Atlanta Dream names NFL Executive and Sports Industry Veteran Morgan Shaw Parker as President and Chief Operating Officer

The Atlanta Dream announced today that NFL Executive Morgan Shaw Parker will join the team as President and Chief Operating Officer. Shaw Parker brings over 25 years of experience and values-driven leadership at all levels of the sports industry.

Most recently she served as Vice President and Chief Marketing Officer at Arthur M. Blank Sports & Entertainment (AMBSE) where she led marketing and communications initiatives for the Atlanta Falcons and Mercedes-Benz Stadium.

Prior to AMBSE, Shaw Parker spent over a decade at Nike, Inc., five years with the Kansas City Chiefs and several years with two industry-leading sports marketing agencies.

"It is an incredible honor to join the WNBA and the Atlanta Dream, an organization whose new leadership celebrates its players and embraces their powerful roles both on the court and in the Atlanta community," said Shaw Parker.

Dream Sign Blake Dietrick to Rest of Season

The Atlanta Dream signed guard Blake Dietrick to a rest-of-season contract on Tuesday, August 24.

The 5-10 guard out of Princeton will play her third season with the Dream in 2021, returning after her career performance in the 2020 WNBA Bubble in Bradenton, Fla. Last year, Dietrick averaged 5.9 points, 3.4 assists and 1.6 rebounds per game, shooting 44.8 percent from beyond the arc – setting the Atlanta Dream single-season record.

Most recently, Dietrick represented the United States earlier this week at the FIBA 3x3 Women's Series in Constanta, Romania, helping her team to a fourth-place finish in the tournament.

Candice Dupree Comes Back Down South

The Atlanta Dream most recently signed seven-time WNBA All-Star Candice Dupree to a contract on July 26. The Tampa, Fla. native is in her 16th year in the league and ranks as one of the top players in WNBA history in the all-time records books.

Dupree has 69 career double-doubles, which stands as the 12th-most double-doubles in WNBA history and 5th-best among active players. She has recorded a double-double in 14.3% of all games she has played (484).

Against Los Angeles (8/17), she recorded her 900th assist in the WNBA, joining Tamika Catchings as just the second player in league history with 6,000+ PTS, 3,000+ REB and 900+ AST (via Across the Timeline).

Darius Taylor Named Interim Assistant Coach

Prior to the team retuning to Atlanta from the Olympic hiatus, Mike Petersen stepped down from his role as the Dream's Interim Head Coach. "For health reasons that the grind of the WNBA season will not allow me to adequately address, I have decided to step down from my coaching duties with the Dream," Petersen said. "I want to thank the Atlanta Dream players, staff and ownership for the opportunity to be part of an amazing organization."

Darius Taylor was elevated to the head coaching role and will lead the team as a head coach for the first time in his career as the Dream faces Phoenix on August 15.

Taylor's career began at Temple University in the early 2000's as an assistant coach under Dawn Staley (where he coached Candice Dupree). Prior to joining former head coach Nicki Collen's staff in Atlanta along with Mike Petersen, Taylor had left the coaching world, following his now-wife Joni Taylor to Athens as she took over the Georgia Bulldogs women's basketball program.

Courtney Williams

Second-year Dream guard Courtney Williams is averaging 16.5 points, 6.8 rebounds, and 4.1 assists per game. She's the only player in the league averaging 16/6/4. The only players to do it in the history of the league are Candace Parker (4 times), Tamika Catchings, and Swin Cash.

Williams is 2^{nd} in the league in total minutes (1,067) and 2^{nd} in minutes per game (34.4). Her previous career-high was 30.5 minutes per game, set last year.

Williams is hitting 38.2% on threes after shooting 23.5% last season. She's one of only 9 players who have attempted 90 threes and are hitting at least 38.2%.

Ball Thieves

The Dream lead the league in steals per game (9.0) and steal rate (steal on 10.0% of opponent plays finished).

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Tiffany Hayes recorded five steals at Washington (6/17) and Cheyenne Parker recorded five against Minnesota (6/23).

- Hayes was the first Dream player to record five in a game since Renee Montgomery did it in 2018.
- The last time two different Dream players had five-steal games was in 2016 (Bria Holmes, Sancho Lyttle) (via Elias). The franchise record is four players with 5+ steals in a season.

