2019: Has started in all 21 games this season ... Her 6.9 rebounds per game ranks 16th in the league ... Her 145 total rebounds ranks 8th in the league ... Just the 9th player in WNBA history to eclipse both 300 career blocks and 300 career rebounds.

G #7 BRITTNEY SYKES 5-9 | 154 | Syracuse

2019: Has started in 14 of 21 games this season ... Averaging 11.1 points and 4.6 rebounds per game ... Scored 22 points in the third quarter at Phoenix (7/7), tying a WNBA record for most points in a quarter, previously set by Diana Taurasi.

C #1 ELIZABETH WILLIAMS 6-3 | 200 | Duke

2019: Has started in all 21 games this season ... Averaging 1.6 blocks per game, which is currently the 7th-highest average in the league ... Her 34 total blocks ranks 4th in the WNBA this season.

CHICAGO (AP) Diamond DeShields scored 20 of her season-high 22 points in the first half, Stefanie Dolson made a go-ahead layup with 2.3 seconds left and the Chicago Sky beat the Atlanta Dream 77-76 on Wednesday.

DeShields made 1 of 2 free throws with 31.3 seconds left to pull Chicago to 76-75, and the Sky forced Atlanta into a long 3-pointer by Alex Bentley at the other end. After a timeout at 6.9, Courtney Vandersloot drew two defenders on a drive into the lane and found an open Dolson under the basket. Atlanta had an open shot in the corner at the buzzer but Brittney Sykes' shot was off the mark.

DeShields was 10 of 13 from the free-throw line and also grabbed eight rebounds for Chicago (10-8), which has won three straight games. Dolson finished with six points and nine rebounds.

Renee Montgomery led Atlanta (5-12) with 23 points and six assists. Jessica Breland had 10 points and 13 rebounds. The Dream led by double figures midway through the third quarter.

AUGUST 3, 2018

ATLANTA (AP) Angel McCoughtry scored 21 points, Tiffany Hayes added 19 and the Atlanta Dream beat the Chicago Sky 89-74 on Friday night.

Atlanta closed the third quarter on a 6-0 run, for a 64-59 lead, and held Chicago to 4-of-17 shooting in the frame.

Hayes and Alex Bentley each made a 3-pointer on Atlanta's first two possessions of the fourth quarter for a 70-59 lead and the Dream led by at least seven points the rest of the way.

Jessica Breland had 13 points and nine rebounds for Atlanta (17-10). The second-place Dream are three games back of Seattle (20-7) in the playoff standings and one game ahead of Los Angeles (16-11).

Courtney Vandersloot led Chicago (10-18) with 24 points, seven assists and four steals. Allie Quigley was held to eight points.

Vandersloot sank a running 3-pointer just before the halftime buzzer, capping Chicago's 9-0 run for a 43-42 lead. She had 16 points in the first half, including 3-of-3 shooting from 3-point range.

JUNE 27, 2018

CHICAGO (AP) Diamond DeShields scored 23 points, Allie Quigley had 22 and the Chicago Sky beat the Atlanta Dream 93-80 on Wednesday.

DeShields also had 11 rebounds to help Chicago (5-9) win its second straight after a six-game losing streak.

Stefanie Dolson added 12 points.

Renee Montgomery led Atlanta (7-7) with 19 points. Elizabeth Williams and Layshia Clarendon each had 13 points.

Last Time Out: Dream vs. Sky

When the Dream traveled to Chicago in July, they led for the majority of the game before a go-ahead layup by Stefanie Dolson with 2.3 seconds left gave the Sky the win. Renee Montgomery paced the Dream with a season-high 23 points, including six made three-pointers. Jessica Breland had her first double-double of the season and the 19th of her career with 10 points and 13 rebounds.

Dream Sign Alaina Coates

The Atlanta Dream have signed center Alaina Coates, president and general manager Chris Sienko announced Thursday (July 18). The former University of South Carolina standout will join the team on Sunday and is active for Tuesday's game against the Sparks. The 6-4 Coates played in 14 games with Minnesota this season, averaging 2.4 rebounds and 2.5 points per game.

"We are thrilled to add a player with the size and athleticism of Alaina," head coach Nicki Collen said. "We have struggled at times with defensive rebounding and scoring efficiently around the rim this season, and we believe she can help us in those two areas now and in the future."

Career Milestones

On July 31, Renee Montgomery made the 500th three-pointer of her career. She is just the 13th player in WNBA history to reach this milestone.

Brittney Sykes is 15 points away from 1,000 career points.

Jessica Breland reached 300 career blocks on June 21 at Connecticut, making her just the 19th player in WNBA to reach the milestone. Tiffany Hayes reached 3,004 career points in the June 19 matchup against the Fever.

Dream Hold Lynx to 53

On July 12, Atlanta beat Minnesota 60-53 for the team's second straight win and fifth of the season. Minnesota's 53 points is the second fewest Atlanta has held a team to in franchise history, and the Lynx's 21 points in the second half is tied for the fewest allowed in Dream history. The 113 combined points in the game were the fewest seen in the WNBA since Los Angeles beat San Antonio 60-52 on Aug. 30, 2015.

From 7/12/19 to 7/23/19, Renee Montgomery held the longest streak of consecutive games with at least one made three-pointer in the WNBA. She held the second-highest record until Diana Taurasi broke her streak of 44 consecutive games. It is the longest streak of consecutive games with a three-pointer in Dream history.

In just two seasons with the Dream, Renee Montgomery has already climbed up the ranks as her 113 three-pointers made stands as fourth-most in franchise history. Five active players are on the Dream's top-ten list, led by Tiffany Hayes' 261 three-pointers.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Where in the World was Alex Bentley?

Alex Bentley missed four games while in Serbia with the Belarus national team to compete at Eurobasket. In Belarus' three games at the tournament, the team went 1-2, exiting the tournament in the group stage. Bentley averaged 11.7 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3 assists and 1.7 steals in 30.9 minutes per game.

Sykes' Famous Sneakers

After the Dream's May 31 game against the Seattle Storm, a video of guard Brittney Sykes giving Mya Nelson - a 9-year-old Dream fan - her game-worn sneakers went viral. The original video has nearly 300,000 views on Twitter alone, and has been picked up by a number of national outlets.

Dream in the Preseason

Atlanta spent the preseason on the road, picking up two wins against Dallas (82-59) and New York (92-87) in Connecticut, but fell to Washington in a 75-64 decision in Albany, Ga. The game marked the Dream's first game in the state of Georgia outside of Atlanta.

WSB-TV Multimedia Partnership

The Atlanta Dream and WSB-TV announced a new multi-platform media deal that will feature Dream games being broadcast and streamed across WSB-TV platforms this season. WSB-TV will present a total of 18 Dream games this season, including eight road contests. The Dream also named its announcing team for the upcoming season with Andy Demetra handling play-by-play duties and Amy Audibert serving as analyst.

Collen Chosen as Best Manager/Motivator of People

In the 2019 WNBA GM survey, head coach Nicki Collen led all candidates with 50% of the vote for the best manager/motivator of people. Tiffany Hayes was chosen as the league's most underrated player, tied with LA's Chelsea Gray and Chicago's Allie Quigley. The Dream was chosen as the best defensive unit.

Dream Draft Three in 2019 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2019 WNBA Draft. Collen drafted Brianna Turner with the 11th overall pick, Maite Cazorla (Oregon) in the second round (23rd overall) and Li Yueru (China) in the third round (35th overall). The team then traded Turner to Phoenix for the draft rights to the Mercury's 2018 first round selection, Marie Göllich.
