On January 5th, we watched as The Dream's activism was pivotal in changing the balance of power in our government. We embraced the euphoria that ensued, until the next day when insurrectionists stormed our Capitol and attempted to subvert our democracy. We felt compelled to take a stand to amplify the message of the Atlanta Dream and promote change and social justice. As Cathy shared her own infectious excitement for the future of the league, she encouraged us to pursue our interest in The Dream with a clear message that the upfront investment would be significant, a long-term horizon critical, and a progressive culture, essential. In a bit of a whirlwind, we closed two months later.

So, what is our mission? Our mission is to create the flagship franchise in the WNBA, to respect our players as athletes and people, to give back to the community, and to build an organization that honors the legacy of our name – The Atlanta Dream – by rising to meet the fierce urgency of now.

What about "The Game?" Women's hoops is an extraordinary blend of speed, skill, and grit. The 2021 Dream is loaded with incredible talent. Equally impressive, though, is the professionalism with which the players have embraced us and their passion to create a championship culture.

To our current and future players, to the legions of worldwide Dream fans, to the city of Atlanta we say: We are here to elevate, win, inspire, and captivate. Together. We are excited about this journey, and we are in it for the long run.

The No. 1 overall pick in the 2022 WNBA Draft, Rhyné Howard has taken the league by storm since the first game of her professional career. Following Sunday's game against Seattle, Howard is the WNBA's 12th-leading scorer with 15.1 points per game and the highest-scoring rookie this season.

She eclipsed 100 points in only five games, and reached 123 after the May 20th game against Washington, the sixth-most of any rookie in league history in that time span and the most of any Dream rookie.

She paces the WNBA from the 20-24 foot range with 2.1 average field goals, shooting 41.7% from that range. She has made an average of 2.6 three's per game, the sixth-most in the league.



July 5 - WNBA Rookie of the Month, x2 | For the second consecutive month, Howard was named the WNBA Kia Rookie of the Month. In the month of June, Howard averaged 14.3 points and 2.7 assists, making 5.3 field goals and 2.1 three-pointers per game, all of which ranked first among rookies last month.

June 28 - Rookie All-Star | Howard was named to the 2022 WNBA All-Star reserves squad, making her the only first-timer in the 2022 AT&T All-Star Game and only the second-ever Dream rookie to earn the honor (Shoni Schimmel in 2011).

June 1 - WNBA Rookie of the Month | Howard was named the league's Kia Rookie of the Month on Wednesday, June 1, after averaging a team-high 16.9 points in the first month of her professional career, and leading all rookies with 1.5 steals per game. Howard is the Dream's first WNBA Player of the Month since Brittney Sykes won in July and August of 2017.

May 16 - Eastern Conference Player of the Week | Howard was named the WNBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week, making her the first rookie to win the award in the first week of their WNBA career since Tamika Catchings in 2002, and the first Dream rookie to ever earn the WNBA Player of the Week award. Howard is the Dream's first WNBA Player of the Week since Tiffany Hayes won in 2018 and the first rookie to win the award since the 2019 season. She was also given the Associated Press Player of the Week honor on Monday, May 16.

May 15 - 33-Point Game | Howard tied the record for third-most points scored in a game by a Dream rookie with 33 points in a win over the Indiana Fever on May 15. Her 17 points in the first quarter of that game is tied for the third-most scored in a quarter by a first-year player in the WNBA and the most ever scored by a rookie in a first quarter of any WNBA game.

May 7 - Debut at Dallas | Howard scored 16 points, tallied four blocks and two steals, and dished out four assists in the first game of her pro career, making her the first player in WNBA history to record four made three-pointers and four blocks in their debut. She is still the only player in the league in 2022 to have a game with at least 16 points, four blocks and two steals in a game. She took 12 threes in the meeting with Dallas, which is the most by a Dream player since Renee Montgomery took 13 in 2019.

CHEYENNE PARKER

COMEBACK SEASON

Parker played only 13 games in 2021, missing the first six games of the season due to the league's COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols, and not returning to the court after July's Olympic Break due to her pregnancy, missing the final 13 games of the season.

Parker gave birth to her daughter, Naomi, in December of 2021, and reported to the Dream's training camp in April - just four months later - fully cleared to play. Since then, she has put up similar numbers to her career-best season in 2020, and had better stats through 13 games than she did in 2021.

AARI McDONALD

SIXTH WOMAN

Second-year guard Aari McDonald is making an early case for Sixth Woman of the Year, averaging 11.1 points, 2.7 assists and a team-high 1.7 steals per game (the fifth-best in the league). The Dream's 2021 No. 3 overall pick came off the bench to score 20 points against Las Vegas earlier this season (5/13).

