Atlanta Dream names NFL Executive and Sports Industry Veteran Morgan Shaw Parker as President and Chief Operating Officer

The Atlanta Dream announced today that NFL Executive Morgan Shaw Parker will join the team as President and Chief Operating Officer. Shaw Parker brings over 25 years of experience and values-driven leadership at all levels of the sports industry.

Most recently she served as Vice President and Chief Marketing Officer at Arthur M. Blank Sports & Entertainment (AMBSE) where she led marketing and communications initiatives for the Atlanta Falcons and Mercedes-Benz Stadium.

Prior to AMBSE, Shaw Parker spent over a decade at Nike, Inc., five years with the Kansas City Chiefs and several years with two industry-leading sports marketing agencies.

"It is an incredible honor to join the WNBA and the Atlanta Dream, an organization whose new leadership celebrates its players and embraces their powerful roles both on the court and in the Atlanta community," said Shaw Parker.

Dream Sign Blake Dietrick to Rest of Season

The Atlanta Dream signed guard Blake Dietrick to a rest-of-season contract on Tuesday, August 24.

The 5-10 guard out of Princeton will play her third season with the Dream in 2021, returning after her career performance in the 2020 WNBA Bubble in Bradenton, Fla. Last year, Dietrick averaged 5.9 points, 3.4 assists and 1.6 rebounds per game, shooting 44.8 percent from beyond the arc – setting the Atlanta Dream single-season record.

Most recently, Dietrick represented the United States earlier this week at the FIBA 3x3 Women's Series in Constanta, Romania, helping her team to a fourth-place finish in the tournament.

Candice Dupree Comes Back Down South

The Atlanta Dream most recently signed seven-time WNBA All-Star Candice Dupree to a contract on July 26. The Tampa, Fla. native is in her 16th year in the league and ranks as one of the top players in WNBA history in the all-time records books.

Dupree has 69 career double-doubles, which stands as the 12th-most double-doubles in WNBA history and 5th-best among active players. She has recorded a double-double in 14.3% of all games she has played (484).

Against Los Angeles (8/17), she recorded her 900th assist in the WNBA, joining Tamika Catchings as just the second player in league history with 6,000+ PTS, 3,000+ REB and 900+ AST (via Across the Timeline).

Aari McDonald Sets Dream Free Throw Record

Aari McDonald most recently set the Atlanta Dream franchise record with 31 consecutive made free throws. Her 31-straight stood as the longest streak among active players in the league until she missed her second free throw against Phoenix on 8/15.

McDonald has been reliable at the charity stripe for the Dream all season, shooting 91.5% from the line so far this season. She is one of only six players this season to shoot above 90% with at least 45 attempts, and the only rookie to do it this year. The other five are Kayla McBride (MIN), Aerial Powers (WAS), Sabrina Ionescu (NYL), Allie Quigley (CHI) and Kelsey Plum (LVA).

Darius Taylor Named Interim Assistant Coach

Prior to the team retuning to Atlanta from the Olympic hiatus, Mike Petersen stepped down from his role as the Dream's Interim Head Coach. "For health reasons that the grind of the WNBA season will not allow me to adequately address, I have decided to step down from my coaching duties with the Dream," Petersen said. "I want to thank the Atlanta Dream players, staff and ownership for the opportunity to be part of an amazing organization."

Darius Taylor was elevated to the head coaching role and will lead the team as a head coach for the first time in his career as the Dream faces Phoenix on August 15.

Taylor's career began at Temple University in the early 2000's as an assistant coach under Dawn Staley (where he coached Candice Dupree). Prior to joining former head coach Nicki Collen's staff in Atlanta along with Mike Petersen, Taylor had left the coaching world, following his now-wife Joni Taylor to Athens as she took over the Georgia Bulldogs women's basketball program.



NOTES AND STORYLINES

Ball Thieves

Atlanta is averaging 9.1 steals per game, the most in the league. It's the 14^{th} -highest average all-time by any team and the highest in the WNBA since 2012, when the Dream averaged 9.8 steals per game. (Los Angeles: 8.3, 2^{nd}).

Only three teams this season have picked up more steals in a game than the Dream when playing Atlanta this season - Minnesota on June 6 (12-7), Dallas on both May 27 (8-5) and September 2 (10-5), and Indiana on September 14 (9-5).

