### **MATCHUP QUICK HITS**

Thursday's matchup marks the New York Liberty's 58th all-time regular-season meeting against the Atlanta Dream and the fourth and final head-to-head matchup of their 2023 regular-season series.

Against the Dream, the Liberty are 35-22 (.614) in their all-time regular season series. The two franchises have also met twice in the postseason, with their last meeting coming in the Conference Finals of the 2010 WNBA Playoffs.

Last season, New York won three of their four meetings against Atlanta, including their playoff-berth-clinching, 87-83 victory at Barclays Center on August 14 in New York's regular-season finale.

Last game, New York weathered an 18-point, second-half deficit, marking their largest comeback of the season, en route to an 86-82 victory and securing, at 17-5, the best start in franchise history and its first regular-season series sweep of Seattle since 2015.

That evening, **Jonquel Jones** totaled 13 points on 50% (5-10) shooting from the field, a season-high 17 rebounds, two assists, and a block, marking her third consecutive double-double and fifth of the season. That performance marked Jones' first three-game span of consecutive double-doubles since 2022 (6/17 vs. SEA, 6/19 at WAS, & 6/22 vs. NYL). Her 17 rebounds also tied for the fifth most single-game rebounds in her career.

Highlighted by a nine-point, seven-assist fourth quarter, **Sabrina Ionescu** finished 12 points, 12 rebounds, and a season-high 12 assists, marking the fourth triple-double of her career and breaking a tie with Candace Parker for the second-most career triple-doubles in the regular season all-time.

The Liberty last played the Dream on June 23, 2023, at Gateway Center Arena, where New York's 110 points set the franchise record for the second-most points in a single game. The Liberty's 30-point margin of victory that game is the largest margin in their all-time series against Atlanta, their second-largest road margin of victory in franchise history, and was their first 30-point victory since their 92-62 win over Chicago in 2017.

**Betnijah Laney** finished with 19 points on 58.3% (7-12) shooting from the field, including a season-high four triples on 50% (4-8) from deep, three rebounds, and three assists.

Highlighted by a 12-point first quarter, **Jonquel Jones** finished with a then season-high 18 points on 66.7% (6-9) shooting from the floor, including 66.7% (2-3) from three, nine rebounds, and two blocks.

For Atlanta, Rhyne Howard finished with 24 points and six rebounds, while Allisha Gray added 17 points and four rebounds.

As of July 25, **Courtney Vandersloot** is the league leader in assists per game (8.3). **Breanna Stewart** ranks second in the W in scoring (22.6) and tied for fourth in rebounding (9.3). **Jonquel Jones** is fifth in three point percentage (42.6).

**Sabrina lonescu** is the only player leaguewide averaging 16-plus points, six-plus rebounds, and five-plus assists per game. She also ties for second in the WNBA in three-pointers made (66).

Through July 25, New York leads the W in assists per game (24.5), assist percentage (77.3), and assist ratio (20.6).

New York leads the WNBA in three-pointers made (239) and three-point percentage (38.3). The Liberty are second in scoring (88.7), second in rebounding (37.7), and fifth in blocks (4.7). They are also second in field goal percentage (45.7), free throw percentage (83.1), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.62), offensive rating (107.6), and net rating (7.2).

**Betnijah Laney** joined the Liberty in 2021 following a career-best season with the Dream in 2020, where she started in all 22 games she appeared in and averaged 17.2 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 4.0 assists per contest in her lone season with the Dream in 2020. Laney's performance that season garnered her the WNBA's Most Improved Player Award and a WNBA All-Defensive First Team selection.

**Marine Johannès** and **Iliana Rupert** were both members of the bronze-medal-winning French women's national basketball team at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

**Tanisha Wright**, who is in her second season as Head Coach of the Dream, spent three seasons with New York (2015-16, 2019), averaging 6.3 points per game in 94 appearances, 79 of which were starts. Wright and her assistant coach, Liberty Ring of Honor Member Vickie Johnson, are two of 12 players in WNBA history with at least 3,000 points, 1,000 rebounds, and 1,200 assists in a career. This list includes current Liberty guard **Courtney Vandersloot**.

Vickie Johnson is in her first season with Atlanta. Ranked second on the franchise's all-time scoring and assist lists, Johnson spent the first nine seasons of her WNBA career in the Big Apple, during which she garnered two All-Star selections (1999 & 2001) and averaged 11.5 points per game. She is also the franchise leader in games played and minutes.

New York selected **AD Durr** second overall in the 2019 WNBA Draft. They made 18 appearances with the Liberty, including 15 starts, where they averaged 9.7 points on 46.7% shooting from the field in 26.7 minutes per game.

