MINNEAPOLIS (AP) Tiffany Hayes scored a season-high 28 points, hitting a career-best six 3-pointers, to help the Atlanta Dream beat the Minnesota Lynx 86-66 on Sunday night.

Alex Bentley added 19 points and Angel McCoughtry had 11 points and eight rebounds for Atlanta (18-10).

McCoughtry hit a 3-pointer and Hayes added two more during a 16-1 run over the final four-plus minutes of the first half that made it 49-34 at the break. Sylvia Fowles scored the final six points in an 8-0 run that trimmed Minnesota's deficit to 54-48 with 3:49 left in the third quarter, but Hayes answered with a 3 and the Lynx (15-13) got no closer.

Fowles led Minnesota with 17 points and 10 rebounds. Maya Moore and Seimone Augustus added 15 points apiece.

The Lynx have lost three games in a row.

Atlanta hit a season-high 12 3-pointers.

Moore has reached at least 20 points

run with back-to-back 3-pointers that gave Minnesota a 74-53 lead to start the fourth quarter. The Dream got the deficit no closer than the final score.

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Lynx

Tiffany Hayes scored 28 points and made a career-high 6 3-pointers the last time these two teams met. Alex Bentley added 19 points and Angel Mc-Coughtry scored 11 points to round out the Dream's trio of double-digit scorers. With an 86-66 win, the Dream snapped a 10-game losing streak at the Target Center.

Career Milestones

Jessica Breland reached 300 career blocks on June 21 at Connecticut, making her just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone. Her 300 current career blocks ranks 5th among active players in the league.

Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in the June 19 matchup against the Fever. Hayes saw a season-high 28 points and four made three-pointers in the Dream's 10-point victory over Indiana.

Where in the World was Alex Bentley?

Alex Bentley missed four games while in Serbia with the Belarus national team to compete at Eurobasket. In Belarus' three games at the tournament, the team went 1-2, exiting the tournament in the group stage. Bentley averaged 11.7 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3 assists and 1.7 steals in 30.9 minutes per game.

Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked up by a number of national outlets.

"She was one of the loudest little kids in the building," Sykes said. "She was cheering us on. Mind you, we're getting beaten by Seattle. But she's giving us encouragement, telling us to keep going, telling us how much she loved the Dream, how much she loved our fight and everything. After I watched that video, our GM (Chris Sienko) sent it to us in a group chat and said, 'This is why we play. Keep in mind there's fans that love us and enjoy us.'"

Atlanta Block Party

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall).
