#### 2020 Rookie of the Year Frontrunner vs. Sabrina Ionescu

New York's Sabrina Ionescu and Atlanta's Chennedy Carter – the No. 1 and No. 4 overall picks in the 2020 WNBA Draft, respectively – will meet for the first time in their professional careers on Friday. The last time these two met was on November 16, 2017 when the Oregon Ducks visited the Texas A&M Aggies in College Station. Carter put up 23 points with 7 rebounds and 7 assists, while Ionescu tallied 16 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists. The Ducks walked away with the win, 83–28.

#### 2020 WNBA Season at IMG Academy

The league's 24<sup>th</sup> season will take place in Bradenton, Florida at IMG Academy, the Official Home of the 2020 WNBA season, and will include a 22-game schedule for each of its 12 teams. The Dream's regular season will run from July 26 to September 11, and will be followed by a standard-format Playoff series.

#### **Opening Night**

In the Dream's 105-95 season-opening win over Dallas, Atlanta showed off a fast new offensive pace to emerge as the top-scoring team through the first games. Monique Billings led all scorers over the weekend, finishing with 30 points and 13 rebounds for her second career double-double. All five starters for the Dream scored in double digits and combined for 100 points for the first time in franchise history and just the sixth time in WNBA history.

#### **Returning Players**

Dream veteran center Elizabeth Williams and forward Monique Billings are the only returning players on Atlanta's roster this season. They are joined by 11 new players, three of which are rookies. Blake Dietrick played for the Dream in 2018 and returned for training camp in 2019, but was waived by Atlanta and picked up by Seattle for the 2019 season.

Only one other team\* in WNBA history has returned two or fewer players from the previous season – Phoenix in 2017 (returned Diana Taurasi and Brittney Griner).

#### **Career Milestones**

Elizabeth Williams needs 21 blocks to surpass Erika de Souza (281) as Atlanta's career blocks leader, and only needs one rebound to reach 1,000 in her career. She is also 43 points away from 1,500 career points.

Shekinna Stricklen is 4 steals away from 200 and 9 made free throws away from reaching 250 in her career.

Courtney Williams is one steal away from reaching 100 in her career.

#### Hollywood

Chennedy Carter started off her 2020 Rookie of the Year campaign with a bang last Sunday night, scoring 18 points with 8 assists with only two turnovers. She led all rookies in scoring and ranked second in the league in assists (behind Courtney Vandersloot's 11)

The standout was one of the most dynamic scorers in NCAA D-I during her three-year career at Texas A&M. She scored at least 26 points in all six of her career NCAA Tournament games, leading the Aggies to the NCAA Sweet 16 twice. Among players with at least five NCAA Tournament games played, Carter ranks third in scoring average at 31.0 points per game, trailing only Elena Delle Donne [34.4 PPG at Delaware] and Sheryl Swoopes [31.7 PPG at Texas Tech].

#### Courtney Williams and Glory Johnson Join the Dream

Atlanta newcomers Courtney Williams and Glory Johnson have been taken off the injury list and are set to join the team for Friday's game against New York. Johnson recently announced that she had contracted COVID-19 after coming into the WNBA bubble in Florida, but that she had been asymptomatic and is now healthy.

#### **Laney Finding Her Place**

After spending the first four years of her career with Indiana and Chicago, guard Betnijah (buh-NIGH-jah) Laney is finding her place with Atlanta. Originally brought in for her defensive mindset, she has proven herself to be a strong offensive player and was a standout for the Dream during training camp. In her first game in red and gray, Laney started and put up a career-high 19 points with 3 assists and grabbed two defensive boards.

#### **Connecticut South**

Shekinna Stricklen and Courtney Williams, who helped Connecticut reach the WNBA Finals last season, are new to Atlanta but not to Nicki Collen, who spent 2015–17 as an assistant with the Sun. Last year, Stricklen ranked third in the league in made threes (76) and Williams was 20th in scoring (13.2 ppg).



#### NOTES AND STORYLINES

#### Intersectionality, n.

The interconnected nature of social categorizations such as race, class, and gender, regarded as creating overlapping and interdependent systems of discrimination or disadvantage; a theoretical approach based on such a premise. [Oxford Dictionary].

Intersectional theory asserts that people are often disadvantaged by multiple sources of oppression: their race, class, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, and other identity markers. Intersectionality recognizes that identity markers (e.g. "woman" and "black") do not exist independently of each other, and that each informs the others, often creating a complex convergence of oppression.<sup>1</sup>

#### Kimberlé Crenshaw and the Creation of "Intersectionality"

Twenty-eight years ago, Kimberlé Crenshaw coined the term "intersectionality" in a paper as a way to help explain the oppression of African-American women. Crenshaw's then somewhat academic term is now at the forefront of national conversations about racial justice, identity politics, and policing—and over the years has helped shape legal discussions. A leading thinker and scholar in the field of critical race theory, Crenshaw, a professor at Columbia Law School, directs the Center for Intersectionality and Social Policy Studies and is a co-founder of the African American Policy Forum, a think tank, both based on campus.

