RECENT MEETINGS WITH WINGS

MAY 26, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Skylar Diggins-Smith scored 12 of her 26 points in the fourth quarter and Liz Cambage had 14 points, 14 rebounds and four blocks to help the Dallas Wings beat the Atlanta Dream 80-70 on Saturday night.

Kayla Thornton also scored 14 points for the Wings (2-2).

Thornton's jumper midway through the first quarter gave Dallas a 12-10 lead and the Wings never again trailed. They opened the second quarter with an 11-2 run, including five points from Cambage, to take a 13-point advantage and went into the break with a 39-31 lead.

Atlanta used a 9-2 spurt - capped by Brittney Sykes' 3-pointer - to pull within two points with two minutes left in the third quarter, but would get no closer. Diggins-Smith answered with a pull-up jumper and, after a the Wings got a stop on the other end, hit two free throws to make it 54-48.

Angel McCoughtry led the Dream (1-2) with 19 points, and Elizabeth Williams and Tiffany Hayes added 14 apiece.

AUGUST 11, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Renee Montgomery was 6 of 7 from 3-point range and scored 24 points to help the Atlanta Dream beat the Dallas Wings 92-82 on Saturday.

Elizabeth Williams had 18 points, nine rebounds and five blocks, Tiffany Hayes added 15 points, seven boards and five assists and Jessica Breland scored 13 points for Atlanta. The Dream (21-10), who learned Thursday that all-star forward Angel McCoughtry will miss the rest of the season due to a knee injury, have won five games in a row and 13 of their last 14.

Montgomery's first 3-pointer capped a 14-2 spurt that made it 16-6 midway through the first quarter and Atlanta led the rest of the way. The Wings scored the first 10 points of the fourth quarter, trimming their deficit to 70-67 with seven minutes left after Tayler Hill hit a 3. Williams scored six points and Montgomery hit two 3-pointers as the Dream scored 12 of the next 14 points to push their lead to 13 with three minutes to go.

Skylar Diggins-Smith led Dallas (14-16) with 26 points and 10 assists. The Wings have lost seven in a row and have a two-game lead over the Las Vegas Aces - which plays last-place Indiana later Saturday - for the eighth and final playoff spot. Dallas and Aces play in Las Vegas on Friday before wrapping up the regular season on Aug. 19.

MAY 24, 2019

ATLANTA -- One year after a stout defense helped Atlanta advance to the WNBA semifinals, the Dream turned to that strength to help cap a comeback in their 2019 opener.

Jessica Breland scored 17 points, including a late go-ahead three-point play, and Atlanta held Dallas without a field goal in the final 2 minutes as the Dream rallied to beat the Wings 76-72 on Friday night. Center Elizabeth Williams said Atlanta coach Nicki Collen expects defense to make decisive stands. "At the end of games she trusts us to get stops," Williams said.

The Dream led the WNBA in field goal percentage defense (42.3) last season. The Wings made 26 of 74 shots (35.1 percent). Dallas led 55-47 before Atlanta won the final period, 29-17. "It was ugly but I think we did what we do and that's battle," Collen said. "... It took a little while to get everyone on the same page, but we just don't give up."

Renee Montgomery had 15 points for the Dream.

Allisha Gray had 14 points off the bench to lead Dallas. Rookie Arike Ogunbowale had 12 points. Another rookie, Brooke McCarty-Williams, had eight points and eight assists.

Imani McGee-Stafford's layup gave Dallas a 67-65 lead. McCarty-Williams' steal set up Gray's layup, stretching the lead to four points. Another steal by Gray set up her free throws for a 71-65 advantage.

Following a 3-pointer by Montgomery, Brittney Sykes made two of three free throws and grabbed the rebound on the miss to set up Breland's go-ahead three-point play with 1:17 remaining.

The Dream led 20-14 before the Wings scored the final five points of the first period to launch a 15-0 run for a 29-20 advantage. McGee-Stafford

ford's offensive rebound and basket capped the run.

Sykes' 3-pointer snapped Atlanta's scoring drought, but Dallas led 39-34 at halftime. Every Wings player in uniform scored in the half, including five players off the bench.

Marie Guilich scored all of her six points in the final quarter to help Atlanta rally. Tiffany Hayes, a first-team all-WNBA selection last year, scored only five points while making only two of eight shots from the field. She missed each of her four 3-point attempts.

