When they joined the Atlanta Dream in October 2021, coach Tanisha Wright and general manager Dan Padover took stock of their new WNBA team. It didn't take long.

Atlanta had just three players under contract -- one of whom had missed two-thirds of the 2021 season under suspension -- and a 2022 first-round draft pick. The Dream had gone a combined 23-65 from 2019 to 2021 and had a contentious separation from one of its former owners.

The mission for the new ownership group, front office and coaches was nothing short of an overhaul. But how do you fix a broken franchise? It starts from the top.

"Our league deserves owners who are just as passionate about this as we are," said Wright, who played in the WNBA for 14 seasons before becoming a coach. "I think that's exactly the type of ownership group that we have now: They're excited not only for the Atlanta Dream, but for the growth of the WNBA as a whole."

The Dream finished 2022 at 14-22 and just out of the playoffs, and No. 1 draft pick Rhyne Howard was WNBA Rookie of the Year. In the offseason, Atlanta had a handful of headlining acquisitions, including Allisha Gray, the 2017 rookie of the year. And entering the 2023 season -- which opens for the Dream on May 20 (1 p.m. ET, ABC) at the Dallas Wings -- there's an energetic feeling of potential.

"We know how hard we can work and what we can accomplish," Howard said. "It's only up from here. It's gonna be a good journey."

The vibe is much different than the summer of 2020, when the Dream organization seemed in crisis as the players' relationship with then-Atlanta ownership became fractured beyond repair.

Real estate investor Larry Gottesdiener knew this when he bought the Dream in February 2021 with an ownership trio that included former WNBA player Renee Montgomery.

Gottesdiener has made a fortune looking at spaces, imagining what could be there and then making it happen. The Dream, who entered the WNBA in 2008 as an expansion franchise and made three trips to the WNBA Finals between 2010 and 2013, weren't literally building from the ground up in 2021, but it felt like it.

Billings' Career Night leads to Postseason Berth

Monique Billings scored 15 points on 6-for-11 shooting and grabbed 14 rebounds as the Dream clinched a playoff berth with a 79-68 victory over Seattle on Wednesday (9/6).

Billings surpassed 1,000 career rebounds with her 14 boards -- including a career-high 12 defensive rebounds. She finished the game with her eleventh career double-double and second of the season. WNBA All-Stars Cheyenne Parker and Allisha Gray added a combined 35 points in the victory.

The postseason berth is the ninth in team history and the first for the Dream since 2018. The first round of the 2023 WNBA Playoffs presented by Google is scheduled to begin on Sept. 13.

Dream Guards Make More History

Both Rhyne Howard and Alisha Gray eclipsed the 600-point mark on the season, marking the first time in franchise history that two Dream players have scored 600 points in a single season. With two regular season games remaining, Howard leads the team with 641 points, while fellow guard Gray has scored 619.

Forward Cheyenne Parker looks to join Howard and Gray in the 600 Club, needing to score 30 more points to reach 600 this season. The 2023 WNBA All-Star has scored 20 or more points in four of her last five games, making the feat attainable before the end of the regular season.

<u>August</u>

ATL All-Stars Break Franchise History

Cheyenne Parker recorded her seventh double-double of the season against Indiana (8/27) with 24 points and 10 rebounds, but that wasn't her only highlight. With her 16th point of the game, she joined guards Allisha Gray and Rhyne Howard in eclipsing 500 points on the season, the first time in franchise history that three players have each breached the 500 milestone in a season. The accolades keep mounting for the trio who have individually and as a group cemented themselves in Dream history.

Howard In A League Of Her Own

Howard's 17-point night against Indiana (8/27) propelled her to 600 points on the season. Howard is the first player in franchise history to score 600 points in a season since Angel McCoughtry scored 643 in 2016. In her second year in the WNBA, the sky is the limit for Howard with her scoring ability continuing to excel as she keeps rewriting the record book.

Monique's Magical Night

Monique Billings checked off several milestones in Friday's game against Los Angeles. The Dream forward hit the 1,000-point mark during her last field goal of the contest. Billings finished the game with 10 points and 10 rebounds -- one on the offensive glass and nine defensive boards -- to finish with her first double-double of the season. It serves as the UCLA alum's 10th career double-double in her sixth season of WNBA play.

