RECENT MEETINGS VS. WINGS

May 26, 2018 at Atlanta

ATLANTA (AP) Skylar Diggins-Smith scored 12 of her 26 points in the fourth quarter and Liz Cambage had 14 points, 14 rebounds and four blocks to help the Dallas Wings beat the Atlanta Dream 80-70 on Saturday night.

Kayla Thornton also scored 14 points for the Wings (2-2).

Thornton's jumper midway through the first quarter gave Dallas a 12-10 lead and the Wings never again trailed. They opened the second quarter with an 11-2 run, including five points from Cambage, to take a 13-point advantage and went into the break with a 39-31 lead.

Atlanta used a 9-2 spurt - capped by Brittney Sykes' 3-pointer - to pull within two points with two minutes left in the third quarter, but would get no closer. Diggins-Smith answered with a pull-up jumper and, after a the Wings got a stop on the other end, hit two free throws to make it 54-48.

Angel McCoughtry led the Dream (1-2) with 19 points, and Elizabeth Williams and Tiffany Hayes added 14 apiece.

May 20, 2018 at Dallas

ARLINGTON, Texas (AP) Skyler Diggins-Smith scored 25 points, and Liz Cambage had 21 points, nine rebounds and four blocks to help the Dallas Wings beat the Atlanta Dream 101-78 on Sunday.

Christmas-Kelly finished with 15 points, hitting 11 of 14 free throws, and 10 rebounds, Kaela Davis also scored 15 points, and Kayla Thornton added 13 for the Wings (1-1).

Christmas-Kelly hit two free throws hit two free throws cap a 9-2 spurt that made it 33-26 midway through the second quarter and Diggins-Smith converted a 3-point play with 1:38 left in the first half pushed the lead to 17. Dallas outscored the Dream 37-15 in the quarter and led by double figures throughout the second half.

Angel McCoughtry, who sat out last season to rest, had 13 points. She was one of five players to score in double figures for Atlanta (0-1) and hit a jumper early in the fourth quarter to become the 18th player in league history with at least 5,000 career points. The four-time WNBA All-Star is 10 points behind Taj McWilliams-Franklin's 5,013 for 17th on the career list.

August 19, 2017 at Dallas

ARLINGTON, Texas (AP) Glory Johnson had 23 points and 13 rebounds and the Dallas Wings beat the Atlanta Dream 90-86 on Saturday night.

Skylar Diggins-Smith added 17 points and 11 rebounds, and Theresa Plaisance had 12 points and 10 rebounds to help Dallas (14-16) end a two-game losing streak. Atlanta (10-20) has dropped nine straight.

Tiffany Hayes made a pair of free throws with six left for Atlanta, and Allisha Gray iced it by making one of two free throws with five seconds left. Hayes led the Dream with 22 points.

McCoughtry Sidelined with Season Ending Injury

Angel McCoughtry will miss the remainder of the 2018 WNBA season due to torn ligaments in her left knee, an injury suffered in the fourth quarter of the Dream's game against the Las Vegas Aces Tuesday, August 7.

"I want to thank all the fans, my coaching staff and teammates for giving me the chance to come back and play for the Dream this season," McCoughtry said. "I am disappointed with the injury but I believe our team is in good hands. We have a supportive group and a lot of goals to still accomplish. I plan to be there every step of the way to help us reach them. I appreciate everyone and know I will come back stronger than ever."

McCoughtry has played in all 29 games for the Dream this season, averaging 16.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in 27.5 minutes. A 2018 WNBA All-Star, McCoughtry has helped lead the Dream to a 19-10 record, including victories in 11 of its last 12 games.

Dream Breaking Multiple Records in Single Game vs Aces

The Dream set multiple records against the Las Vegas Aces on Tuesday, August 7. The team set a new franchise record for most blocks in a game with 14. Atlanta also set a new record for most points scored in a single game with 109 points. Elizabeth Williams shot 91.7 percent from the field, the best FG% in a single game in Dream history. The final score, 109-100 was the first time two teams scored 100 points in regulation since 2011 when Phoenix beat Minnesota 112-105. Nicki Collen ranks third for best records by first-year WNBA coaches (minimum 25 games) with a 19-10 record.

Dream Setting Offensive Records

The Dream was only the second team in WNBA history to finish with four players with 20+ points (24-Angel McCoughtry, 23-Jessica Breland, 21-Tiffany Hayes, 21-Renee Montgomery) when they did it against the Washington Mystics on July 11, 2018. The last time was Phoenix in a 2OT game vs Minnesota on July 24, 2010.

Atlanta also recorded a season-high 31 assists against the Mystics, good for second all-time in franchise history (32 - at Sacramento, Sept. 4, 2009).

Against the Indiana Fever on July 13, 2018, the Dream saw seven players score at least 10+ points in the same game for the first time in franchise history.

Elias Sports said Tiffany Hayes' game-winning field goal at Connecticut (7/17) was the longest (46.7 FT) game-winner made in the last 10 seconds of a regular-season game in WNBA history.

