2019: Has started in all 18 games this season ... Her 7.1 rebounds per game ranks 13th in the league ... Her 127 total rebounds ranks 10th in the league ... Just the 19th player in WNBA history to eclipse 300 career blocks.

G #7 BRITTNEY SYKES 5-9 | 154 | Syracuse

2019: Has started in 11 of 18 games this season ... Averaging 11.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game ... Scored 22 points in the third quarter at Phoenix (7/7), tying a WNBA record for most points in a quarter, previously set by Diana Taurasi.

ATLANTA (AP) Elena Delle Donne had a rather quiet night by her high standards.

No worries.

The Washington Mystics are headed to the WNBA Finals for the first time in franchise history.

Rookie Ariel Atkins, Kristi Toliver and Tianna Hawkins picked up the slack for the Mystics, who held off the Atlanta Dream 86-81 in the decisive fifth game of their semifinal series Tuesday night.

"Wow," coach Mike Thibault said. "We're here because we're persistent, we're resilient and we play together."

The Dream led 71-69 with just under 7 minutes remaining but suddenly went cold at the worst time of a turnaround season. Washington seized the lead with a 9-0 run and survived a desperation 3-pointer by Tiffany Hayes, earning a spot in the Finals against Seattle.

Delle Donne was held to 14 points, far below the 24.7 she was averaging in the series despite missing Game 3 with a knee injury. She did make a big jumper with 1:41 remaining, and sealed the victory with four straight free throws in the closing seconds.

Yet this was really about Atkins, playing with the poise of a veteran while scoring 20 points. And Toliver, who came up huge in the first half and finished with 19. And don't forget Hawkins, who chipped in with 17.

"That's why I came to D.C. - to make history," Toliver said. "It's very special to do it with this group of people. We just have a great, great locker room. It's an exciting time to be a D.C. fan and I'm glad I'm on the winning side of it right now."

Alex Bentley scored 16 points to lead five Atlanta players in double figures. But the Dream couldn't overcome the

loss of star Angel McCoughtry late in the regular season to a knee injury.

"I just got done bawling in the locker room," said red-eyed Nicki Collen, who earned coach of the year honors in her debut season for leading the Dream to a 23-11 record - an 11-win improvement over 2017. "I'm incredibly proud of this team. We're further ahead than I thought we would be when I took this job."

"Damn, a hell of a year."

The first half was a back-and-forth offensive show, even though Delle Donne was limited to four points.

Toliver carried the load with 17 points - much of it from long range. She knocked down a 3-pointer from almost 30 feet and even tried one from just inside the midcourt stripe.

The Dream responded with a more balanced attack, led by Bentley with 11 points off the bench, and were up 50-49 at halftime.

Both teams clamped down defensively in the second half.

In the end, Washington got the stops that mattered. After Bentley hit a 3 and Washington failed to get the ball inbounds, Atlanta had a chance to tie. But Bentley couldn't get open, forcing Hayes to throw up a wild shot that didn't hit anything.

"We knew offense was not going to win this game," Toliver said. "We knew it would come down to defense and rebounding."

Washington grabbed 17 offensive rebounds.

HOLDING HER TONGUE

Collen and her players were not happy with the way the game was called - especially in the fourth quarter.

The Dream was whistled for 21 fouls, compared to 10 for the Mystics. Renee Montgomery fouled out, depriving Atlanta of a much-needed 3-point threat in the closing seconds.

Washington finished 16 of 19 from the foul line. Atlanta was 8 of 9.

"There's a lot I really could say that I'm not supposed to say," Collen said. "So I'm going to hold my tongue about what I'm not supposed to say."

TIP-INS

Delle Donne did lead the Mystics with 11 rebounds. She also had four assists, two blocks and a steal. ... Montgomery and Brittney Sykes had 15 points each for the Dream. Hayes added 13 and Elizabeth Williams 10. Jessica Breland grabbed 12 rebounds. ... Breland hobbled to the bench after a wild scramble in the lane midway through the third quarter but was able to return about 2 1/2 minutes later.

DROP THE MIC

After watching the game from the bench, McCoughtry grabbed a microphone to thank the home crowd for their support.

"We've got a great team," she said. "We'll be back."

