BACK HOME AGAIN!

For the first time since the 2019 regular season, the Indiana Fever return to the greatest basketball arena in the world and will play the entire 2023 season at Gainbridge Fieldhouse. 2020 was spent in the 'Wubble' in Bradenton, Florida, while home games in 2021 and 2022 were played at Gainbridge Fieldhouse, Indiana Farmers Coliseum and Hinkle Fieldhouse.

TUNE IN

This year's broadcast schedule is highlighted by 10 regular season home games on Bally Sports Indiana, which is available on cable, satellite, and streaming providers throughout the region. Fever games on Bally Sports Indiana also stream live on the Bally Sports app and on BallySports.com for fans who sign in with their pay-TV login and password. In addition, there's a new option to watch Bally Sports' Fever telecasts: Bally Sports+, the stand-alone streaming service that launched last fall. For more information or to sign up, visit BallySportsPlus.com. Additional Fever games will be broadcast on ESPN, NBA TV, CBS Sports Network, ION, Prime Video, Twitter and Meta Quest platforms. For the fourth consecutive season, 23 regular season games will be available via the official Indiana Fever Facebook page. This year's streaming services will continue to extend to fans across the entire state of Indiana, as well as in Ohio and Kentucky.

ON THE WAY UP

Indiana began the 2023 regular season as one of the youngest teams throughout the WNBA. The following chart shows the youngest teams in the WNBA on opening day based on average age of players on its roster:

- Dallas - Average Age 25 years, 63 days
- Indiana - Average Age 26 years, 9 days**
- Atlanta - Average Age 26 years, 47 days

ATL 2 INDY

Four additions to the Fever coaching staff and roster came to Indiana ahead of the 2023 season after suiting up for the Atlanta Dream in 2022. Fever Head Coach **Christie Sides** was named the ninth head coach in franchise history on November 4, 2022. Sides served as an assistant coach for the Atlanta Dream during the 2022 season under Tanisha Wright. She had been associate women's head coach at the University of Louisiana-Monroe since 2019, the role she moved to after a two-year stint with the Fever. On January 13, Indiana Fever acquired guard **Kristy Wallace** from Atlanta. in exchange for Danielle Robinson. Wallace started 18 of 29 games played in 2022 with Atlanta and averaged 6.6 points and 2.2 assists per game. On February 1, **Erica Wheeler** signed a multi-year contract with Indiana after playing 2022 with Atlanta. Wheeler played with the Fever from 2016-19, averaged double figures in two of her four seasons in Indiana and was the Most Valuable Player of the 2019 WNBA All-Star Game. The very next day, Indiana signed free agent **Maya Caldwell**, who played in nine games and started seven in 2022 for Atlanta. She averaged 10.9 points, 2.4 rebounds and 2.2 assists for the Dream.

ATHLETES UNLIMITED SUCCESS

Lexie Hull, **Kelsey Mitchell** and **NaLyssa Smith** each participated in the 2023 Athletes Unlimited season. **Smith** compiled 6,811 leaderboard points to finish season as the Athletes Unlimited Basketball champion. She ranked second in the league with 3,211 stat points in addition to standing sixth in the circuit with 3,150 win points. **Mitchell** completed her second year with AU and finished ninth on the league's final leaderboard with 5,386 points. She was second in the league with 510 win points while accumulating 2,526 stat points. **Hull** was honored as Athletes Unlimited Basketball Defensive Player of the Year, an All-Defensive Team selection who started all 15 games during her inaugural campaign in the league and finished eighth on the final leaderboard with 5,411 points.