MAJOR VOIDS

The Dream are without two-time league scoring champion Angel McCoughtry, who was not in uniform but sat on the bench as she continues to recover from a left knee injury late in the 2018 season. Collen recently described McCoughtry's status as "month to month."

The Wings must regroup after trading 6-foot-8 Australian Liz Cambage to Las Vegas on May 16 for Moriah Jefferson, Isabelle Harrison and the Aces' first two draft picks in 2020. Cambage was the runner-up to Breanna Stewart in last season's WNBA MVP vote.

Dallas also is without All-Star guard Skylar Diggins-Smith, who gave birth this spring.

HOME AGAIN

Following two seasons at Georgia Tech, the Dream have returned to State Farm Arena, also the home of the NBA's Atlanta Hawks. Before a two-year renovation, the facility was called Philips Arena.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Wings

The last time these two teams met was in the first game of the WNBA season, and the first home game for Atlanta in State Farm Arena on May 24. The Dream won a close 76-72 decision behind a 52.9% shooting effort and a season-high 17 point outing from Jessica Breland. The Dream enters Saturday's matchup on a two-game winning streak over the Wings.

With their five straight losses this season, the Wings have not won in seven straight games. Their last win was on August 17, 2018 against the Las Vegas Aces, a win that snapped a nine-game losing streak for Dallas.

Career Milestones

Jessica Breland only needs two more blocks to reach 300 in her career. She will become just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone, and her 298 current career blocks ranks fifth among active players in the league.

Elizabeth Williams is two steals away from reaching 100 in her career.

Where in the World is Alex Bentley?

Saturday's game against the Wings will be Bentley's last game for a few weeks as she travels to Serbia to compete with Belarus in the 2019 FIBA Women's Eurobasket. Belarus will play in Group D along with Russia, Belgium and Serbia in Zrenjanin, Serbia beginning on June 27. The finals are set for July 7.

Undefeated in Five or Fewer

With the team's four-point win over the Wings on opening night, the Dream is now 10-0 in regular season games decided by five points or fewer since head coach Nicki Collen took over in 2018.

Hitting Double Digits

Six different players have scored 10 or more points in a game so far this season, as Nia Coffey (11) and Jessica Breland joined the double digit club on June 6 against Las Vegas. Brittney Sykes has scored in double digits a team-high three times this season, as she remains the team's leading scorer with 46 points so far (11.5 PPG).

Sharp Shooter

Renee Montgomery has connected on at least one three point shot in each of the first four games of the season, hitting a season-high three 3PFG in the season opener against Dallas.

Dream in the Preseason

Atlanta spent the preseason on the road, picking up two wins against Dallas (82-59) and New York (92-87) in Connecticut, but fell to Washington in a 75-64 decision in Albany, Ga. The game marked the Dream's first game in the state of Georgia outside of Atlanta.

WSB-TV Multimedia Partnership

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was

chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall). The team then traded Turner to Phoenix for the draft rights to the Mercury's 2018 first round selection, Marie Glich.

2018 Records

Last season, the Dream shot 47.6 percent from the field in clutch time (defined as the last five minutes of the fourth quarter/OT with score within five points), which was the best mark in the league.

In 2018, the Dream set a franchise record with 18.4 three-point field goal attempts per game, the most earned in a single season.

Atlanta's 31.8 3FG% in 2018 ranks second in franchise history.

The team's 26.0 defensive rebounds per game (885/34) in 2018 was the most earned in franchise history (tied with 26.0 in 2010).

Atlanta's eight straight wins from July 8-24 in 2018 is the most consecutive games won in program history.

The Dream's 67.6% overall winning percentage, 76.5% home game winning percentage and 58.8% road game winning percentage in 2018 are all franchise records.

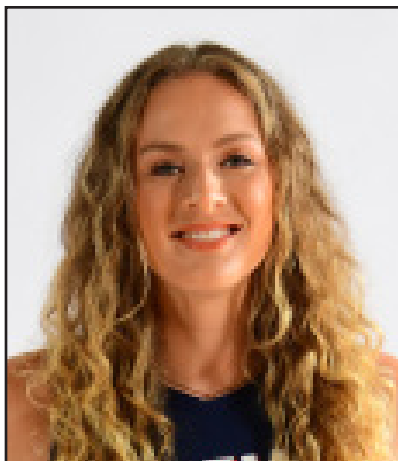
