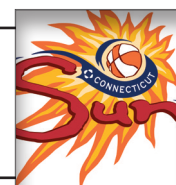

JUNE 9, 2019

ATLANTA (AP) Jonquel Jones had 17 points and 13 rebounds, Alyssa Thomas also had a double-double and the Connecticut Sun turned back the Atlanta Dream 65-59 on Sunday.

Thomas, who had 12 points and 12 rebounds, ended a three-minute dry spell with a jumper to that put the Sun up 59-57 with 3 1/2 minutes to play and start a 9-0 run. She added a free throw at the 2:18 mark and Jones hit a 3 off a Thomas assist and Courtney Williams hit a 17-foot to make it 65-57 with 34 seconds to go.

Tiffany Hayes made a layup with 28.1 seconds left, the first basket for Atlanta since Alex Bentley tied the game at 57 at the 6:07 mark. The Dream missed seven shots and three turnovers in that decisive stretch.

Williams added 13 points for Connecticut (5-1), which has the best record in the league. The Sun made 7 of 10 shots for a 16-4 lead to start the game. It was 26-13 after one quarter before Atlanta slowly battled back.

Hayes and Brittney Sykes had 14 points each for the Dream (1-4).

JULY 17, 2018

UNCASVILLE, Conn. (AP) Tiffany Hayes sank a shot from beyond halfcourt at the buzzer to help the Atlanta Dream win their fifth straight game with an 86-83 victory over the Connecticut Sun on Tuesday night.

Connecticut's Alyssa Thomas made two free throws with 31.9 seconds remaining to tie it at 83. After an Atlanta miss and a tie-up, Connecticut inbounded it with 10.9 seconds left, but Hayes intercepted a pass in the corner, took two dribbles and swished the long winner.

Angel McCoughtry scored 24 points off the bench for Atlanta (13-9). Hayes finished with 18 points and Elizabeth Williams added 16.

Brittney Sykes hit a wide open 3-pointer to pull Atlanta to 79-75 and another miscue on the Sun's next possession led to McCoughtry's fastbreak layup. McCoughtry tied it at 81 on a contested 3-pointer and Williams gave Atlanta its first lead since 2-0 on the Dream's next possession.

Jonquel Jones scored 10 of her 19 points in the second quarter for Connecticut (12-11). Rachel Banham added 15 points with three 3-pointers.

JUNE 22, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Angel McCoughtry scored 25 points, Layshia Clarendon hit two free throws with 9.4 seconds left and the Atlanta Dream overcame a 13-point second-half deficit to beat the Connecticut Sun 75-70 on Friday night.

Brittney Sykes scored 13 points, Damiris Dantas added 11, and Elizabeth Williams had 10 rebounds and three blocks.

Shekinna Stricklen hit a 3-pointer to give Connecticut (7-5) a 13-point lead midway through the third quarter, and Rachel Banham's 3-point play about four minutes later made it 56-47. But the Dream (7-6) scored the next 24 points - including the first 20 in the fourth quarter - and took a 15-point lead when Renee Montgomery hit a 3-pointer with 3:15 to play.

Chiney Ogumike's hook shot with 3:01 remaining ended the Sun's scoring drought of eight-plus minutes and sparked a 12-0 run that trimmed Connecticut's deficit to five with 50.9 seconds left. Alex Bentley's jumper with 10.2 remaining made it 73-70 before Clarendon's foul shots capped the scoring.

Bentley led the Sun with 18 points, Ogumike scored 16 points, and Jasmine Thomas added 13. Connecticut, which has lost four in a row, was held to its fewest points in a game this season.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Sun

This is the second meeting in the series between the two teams this season. Earlier this month in Atlanta, Tiffany Hayes and Brittney Sykes each scored 14 points in the Dream's last matchup with the Sun. Atlanta set team highs in offensive, defensive, and total rebounds with 46 total grabs. Atlanta held Connecticut to a season-low 65 points and 21 made field goals.

Career Milestones

Jessica Breland only needs one more block to reach 300 in her career. She will become just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone, and her 299 current career blocks ranks 5th among active players in the league.

Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in Wednesday's matchup against the Fever. Hayes saw a season-high 28 points and four made three-pointers in the Dream's 10-point victory over Indiana.

Elizabeth Williams completed her 101st steal against Indiana on Wednesday.

Where in the World is Alex Bentley?

The Dream's June 15th matchup in Dallas was Bentley's last game for a few weeks as she travels to Serbia to compete with Belarus in the 2019 FIBA Women's Eurobasket. Belarus will play in Group D along with Russia, Belgium and Serbia in Zrenjanin, Serbia beginning on June 27. The finals are set for July 7.

Welcome, Natisha!

The Atlanta Dream signed 5'7" guard Natisha Hiedeman to take Bentley's vacated spot on the roster while she fulfills overseas obligations. Hiedeman comes from Marquette - head coach Nicki Collen's alma mater - where she became only the third Golden Eagle to be selected in the WNBA Draft. She was chosen as the No. 18-overall selection by Minnesota before her draft rights were traded to Connecticut.

The 2018-19 unanimous Big East Player of the Year saw her first professional action with the Sun in each of Connecticut's three preseason games, where she averaged 5.0 points per game.

Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked up by a number of national outlets.

"She was one of the loudest little kids in the building," Sykes said. "She was cheering us on. Mind you, we're getting beaten by Seattle. But she's giving us encouragement, telling us to keep going, telling us how much she loved the Dream, how much she loved our fight and everything. After I watched that video, our GM (Chris Sienko) sent it to us in a group chat and said, 'This is why we play. Keep in mind there's fans that love us and enjoy us.'"

Atlanta Block Party

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Dream in the Preseason

Atlanta spent the preseason on the road, picking up two wins against Dallas (82-59) and New York (92-87) in Connecticut, but fell to Washington in a 75-64 decision in Albany, Ga. The game marked the Dream's first game in the state of Georgia outside of Atlanta.

WSB-TV Multimedia Partnership

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall).