A NEW REBEL

On March 23, the Indiana Fever announced today the team will showcase a new WNBA Nike Rebel edition uniform in 2023. Inspired by past achievements and the rich history of basketball in the Hoosier State, this Fever Rebel uniform will honor the history that has shaped the Fever franchise:

- 1972 – U.S. Senator Birch Bayh, representing Indiana, co-authored the landmark legislation of Title IX being signed into law. Senator Bayh later became the Fever's 5,500th season ticket holder, officially securing the Fever as a WNBA franchise.
- 1999 – Indianapolis, Indiana was awarded a WNBA expansion franchise to begin play in 2000.
- 2009 – The Indiana Fever advanced to the first WNBA Finals in franchise history.
- 2012 – The Fever captured the first WNBA title in franchise history.
- 2020 – Tamika Catchings became the first player in franchise history to be enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. The 'Basketball Chose Me' label on the uniform's belt buckle is a nod to the message Catchings shared during her acceptance speech at the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2020 Enshrinement Ceremony.

COMMISSIONER'S CUP

The third annual Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase is an in-season competition throughout the regular season, with players competing for a prize pool and an additional pool of money for charitable and civic organizations. Commissioner's Cup games are denoted on the regular season schedule with the Cup trophy. The 2022 Commissioner's Cup Championship featured the 2022 WNBA Champion Las Vegas Aces vs. the 2021 WNBA Champion Chicago Sky, with the Aces coming out as the Commissioner's Cup Champions. **Indiana currently sits at 0-2 in Commissioner's Cup Games.**





NBA ALL-STAR 2024 COMING TO INDIANAPOLIS

Indianapolis will host NBA All-Star from Feb. 16-18, 2024. NBA All-Star has not come to the Circle City since 1985. The city was originally scheduled to host All-Star festivities in 2021 before being rescheduled to 2024 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. In the years since, leaders from Pacers Sports & Entertainment and the All-Star Host Committee have traveled to NBA All-Star every year, studying the many components of the event and how each city executes it, with the goal of putting on the greatest All-Star event the league has ever seen in 2024. The Indiana Fever named Christie Sides the ninth head coach in franchise history on November 4, 2022. Sides, a former Fever assistant and native of Baton Rouge, LA, brings more than 20 years of professional and college coaching experience.

Sides served as an assistant coach for the Atlanta Dream during the 2022 season under head coach Tanisha Wright. She had previously been associate women's head coach at the University of Louisiana-Monroe since 2019, which was the role she moved to after a two-year stint with the Fever in 2018 and 2019.

Other stops in Sides' twenty-year career include the Chicago Sky, where she spent six seasons as assistant coach; Northwestern University, where she was first an assistant and later associate head coach; and Louisiana State University, where she was an assistant for a program that advanced to three Women's Final Fours. Additionally, Sides enjoyed significant success overseas. She was an assistant for Spartak Moscow Region in Russia, where she helped capture consecutive FIBA EuroLeague Championships in 2009 and 2010 and lead the team to five Final Eight finishes overall. She also served as an assistant with the Slovakian Women's National Team for two years in the same period.

As a player, Sides played her first two college seasons at Ole Miss for Hall of Fame head coach Van Chancellor and helped the Rebels to a 34-22 record. She transferred to Louisiana Tech and finished her playing career for fellow Hall of Fame coach Leon Barmore. Sides helped the Lady Techsters to a 61-6 record in two seasons, including a trip to the 1999 Final Four. She still holds the career record at Tech for 3-point field goal percentage (.448). As a senior at Central Private High School, Sides was named the Louisiana Gatorade Player of the Year.

Berger was a four-time All-Big Ten First Team selection and the all-time winningest player in Indiana's history with 118 victories over five seasons from 2018-23. A Louisville native, Berger finished her IU career ranked seventh in program history in points (1,841) and second in assists (573). In 2022-23, she helped Indiana to its first-ever No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament as the team's No. 2 scorer and assists leader. Berger was a four-time All-Big Ten First Team recipient, three-time USWBA All-American Honorable Mention, two-time Associated Press All-American Honorable Mention and part of the Big Ten All-Tournament Team in 2022.

