ATLANTA (AP) Jessica Breland scored 19 points, Alex Bentley made a late go-ahead 3-pointer and the short-handed Atlanta Dream beat the Los Angeles Sparks 79-73 on Thursday night.

It was Atlanta's first victory without star Angel McCoughtry, who the team announced just before the game that she would miss the remainder of the season due to torn ligaments in her left knee. She was averaging 16.5 points, including a career-high 39 points at New York earlier this year.

Bentley finished with 13 points and Elizabeth Williams had 10 points and seven rebounds for Atlanta.

Atlanta (20-10) is 2 1/2 games behind first-place Seattle (23-8) and a game ahead of third-place Washington (19-11). The Storm have clinched a top-two seed and will receive a double-bye to the semifinals.

Bentley made a 3-pointer to give Atlanta a 71-68 lead and she came off a high screen to drain a long jumper to make it 75-70. Riquna Williams answered with a 3-pointer to pull Los Angeles closer but Tiffany Hayes secured it at the free-throw line with 4.4 seconds left.

Candace Parker had 20 points and 12 rebounds for her 11th double-double of the season for Los Angeles (18-12). Williams added 18 points off the bench and Chelsea Gray had 13 for the Sparks, who were playing the second-half of a back-to-back after winning in New York on Wednesday night.

JULY 24, 2018

LOS ANGELES (AP) Angel McCoughtry scored 15 of her 19 points in the first half and the Atlanta Dream beat the Los Angeles Sparks 81-71 on Tuesday night for their franchise-best eighth straight victory.

Tiffany Hayes split a double team and made a floater in the lane to give Atlanta a 73-67 lead. On the Dream's next possession, McCoughtry hit a turnaround jumper to cap a 13-2 run.

Brittney Sykes added 13 points for Atlanta (16-9) and Hayes finished with 12 on 5-of-13 shooting. Elizabeth Williams also had 12 points.

Chelsea Gray scored 18 points for Los Angeles (15-11), which has lost five straight games at home. Candace Parker had 17 points, nine rebounds and five assists. Nneka Ogumike missed her third straight game with an illness and Alana Beard did not play due to a groin injury.

San Antonio Spurs guard DeMar DeRozan sat courtside.

JUNE 12, 2018

LOS ANGELES (AP) Candace Parker scored 18 points, Nneka Ogumike had 11 points and 10 rebounds and the Los Angeles Sparks beat the Atlanta Dream 72-64 on Tuesday night.

Odyssey Sims made a hook shot in the lane to extend Los Angeles' lead to eight points with 41.1 seconds to go and Essence Carson had a block at the other end to seal it.

Chelsea Gray added 10 points with seven assists for Los Angeles (6-2). The Sparks won four times during their five-game home-stand.

Parker scored 13 points in the first half to help Los Angeles to a 43-32 lead.

Tiffany Hayes scored 16 points for Atlanta (5-4), which had its three-game winning streak snapped. Jessica Breland added 14 points and Angel McCoughtry was held to 12 points on 3-of-14 shooting. The Dream shot just 38.5 percent from the floor, including 2 of 12 from 3-point range.

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Sparks

These two teams last met just over a week ago on July 2 in Minnesota, and the Lynx came away with an 85-68 win. Where in the World was Alex Bentley?

Alex Bentley missed four games while in Serbia with the Belarus national team to compete at Eurobasket. In Belarus' three games at the tournament, the team went 1-2, exiting the tournament in the group stage. Bentley averaged 11.7 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3 assists and 1.7 steals in 30.9 minutes per game.

Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked up by a number of national outlets.

"She was one of the loudest little kids in the building," Sykes said. "She was cheering us on. Mind you, we're getting beaten by Seattle. But she's giving us encouragement, telling us to keep going, telling us how much she loved the Dream, how much she loved our fight and everything. After I watched that video, our GM (Chris Sienko) sent it to us in a group chat and said, 'This is why we play. Keep in mind there's fans that love us and enjoy us.'"

Dream in the Preseason

Atlanta spent the preseason on the road, picking up two wins against Dallas (82-59) and New York (92-87) in Connecticut, but fell to Washington in a 75-64 decision in Albany, Ga. The game marked the Dream's first game in the state of Georgia outside of Atlanta.

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall). The team then traded Turner to Phoenix for the draft rights to the Mercury's 2018 first round selection, Marie Göllich.