### **2023 STORYLINES**

#### **REWRITING RECORD BOOKS**

At 17-5, New York has set the franchise record for the best start to a season in 2023.

This season, the Liberty are averaging a would-be WNBA record in assist percentage. New York is also averaging would-be franchise bests in points per game, assists per game, three-pointers made per game, offensive rating, and net rating.

If the WNBA season ended today, New York would finish as one of just six franchises to average at least 87 points per game and join Las Vegas as the only other team in the last four seasons to average 87-plus points per game for a full season.

### **NOTHING BUT NET**

This season, the New York Liberty are averaging a would-be franchise record 107.6 offensive rating and 7.2 net rating. Including their 100.4 defensive rating, New York is top-five across all three categories.

Before 2023, 17 teams in WNBA history averaged at least an offensive rating of 106.5 and a net rating of 6.5 while averaging a sub-100.5 defensive rating. Of these 17 teams, 15 reached the WNBA Finals, and 10 were eventually crowned WNBA Champions. The 2012 San Antonio Silver Stars and the 2021 Las Vegas Aces were the only teams of the 17 not to reach the WNBA Finals — both losing in the semifinals. The 2021 Aces fell to the Phoenix Mercury, coached by **Sandy Brondello**.

This season, both the New York Liberty and the Las Vegas Aces meet this criteria. Multiple teams meeting these criteria in the same season has occurred just four other times in WNBA history in 2012, 2016, 2017, and 2020. The two teams met in the WNBA Finals in three of those four seasons.

### THE WHITEBOARD

New York acquired the All-Star trio of **Jonquel Jones**, **Breanna Stewart**, and **Courtney Vandersloot** this last offseason, all 2022 WNBA All-Stars.

The Liberty is the first team to add three All-Stars from the previous season in a single offseason in WNBA history.

#### A HISTORIC HOMECOMING

**Breanna Stewart** has been on a tear in her debut season with the Liberty.

On June 13, Breanna Stewart became the first player in WNBA history to record at least 200 points, 100 rebounds, and 40 assists through their team's first 10 games with her 28-point, 14-rebound, seven-assist performance in the Liberty's 80-71 victory.

Her 45-point performance against the Fever on May 27 is the most scored in under 31 minutes played in WNBA history and the second-most by any player, WNBA or NBA, in their home debut at Barclays Center. That same game, she further set career-highs in scoring (45), three-pointers made (6), a new Liberty single-game scoring record (45), a new franchise record for made field goals (15), and her 29-point first-half set

a new career-high for first-half scoring—one point shy of the most-ever in first-half scoring in WNBA history.

To date, Stewart's historic debut season in Seafoam has also included the following accolades and records:

- Voted 2023 WNBA All-Star Captain for the second-consecutive season.
- Named KIA WNBA Player of the Month for the month of May.
- Named WNBA Player of the Week thrice on 5/30, 6/13, and 7/13.
- Set franchise record for most points over a two-game span with 66 points from 5/21 to 5/27.
- Became the fastest player to reach 4,000 points on 6/27
- Set Liberty franchise record for the most career 40-point games with her 43-point performance against the Mercury on 7/5
- Became the first player with multiple 40-point games in a season since 2018 on 7/5
- Recorded second-ever game of at least 40 points, 12 rebounds, and five assists in WNBA history on 7/5

#### SAB MAKING HISTORY

**Sabrina lonescu** entered her fourth WNBA season fresh off a break-out 2022 campaign that saw her earn her first All-WNBA selection and eclipse Liberty Ring of Honor Member **Teresa Weatherspoon's** then 23-year-old single-season franchise assist record of 205 assists with her 228 total dimes last season. She became the first-ever WNBA player to record 500+ points, 200+ rebounds, and 200+ assists in a single season.

Notching two of her three career triple-doubles last season, lonescu not only became the first-ever player to record a triple-double in less than three quarters against Chicago (6/12/22) but also secured the first 30-point triple-double at Las Vegas (7/6/22).

On May 15, the New York Liberty inked **Sabrina lonescu** to a multi-year extension, linking their 2020 draftee to the Big Apple through the 2025 season. New York selected lonescu with the No. 1 overall pick in the 2020 WNBA Draft out of Oregon. Entering her fourth WNBA season, the 5-foot-11 guard has been critical to the organization's turnaround. Through 69 regular season games, including 65 starts, Sabrina has averaged 14.9 points, 6.4 rebounds, and 6.1 assists per game—the only-ever WNBA player with such career averages across the three categories.

