F #51 JESSICA BRELAND 6-2 | 166 | North Carolina

2019: Has started in all ten games this season ... Her 6.6 rebounds per game ranks 19th in the league ... Her 66 total rebounds ranks 25th in the league ... Just the 19th player in WNBA history to eclipse 300 career blocks.

F #10 NIA COFFEY 5-10 | 155 | Northwestern

MAY 31, 2019

ATLANTA (AP) Natasha Howard had 19 points and 14 rebounds, Jordin Canada added 12 points and eight assists, and the Seattle Storm beat the Atlanta Dream 82-66 on Friday night.

Alysha Clark had 11 points and Mercedes Russell and Jewell Loyd each scored 10 for Seattle. The defending WNBA champion Storm continue to be without reigning MVP Breanna Stewart (out for the season due to an Achilles injury), 11-time all-star Sue Bird (out indefinitely after arthroscopic surgery Thursday on her right knee) and head coach Dan Hughes (on medical leave after having a cancerous tumor removed from his digestive tract on May 14).

Howard hit two free throws before Canada scored back-to-back baskets to spark a 16-4 run that gave Seattle a 25-12 lead with six minutes left in the second quarter and the Dream (1-1) trailed by double figures the rest of the way.

Brittney Sykes led Atlanta with 12 points. The Dream shot just 32.9 percent (24 of 73) from the field, including 6 of 23 (26.1 percent) from 3-point range.

The Storm had 23 assists and 30 made field goals.

JULY 22, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Elizabeth Williams scored a season-high 17 points and grabbed eight rebounds to help the Atlanta Dream win their franchise-record seventh straight game with an 87-74 victory over the Seattle Storm on Sunday.

Seattle's Sue Bird, already the all-time WNBA assists leader, played her 500th career game, passing DeLisha Milton-Jones (499) for the WNBA record for games played.

Angel McCoughtry and Tiffany Hayes added 16 points each for Atlanta, which took the season series 2-1 with the win over Seattle.

The Dream (15-9) scored the last five points of the second quarter and led 50-34 after Hayes' 3-pointer to open the third. The Storm (18-7) closed within 52-45 in the middle of the third but got no closer.

Breanna Stewart had 31 points and eight rebounds for Seattle, which had its three-game winning streak snapped. Bird added 12 points with four 3-pointers and Jewell Loyd scored 11.

JULY 6, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Breanna Stewart had 29 points, nine rebounds and three blocks to help the Seattle Storm beat the Atlanta Dream 95-86 on Friday night for their fourth straight victory.

Sue Bird added 18 points and 10 assists, Alysha Clark scored 14 points and Jewell Loyd had 11 for Seattle (14-5). Natasha Howard had 10 points and 10 rebounds.

After Atlanta (8-9) jumped to a 9-2 lead, the Storm scored 14 of the next 15 points and never again trailed. Stewart converted a four-point play and then hit a jumper to spark a 14-0 run that made it 50-21 with a minute left in the first half.

The Dream outscored Seattle 29-19 in the third quarter and a 3-pointer by Tiffany Hayes trimmed their deficit to 72-66 early in the fourth, but Atlanta got no closer. Loyd answered with a 3 and then a pull-up jumper to push the lead back into double figures.

Angel McCoughtry scored 26 points and Hayes added 23 for the Dream.

Seattle shot 51.4 percent from the field, including 9 of 20 from 3-point range.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Storm

The Storm handed the Dream their first loss of the season on May 31, defeating Atlanta in an 82-66 decision at State Farm Arena. Brittney Sykes scored a team-leading 12 points, while Jessica Breland, Monique Billings and Nia Coffey all grabbed 8 rebounds each.

Career Milestones

Jessica Breland reached 300 career blocks on June 21 at Connecticut, making her just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone. Her 300 current career blocks ranks 5th among active players in the league.

Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in the June 19 matchup against the Fever. Hayes saw a season-high 28 points and four made three-pointers in the Dream's 10-point victory over Indiana.

Where in the World was Alex Bentley?

Alex Bentley missed four games while in Serbia with the Belarus national team to compete at Eurobasket. In Belarus' three games at the tournament, the team went 1-2, exiting the tournament in the group stage. Bentley averaged 11.7 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3 assists and 1.7 steals in 30.9 minutes per game.

Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked up by a number of national outlets.

"She was one of the loudest little kids in the building," Sykes said. "She was cheering us on. Mind you, we're getting beaten by Seattle. But she's giving us encouragement, telling us to keep going, telling us how much she loved the Dream, how much she loved our fight and everything. After I watched that video, our GM (Chris Sienko) sent it to us in a group chat and said, 'This is why we play. Keep in mind there's fans that love us and enjoy us.'"

Atlanta Block Party

Three different Dream players recorded at least three blocks against Dallas in the team's 2019 season opener. The two other times this has happened in WNBA history, at least one Dream player was involved - Jes-

Dream in the Preseason

Atlanta spent the preseason on the road, picking up two wins against Dallas (82-59) and New York (92-87) in Connecticut, but fell to Washington in a 75-64 decision in Albany, Ga. The game marked the Dream's first game in the state of Georgia outside of Atlanta.

WSB-TV Multimedia Partnership

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was
