2019: Has started in all 17 games this season ... Her 7.2 rebounds per game ranks 11th in the league ... Her 122 total rebounds ranks 9th in the league ... Just the 19th player in WNBA history to eclipse 300 career blocks.

G #7 BRITTNEY SYKES 5-9 | 154 | Syracuse

2019: Has started in 10 of 17 games this season ... Averaging 10.7 points and 4.8 rebounds per game ... Scored 22 points in the third quarter at Phoenix (7/7), tying a WNBA record for most points in a quarter, previously set by Diana Taurasi.

C #1 ELIZABETH WILLIAMS 6-3 | 200 | Duke

2019: Has started in all 17 games this season ... Averaging 1.7 blocks per game, which is currently the 4th-highest average in the league ... Her 29 total blocks ranks 3rd in the WNBA this season.

G #15 TIFFANY HAYES 5-10 | 155 | UConn

2019: Has started in all 17 games this season ... Averaging 13.5 points per game and 2.9 assists per game ... Her .319 3-pointer percentage ranks 33rd in the league ... Eclipsed 3,000 career points with 28 points against Indiana (6/19).

ATLANTA (AP) Jonquel Jones had 17 points and 13 rebounds, Alyssa Thomas also had a double-double and the Connecticut Sun turned back the Atlanta Dream 65-59 on Sunday.

Thomas, who had 12 points and 12 rebounds, ended a three-minute dry spell with a jumper to that put the Sun up 59-57 with 3 1/2 minutes to play and start a 9-0 run. She added a free throw at the 2:18 mark and Jones hit a 3 off a Thomas assist and Courtney Williams hit a 17-foot to make it 65-57 with 34 seconds to go.

Tiffany Hayes made a layup with 28.1 seconds left, the first basket for Atlanta since Alex Bentley tied the game at 57 at the 6:07 mark. The Dream missed seven shots and three turnovers in that decisive stretch.

Williams added 13 points for Connecticut (5-1), which has the best record in the league. The Sun made 7 of 10 shots for a 16-4 lead to start the game. It was 26-13 after one quarter before Atlanta slowly battled back.

Hayes and Brittney Sykes had 14 points each for the Dream (1-4).

JUNE 21, 2019

UNCASVILLE, Conn. (AP) Shekina Stricklen made seven 3-pointers and scored 24 points and the Connecticut Sun beat the Atlanta Dream 86-76 on Friday night to extend their franchise-record, regular-season home winning streak to 13 games.

Jonquel Jones added 18 points and eight rebounds for Connecticut (9-1). The Sun have won seven straight overall.

Stricklen made three 3-pointers in the first half to help Connecticut build a 39-25 lead. The Dream (2-6) shot just 26.5% in the first half, including 2 of 11 from 3-point range. Connecticut started the second half on an 11-3 run for a 50-28 lead and finished the quarter with 26 points.

Atlanta pulled to 75-70 late in the fourth, but Stricklen answered with her sixth 3-pointer and Jones made a hook shot on the Sun's next possession.

Jasmine Thomas added 13 points with nine assists for Connecticut, which made 12 of 23 3-pointers. Stricklen hit 7 of 11 from distance, one shy of tying her career high for makes.

Jessica Breland had 17 points and eight rebounds for Atlanta, and Tiffany Hayes had 12 points, five rebounds and six assists. The Dream have lost six of seven.

ATLANTA (AP) Tiffany Hayes scored 18 points, Elizabeth Williams had a season-high 17 points and nine rebounds and the Atlanta Dream beat the Connecticut Sun 78-75 on Wednesday.

Alex Bentley sank an open 3-pointer with 2:01 remaining to give Atlanta a 72-67 lead. Connecticut got within 76-75 after Courtney Williams made her first 3-pointer of the game with 10.5 seconds left. Bentley added two free throws for a three-point lead and Williams was short on a 3 at the buzzer.

Renee Montgomery added 12 points and Bentley 11 for Atlanta (4-10). Jessica Breland grabbed a season-high 13 rebounds. The Dream overcame 20 turnovers to beat the Sun for the first time in three games this season.

Williams led Connecticut (9-6) with 13 points. Jasmine Thomas added 12 points and five assists. Jonquel Jones, averaging a team-high 15.5 points, was just 3 of 8 from the field for seven points.

Four players scored in double digits behind Tiffany Hayes' 18 points as the Dream beat the Sun 78-75 in a midweek day game in Atlanta. Elizabeth Williams saw a season-high 17 points and nine rebounds, while Jessica Breland grabbed a season-high 13 boards.

The Dream has one more chance to even up their record with the Sun this season as they face each other for the fourth time in 41 days of the regular season on Friday.

Dream Sign Alaina Coates

The Atlanta Dream have signed center Alaina Coates, President and General Manager Chris Sienko announced Thursday (July 18). The former University of South Carolina standout will join the team this Sunday when the team returns to Atlanta. The 6-4 Coates played in 14 games with Minnesota this season, averaging 2.4 rebounds and 2.5 points per game.

"We are thrilled to add a player with the size and athleticism of Alaina," head coach Nicki Collen said. "We have struggled at times with defensive rebounding and scoring efficiently around the rim this season, and we believe she can help us in those two areas now and in the future."

Career Milestones

Renee Montgomery is only three made three-pointers away from reaching 500 in her career. She will become only the 13th player in the WNBA to reach this milestone.

Alex Bentley is 7 assists away from 600.
Jessica Breland is 2 assists away from 300.
Monique Billings is 8 points away from 200.

Jessica Breland reached 300 career blocks on June 21 at Connecticut, making her just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone. Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in the June 19 matchup against the Fever.

Dream Hold Lynx to 53

On July 12, Atlanta beat Minnesota 60-53 for the team's second straight win and fifth of the season. Minnesota's 53 points is the second fewest Atlanta has held a team to in franchise history, and the Lynx's 21 points in the second half is tied for the fewest allowed in Dream history. The 113 combined points in the game were the fewest seen in the WNBA since Los Angeles beat San Antonio 60-52 on Aug. 30, 2015.

Bentley averaged 11.7 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3 assists and 1.7 steals in 30.9 minutes per game.

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall). The team then traded Turner to Phoenix for the draft rights to the Mercury's 2018 first round selection, Marie Göllich.