INTERNATIONAL

Berger was named to the 12-member Team USA roster for 2021 AmeriCup. She helped USA to a gold medal and perfect 6-0 record. Berger averaged 5.2 points, 3.2 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor and 81.8 percent at the free throw line. COLLEGE

Boston completed one of the most accomplished college careers in college basketball history. Boston finished her career with the Gamecocks from 2019-23 as the program's all-time leader in the following categories: Consecutive games started (138), Rebounds (1,493), Offensive rebounds (518), Offensive rebounds in SEC games (244), Defensive rebounds (975), Defensive rebounds in SEC games (485), Rebounds in SEC games (729), Blocked shots in SEC games (165), Double-doubles (82), Double-doubles in SEC games (42), Triple-doubles (2).

Boston was a four-time All-America recipient, four-time Lisa Leslie Center of the Year, four-time SEC Defensive Player of the Year, two-time National Player of the Year, two-time Naismith Defensive Player of the Year, two-time SEC Player of the Year and was also the 2022 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player guiding the Gamecocks to a national championship.

During her senior year, Boston shot a 55.9 field goal percentage and was her best shooting season since her freshman campaign. Defensively she averaged 2.0 blocks per game, including an SEC-best 2.3 per conference outing this past season. Boston picked up SEC Player of the Year honors for the second-straight season as South Carolina finished the season with a 36-1 record.

In her penultimate season, Boston became South Carolina's first Honda Cup Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year and CoSIDA Academic All-America Team Member of the Year. She swept the national player of the year awards, including becoming the first player, male or female, to win both the Naismith Trophy and Naismith Defensive Player of the Year. She also claimed the SEC Female Athlete of the Year. Boston played an integral role as part of the first team in program history to be ranked No 1 in both the AP and the USA Today Coaches' Polls every week of the season capturing the program's second National Championship.

As a sophomore, Boston recorded the first triple-double in program history in SEC play with 16 points, 11 rebounds and 10 blocks against Georgia. In her freshman season with the Gamecocks from 2019-20, Boston posted the first triple-double by a freshman in program history and the first by any NCAA Division I player in her career debut against Alabama State. She later became the program's first National Freshman of the Year.

INTERNATIONAL

As a part of USA Basketball, Boston has earned four gold medals and was named MVP of the 2017 FIBA U16 Americas Cup after leading team with 11.8 points and 8.6 rebounds per game.

2022: Cannon was initially re-signed by the Fever on February 4, 2022, but was waived by Indiana on April 13. After playing the first game of the regular season with the Phoenix Mercury against the Las Vegas Aces, she returned to Indiana as a free agent on June 5. In 24 games played in 2022, Cannon averaged career-highs of 6.8 points and a 52.6 field goal percentage, 3.1 rebounds and started two games. Cannon had the highest scoring season of her career, made more field goals, as well as 3-point field goals, and also recorded the most steals than in any other season in her career. She ended 2022 with eight games scoring in double figures, pushing her career total to 12 games scoring at least 10 points.

2021: In just 20 games played during the 2021 season, Cannon served as the unequivocal journeywoman during the 2021 WNBA season becoming the fifth woman in WNBA history to play for three different teams during the same season. With Indiana, Cannon averaged 6.9 points, 4.5 rebounds and 18.4 minutes per contest in 12 games, while starting the first six games of her career. She signed the first of three 7-day contracts with Indiana on July 28, before ultimately being signed for the rest of the season on September 6. Before signing with the Fever, Cannon joined Connecticut on June 7 and averaged 4.2 points, 3.0 rebounds and 11.5 minutes per contest in five games before being released. She began the 2021 season with the Las Vegas Aces and appeared in three games.

2020: Cannon was signed on September 9, and came out of quarantine to be eligible to play on September 12. She played just 24 seconds during the regular season, all in the last game of the season on September 13 vs. Seattle. In the postseason with Las Vegas, Cannon tied a then career scoring high with 17 points on October 4 vs. Seattle, going 8-of-10 from the field. She also tied her playoff career high with five rebounds, and handed out a playoff career-high 2 assists vs. Seattle on October 4.