FRENZIED THIRD

Hawkins took over for Washington in the final 2 minutes of the third quarter, single-handedly ripping off an 8-0 run with a pair of 3-pointers and a fast-break layup that turned a 61-59 deficit into a 67-61 lead for the Mystics.

But the Dream finished the period on a high. After Delle Donne missed wide-open 3 from the top of the key, Montgomery raced to the other end of the court, curled behind a pick and hurled up a 3-pointer at the buzzer that cut the deficit to 67-64 heading to the final period.

PLAYOFF HISTORY

The Dream missed out on the fourth trip to the Finals in franchise history. They were swept in each of their three previous appearances.

The Mystics were in the semifinals for the second year in a row. This time, they made it over the hump.

JUNE 1, 2019

WASHINGTON (AP) Ariel Atkins scored 21 points, Elena Delle Donne added 18 in her season debut and the Washington Mystics coasted to a 96-75 victory over the Atlanta Dream on Saturday night.

The Mystics christened their new Entertainment and Sports Arena by shooting 57 percent, led by Delle Donne, who was 5 for 5 for 10 points in the first quarter to help built a 26-16 lead.

It was 52-35 at the half as Delle Donne, who missed the season opener with a sore left knee, was 7 for 7 and Washington shot 61 percent.

Atkins finished 8 of 11 from the field with four 3-pointers. Emma Messeman added 14 points for Washington (1-1) and Kristi Toliver and Shatori Walker-Kimbrough had 10 apiece. Toliver sat out most of the second half of the season opener with a knee injury.

The Dream (1-2), playing on back-to-back nights, got 11 points from Tiffany Hayes and Alex Bentley.

The Mystics, who beat the Dream in the semifinals last year, are the primary tenant in the 4,200-seat arena in southeast D.C.

ATLANTA (AP) Elena Delle Donne scored eight of her 21 points in a game-changing 14-0 run to start the second half and the Washington Mystics rolled to an 89-73 win over the Atlanta Dream on Sunday.

Kristi Toliver and reserve Tianna Hawkins added 17 points apiece for the Mystics (7-3), who won their third-straight on a four-game road trip. Delle Donne also had 10 rebounds. Toliver hit three 3s, pushing her career total to 581 which is ninth best in league history.

Tiffany Hayes led the Dream (2-7), who led 45-42 at the half, with 18 points. Monique Billings came off the bench to score 10 points and grab 14 rebounds.

LaToya Sanders opened the second half with a basket to cut the deficit to one and after an Atlanta miss, Delle Donne hit the go-ahead 3-pointer, making it 47-45. The Dream missed two free throws, the Mystics made two and then Atlanta had three-straight turnovers before a miss. Delle Donne scored inside and hit another 3 and the lead was 10.

Atlanta had two more misses before rookie Maite Cazorla ended the drought but Washington scored the next seven.

Washington, the league's leader in points (85.6) and 3s per game (9.13) shot 46% overall and made 10 of 29 3-pointers.

The 6-4 Coates played in 14 games with Minnesota this season, averaging 2.4 rebounds and 2.5 points per game.

"We are thrilled to add a player with the size and athleticism of Alaina," head coach Nicki Collen said. "We have struggled at times with defensive rebounding and scoring efficiently around the rim this season, and we believe she can help us in those two areas now and in the future."

Career Milestones

Renee Montgomery is only two made three-pointers away from reaching 500 in her career. She will become only the 13th player in the WNBA to reach this milestone.

Alex Bentley is 5 assists away from 600.
Jessica Breland is 1 assist away from 300.
Monique Billings is 8 points away from 200.

Jessica Breland reached 300 career blocks on June 21 at Connecticut, making her just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone. Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in the June 19 matchup against the Fever.

Dream Hold Lynx to 53

On July 12, Atlanta beat Minnesota 60-53 for the team's second straight win and fifth of the season. Minnesota's 53 points is the second fewest Atlanta has held a team to in franchise history, and the Lynx's 21 points in the second half is tied for the fewest allowed in Dream history. The 113 combined points in the game were the fewest seen in the WNBA since Los Angeles beat San Antonio 60-52 on Aug. 30, 2015.

The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall). The team then traded Turner to Phoenix for the draft rights to the Mercury's 2018 first round selection, Marie Göllich.