Tiffany Hayes recorded five steals at Washington (6/17) and Cheyenne Parker recorded five against Minnesota (6/23).

- Hayes was the first Dream player to record five in a game since Renee Montgomery did it in 2018.
- The last time two different Dream players had five-steal games was in 2016 (Bria Holmes, Sancho Lyttle) (via Elias). The franchise record is four players with 5+ steals in a season.

The Dream is averaging 12.0 turnovers per game this season, the second-fewest in the league this year and on track for the fewest in franchise record (current all-time low: 12.2 in 2017) (Los Angeles: 13.8, 5th). Atlanta also owns the second-lowest turnover percentage rate this year at 14.8%, behind only Las Vegas's 14.0% (Los Angeles: 17.5, 6th).

Protecting the Glass

The Dream rank second in the league with 9.8 offensive rebounds per game, behind only Dallas' 10.2 per game (Los Angeles: 6.2, 11th).

Monique Billings ranks third in the league with 2.7 offensive rebounds per game (a career best for her) and 8^{th} with a 9.9% offensive rebound percentage.

Courtney Williams leads all guards with 1.5 offensive rebounds per game and 44 total o-boards so far this season. She also leads all true guards with 6.8 total rebounds per game and 203 total.

Backcourt Trio

The backcourt trio of Courtney Williams, Tiffany Hayes and Chennedy Carter averaged a combined 51.8 points per game in the five games they played together.

Injuries and Rotating Lineups

The Dream have yet to have a fully healthy roster this season, with Crystal Bradford, Tianna Hawkins, Candice Dupree, Cheyenne Parker, Chennedy Carter, Shekinna Stricklen, Tiffany Hayes and Odyssey Sims all landing on the inactives list at some point this season. Atlanta has not played one game with an empty injury report yet this season.

Shekinna Stricklen played her 300th career game against Indiana (7/11) and Monique Billings played in her 100th career game at Connecticut (7/9).

Elizabeth Williams reached 300 career blocks in a Dream uniform with a season-best 3 against Minnesota (6/23).

In the same game, Cheyenne Parker reached 100 career steals with her first steal against Minnesota (6/23). She went on to record 5 in that game, a Dream record for the season.

Tianna Hawkins reached 500 career made field goals with four against Washington (6/13), bringing her to 502 after the game.

Monique Billings reached 500 career rebounds with a team-leading 7 against Chicago (5/25), bringing her to 503 after the game.

Billings also reached 500 career points with 2 against Minnesota (6/6).

Elizabeth Williams, All-Time Blocks Leader

Dream vetaran Elizabeth Williams took over as the Dream's all-time blocks leader, currently sitting at 329 total blocks with the Dream through 30 games this season.

Williams set the single game record for the 2020 WNBA season with 6 blocks against New York (9/3).

Crystal Bradford

Guard Crystal Bradford came back to the league this season for the first time since her rookie season in 2015 with Los Angeles, making her way into the Dream's starting lineup halfway through the season. Bradford previously played for Ramat Hasharon in Israel and Besiktas in Turkey.

Bradford suffered a Jones fracture in her right foot during the Dream's game against Chicago on August 24 and underwent surgery on August 30 to repair the fracture. She will remain out for the rest of the Dream's 2021 season.

Pro Baller, Mother, and Software Engineer Tianna Hawkins

When Dream forward Tianna Hawkins isn't playing, she is juggling one of her many other responsibilities. Not only is she a mother to her five-year-old son, Emanuel, she is also a part-time software engineer with Microsoft. A graduate of the University of Maryland with a degree in Criminology and Criminal Justice, Hawkins would like to become a federal agent after her professional career. While in college, she even had the opportunity to intern with the Secret Service.

Dream Draft Three in 2021 WNBA Draft

The Dream drafted three players in the 2021 WNBA Draft, picking guard Aari McDonald out of Arizona with the third overall selection, Spanish star Raquel Carrera with the 15th overall pick and Lindsey Pulliam out of Northwestern with the 27th pick.


At Arizona, McDonald led the Wildcats to the team's first NCAA Finals appearance in 2021, averaging 24.8 points in their six games of the NCAA Tournament, including dropping 33 points against Indiana in the Elite Eight. The 5-6 guard earned Pac-12 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year awards her redshirt senior year before becoming the first Wildcat to ever be drafted in the first round of a WNBA Draft. McDonald is still working to finish her masters degree at Arizona, studying Applied Behavior Analysis.