2017: Signed as a free agent with Phoenix on February 8, 2017 and played in 34 games with the Mercury. Cannon scored in double-figures on three occasions for the Mercury, including a career-high 17 points at Dallas on August 10. She grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds, and handed out a career-high three assists vs. Atlanta on September 3. Cannon led all WNBA rookies in field goal percentage, while ranking seventh in scoring and third in rebounding.

Cannon played her senior season at Florida Southern from 2010-11. During her senior season with Florida Southern, she led the Mocs to a 26-5 record, winning both the Sunshine State Conference regular season and tournament championships. Southern would advance into the NCAA Tournament, where the Mocs finished as the Regional Runner-up. That year, Cannon led the team in both scoring averaging 15.7 points per game and 12.1 rebounds per game.

She played her first three seasons from 2007-10 at UCF. During the 2008-09 season, Cannon earned Conference USA First Team honors and was named the 2009 Conference USA Tournament MVP. She was also a Conference USA All-Freshman Team recipient in 2007-08. She became the program's 12th member of the 1,000-point club during her junior season.

Egbo started 31 of 33 games played and averaged 7.2 points, 6.3 rebounds, 1.2 blocks and played 21.8 minutes per game during her rookie campaign. The 6-foot-4 center finished the season fifth in the league in blocks per game, and finished in the top five among WNBA rookies in points, rebounds, steals, blocks and minutes per game. Egbo was taken with the 10th overall pick in the 2022 WNBA Draft to complete the Baylor frontcourt move to Indiana. It was the third time in Fever franchise history college teammates were taken in the same draft, joining Zuzu Klimesova and Jillian Danker (Vanderbilt) in 2002, as well as Kelsey Mitchell and Stephanie Mavunga (Ohio State) in 2018. In her senior season with Baylor, the Houston, Texas native averaged 11.0 points, 8.4 rebounds, 1.8 blocks, 23.6 minutes and a 49.8 field goal percentage in 23.6 minutes per contest in 35 games played. Egbo finished her Baylor career fifth in program history with 183 career blocks. Her 63 blocks in 2021-22 tied her for third overall as a senior. She was named Honorable Mention All-Big 12 during her senior season.

2022: In her fifth season in the WNBA, all while wearing an Indiana Fever jersey, Kelsey Mitchell solidified her place as one of the greatest players in franchise history. In 2022, Mitchell averaged career-highs with 18.4 points per game, 4.2 assists per game and shot 43.8 percent from the field, to go along with 1.9 rebounds and 32.6 minutes per contest in 31 games played. Before missing the last five games of the regular season with a partial plantar fascia tear in her left foot, Mitchell played in all 153 games of her WNBA career, which is now the longest consecutive games played streak in franchise history and was also the longest active streak in the WNBA. Her 569 points scored this season tied her career-best with her 2021 scoring total, which was achieved in 32 games played. Mitchell scored more from the free throw line this season than in any other prior season making 105 free throws. She also finished with the eighth most field goals made in a regular season in franchise history with 196. Her 17 games scoring at least 20 points this season tied Tamika Catchings for the second most scored by a Fever player. She will enter the 2023 season third in franchise history in points scored (2,428), third in field goals made (855) and second in 3-point field goals made (347).

2021: Mitchell finished her fourth season with Indiana as the eighth leading scorer in the WNBA. Mitchell's scoring efforts will continue to be a top storyline in 2022 as she ended this year on a 23-game streak of scoring at least 10 points, which leads the league for longest active streak, heading into the new season. For the second straight season, Mitchell finished in the top 10 in the WNBA in minutes played per game playing 33.1 minutes for seventh best in the league. This season was the highest scoring season in Mitchell's career, 569 points, and also the fifth most by a Fever player in franchise history. Her 13 games scoring at least 20 points in 2021 were the most in a season in her career. The 212 made field goals were also the third most scored in a season by a Fever player. During the 2021 season, Mitchell ascended to third all-time in 3-point field goals made (275), fourth in scoring (1,859 points), fifth in field goals made (659) and seventh in assists (324) in Fever franchise ranks.

