WASHINGTON (AP) Elena Delle Donne wasn't about to let a knee injury sideline her again with the Washington Mystics season at stake.

She had 15 points and 10 rebounds in her return from a bone bruise in her left knee and the Mystics forced a decisive Game 5 with a 97-76 win over the Atlanta Dream in the WNBA semifinal series.

Delle Donne started, played 34 minutes, sank 3 of 5 three-point attempts and scored 11 points in the second half after sitting out Friday's 81-76 loss. She suffered the injury in the final minutes of Atlanta's 78-75 Game 2 victory.

"I would have killed coach (Mike Thibault) if he didn't let me play full out," Delle Donne said. "He knows. I gave him the look and he knew I was fully ready to go and wanted to be in there as much as I could."

The 2015 WNBA Most Valuable Player award winner sported a bulky brace on her left knee. She failed to score until less than four minutes remained in the first half, but her presence immediately helped open the floor for teammates. Washington shot 50 percent from the field overall and sank 12 of 26 from beyond the 3-point arc.

"Whether Delly is on crutches, it doesn't matter. If she's on the floor, they have to respect her and honor her," Kristi Toliver said. "That changes everything for everyone."

Toliver led the Mystics with 22 points as all five starters scored in double figures. Ariel Atkins scored 19 points, Natasha Cloud

13 and LaToya Sanders 10.

"Elena Delle Donne, she kind of sucks you in (defensively)," Dream guard Renee Montgomery said, "but they caught fire."

Tiffany Hayes, Montgomery, Brittney Sykes and Jessica Breland each scored 12 points for the Dream.

The series shifts back to Atlanta for the finale of the best-of-5 series on Tuesday. The Mystics have never reached the WNBA finals in the franchise's 21 seasons.

Atlanta remains one victory away from the franchise's fourth finals appearance and first since 2013.

While Washington welcomed the return of its best player, Atlanta remains without All-Star forward Angel McCoughtry, who suffered a knee injury Aug. 7 against Las Vegas. It also still has home-court advantage for the decisive game. The Dream, who closed the regular season winning 16 of 19 games, haven't lost two games in a row since June 27-29.

"If you told me in February or May or June, even in early July that we would have one game with a chance to go to the Finals I'd be pretty excited," Atlanta coach Nicki Collen said. "I certainly told (the players) we have to learn from this game, but we also have to flush. We've built up too much momentum to hang our heads."

The Mystics raced out to a 26-12 lead in the second quarter and entered halftime up 44-35. Toliver, who had only seven points on 3 of 15 shooting in Game 3 topped all scorers with 12 points in the first half.

Delle Donne's second 3-point-er stifled Atlanta's momentum after the Dream's 10-0 run cut Washington's lead to 62-57 with 2:04 left in the third. Washington pulled away with a 22-7 run starting the fourth quarter for its largest lead at 90-67.

"No one had to be Superwoman, but we just needed to get a little bit smarter and get back to getting stops," Delle Donne said as the postgame press conference ended. Toliver spoke up leaving the dais.

"But we got our Superwoman back."

TIP-INS

Toliver and Cloud, Washington's starting backcourt, combined to make 13 of 26 shots after finishing 4 of 22 in Game 3. ... The Mystics outrebounded the Dream 40-31. Atlanta shot 14 of 25 on free throws. ... Washington turned Atlanta's nine first-half turnovers into 12 points while the Dream scored one point off the Mystics' eight miscues.

WHAT'S NEXT

The teams split the first two games in Atlanta, though Washington held a double-digit lead in Game 2 before losing. Delle Donne averaged 29.5 points and 13.5 rebounds in Atlanta.

RECENT MEETINGS WITH MYSTICS

SEPTEMBER 4, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Elena Delle Donne had a rather quiet night by her high standards.

No worries.

The Washington Mystics are headed to the WNBA Finals for the first time in franchise history.

Rookie Ariel Atkins, Kristi Toliver and Tianna Hawkins picked up the slack for the Mystics, who held off the Atlanta Dream 86-81 in the decisive fifth game of their semifinal series Tuesday night.

"Wow," coach Mike Thibault said. "We're here because we're persistent, we're resilient and we play together."

The Dream led 71-69 with just under 7 minutes remaining but suddenly went cold at the worst time of a turnaround season. Washington seized the lead with a 9-0 run and survived a desperation 3-pointer by Tiffany Hayes, earning a spot in the Finals against Seattle.

Delle Donne was held to 14 points, far below the 24.7 she was averaging in the series despite missing Game 3 with a knee injury. She did make a big jumper with 1:41 remaining, and sealed the victory with four straight free throws in the closing seconds.

Yet this was really about Atkins, playing with the poise of a veteran while scoring 20 points. And Toliver, who came up huge in the first half and finished with 19. And don't forget Hawkins, who chipped in with 17.

"That's why I came to D.C. - to make history," Toliver said. "It's very special to do it with this group of people. We just have a great, great locker room. It's an exciting time to be a D.C. fan and I'm glad I'm on the winning side of it right now."

Alex Bentley scored 16 points to lead five Atlanta players in double figures. But the Dream couldn't overcome the loss of star Angel McCoughtry late in the regular season to a knee injury.

"I just got done bawling in the locker room," said red-eyed Nicki Collen, who earned coach of the year honors

in her debut season for leading the Dream to a 23-11 record - an 11-win improvement over 2017. "I'm incredibly proud of this team. We're further ahead than I thought we would be when I took this job.

"Damn, a hell of a year."

The first half was a back-and-forth offensive show, even though Delle Donne was limited to four points.