This season, lonescu is rewriting record books. In her debut appearance, she won WNBA STARRY® 3-Point Contest in record fashion. Her 37-point final round marked an all-time WNBA and NBA single-round record, and her title is the first in Liberty franchise history.

In June, Ionescu set the Liberty franchise record for three-pointers made with career-high eight threes and tied the franchise record for third-most points in a single game with 37 points on June 9. On June 27, she became the fastest guard to record 500 rebounds in league history. In July, she further became the second-fastest player in WNBA history to reach 200 threes on July 19.

### **2023 STORYLINES**

### JJ'S IN THE HOUSE

Fresh off her second-career WNBA Finals appearance, the Liberty acquired **Jonquel Jones** via trade this past offseason. The 6-foot-6 forward spent six seasons in the Constitution State, where the four-time All-Star won the 2021 MVP, 2018 Sixth Woman of the Year, and 2017 Most Improved Player awards and was a four-time All-WNBA selection. In 196 career games, including 149 starts, she posts career averages of 13.6 points, 8.6 rebounds, and 1.2 blocks per game on 51.1% shooting from the field and 37.7% from three.

A three-time All-Defense selection, Jones will bring her rebounding and blocking prowess to New York. In her six-season career, she ranked top 10 in total blocks five times and rebounds four times, leading the WNBA in total blocks in 2019 and total rebounds and offensive rebounds in 2017 and 2019. She is a three-time WNBA leader in rebounds per game and led the league in blocks per game in 2019, averaging two blocks per game.

### SLOOT, THERE SHE IS

The New York Liberty welcomes **Courtney Vandersloot** to the Big Apple. Coming off a twelve-season stay in the Windy City that saw her win the 2021 WNBA Championship and accumulate five All-WNBA selections, the four-time All-Star has personified playmaking.

The quintessential playmaker, Sloot has ranked in the top 10 in assist percentage in every season of her career, leading the league seven times. In all but two of her twelve seasons in the WNBA, she ranked top 10 in total assists and assists per game. She is a six-time WNBA leader in per-game assists, including five-straight seasons from 2017 to 2021, and she is a five-time WNBA leader in total assists, including four-straight seasons from 2018 to 2021. She ranks third all-time in career assists behind New York native **Sue Bird** (3234) and **Ticha Penicheiro** (2600).

In her illustrious career, the 5-foot-8 guard has recorded two triple-doubles, including one of just four post-season triple-doubles in WNBA history.

### AN EMPIRE STATE HOMECOMING

Coming off an award-laden six-season stint in Seattle, four-time All-Star **Breanna Stewart** signed with the Liberty this past offseason in free agency, marking her official return to her home state of New York.

The 6-foot-4 Syracuse, New York native spent six seasons in the Pacific Northwest and has posted career averages of 20.3 points, 8.6 rebounds, 2.9 assists, and 1.5 blocks per game on 47.3% from the field and 36.9% from deep. Entering her first season as a Liberty, the four-time All-Star's WNBA career already features the 2018 MVP, two WNBA Championships, two Finals MVPs, five All-WNBA selections, four All-Defense selections, the 2016 Rookie of the Year, the inaugural Commissioner's Cup MVP, and a W25 selection.

#### **HUSKIES AND DUCKS IN BK**

This season, in Brooklyn, will see two sets of college teammates reunite in seafoam.

The 2023 season will mark the first time **Breanna Stewart** and **Stef Dolson**—acquired in free agency over the last two offseasons—are teammates since the former WNBA Champions' played at UCONN. In two seasons, these former Huskies posted a 75–4 record (40–0 in 2013–14) and captured two NCAA Championships as teammates from 2012 to 2014.

New York Liberty draftees **Sabrina Ionescu** and **Nyara Sabally** were teammates for two seasons at Oregon.

#### YEAR TWO FOR COACH BRONDELLO

The 2023 campaign marks **Sandy Brondello's** second season at the helm of the New York Liberty. A former WNBA player and veteran coach, Brondello led the Liberty to the franchise's first postseason victory since 2015, where the Liberty upset the then-defending Champion Chicago Sky in the opener of their three-game first-round series.

Before she arrived in the County of Kings, Brondello guided the Phoenix Mercury to the 2014 WNBA Championship as its head coach and led the organization to the postseason in all eight of her season in the desert. She won the 2014 WNBA Coach of the Year award, and her 25 career postseason wins rank fifth all-time.