2020: As the sixth leading scorer in the WNBA averaging 17.9 points per game during the 2020 season, Kelsey Mitchell was the offensive catalyst for the Fever. In her third season, Mitchell set career-high marks in 2020 for points per game, rebounds per game (2.2), assists per game (2.8), minutes per game (32.1), field goal percentage (44.8%), 3-point field goal percentage (38.9%) and free throw percentage (84.9%). Mitchell averaged the seventh most minutes per game played throughout the WNBA during the 2020 season. Mitchell's greatest accomplishment, however, did not happen on the basketball court in 2020. On August 7, Mitchell completed her master's degree in Sports Administration from the University of Cincinnati. Later that day against the Minnesota Lynx, Mitchell became the second fastest player in franchise history to reach 1,000 career points in her 74th game with the Fever. She also became the 217th WNBA player to reach 1,000 career points with 15 points against Minnesota. On August 15 against Los Angeles, Mitchell ended with her ninth-career game with at least 25 points to go along with 8-of-13 shooting and six rebounds. Mitchell and Sparks guard Riquna Williams each drained seven 3-point field goals, which was the first game in WNBA history featuring two players who each made at least seven field goals from beyond the arc.

2019: In the season finale at home against Connecticut on September 8, Mitchell poured in the most points ever scored by a Fever player (38) and made the most 3-point field goals (9) in a game in franchise history. She reached double figures in 22 of 34 games and finished with seven games with at least 20 points. Mitchell ended the season with the second most made 3-point field goals (79) in a season in franchise history only behind Katie Douglas (80, 2012). She dished out a career-high nine assists vs. Minnesota on August 3.

2018: Mitchell's rookie campaign got off to a fast start with 136 points in her first seven games (19.4 ppg). During that stretch, she had back-to-back games of 26 points with four games of 20+ points and reached 100 points in just her sixth game. Only six players in WNBA history have reached 100 points in fewer games. Mitchell finished the season with 34 appearances and 17 starts. Her 12.7 points per game were second on the team and her 70 3-pointers were fourth in Fever history in a season. Her 70 3-point field goals were the most by a WNBA rookie since Tamika Catchings' league rookie record of 76 in 2002. She also was second on the team with 92 assists, the most ever by an Indiana rookie besides Catchings. Mitchell totaled 20 or more points six times, with a season-high 26 on three occasions: vs. Seattle on July 24; vs. Dallas on June 8; and vs. New York on June 2. She tallied a season-high five 3-pointers three times and had a season-highs of six rebounds and six assists in the club's final game at Chicago on August 19. Mitchell was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team and was the only rookie participant in the 3-point shooting contest at the WNBA All-Star Game.

Mitchell was a three-time Big Ten Player of the Year (2015, 2017, 2018) at Ohio State and was the first four-time All-American in Buckeyes history. She finished her career No. 2 on the NCAA's career scoring list (3,402 points) and hit more 3-pointers (497) than any player in NCAA history. Mitchell played and started in a school-record 139 games while leading OSU to 106 wins, two Big Ten titles, a Big Ten tournament title and four trips to the NCAA Tournament. She scored in double figures in all but two college games, and hit a 3-pointer in all but three. Mitchell was a 12-time Big Ten Player of the Week and left Columbus owning 17 career, season and single-game marks at OSU, as well as eight Big Ten records and four NCAA career marks including most 3FG made, most 3FG attempted (1,286) and most field goal attempts (2,560). Mitchell finished her career with an NCAA-best 92 consecutive games with at least one 3-point field goal. She was the fastest player in NCAA history to reach 2,000 career points, using 79 games to reach the milestone. Mitchell scored at least 20 points 109 times, and 30 or more points 28 times.