Toliver carried the load with 17 points - much of it from long range. She knocked down a 3-pointer from almost 30 feet and even tried one from just inside the midcourt stripe.

The Dream responded with a more balanced attack, led by Bentley with 11 points off the bench, and were up 50-49 at halftime.

Both teams clamped down defensively in the second half.

In the end, Washington got the stops that mattered. After Bentley hit a 3 and Washington failed to get the ball inbounds, Atlanta had a chance to tie. But Bentley couldn't get open, forcing Hayes to throw up a wild shot that didn't hit anything.

"We knew offense was not going to win this game," Toliver said. "We knew it would come down to defense and rebounding."

Washington grabbed 17 offensive rebounds.

HOLDING HER TONGUE

Collen and her players were not happy with the way the game was called - especially in the fourth quarter.

The Dream was whistled for 21 fouls, compared to 10 for the Mystics. Renee Montgomery fouled out, depriving Atlanta of a much-needed 3-point threat in the closing seconds.

Washington finished 16 of 19 from the foul line. Atlanta was 8 of 9.

"There's a lot I really could say that I'm not supposed to say," Collen said. "So I'm going to hold my tongue about what I'm not supposed to say."

TIP-INS

Delle Donne did lead the Mystics with 11 rebounds. She also had four assists, two blocks and a steal. ... Montgomery and Brittney Sykes had 15 points each for the Dream. Hayes added 13 and Elizabeth Williams 10. Jessica Breland grabbed 12 rebounds. ... Breland hobbled to the bench after a wild scramble in the lane midway through the third quarter but was able to return about 2 1/2 minutes later.

DROP THE MIC

After watching the game from the bench, McCoughtry grabbed a microphone to thank the home crowd for their support.

"We've got a great team," she said. "We'll be back."

FRENZIED THIRD

Hawkins took over for Washington in the final 2 minutes of the third quarter, single-handedly ripping off an 8-0 run with a pair of 3-pointers and a fast-break layup that turned a 61-59 deficit into a 67-61 lead for the Mystics.

But the Dream finished the period on a high. After Delle Donne missed wide-open 3 from the top of the key, Montgomery raced to the other end of the court, curled behind a pick and hurled up a 3-pointer at the buzzer that cut the deficit to 67-64 heading to the final period.

PLAYOFF HISTORY

The Dream missed out on the fourth trip to the Finals in franchise history. They were swept in each of their three previous appearances.

The Mystics were in the semifinals for the second year in a row. This time, they made it over the hump.

RECENT MEETINGS WITH MYSTICS

JUNE 1, 2019

WASHINGTON (AP) Ariel Atkins scored 21 points, Elena Delle Donne added 18 in her season debut and the Washington Mystics coasted to a 96-75 victory over the Atlanta Dream on Saturday night.

The Mystics christened their new Entertainment and Sports Arena by shooting 57 percent, led by Delle Donne, who was 5 for 5 for 10 points in the first quarter to help built a 26-16 lead.

It was 52-35 at the half as Delle Donne, who missed the season opener with a sore left knee, was 7 for 7 and Washington shot 61 percent.

Atkins finished 8 of 11 from the field with four 3-pointers. Emma Messeman added 14 points for Washington (1-1) and Kristi Toliver and Shatori Walker-Kimbrough had 10 apiece. Toliver sat out most of the second half of the season opener with a knee injury.

The Dream (1-2), playing on back-to-back nights, got 11 points from Tiffany Hayes and Alex Bentley.

The Mystics, who beat the Dream in the semifinals last year, are the primary tenant in the 4,200-seat arena in southeast D.C.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Mystics

This is the second meeting in the series between the two teams this season. Earlier this month in Washington, Tiffany Hayes and Alex Bentley both scored 11 points in the matchup, but the Mystics ran away with a 21-point victory. The game was held just a day after the Dream's second game of the season against the Seattle Storm in Atlanta.

Career Milestones

Jessica Breland reached 300 career blocks in Friday's game at Connecticut, making her just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone. Her 300 current career blocks ranks 5th among active players in the league.

Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in Wednesday's matchup against the Fever. Hayes saw a season-high 28 points and four made three-pointers in the Dream's 10-point victory over Indiana.

Where in the World is Alex Bentley?

The Dream's June 15th matchup in Dallas was Bentley's last game for a few weeks as she travels to Serbia to compete with Belarus in the 2019 FIBA Women's Eurobasket. Belarus will play in Group D along with Russia, Belgium and Serbia in Zrenjanin, Serbia beginning on June 27. The finals are set for July 7.

Welcome, Natisha!

The Atlanta Dream signed 5'7" guard Natisha Hiedeman to take Bentley's vacated spot on the roster while she fulfills overseas obligations. Hiedeman comes from Marquette - head coach Nicki Collen's alma mater - where she became only the third Golden Eagle to be selected in the WNBA Draft. She was chosen as the No. 18-overall selection by Minnesota before her draft rights were traded to Connecticut.

The 2018-19 unanimous Big East Player of the Year saw her first professional action with the Sun in each of Connecticut's three preseason games, where she averaged 5.0 points per game.

Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked

up by a number of national outlets.

"She was one of the loudest little kids in the building," Sykes said. "She was cheering us on. Mind you, we're getting beaten by Seattle. But she's giving us encouragement, telling us to keep going, telling us how much she loved the Dream, how much she loved our fight and everything. After I watched that video, our GM (Chris Sienko) sent it to us in a group chat and said, 'This is why we play. Keep in mind there's fans that love us and enjoy us.'"

Atlanta Block Party

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall).