The Dream is averaging 12.1 turnovers per game this season, the second-fewest in the league this year and on track for the fewest in franchise record (current all-time low: 12.2 in 2017). Atlanta also owns the second-lowest turnover percentage rate this year at 14.9%, behind only Las Vegas's 14.2%.

Atlanta also ranks second in the league in low turnover rate, turning the ball over on only 12.9% of their plays finished with a shot, free throw, or turnover.

The difference between the Dream's turnovers per game (12.1) and steals per game (9.0) is just 3.10. That's the second-smallest gap in WNBA history (steals closest to turnovers in history). The 1998 Houston Comets were at 2.83.

Protecting the Glass

The Dream rank second in the league with 9.7 offensive rebounds per game, behind only Dallas' 10.2 per game. Atlanta ranks 4th in offensive rebounding rate, pulling down the board on 25% of their own misses.

Monique Billings ranks third in the league with 2.8 offensive rebounds per game (a career best for her) and 9^{th} with a 10.0% offensive rebound percentage.

Courtney Williams leads all guards with 1.5 offensive rebounds and 6.9 total per game, and 45 total o-boards and 213 total rebounds so far this season. She ranks second in the league with an average of 5.4 defensive boards and 168 total DREB, behind only CON's DeWanna Bonner.

Double-Doubles

Courtney Williams leads the Dream this year with 7 double-doubles and two instances of back-to-back double-doubles. Most recently she went back-to-back with 15 PTS/11 REB against Indiana and 13 PTS/10 REB against Los Angeles, bringing her to 11 double-doubles in her Dream career - the fifth-most in franchise history. She has done it in 20% of her games in an Atlanta uniform, which ranks third all-time in franchise history.

Aari McDonald Sets Dream Free Throw Record

Aari McDonald most recently set the Atlanta Dream franchise record with 31 consecutive made free throws. Her 31-straight stood as the longest streak among active players in the league until she missed her second free throw against Phoenix on 8/15.

Pro Baller, Mother, and Software Engineer Tianna Hawkins

When Dream forward Tianna Hawkins isn't playing, she is juggling one of her many other responsibilities. Not only is she a mother to her five-year-old son, Emanuel, she is also a part-time software engineer with Microsoft. A graduate of the University of Maryland with a degree in Criminology and Criminal Justice, Hawkins would like to become a federal agent after her professional career. While in college, she even had the opportunity to intern with the Secret Service.

Dream Draft Three in 2021 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2021 WNBA Draft, picking

guard Aari McDonald out of Arizona with the third overall selection, Spanish star Raquel Carrera with the 15th overall pick and Lindsey Pulliam out of Northwestern with the 27th pick.

At Arizona, McDonald led the Wildcats to the team's first NCAA Finals appearance in 2021, averaging 24.8 points in their six games of the NCAA Tournament, including dropping 33 points against Indiana in the Elite Eight. The 5-6 guard earned Pac-12 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year awards her redshirt senior year before becoming the first Wildcat to ever be drafted in the first round of a WNBA Draft. McDonald is still working to finish her masters degree at Arizona, studying Applied Behavior Analysis.

2021 Dream Uniforms

Entering the 2021 season, the WNBA and Nike have joined forces to tell H.E.R. story. The Dream worked with Nike to create three special uniforms that convey a message around the unique characteristics of Atlanta and to tell our story. The three uniforms have been given the names Heroine, Explorer and Rebel to highlight the power, potential and attitude of the WNBA athlete.

Atlanta Dream's Nike Heroine Edition in white and Atlanta Dream's Nike Explorer Edition in red uniforms capture the passion, courage and heart of the Georgians who championed the Civil Rights Movement. The belief in a more equitable tomorrow is amplified, represented by shimmering rays cast over a striking, bold red field — details that symbolize hope.