Born November 12, 1995, with twin sister Chelsea...her parents are Mark and Cheryl Mitchell, and she also has twin brothers, Cameron and Kevin, who are four years older... Mitchell attended Princeton High School in Cincinnati where her prolific scoring carried her to numerous prep All-America teams and an Ohio state title as a senior. Mitchell was named Ohio Ms. Basketball and the Ohio Gatorade Player of the Year in 2014, averaging 26.1 points, 4.4 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 3.9 steals. A three-time Cincinnati Enquirer Player of the Year, she was heralded as the top point guard in the country. She finished her prep career as the all-time scoring leader at Princeton with 2,051 points, and set an arena scoring record at Nutter Center in Dayton with 50 points in a regional semifinal win over defending champion Kettering Fairmont. As a junior, she averaged 23.3 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals. She was inducted into the Princeton High School Athletic Hall of Fame in 2020.

2023: Was the individual champion of the 2023 Athletes Unlimited season.

2022: As the third ever draft pick made at No. 2 overall in Indiana Fever history, forward NaLyssa Smith lived up to the expectations in her first season with the Fever, earning WNBA and AP All-Rookie Honors. Smith started all 32 games played in during the 2022 campaign and averaged 13.5 points, 7.9 rebounds, 1.4 assists and shot 41.9 percent from the field. Smith was one of seven players in the WNBA to average at least 13 points, 7.5 rebounds and one assist per game in 2022, joining Sylvia Fowles, Jonquel Jones, Candace Parker, Breanna Stewart, Alyssa Thomas and A'ja Wilson. In Smith's rookie season, she was the leading rebounder among rookies and sixth in the WNBA in rebounds per game, second among rookies in scoring average and averaged the second most minutes played among first-year players. Among Fever rookie seasons in franchise history, Smith finished with the second best rookie-scoring season (433 points), made the second most field goals (160 made field goals), the third best rookie-rebounding season (253 rebounds) and finished with the third most double-doubles recorded with eight. The rest of the 2022 WNBA rookie class only combined for nine such performances during the regular season. Smith's vast skillset also led her to earning an invitation to the WNBA Skills Challenge, as part of WNBA All-Star Weekend in Chicago. During the offseason heading into the 2023 season, Smith was invited to both the 2022 Women's National Team Training Camp and the 2022 Women's 3x3 AmeriCup team with USA Basketball.

From 2018-22 with the Baylor Bears, Smith compiled 2,048 points and 1,098 rebounds, making her the seventh player in Baylor history to reach at least 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in their career. Smith was the All-Big 12 Player of the Year twice and made the All-Big 12 First Team her final three years with Baylor. During the 2021-22 season, Smith averaged 22.1 points, 11.5 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 1.1 blocks in 32.9 minutes per contest in 35 games, all of which she started. The 6-foot-4 Converse, Texas, native received the Katrina McClain Award as the nation's top power forward her last two seasons in Waco, becoming the second person in the award's history to repeat, joining Ruthy Hebard. The accolades continued to pour in after her senior campaign, earning seven different All-America honors, including first-team selections by Sports Illustrated, The Athletic, Associated Press, USBWA, the John R. Wooden Award and the WBCA. She earned a second-team nod from the Senior CLASS Award. Following her junior season, Smith was recognized as a first-team All-America from the Associated Press, ESPN.com, WBCA and John R. Wooden entities. She earned second-team All-America honors from the USBWA as well.

Selected to the 2019 USA Basketball Women's U19 National Team, but withdrew due to injury concerns. Prior to the U19 team, Smith was selected to the 12-member 2018 Women's U18 National Team and helped the USA to a Gold Medal win against Canada. She averaged 11.0 points and 6.2 rebounds per contest in six games at the FIBA World Championships.