She recorded 7 steals against Minnesota (6/1), just the third Dream player to grab at least 7 in a game (Angel McCoughtry, Sancho Lyttle) and just one off the franchise record. With 13 points that night, she also became the fourth player in WNBA history to have at least 10 points and 7 steals off the bench, joining Angel McCoughtry (2009), Matee Ajavon (2012) and Brittney Sykes (2021).

Howard at 2022 AT&T WNBA All-Star

Rhyne Howard competed in all three events throughout WNBA All-Star weekend: the MTN DEW 3-Point Contest, the Skills Challenge and the All-Star Game - one of just two players to do this along with the Aces' Kelsey Plum. She is the Dream's second-ever rookie All-Star (Shoni Schimmel in 2011) and the first to compete in the All-Star game and all other events of the weekend.

Howard scored 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting with five boards and four assists in her All-Star Game debut, and finished in the top three in Saturday's 3-Point Contest.

As the Dream plays in Chicago for the first game back from the All-Star break, every member of the Dream was able to attend Howard's first All-Star game, including Atlanta's coaching staff and owner Larry Gottesdiener.

Howard is Consecutive WNBA Rookie of the Month

Atlanta Dream rookie guard Rhyne Howard was named the WNBA Kia Rookie of the Month for the second consecutive month, the league announced on Tuesday, July 5.

The accolade marks Howard's fifth of her debut season, coming just a week after she was named to the 2022 WNBA All-Star team. She became the Dream's second-ever rookie All-Star in franchise history, and is the only first-time All-Star in this year's class.

In the month of June, Howard averaged 14.3 points and 2.7 assists, making 5.3 field goals and 2.1 three-pointers per game, all of which ranked first among rookies last month. She is pacing all first-year players in the league this season in points (15.3), three-pointers made (2.4) and steals (1.5) per game, ranking in the top 13 in each category among all players.

Hayes Returns, Wheeler Forces OT to Beat Liberty

Tiffany Hayes made the most of her first game of the season, providing the spark in overtime to lift the Atlanta Dream over the New York Liberty.

Hayes, who missed the first 19 games with a right knee injury, scored nine of her 21 points in OT to give the Dream a 92-81 victory over the Liberty on Thursday night.

"It feels great to have all our players, still missing Nia (Coffey)," said Atlanta coach Tanisha Wright about finally having an almost full roster.

Hayes scored the first seven points in OT, hitting a 3-pointer from each wing and then getting fouled shooting another 3. She made only one of those free throws to make it 86-79.

New York led 79-76 with 7.5 seconds left when Erica Wheeler took the ball and dribbled the clock down before hitting a 3-pointer from the top of the key at the buzzer to send the game to overtime. (Associated Press)

Rhyne Howard Named WNBA All-Star

Atlanta Dream rookie guard Rhyne Howard was named a 2022 AT&T WNBA All-Star reserve, the league announced on Tuesday, June 28. With the nomination, Howard becomes the Dream's second-ever rookie All-Star in franchise history and the only first-timer to be named to the 2022 squad.

The No. 1 overall pick in the 2022 WNBA Draft has taken the league by storm, has consistently ranked in the top-15 in the WNBA in points (16.4, 12th) and steals (1.6, 8th) since her debut. In the first week of her career, Howard averaged 20.8 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.3 assists in four games, including a 33-point outing at Indiana on May 15. Howard eclipsed 100 points in only five games and reached 135 points after the May 29th game against Phoenix, the sixth-most of any rookie in WNBA history in that time span.

Maya Caldwell Starts, Leads in First WNBA Game

Guard Maya Caldwell was signed to the Dream on a hardship contract on Monday, June 20 and started in her first WNBA game on Tuesday, June 21. In 30 minutes on the court Caldwell led all players in the game with 18 points (4-of-5 from three) and led the Dream with two steals.

Caldwell participated in the Dream's 2022 training camp, playing two preseason games with Slocum was drafted to Dan Padover's Las Vegas Aces in 2021 and played 21 games in her rookie season.

An emergency hardship exception is allowed, at the discretion of the league, when a team has fewer than 10 available players on their roster. This can be a result of injury or illness, but players who are away from the team for other reasons count as well. If granted the exception, the team can sign as many players to replacement contracts as needed to reach 10 available players. As the original players return to play, the team must terminate those replacement contracts to remain at 10 players until at least 10 non-replacement players are available.