Renee Montgomery set a new franchise record by knocking down seven three-point field goals at win vs New York (7/19). She passed Betty Lenox, who scored six twice in 2018.

Angel Creeping Up Career Scoring List

Angel McCoughtry now ranks 15th overall among WNBA career scoring leaders at 5,468 career points- She became the second fastest in league history to 5,000 points to reach the 5,000 point total behind Diana Taurasi. The star continues to break records, including setting a new high of 39 points in a game against the New York Liberty (6/19).

McCoughtry More Than a Scorer

Angel McCoughtry has always been talked about as a scorer but she does it on the defensive side of the ball as well. She is a perennial member of the WNBA All-Defensive team and is now ranked 10th place all-time with 597 career steals.

Hayes Also a Scoring Machine

Averaging 17.8 points, Tiffany Hayes has topped 2,500 career points over her 6+ year career in the WNBA. The standout guard has 2,858 points so far. She has eleven 20+ games in 2018 through 27 games played and 38 in her career.

Tiffany Among League Leaders in Free Throw Attempts

Known for her ability to get to the basket, Tiffany Hayes has also shown the ability to draw fouls and get to the free throw line. She is attempting 5.3 per game this season.

She tied the Atlanta Dream franchise record for attempts in one quarter when she shot 12 in the 1st Quarter against the Indiana Fever on June 14, 2018.

Due to scheduling at McCamish Pavilion, the Dream hit the road this June and gained some frequent flyer miles. Atlanta will fly 7,391 miles between June 6-20. The team has visited Las Vegas, Seattle, Los Angeles, Atlanta, Indianapolis and New York in that time.

Dream Dominating Eastern Conference Player of the Week Awards

Tiffany Hayes has been named POW three times this season, most recently for the week of August 5th. She ranked first in the Eastern Conference in scoring (21.7 ppg) while connecting on 53.3 percent of her shots from the field (24-of-45), including 10-of-21 (47.6) from three-point range. Hayes also averaged 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists for the week.

The first nomination (6/10) Hayes was selected Player of the Week for the first time in her seven seasons. Behind Hayes, Atlanta went 3-0 against Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle to improve its record to 5-3. She paced Eastern Conference players in points (23.0 ppg) and led all scorers in each of her three games.

The second nomination (7/22) Hayes ranked second in the Eastern Conference in scoring (18.0 ppg) to go with 4.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game. The highlight of the week for the 5-10 guard came on July 17, when she made a game-winning, buzzer-beating half-court shot to complete an 18-point effort as Atlanta defeated the host Connecticut Sun 86-83.

Nicki Collen Named Coach of the Month

Collen guided the East-leading Dream to a 9-2 mark in July, which tied the Seattle Storm for the league's best record for the month. Atlanta went 4-0 on the road and 5-2 at home to improve to 16-10 overall, moving from ninth place to second in the league standings.

The Dream won a franchise-best eight consecutive games during July, highlighted by an 87-74 home win over the league-leading Storm on July 22. In its four road games, Atlanta posted wins over the Indiana Fever, Washington Mystics, Connecticut Sun and Los Angeles Sparks.

Renee Montgomery Sharp Shooting This Season

Renee Montgomery broke the franchise record for most three-pointers in a game against New York Liberty (7/19) with seven. She surpassed Betty Lennox who held the record with six three pointers made in a game twice. During WNBA All-Star game Montgomery competed in the 3-Point Contest at halftime and notched 18 points, good for fifth place. She has hit the second most three pointers in a season in franchise history with 56. She needs just seven more to break the franchise record to pass Lennox (63 in 2008).

Dream Swap Clarendon, Pick for Bentley

The Atlanta Dream traded Layshia Clarendon and a 2019 second round pick to the Connecticut Sun for Alex Bentley on Monday, July 9. Bentley played for the Dream as a rookie in 2013.

Angel McCoughtry Named to WNBA All-Star 2018

Angel McCoughtry earned her fifth selection to the WNBA All-Star when it was announced on Tuesday, July 17. She will represent the Dream at the game in Minnesota on Saturday, July 28. She will play on Team Parker after being selected by captain Candace Parker.

Jessica Breland Named Player of the Week (7/9)

Breland was selected Player of the week for the first time in her seven-year career. She led the Eastern Conference in rebounding (9.3 rpg) and blocked shots (2.67 bpg), ranked sixth in scoring (14.7 ppg) and finished fifth in field goal percentage (54.1, 20-of-37). Behind Breland, Atlanta went 3-0 and extended its winning streak to four games.

Angel McCoughtry Named Player of the Week (6/25)

McCoughtry was selected Player of the Week for the 16th time in her nine seasons. She averaged a WNBA-high 32.0 points per game and paced the league in minutes (35.2 mpg) last week as Atlanta went 1-1. She was also first among Eastern Conference players in rebounding (11.0 rpg), sixth in free throw percentage (83.9, 26-of-31) and 10th in assists (3.0 apg).