2022: Vivians signed a qualifying offer from the Indiana Fever on February 7, 2022 heading into what was the most impactful year of Victoria Vivians' career with Indiana. Vivians averaged career highs in points per game (9.8), rebounds per game (3.6), assists per game (2.4) and started a career-best 30 games this season. Vivians made more field goals (126), made more free throws (46), pulled down more rebounds (125) and recorded more steals (37) than any other year in her career. Her first made 3-point field goal of the 2022 regular season made her the 13th player in franchise history to surpass 100 3-point field goals in a Fever uniform and enters 2023 seventh all-time. Because of the WNBA season expanding to the longest regular season in league history, Vivians joined Emily Engstler and Destanni Henderson as the only players in franchise history to play more than 34 games in a regular season.

2021: After missing the entire 2019 season and having her 2020 season cut short due to injury, Vivians returned to play a key role with the Indiana Fever in 2021. In 31 games, Vivians averaged 6.8 points, 3.1 rebounds, 1.3 assists, 1.1 steals and 21.3 minutes per contest. She added eight starts to increase her career total to 34 games started during her WNBA tenure. During the 2021 season, Vivians also eclipsed the 500-point mark in her career and will also enter the 2022 season with 99 made 3-point field goals, which is good for 13th all-time in Fever franchise history.

2020: Vivians was slated to be an integral piece in Marianne Stanley's rotation during the 2020 season. After making a full recovery from an ACL injury, which took away her 2019 season, Vivians played in six games for the Fever in 2020. Vivians appeared in the first four games of the season, but unfortunately sustained a right knee injury against the Atlanta Dream on August 2. She returned for two more games against the Washington Mystics and Las Vegas Aces, but would not play in another game the rest of the season.

2019: Missed the entire season due to an ACL injury.

2018: Vivians played in all 34 games and started in the last 26, averaging 8.9 points, 3.1 rebounds, 1.2 assists and nearly a steal per game. Vivians had 13 double-figure scoring games and scored 20+ points on three occasions including a season-high 27 points against Atlanta on July 1. Her 21 second-half points against the Dream were the most by a Fever player since Katie Douglas in 2013. Vivians scored five 3-point field goals on four different occasions and finished with 65, the third-best rookie figure in club history. She combined with teammate Kelsey Mitchell (70) to hit the most 3-pointers by any rookie duo in WNBA history (135). Vivians had five 3-point field goals by halftime vs. Seattle on August 7, to fall one shy of the league's single-half record by a rookie. Vivians had a season-high nine rebounds against Washington on August 15, and followed that game with eight against Chicago on August 18.

Vivians was a four-time All-America recipient and the 2018 recipient of the Drysdale Award as nation's top shooting guard, on top of winning multiple national and SEC honors all four seasons of her college career. She was a four-year starter at Mississippi State and finished her career with 2,527 points – second in school history and ninth in SEC history. Vivians averaged 17.1 points over her career which was sixth in MSU history. Her 281 3-point field were also second in Bulldogs history and 7th in the SEC. She finished her career ranked fourth on MSU charts in free throws (400), fourth in steals (218) and fifth in free-throw percentage (76.5). She averaged 18.4 points per game against ranked opponents in her career. Vivians won the Gillom Trophy in four consecutive seasons, reflecting Mississippi's top women's college basketball player.

2022: With the Atlanta Dream, Wheeler averaged 8.4 points, 3.9 assists, 3.1 rebounds and played 26.3 minutes per contest in 30 games. Wheeler started all 30 games played and scored in double figures in 10 games during the 2022 season.

2021: In Wheeler's lone season with the Los Angeles Sparks, she started in all 32 games with the Sparks. Wheeler averaged a career-best 13.6 points, to go along with 4.8 assists per game and shot 35.5 percent from 3-point range. Wheeler scored in double-figures 23 times and reached the 20 point mark in five games.

2020: Wheeler remained in the WNBA Medical Protocol for the entirety of the 2020 season and never joined the Indiana Fever in Bradenton, Florida.