AD Returns Home

The Atlanta Dream acquired guard AD Durr from New York in a trade that sent Megan Walker and the draft rights to Dream's 2021 second round Draft pick, Raquel Carrera, to the Liberty on June 8. AD met the Dream on the road in Phoenix and played a season-high 25 minutes for her former teammate and new head coach Tanisha Wright against the Mercury (6/10). The Douglasville, Ga. native and St. Pius X graduate was selected with the No. 2 overall pick in the 2019 WNBA Draft by the Liberty.

Emory Healthcare is Dream's First-Ever Marquee Jersey Partner

The Dream's official healthcare provider and founding partner of the franchise, Emory Healthcare, became the Dream's first partner to be displayed on the marquee position of the team's uniforms. In addition to the jersey placement, Emory Healthcare has a continued and significant presence at all Dream games at Gateway Center Arena. Emory Healthcare provides sports medicine physicians for all games, as well as health and wellness services to players across the health system.

Rhyné Howard named Eastern Conference Player of the Week

Howard was named the WNBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week on Monday, May 16. The honor made her the first rookie to win the award in the first week of their WNBA career since Tamika Catchings in 2002, and the first Dream rookie to ever earn the WNBA Player of the Week award. Las Vegas' A'ja Wilson won for the Western Conference.

Howard is the Dream's first WNBA Player of the Week since Tiffany Hayes won in 2018 and the first rookie to win the award since the 2019 season. With 83 points through her first four games, Howard is just the 6th rookie in WNBA history to score 80 in such a span.

She also received the Associated Press Player of the Week honor on Monday, May 16.

Howard Shows Out in 33-pt Game at Indiana

Dream Sell Out Home Opening Week

The Dream announced a full sell-out of both their home opener against the Los Angeles Sparks Wednesday night and their matchup against the Las Vegas Aces Friday evening with 3,138 fans in attendance both nights - setting the Gateway Center Arena attendance record.

Record-Setting W in Dallas

First-year head coach Tanisha Wright earned her first win with the Dream on Saturday, May 7, defeating the Dallas Wings 66-59.

Atlanta held Dallas to just 24.3% shooting from the field, marking the **lowest opponent shooting percentage in franchise history**. It was the lowest shooting percentage the Wings have ever seen and is tied for the franchise low (the Tulsa Shock shot 24.3% against Washington in 2013).

Rookie guard Rhyné Howard became the first player in WNBA history to record four made three-pointers and four blocks in their debut, as she went on to lead the Dream in nearly every statistical category. She took 12 threes on Saturday, the most by a Dream player since Renee Montgomery took 13 in 2019.

The last time Atlanta held a team to 59 or fewer points was a 62-56 win over New York in 2020. The last time Atlanta has done it in a true road game was a 67-53 win at Indiana in Game 2 of the 2013 Conference Finals to clinch the series.

Dream Trade Up for No. 1 Overall Draft Pick, Select Rhyné Howard and Naz Hillmon at No. 15 in 2022 WNBA Draft

In a historical move, the Dream acquired the No. 1 overall pick in the 2022 WNBA Draft in a trade that sent Atlanta's 2022 No. 3 overall pick and 2022 No. 14 pick (second round) to the Mystics. Washington also received the right to swap its own 2023 first round pick with the 2023 first round pick Atlanta acquired from Los Angeles earlier this year (received along with Erica Wheeler).

Kentucky's Rhyné Howard became Atlanta's second-ever No. 1 Draft pick after the Dream selected Angel McCoughtry with the first pick in the 2009 WNBA Draft. The 6-2 guard became Kentucky's first player to ever go No. 1 in a WNBA Draft, and left Lexington as the program's all-time top three-point shooter and a two-time SEC Player of the Year. She finished the 2021-22 season as the only player in the nation with over 600+ points, 200+ rebounds, 100+ assists, 70+ steals and 35+ blocks.

With the No. 15 selection the Dream picked Naz Hillmon out of Michigan, making her the highest-drafted player in program history and the Wolverines' first player drafted to the WNBA since 2005. She is the first Michigan basketball player – male or female – in school history to score 2,000 points and grab 1,000 rebounds, finishing with 2,150 points and 1,042 rebounds.

Howard Puts Up 29 Against Tanisha Wright's 49ers

When Charlotte women's basketball - led by head coach Cara Consuegra and assistant coach Tanisha Wright - played Kentucky in Lexington in 2019, sophomore guard Rhyné Howard scored 29 points with 7 rebounds, 4 steals and 2 assists in the Wildcats' 86-39 win.

Rookie Connection

Howard and Hillman previously played together with USA Basketball, where they led their team to a gold medal finish at the FIBA U19 World Cup, going 7-0 in the tournament held in Bangkok, Thailand.

