regular season on Sunday. The Sparks beat Minnesota 78-67 on Aug. 27 and own the tiebreaker over the Lynx. Atlanta (12-21) was eliminated from the postseason.

Nneka Ogumike and Odyssey Sims added 13 points apiece for the Sparks. Jantel Lavender chipped in 12 points.

Tiffany Hayes scored 19 points to lead Atlanta, which committed a season-high 19 turnovers.

Parker picked up her 1,000th career assist in the first quarter with a pass to Chelsea Gray, who made a 26-footer. Gray hit another 3 on the Sparks' next possession to cap a 14-2 opening run as Los Angeles built a 43-29 halftime lead. Gray finished with eight points.

Chicago Bulls star Dwyane Wade was at the game.

June 30, 2017 at Atlanta

ATLANTA (AP) Candace Parker scored 21 points and grabbed 13 rebounds, Chelsea Gray added 20 points, and Los Angeles beat the Atlanta Dream 85-76 on Friday night for the Sparks' seventh straight victory.

It was tied at 23 after the first quarter, but Los Angeles opened the second on a 16-2 run - with six points apiece from Riquana Williams and Parker - as Atlanta went scoreless for six-plus minutes. The Dream closed the half on an 11-5 spurt to pull to 44-36.

Parker made back-to-back 3-pointers early in the third quarter for a 52-38 lead. Atlanta got within eight points with 1:07 remaining but Los Angeles' offensive rebound led to Gray's 3-point play to seal it.

Nneka Ogumike had 11 points and seven rebounds for Los Angeles (11-3). The Sparks shot 51.7 percent from the field, including 8 of 17 from distance.

Tiffany Hayes scored 18 points and Elizabeth Williams added 16 for Atlanta (6-6), which has lost six of seven.

The Dream was only the second team in WNBA history to finish with four players with 20+ points (24-Angel McCoughtry, 23-Jessica Breland, 21-Tiffany Hayes, 21-Renee Montgomery) when they did it against the Washington Mystics on July 11, 2018. The last time was Phoenix in a 2OT game vs Minnesota on July 24, 2010.

Atlanta also recorded a season-high 31 assists against the Mystics, good for second all-time in franchise history (32 - at Sacramento, Sept. 4, 2009).

Against the Indiana Fever on July 13, 2018, the Dream saw seven players score at least 10+ points in the same game for the first time in franchise history.

Elias Sports said Tiffany Hayes' game-winning field goal at Connecticut (7/17) was the longest (46.7 FT) game-winner made in the last 10 seconds of a regular-season game in WNBA history.

Renee Montgomery set a new franchise record by knocking down seven three-point field goals at win vs New York (7/19). She passed Betty Lenox, who scored six twice in 2018.

Angel Creeping Up Career Scoring List

Angel McCoughtry now ranks 15th overall among WNBA career scoring leaders at 5,384 career points- She became the second fastest in league history to 5,000 points to reach the 5,000 point total behind Diana Taurasi. The star continues to break records, including setting a new high of 39 points in a game against the New York Liberty (6/19).

Tiffany Hayes Named Player of the Week (7/22)

Hayes was selected Player of the Week for the first time this season. She averaged a WNBA-high 32.0 points per game and paced the league in minutes (35.2 mpg) last week as Atlanta went 1-1. She was also first among Eastern Conference players in rebounding (11.0 rpg), sixth in free throw percentage (83.9, 26-of-31) and 10th in assists (3.0 apg).

Nicki Collen was named head coach of the Atlanta Dream on October 30, 2017.

Earning her first head coaching position, Collen came to the Dream after pair of successful seasons as an assistant coach for the Connecticut Sun. Working for 2017 WNBA Coach of the Year Curt Miller, Collen helped the Sun compile an impressive 21-13 record and finished with the fourth-best regular season record in the WNBA, earning the franchise's first postseason appearance since 2012.

Connecticut, who lost former No. 1 pick Chiney Ogwumike to injury prior to the 2017 season, improve on a 14-20 record in 2016.

Prior to moving to Connecticut, Collen served under head coach Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Joining the staff in July of 2014, Collen helped guide the Eagles to consecutive 30-win seasons. The 2015-16 team completed a 33-6 campaign with a trip to the WNIT Championship game, where it was edged by South Dakota on April 2nd. The 2014-15 Eagles were 31-3 with a 26-game winning streak and an undefeated record in the Atlantic Sun Conference. That team also made history with its first Division I national ranking and its first NCAA Tournament victory, a 75-67 win over 10th-seeded Oklahoma State.

Before moving to FGCU, Collen enjoyed great success as an assistant coach at Arkansas, Louisville, Ball State and Colorado State. During her nine seasons as an assistant coach at the collegiate level, Collen helped teams reach three NCAA tournaments and five WNITs.

Collen played one year of professional basketball with the BCM Alexandros team in Greece.

As a player at Purdue, Collen was a member of Big 10 championship teams that advanced to the Final Four in 1994 and the Elite Eight in 1995. Collen transferred to Marquette as a junior, competing in two more NCAA tournaments while also securing a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering.

Collen and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.