2019: Wheeler became the first player in Fever franchise history to win All-Star Game MVP with 25 points, seven 3-pointers and seven assists leading Team Wilson to a 129-126 win over Team Delle Donne. Her 171 assists set a Fever single-season record. Moved up to third with most assists in a career (572). She ended the season as the Fever career assist average leader with 4.01 per game.

2018: Appearing in all 34 games with Indiana, Wheeler started in 22 games while averaging 7.8 points per game. Her 141 assists in 2018 are the third most assists in a season by a Fever player in franchise history. She scored a season-high 15 points at Atlanta on July 13. Wheeler had a near triple-double vs. Las Vegas on June 12, finishing with 12 points, seven rebounds and eight assists.

2017: Wheeler was second on the Indiana Fever in scoring and tops in assists while averaging 11.8 points and 4.1 assists per game. She was one of four players to appear in every Fever game, and second on the team with 26 starts. Wheeler eclipsed 20 points five times and reached double-figure scoring on 18 occasions. Her career scoring high of 33 points came at Madison Square Garden against New York on August 8 while shooting 12-of-18 overall and 7-of-11 from 3-point range. She generated a season-high nine assists at Dallas on July 25, and had six or more assists 11 times. Wheeler led the Fever in scoring nine times, and was tops in assists in 15 games.

2016: A training camp free agent to begin the season, Wheeler wound up starting 25 games overall, and 18 of Indiana's last 20 games. Wheeler made her first playoff start and scored 10 points in a first-round loss to Phoenix on September 21. In 34 regular season games, she averaged 8.4 points, 2.1 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game, contributing a season-high 20 points at Los Angeles, on September 4. She had 10 points and a season-high nine assists in a near double-double at Chicago, on June 29. She had 18 points and seven assists at Atlanta, on May 29. Wheeler earned her first career start during her Fever debut against Dallas on May 14, and matched her previous scoring high with 13 points, including 6-of-8 free throw attempts.

2015: Wheeler's rookie season in the WNBA included 17 regular season games with the Atlanta Dream and three with the New York Liberty. She appeared in three playoff games for the Liberty, including Games 1 and 3 of the Eastern Conference Finals against Indiana. Her lone basket in the playoffs came against Indiana on September 23 in Game 1 of the Eastern Conference Finals. Wheeler was waived by the Dream late in the regular season following a three-team trade including Chicago & Minnesota and was signed one month later by the Liberty. She averaged 4.5 points and 1.5 assists with the Dream, and also 4.7 points and 0.3 assists in three regular season games with New York. She posted a season-high 13 points with Atlanta against Indiana on June 16.

Wheeler finished her Rutgers career with 1,027 career points, and ranked fifth all-time at RU in 3-point field goals made (157), third in 3-point field goals attempted (500) and 10th on the Scarlet Knights all-time 3-point field goal percentage list (.314). As a senior, she was an honorable mention All-Big East selection as she led the team in scoring at 10.5 points per game...she led the Scarlet Knights in 3-point shooting at a .354 clip and finished the season attempting 178 shots from downtown to tie for second on the RU single season list for 3-pointers attempted.

The daughter of Eric Wheeler and Melissa Cooper, Wheeler grew up in her grandmother's five-bedroom house with a dozen other siblings and relatives until she was 11 in a rough-and-tumble section of Miami. Her mother helped steer her from playing pick-up ball in local parks, toward organized school and basketball at Monsignor Pace, and eventually Parkway Academy (late in freshman year). Wheeler helped Parkway to a pair of state championships as a junior and senior in 2008 and 2009. Considering South Carolina, LSU and Florida among college choices besides Rutgers, Wheeler was rated the No. 5 point guard in the ESPNU HoopGurlz 100. Her mother passed away during her senior year of college and Wheeler credits RU coach C. Vivian Stringer for helping her become "a young woman that will be ready for life.". Wheeler pays tribute to her mother with tattoos on her right shoulder blade and right leg.