Wheeler and Coffey Return to Atlanta

Both Erica Wheeler and Nia Coffey don the Dream's colors again this season after playing in Atlanta in 2015 and 2019, respectively.

Wheeler signed a training camp contract with the Dream in May 2019 and played 17 games and averaged 4.5 points and 1.5 assists before she was waived in June. Her first full contract was with the Indiana Fever, where she spent four seasons from 2016-19 and claimed the WNBA All-Star MVP title in 2019. She played for the Los Angeles

Sparks in 2021, where she started all 32 regular season games and averaged a career-high 13.6 points and 3.1 rebounds, as well as 4.8 assists and 1.3 steals.

Coffey signed with the Dream as a Free Agent prior to the 2022 season. She was originally acquired by Atlanta in 2019 in a three-team trade that sent the Dream's 2020 No. 13 pick to the New York Liberty. With Atlanta, she averaged 5.0 points and a then-career-high 2.8 rebounds per game. She was traded to Phoenix in a three-team trade and spent the 2020 Bubble season with the Mercury before she was waived and picked up by Los Angeles. Coffey saw a career season with the Sparks in 2021, averaging 8.3 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.2 blocks per game.

Tanisha Wright and Dan Padover Join the Dream

Industry veteran Tanisha Wright joined the Dream as head coach in October 2021, making her the fifth head coach in franchise history. Wright brings over 14 years of experience in the league as a player and coach to this role, most recently serving as an assistant coach for the Las Vegas Aces.

Wright spent ten seasons as a guard with the Seattle Storm, where she helped lead the team to nine straight playoff appearances, and a WNBA Championship in 2010. During her basketball career, she joined the Charlotte 49ers as an assistant coach, before retiring as a player in 2019. In 2020, the Las Vegas Aces signed her as an assistant coach, where she worked closely with industry leader Bill Laimbeer.

Two weeks later, two-time WNBA Executive of the Year Dan Padover was announced as the Dream's General Manager and Executive Vice President, with former Dream coach Darius Taylor being promoted to Assistant General Manager.

Padover spent the past decade in the WNBA, most recently serving as General Manager of the Las Vegas Aces, who finished with the best record in the WNBA in 2020, and the second-best record in the league (24-8) during the regular season this year.

Wright Finalizes Coaching and Development Staff

Head Coach Tanisha Wright brought on Christie Sides, Paul Goriss and Barbara Turner as assistant coaches, Dale McNeil as player development coach, and Katie Buria as assistant athletic trainer and strength and conditioning specialist this season.

Sides brings nearly 20 years of coaching experience to the Dream, most recently serving as the associate head coach for the Louisiana-Monroe Warhawks. She comes to Atlanta with eight years of WNBA coaching experience. Goriss brings two Women's National Basketball League (WNBL) Championships to Atlanta after serving as head coach for the UC Capitals in Canberra, Australia, for the past six seasons.

Turner joins the Dream after spending the last year as a player development assistant and translator with the NBA's Houston Rockets. She played three WNBA seasons after the Seattle Storm drafted her 11th overall in the 2006 WNBA Draft, where she played her rookie season alongside Wright.

McNeil and Buria round out the Dream's development staff. McNeil brings nearly 20 years of player development and coaching experience to the Dream; Buria spent the 2019 season and a part of the 2021 season as an athletic training assistant with the Dream before heading to College Station to serve as Texas A&M's women's basketball athletic trainer for the 2021-22 NCAA season.

Bally Sports to Broadcast Record Number of Dream Games

Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast will televise a record 35 of the Atlanta Dream's 36 games during the 2022 WNBA regular season, the most locally televised games in franchise history.

The broadcast team for Dream games on Bally Sports returns for their second season together in 2022. Angel Gray is back for her second season as play-by-play announcer, while LaChina Robinson and Tabitha Turner will split time as analysts again this season. Robinson returns for her 13th season with the Dream, while Turner will provide commentary for her fourth season.

2022 Dream Uniforms

Entering the 2021 season, the WNBA and Nike joined forces to tell H.E.R. story. The Dream worked with Nike to create three special uniforms that convey a message around the unique characteristics of Atlanta and to tell our story. The three uniforms have been given the names Heroine, Explorer and Rebel to highlight the power, potential and attitude of the WNBA athlete.

Atlanta Dream's Nike Heroine Edition in white and Atlanta Dream's Nike Explorer Edition in red uniforms capture the passion, courage and heart of the Georgians who championed the Civil Rights Movement. The belief in a more equitable tomorrow is amplified, represented by shimmering rays cast over a striking, bold red field — details that symbolize hope.