New Ownership Group

WNBA and NBA Boards of Governors unanimously approved the sale of the Atlanta Dream to Larry Gottesdiener, Chairman of Northland, an industry-leading national real estate firm on February 26, 2021. The three-member investor group is comprised of former Dream star Renee Montgomery, Northland President and Chief Operating Officer Suzanne Abair, and Gottesdiener.

The sale made two-time WNBA champion Renee Montgomery the first former player to become both an owner and executive of a WNBA team. Montgomery sat out the 2020 season to focus on social justice issues and recently announced her retirement from the league after 11 seasons.

LOS ANGELES (AP) Nneka Ogwumike had a putback of a missed 3-pointer with 0.1 seconds left to help the Los Angeles Sparks edge the Atlanta Dream 66-64 on Thursday night.

Atlanta made a 3-pointer on back-to-back possessions - by Aari McDonald and Crystal Bradford - to tie it at 64 with 25.6 left.

Kristi Toliver dribbled down the clock and attempted a long 3-pointer that hit off the back and front of the rim. Ogwumike grabbed the rebound in traffic and ignored the inadvertent shot-clock buzzer to put it off the glass and in.

Ogwumike finished with 17 points, seven rebounds, four assists and three steals for Los Angeles (9-13). Toliver and Amanda Zahui B. each added 10 points. Toliver passed Mwadi Mabika to become Los Angeles' leader in made 3-pointers with 399.

Los Angeles led by 17 points in the second half, but went scoreless for four minutes in the fourth quarter as Atlanta pulled within 62-58.

Courtney Williams scored 23 points and grabbed 11 rebounds for Atlanta (6-16). McDonald scored all 15 of her points in the second half.

On Tuesday, Toliver forced overtime with Atlanta on a last-second jumper and the Sparks pulled away for an 85-80 win.

AUGUST 17, 2021

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Brittney Sykes scored 17 points to lead six Los Angeles players in double figures, and the Sparks beat the Atlanta Dream 85-80 in overtime on Tuesday night.

Sykes opened overtime with a basket for Los Angeles' first lead since 24-23. Kristi Toliver, who forced overtime, gave the Sparks a sixpoint lead with 2:13 left and they led by at least three points the rest of the way.

Erica Wheeler added 16 points for Los Angeles (8-13). Nneka Ogwumike, who went to the locker room in the first half but returned to start the third quarter, had 13 points, nine rebounds and nine assists. Amanda Zahui B. had 14 points, seven rebounds and four assists, Toliver scored 11 and Nia Coffey 10.

Odyssey Sims led Atlanta (6-15) with 26 points and six assists.

Courtney Williams missed her first eight field goals but made a jumper with 52.8 seconds left in the fourth quarter to give Atlanta a 72-70 lead. She made another from the same spot at 5.4 for a 74-72 lead but after a timeout, Toliver sank a shot over the outstreched arm of Williams to force overtime.

AUGUST 30, 2020

BRADENTON, Fla. (AP) Brittney Sykes scored 15 points, Chelsea Gray had 14 - including back-to-back baskets in the final minute - and the Los Angeles Sparks beat the Atlanta Dream 84-79 on Sunday night to win their ninth consecutive game and clinch a spot in the WNBA playoffs.

Los Angeles is the third team to seal a playoff berth, joining the WNBA-leading Seattle and Las Vegas.

Nneka Ogwumike left in the first half and did not return for the Sparks due to a back injury. Kristine Anigwe started the second half in Ogwumike's place and finished with nine points and six rebounds. Candace Parker had just nine points on 4-of-11 shooting but added 10 rebounds and seven assists.

Chennedy Carter, who played 17 minutes Friday against Minnesota in her return from a five-game absence due to an ankle injury suffered on Aug. 10, led the Dream with 26 points on 11-of-19 shooting. Courtney Williams scored 15 points and Monique Billings added 12 points and 14 rebounds.

Carter made a layup to give Atlanta a 74-72 lead with 3:27 to play but Sykes scored the next six points before Parker made a driving layup as she was fouled but missed the and-1 free throw and it was 80-74 with 1:11 remaining. Carter and Gray each made layups before Billings converted a three-point play to make it 82-79 about 40 seconds later. But Gray dribbled into the lane, put on the brakes, and hit a fadeaway from the free-throw line with 8.1 seconds left and the Sparks held on.