#### A BASKETBALL FAMILY

After facing off in the 2021 WNBA Finals as members of the Phoenix Mercury and Chicago Sky, **Sandy Brondello** and her husband, **Olaf Lange**, reunited in Brooklyn last season, coaching on the same staff for the first time since their time in San Antonio. The 2023 season marks the second season of this reunion. Sandy and Olaf have two children, Brody and Jayda.

### **ALL-STAR POWER**

To date, New York's roster features 21 combined All-Star Appearances.

The duo of **Breanna Stewart** and **Courtney Vandersloot** boast five All-Star nods each. **Jonquel Jones** is a four-time All-Star.

**Stef Dolson, Sabrina lonescu,** and **Epiphanny Prince** are two-time WNBA All-Stars, while **Betnijah Laney also** sports an All-Star selection on her resume.

### PRINCE'S NYC RETURN

On June 25, 2023, New York re-signed New York native and 13-year WNBA vet **Epiphanny Prince** to a hardship contract.

Entering her second stint with the franchise, the 5-foot-9 guard spent four seasons with New York from 2015 to 2018, during which she averaged 11.7 points, 2.8 rebounds, and 2.6 assists per game in 74 appearances, 60 of which were starts. In 2015, she was an All-WNBA second-team selection. That season, she ranked top 10 in points and steals per game.

A two-time All-Star and 2020 WNBA Champion, Prince played locally for Murray Bergtraum in high school. There, she scored 113 points in a 137-32 victory over Brandeis High School in 2006, breaking a girls' national prep record previously held by Hall of Famer Cheryl Miller, who scored 105 points in 1982.

# **SANDY BRONDELLO**

### NEW YORK LIBERTY HEAD COACH 2ND SEASON WITH NEW YORK | 11TH SEASON | NO. 9 ALL-TIME IN WINS

Veteran WNBA coach, player, and former Australian Olympian Sandy Brondello (braun-DELL-oh) was named the ninth head coach in Liberty franchise history on January 7, 2022. Brondello joined New York after an eight-year head coaching tenure with the Phoenix Mercury where she led the team to a playoff appearance in each of her eight seasons. To date, Brondello holds an overall regular season record of 197-153 over her 11 combined seasons at the helm of the Liberty, Mercury and San Antonio Silver Stars, making her the ninth-winningest coach in WNBA history.

Additionally, Brondello has compiled a 25-23 postseason record throughout her head coaching career, ranking her as the fifth-winningest coach in league postseason history. In 2014, Sandy was named the WNBA Coach of the Year after she led Phoenix to a WNBA regular season-record 29 wins and capped the season with a WNBA Championship.

A 17-year veteran of the WNBA coaching ranks, Brondello has been affiliated with the league for 23 of its 26 seasons, including her time as a player. A proven winner internationally and in the WNBA, her 18 total years as an assistant coach and head coach have featured 15 playoff appearances, highlighted by a perfect 10-for-10 in postseason berths as a head coach.

Sandy has led her teams to seven Semifinals round berths (formerly conference finals) and three WNBA Finals appearances in 2008, 2014, and 2021. Prior to her time with the Mercury, Brondello served as lead assistant coach for the Los Angeles Sparks (2011-13) under 2012 WNBA Coach of the Year Carol Ross. Brondello led the San Antonio Silver Stars to a 2010 playoff berth in her lone season at the helm following five seasons on the Silver Stars bench as an assistant under Dan Hughes (2005-09), the fourth-winningest coach in league history.

A 2010 inductee into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame, Brondello was named the 11th head coach for the Australian Women's National Basketball team on April 17, 2017. Most recently, Brondello led the Australian National Team to a Quarterfinals appearance in the 2020 Tokyo Summer Olympics. While she serves in her role as head coach for the Liberty, Brondello will continue to prepare the Opals who will host the 2022 FIBA Women's Basketball World Cup.

Brondello finished a stellar 17-year professional playing career with a five-year run in the WNBA in which she played for Detroit (1998-99), Miami (2001-02) and Seattle (2003), and was named a 1999 WNBA All-Star. She began her career with the Women's National Basketball League (WNBL) in Australia (1986-96), and was named the league MVP in 1995. The 5-7 guard was a 10-time German Cup champion while playing with BTV Wuppertal (1992-2002), a three-time European Cup All-Star selection (1994, 1996, 1997), and the 1996 European Cup MVP when she led her team to the title.

An 18-year member of the Australian National Team, Brondello is a four-time Olympian, a two-time silver medalist (2000, 2004) and was named the 1992 Australian International Player of the Year.

Brondello is married to Liberty assistant coach, Olaf Lange, and the couple have two children, Brody and Jayda.