"Intersectionality is a lens through which you can see where power comes and collides, where it interlocks and intersects," Crenshaw said. "It's not simply that there's a race problem here, a gender problem here, and a class or LBGTQ problem there. Many times that framework erases what happens to people who are subject to all of these things."<sup>2</sup>

#### **Elizabeth Williams**

With Dream veteran Tiffany Hayes choosing to forego the 2020 season, Elizabeth Williams becomes the Dream's current active leader in nearly every statistical category with 1,371 points, 927 rebounds, 259 blocks, 134 games played and 4,076 minutes in a Dream uniform.

In her first game of the season, Williams shot a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and 3-of-3 from the charity stripe. She tied the franchise record for most field goals without a miss

#### **Lady Vols**

Glory Johnson and Shekinna Stricklen will appear on the same roster for the first time in their professional careers this summer. The last time the duo played together was at the University of Tennessee, when they led the Lady Vols to back-to-back Elite Eight appearances and three-straight SEC Tournament Championships under legendary coach Pat Summitt. Stricklen and Johnson were selected second and fourth overall, respectively, in the 2012 WNBA Draft.

#### Offseason Moves

Atlanta had the most active offseason of any team in the league this year, aquiring 10 new players through Free Agency, the Draft and trades prior to coming to Florida. The Dream traded for Courtney Williams from Connecticut and Kalani Brown from Los Angeles, along with a talented crop of Free Agents that included Glory Johnson and Shekinna Stricklen. #### Dream Draft Four in 2020 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted four players in the 2020 WNBA Draft, headlined by guard Chennedy Carter out of Texas A&M with the No. 4 overall selection. Collen picked Texas Tech forward Brittany Brewer with the No. 17 overall selection (second round) – Carter and Brewer both signed contracts with the team for the 2020 season.

Collen also selected Oregon State guard Mikayla Pivec and Clemson forward Kobi Thornton with the No. 25 and 27 picks (third round), respectively.

#### A Bold New Era

Atlanta implemented a rebrand prior to the 2020 season, unveiling new logos and colors for the first time since its inaugural season (2008). The Dream also has new uniforms, a new mascot and had been slated for a new home – the Gateway Center Arena @ College Park. The new primary logo reflects a combination of icons related to Atlanta's history. Centered around a basketball, the rising phoenix symbolizes the city's rise from the ashes of the Civil War to become a world city, and a shooting star ties the Dream to its original roots.

#### RECENT MEETINGS WITH LIBERTY

#### JUNE 30, 2019

ATLANTA (AP) Tina Charles had 17 of her 24 points in the first half and the New York Liberty beat the Atlanta Dream 74-58 on Sunday.

The Liberty (5-7) pulled away with 10 straight points to start the second quarter and led 39-28 at halftime.

Renee Montgomery made a pair of 3-pointers to help Atlanta cut the deficit to 56-48 at the end of the third quarter, but the Dream (2-8) would get no closer in the fourth.

Brittany Boyd scored 15 points and No. 2 overall pick Asia Durr added 11 points for New York in her return to her hometown. Reshanda Gray had eight points and 15 rebounds.

New York has gone 5–3 after opening the season with four straight losses.

Brittney Sykes was 4 of 5 from 3-point range and tied a season high with 18 points for the Dream. Renee Montgomery added 11 points and Elizabeth Williams scored 10.

#### **AUGUST 23, 2019**

WHITE PLAINS, N.Y. (AP) Tiffany Hayes scored 19 points to lead five Atlanta starters in double figures, and the Dream beat the New York Liberty 90–87 on Friday night to snap a 12–game losing streak.

Renee Montgomery made a contested layup in the lane with 15.8 seconds left to give Atlanta an 88-87 lead. After Rebecca Allen's free-throw line jumper rolled out, Hayes made two free throws and Allen was long on a corner 3-pointer at the buzzer.

Atlanta (6-22) won its first game since topping Minnesota on July 12, snapping the team's longest slide since starting 0-17 in 2008.

Montgomery finished with 18 points, Brittney Sykes had 17, and Jessica Breland and Monique Billings each scored 11 for Atlanta. Breland also grabbed 12 rebounds for her 20th career double-double.

Atlanta used a 27-11 spurt through the first nine minutes of the third quarter to take a 73-62 lead.

Bria Hartley led New York (9–19) with 17 points, and Tina Charles had 15 points, eight rebounds and five assists.

#### SEPTEMBER 8, 2019

ATLANTA (AP) Tina Charles scored 14 points, Amanda Zahui B added a double-double and the New York Liberty topped the Atlanta Dream 71–63 in a battle between the bottom two teams on Sunday, the last day of the WNBA season.

The Liberty (10–24) had an 18–11 advantage in the third quarter to stretch a 44–38 halftime lead to 63–49 and was never seriously challenged by the Dream (8–26).

Zahui B had 13 points and 11 rebounds. Charles had eight rebounds and closed the season with 156 career double-doubles, one behind Lisa Leslie, who is second on the WNBA all-time list.

Brittney Sykes had 12 points for the Dream and Jessica Breland had 10 points and 12 rebounds.

Atlanta gave a ceremonial start to injured forward Angel McCoughtry, who has been sidelined for the season while recovering from a knee injury she suffered last year. They took her out right after the tip.

A loss in their last game assured the Liberty of having the best odds in the WNBA draft lottery and then they get to end their season with a win to avoid finishing last. The lottery is weighted on a rolling two-year record.

With 16 assists, New York broke its franchise record with 663, one more than last season.


