#### **JULY 13, 2018**

ATLANTA (AP) Tiffany Hayes had 16 points, and the balanced Atlanta Dream beat the Indiana Fever 98-74 on Friday night for their third consecutive victory.

Atlanta (11-9) had seven players score in double figures. Elizabeth Williams and Brittney Sykes scored 14 points apiece. Angel McCoughtry, Jessica Breland, Alex Bentley and Damiris Dantas each had 10.

Erica Wheeler's 3-pointer gave Indiana a 20-10 lead with two minutes left in the first quarter. But the Fever missed 10 of their next 12 field-goal attempts as the Dream went on a 36-6 run capped by Jessica Breland's jumper with a minute left in the first half.

The Dream tied their season high for points in a quarter with 30 in the second, and then outscored Indiana 33-25 in the third.

Tiffany Mitchell led the Fever (2-19) with 17 points and Wheeler finished with 15.

Atlanta, which shot 60 percent from the field in its 106-89 win over Washington on Wednesday, shot 56.9 percent against the Fever. The Dream have won four of five overall.

#### **JULY 1, 2018**

INDIANAPOLIS (AP) Tiffany Hayes made a key runner in the final minute and the Atlanta Dream held off the Indiana Fever for an 87-83 win on Sunday.

Hayes made it 85-79 with 26.2 seconds left and added a pair of free throws with 9.1 seconds left to secure the victory.

The Dream (8-8) had a 17-point halftime lead cut down to 72-69 on Candice Dupree's jumper with 5:06 left and the Fever hung close the rest of the way.

Brittney Sykes led Atlanta with 20 points and seven assists. Hayes added 19 points and Angel Mc-Coughtry scored 15.

Victoria Vivians had 21 of her career-high 27 points in the second half for the Fever (1-16). Natalie Achonwa added 16 points.

Indiana lost its sixth in a row after getting its only win of the season against the Dream on June 16.

#### **JUNE 16, 2018**

INDIANAPOLIS (AP) Victoria Vivians scored a career-best 21 points to help the Indiana Fever win their first game of the season, beating the Atlanta Dream 96-64 on Saturday night. The Fever (1-10) trailed 38-35 at halftime before outscoring the Dream 36-16 advantage in the third quarter.

Indiana opened the fourth quarter with a 15-6 run to lead 86-60 and put the game away. Indiana's 10-game losing streak matched a franchise worst. The Fever's last regular season win came on Aug. 6 and was followed by eight straight losses to end the 2017 season.

Vivians was 5 of 8 from 3-point range, Kelsey Mitchell added 19 points with three 3-pointers and Erica Wheeler scored 10. Angel McCoughtry led the Dream (6-5) with 19 points and eight rebounds and Renee Montgomery added 12 points.

Tiffany Hayes and Stephanie Mavunga suffered ankle injuries in the third quarter and each had to be helped off the court.

#### **NOTES AND STORYLINES**

#### Last Time Out: Dream vs. Fever

The Dream scored nearly 100 points in their last meeting with the Fever, thanks to double digit scoring from seven different Dream players.

The Dream have won the last two games against the Fever, and the last four games when playing in Atlanta.

#### **Career Milestones**

Jessica Breland only needs one more block to reach 300 in her career. She will become just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone, and her 299 current career blocks ranks fifth among active players in the league.

Tiffany Hayes is 24 points away from 3,000 career points. Her current 2,976 points ranks 21<sup>st</sup> among active players in the WNBA.

Elizabeth Williams is one steal away from reaching 100 in her career.

#### Where in the World is Alex Bentley?

Saturday's game against the Wings was Bentley's last game for a few weeks as she travels to Serbia to compete with Belarus in the 2019 FIBA Women's Eurobasket. Belarus will play in Group D along with Russia, Belgium and Serbia in Zrenjanin, Serbia beginning on June 27. The finals are set for July 7.

#### Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked up by a number of national outlets.

"She was one of the loudest little kids in the building," Sykes said. "She was cheering us on. Mind you, we're getting beaten by Seattle. But she's giving us encouragement, telling us to keep going, telling us how much she loved the Dream, how much she loved our fight and everything. After I watched that video, our GM (Chris Sienko) sent it to us in a group chat and said, 'This is why we play. Keep in mind there's fans that love us and enjoy us.'"

#### **Atlanta Block Party**

Three different Dream players recorded at least three blocks against Dallas in the team's 2019 season opener. The two other times this has happened in WNBA history, at least one Dream player was involved - Jessica Breland was a part of all three occurances:

#### **Undefeated in Five or Fewer**

With the team's four-point win over the Wings on opening night, the Dream is now 10-0 in regular season games decided by five points or fewer since head coach Nicki Collen took over in 2018.

#### Dream in the Preseason

Atlanta spent the preseason on the road, picking up two wins against Dallas (82-59) and New York (92-87) in Connecticut, but fell to Washington in a 75-64 decision in Albany, Ga. The game marked the Dream's first game in the state of Georgia outside of Atlanta.

#### **WSB-TV Multimedia Partnership**

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

#### **NOTES AND STORYLINES**

#### Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

#### Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall). The team then traded Turner to Phoenix for the draft rights to the Mercury's 2018 first round selection, Marie Gülich.

#### 2018 Records

Last season, the Dream shot 47.6 percent from the field in clutch time (defined as the last five minutes of the fourth quarter/OT with score within five points), which was the best mark in the league.

In 2018, the Dream set a franchise record with 18.4 threepoint field goal attempts per game, the most earned in a single season.

Atlanta's 31.8 3FG% in 2018 ranks second in franchise history.

The team's 26.0 defensive rebounds per game (885/34) in 2018 was the most earned in franchise history (tied with 26.0 in 2010).