The colorful Atlanta Dream's Rebel Edition pays homage to the sound of Atlanta, defined by the city's unmatched impact on Hip-Hop and R&B. The legacy of the scene's legendary female recording artists is celebrated with vibrant colors, strapping side-striping, and confident lettering—a salute to the swagger, creativity and iconicity of ATL's most influential female musicians. The large ATL wordmark represents the city, while the side-panel design lines invoke vinyl records of the past and the ever-evolving sound of today's female artists. The subtle hints of silver in the uniform — such as the silver star and logo detailing — are symbolic of the platinum and gold records produced by the women of the city.

New Ownership Group

WNBA and NBA Boards of Governors unanimously approved the sale of the Atlanta Dream to Larry Gottesdiener, Chairman of Northland, an industry-leading national real estate firm on February 26, 2021. The three-member investor group is comprised of former Dream star Renee Montgomery, Northland President and Chief Operating Officer Suzanne Abair, and Gottesdiener.

The sale made two-time WNBA champion Renee Montgomery the first former player to become both an owner and executive of a WNBA team. Montgomery sat out the 2020 season to focus on social justice issues and recently announced her retirement from the league after 11 seasons.

UNCASVILLE, Conn. (AP) Jonquel Jones had 24 points and 16 rebounds, DeWanna Bonner added 22 points and the Connecticut Sun beat the Atlanta Dream 84-72 on Friday night to wrap up a spot in the WNBA Commissioner's Cup championship.

Connecticut will represent the Eastern Conference in the inaugural title game Aug. 12 in Phoenix after going 8-1 in Commissioner's Cup games. The title-contending teams will be vying for a prize pool of a \$500,000.

Brionna Jones added 16 points and nine rebounds and Briann January scored 11 points for Connecticut (13-6). Bonner moved into sixth on the WNBA career list for made free throws, passing Cappie Pondexter.

Jones was 11 of 18 from the floor to help her reach 20-plus points for the eighth time this season. The Sun shot 51.5% while holding Atlanta to 38.5%.

Cheyenne Parker scored all 15 of her points in the first half for Atlanta (6-12), which has lost three straight. Crystal Bradford added 12 points and Aari McDonald 10.

MAY 14, 2021

COLLEGE PARK, Ga. (AP) Jonquel Jones had 26 points and eight rebounds, DeWanna Bonner added 21 points, seven rebounds and five assists and the Connecticut Sun beat Atlanta 78-67 on Friday night to spoil the Dream's inaugural game at the Gateway Center.

Jones, playing in her first game for Connecticut in 582 days after opting out last season, scored all 16 of her first-half points in the first quarter to help the Sun build a 22-17 advantage. Connecticut led 43-33 at the break.

Natisha Hiedeman added nine points for Connecticut, which will be without star Alyssa Thomas all season after she injured an Achilles tendon playing overseas. Bonner made four of Connecticut's 10 3-pointers, and Jones and Hiedeman each added two.

Connecticut dominated the paint, outrebounding Atlanta 42-26.

Odyssey Sims and Courtney Williams each scored 14 points for Atlanta, which was without Tiffany Hayes. Tianna Hawkins added 11 points and Chennedy Carter, who picked up her third foul early in the third quarter, had 10 points. Aari McDonald, the No. 3 overall pick in the draft, was held to one point in 16 minutes.

The Dream struggled from the field, going 23 for 64 (35.9%), in interim coach Mike Petersen's first game at the helm.

BRADENTON, Fla. (AP) Rookie Chennedy Carter scored 22 points, Courtney Williams had 20 points and nine rebounds and the Atlanta Dream beat the Connecticut Sun 82-75 on Friday night.

Atlanta (7-14) entered a game behind eighthplace Dallas for the final playoff spot. The Wings were playing the Chicago Sky later Friday. Connecticut (10-12) has already clinched a playoff spot, sitting in seventh.

Betnijah Laney had 14 points, 10 rebounds and four assists, and Monique Billings added 13 points and eight boards for Atlanta, which closes the regular season Sunday against Washington.

DeWanna Bonner led Connecticut with 17 points and eight rebounds. Natisha Hiedeman and Kaila Charles each scored 13 points, and Alyssa Thomas had nine points and nine rebounds. The Sun's next game will be in the playoffs.

Bonner scored 11 points in the first half, making all three of her shots from behind the arc, as the Sun held a 36-33 lead.