The colorful Atlanta Dream's Rebel Edition pays homage to the sound of Atlanta, defined by the city's unmatched impact on Hip-Hop and R&B. The legacy of the scene's legendary female recording artists is celebrated with vibrant colors, strapping side-stripping, and confident lettering—a salute to the swagger, creativity and iconicity of ATL's most influential female musicians. The large ATL wordmark represents the city, while the side-panel design lines invoke vinyl records of the past and the ever-evolving sound of today's female artists. The subtle hints of silver in the uniform — such as the silver star and logo detailing — are symbolic of the platinum and gold records produced by the women of the city.

JUNE 17, 2022

CHICAGO (AP) Kahleah Copper had season highs with 23 points and 10 rebounds, Emma Meesseman scored 17 points and grabbed a season-best 12 rebounds and the Chicago Sky beat the Atlanta Dream 106-100 in overtime Friday night.

Allie Quigley also had 17 points, Azura Stevens and Rebekah Gardner scored 15 apiece and Courtney Vandersloot added 11 for Chicago (10-4).

Meesseman made a jumper, Copper hit a 3-pointer and, after Rhyne Howard made a layup on the other end, Quigley hit another 3 to give the Sky a 99-93 lead about 2 minutes into overtime. Atlanta (7-8) twice trimmed its deficit to two points but Stevens answered each time - the first with a pair of free throws to make it 101-97 with 1:27 to play and the second with a 3-pointer that gave Chicago a five-point lead with less than a minute to go.

AD Durr scored 21 points and McDonald finished with 20 for the Dream. Howard and Cheyenne Parker added 16 points apiece and Destiny Slocum scored a career-high 10.

Ruthy Hebard hit a jumper to give Chicago its biggest lead of the game at 71-53 midway through the third quarter but the Dream responded with an 18-2 run that trimmed their deficit to 73-71 about 4 minutes later after McDonald and Slocum made back-to-back 3-pointers to cap the spurt.

McDonald converted a three-point play before Parker made two free throws to give the Dream a one-point lead with 31.4 seconds left in regulation but Copper made 1-of-2 free throws with 19.0 seconds remaining to tie it at 91-all. Howard missed a potential winning 3-point shot in the closing seconds and Naz Hillmon grabbed the offensive rebound but her put-back attempt was blocked by Stevens to force overtime.

JUNE 3, 2022

COLLEGE PARK, Ga. (AP) Kahleah Copper scored 21 points, Candace Parker had five of her nine in the last 2:37 and the Chicago Sky beat the Atlanta Dream 73-65 on Friday night after blowing a 20-point first-half lead.

The Dream (6-4) took their only lead at 60-58 on a tough drive by Erica Wheeler with 7:45 to play. Chicago rookie Rebekah Gardner tied it with a short shot and followed with a wide-open layup from Courtney Vandersloot for a 62-60 lead for Chicago (6-3).

It was still two point game when Parker's heavily contested 10-footer went through for a 66-62 lead. In the last 1:27 the Sky made 7 of 8 free throws, three by Parker and two by Emma Meesseman, who had 16 points.

Vandersloot had nine points to move by her wife Allie Quigley to become Chicago's career scoring leader at 3,394 points.

Cheyenne Parker led Atlanta with 19 points, and Wheeler had 15. Star rookie Rhyne Howard was held to five on 2-of-12 shooting.

Vandersloot's basket midway through the first quarter made it 20-4 for Chicago and a few minutes later Azura Stevens scored to give the Sky a 26-6 lead.

A 3-pointer by Kristy Wallace cut the deficit to single digits at 35-26 in the middle of the second and it was 39-31 at the half as the Dream closed on a 13-4 run.

AUGUST 24, 2021

COLLEGE PARK, Ga. (AP) Allie Quigley scored 21 points and Candace Parker added 18 to help the Chicago Sky beat the Atlanta Dream 86-79 on Tuesday night.

Quigley was 8 of 11 from the field, including making all three of her 3-point attempts. Parker, who came back after missing a game with a sprained left ankle, passed Temeka Johnson for 11th on the WNBA career assists list.

Kahleah Copper added 16 points for Chicago (12-12), and Courtney Vandersloot had 12 points, five rebounds and 10 assists. The Sky shot 51.5%.

Chicago continues its five-game road trip at Seattle on Friday, followed by Phoenix and Las Vegas.

Odyssey Sims had 17 points, six rebounds and five assists to lead Atlanta (6-18). Courtney Williams added 16 points, six rebounds and four assists.