Four Dream Players on USA Basketball National Team Pool

The Dream are well represented on the nation scene with five players - Tiffany Hayes, Angel McCoughtry, Brittney Sykes and Elizabeth Williams - named to the 2018-20 USA Basketball Women's National Team athlete pool. Hayes and Williams suited up for the national team's exhibition game against China on Thursday, April 26 in Seattle, Wash.

Dream Draft Three in 2018 WNBA Draft

The Atlanta Dream selected three standout seniors in the 2018 WNBA Draft. The team selected Monique Billings (UCLA) No. 15 overall, Kristy Wallace (Baylor) at No. 16 and Mackenzie Engram (Georgia) at No. 27 overall. Wallace will sit out the 2018 WNBA season due to an ACL tear suffered in March.

Nicki Collen was named head coach of the Atlanta Dream on October 30, 2017.

Earning her first head coaching position, Collen came to the Dream after pair of successful seasons as an assistant coach for the Connecticut Sun. Working for 2017 WNBA Coach of the Year Curt Miller, Collen helped the Sun compile an impressive 21-13 record and finished with the fourth-best regular season record in the WNBA, earning the franchise's first postseason appearance since 2012.

Connecticut, who lost former No. 1 pick Chiney Ogwumike to injury prior to the 2017 season, improve on a 14-20 record in 2016.

Prior to moving to Connecticut, Collen served under head coach Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Joining the staff in July of 2014, Collen helped guide the Eagles to consecutive 30-win seasons. The 2015-16 team completed a 33-6 campaign with a trip to the WNIT Championship game, where it was edged by South Dakota on April 2nd. The 2014-15 Eagles were 31-3 with a 26-game winning streak and an undefeated record in the Atlantic Sun Conference. That team also made history with its first Division I national ranking and its first NCAA Tournament victory, a 75-67 win over 10th-seeded Oklahoma State.

Before moving to FGCU, Collen enjoyed great success as an assistant coach at Arkansas, Louisville, Ball State and Colorado State. During her nine seasons as an assistant coach at the collegiate level, Collen helped teams reach three NCAA tournaments and five WNITs.

Collen played one year of professional basketball with the BCM Alexandros team in Greece.

As a player at Purdue, Collen was a member of Big 10 championship teams that advanced to the Final Four in 1994 and the Elite Eight in 1995. Collen transferred to Marquette as a junior, competing in two more NCAA tournaments while also securing a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering.

Collen and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.

McCoughtry Sidelined with Season Ending Injury

Angel McCoughtry will miss the remainder of the 2018 WNBA season due to torn ligaments in her left knee, an injury suffered in the fourth quarter of the Dream's game against the Las Vegas Aces Tuesday, August 7.

"I want to thank all the fans, my coaching staff and teammates for giving me the chance to come back and play for the Dream this season," McCoughtry said. "I am disappointed with the injury but I believe our team is in good hands. We have a supportive group and a lot of goals to still accomplish. I plan to be there every step of the way to help us reach them. I appreciate everyone and know I will come back stronger than ever."

McCoughtry has played in all 29 games for the Dream this season, averaging 16.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in 27.5 minutes. A 2018 WNBA All-Star, McCoughtry has helped lead the Dream to a 19-10 record, including victories in 11 of its last 12 games.

Dream Breaking Multiple Records in Single Game vs Aces

The Dream set multiple records against the Las Vegas Aces on Tuesday, August 7. The team set a new franchise record for most blocks in a game with 14. Atlanta also set a new record for most points scored in a single game with 109 points. Elizabeth Williams shot 91.7 percent from the field, the best FG% in a single game in Dream history. The final score, 109-100 was the first time two teams scored 100 points in regulation since 2011 when Phoenix beat Minnesota 112-105. Nicki Collen ranks third for best records by first-year WNBA coaches (minimum 25 games) with a 19-10 record.

Dream Setting Offensive Records

The Dream was only the second team in WNBA history to finish with four players with 20+ points (24-Angel McCoughtry, 23-Jessica Breland, 21-Tiffany Hayes, 21-Renee Montgomery) when they did it against the Washington Mystics on July 11, 2018. The last time was Phoenix in a 2OT game vs Minnesota on July 24, 2010.

Atlanta also recorded a season-high 31 assists against the Mystics, good for second all-time in franchise history (32 - at Sacramento, Sept. 4, 2009).

Against the Indiana Fever on July 13, 2018, the Dream saw seven players score at least 10+ points in the same game for the first time in franchise history.

Elias Sports said Tiffany Hayes' game-winning field goal at Connecticut (7/17) was the longest (46.7 FT) game-winner made in the last 10 seconds of a regular-season game in WNBA history.

Renee Montgomery set a new franchise record by knocking down

seven three-point field goals at win vs New York (7/19). She passed Betty Lenox, who scored six twice in 2018.

Angel Creeping Up Career Scoring List

Angel McCoughtry now ranks 15th overall among WNBA career scoring leaders at 5,468 career points- She became the second fastest in league history to 5,000 points to reach the 5,000 point total behind Diana Taurasi. The star continues to break records, including setting a new high of 39 points in a game against the New York Liberty (6/19).