The 2018 second-round pick is chasing another milestone. Billings is 23 rebounds away from grabbing 1,000 in her career.

Windy City Sweep

Atlanta's win against Chicago (8/18) not only boosted the Dream back to .500 but also served as a regular-season sweep against the Sky. The 4-0 sweep is the Dream's first sweep of the Sky in franchise history, delivering payback to a Chicago team that swept Atlanta in three games during the 2022 season.

Dream Duo

Allisha Gray and Rhyne Howard's scoring dominance this season has set the new normal for the Dream. Both players eclipsed 500 points scored this season against Seattle on Aug. 10. Howard has scored 641 points to Gray's 619.

In her seventh WNBA season and first with the Dream, Gray has already eclipsed her previous high of 441 points as a rookie in Dallas in 2017. Gray's breakout performance this season has put her name at the forefront of voters' minds when it comes to this year's most improved player. For Howard, the records keep stacking up in her second season in the WNBA. She has already become the first Dream player in franchise history to score 500 or more points in their first two years in the league.

This is only the second time Dream teammates have reached beyond the 500-point mark -- Angel McCoughtry and Iziane Castro Marques scored more than 500 points in 2010. Additionally, Cheyenne Parker scored 500 points in her game against the Fever (8/27), while Howard reached 600 points against the Fever (8/27)

Dream Fans Showing Out With No Sign Of Slowing

The Dream's passionate and loyal fanbase have done it again! Atlanta surged to double-digits in sellouts with their tenth of the season on Sunday (8/6) against the Indiana Fever. Sunday's sellout marks the fourth consecutive for Atlanta and the trademark electric atmosphere is resulting in a formidable fortress for all Dream opponents.

Wright Wins Coach Of The Month

Dream Head Coach, Tanisha Wright was named the WNBA Coach of the Month for July 2023, after an 8-3 record in the month. The Dream started the month off with six straight wins – including a record-setting 112 points in a win over Los Angeles on July 2. Entering the month 6-8, Wright led the team to critical wins that put them back over .500 and up as high as fourth in the WNBA standings.

23' Dream Sights Set On Playoffs

After the win against Washington (7/30) the Dream have now tied their win total from the 2022 season (14) with 15 games still remaining. The Dream have been flirting with the top four in the standings and will look to prove their legitmacy in a heavyweight clash with the cream of the crop, the Las Vegas Aces. Atlanta will enter the last third of the regular season looking to cerment not only a playoff spot but first-round home court advantage.

Howard Cemented In Dream History

Rhyne Howard became the fastest player in Atlanta Dream history to score 1,000 career points in just 59 games. The achievement came in typical Howard fashion with a shot from behind the arc early in the second quarter against Washington (7/30).

Top 10 D-Rob

Danielle Robinson now sits alone in 10th spot on the WNBA All-Time career assists with 1426. After recording four assists against the Mercury (7/25), the veteran point guard overtook her current head coach, Tanisha Wright (1423) and Shannon Johnson (1424) in one game to secure her top 10 status.

Dream Star-Power On Full Display In Vegas

First-time All-Stars Cheyenne Parker and Allisha Gray were joined by two-time All-Star Rhyne Howard in the 2023 AT&T WNBA All-Star Game on Saturday, July 15. Atlanta was one of only three teams with three or more players in the game, joining New York (3) and Las Vegas (4). All three Dream players scored in double digits, combining for 40 — Howard led with 16, Parker put up 14 and Gray finished with 10. All three players hit a four-point shot in the game, with Parker leading the team going 3-of-4 from beyond the arc. Howard led the Team Wilson bench with three assists.

Atlanta's New Big 3

Rhyne Howard was called up as a 2023 AT&T WNBA All-Star, the league announced on Tuesday, July 11, her second All-Star nod. Howard joined Dream teammates Gray and Parker on Team Wilson in the game, stepping in as an injury replacement for the Washington Mystics' Elena Delle Donne.

The Dream's Big Three put the entire WNBA on notice as they led the team's surge up the standings. The Dream owned the longest active win streak before the All-Star Break, winning six games in a row. The last time a Dream team did this was 2018, when it finished 1st in the conference and made the Eastern Conference Finals.

Gray and Parker were both named 2023 AT&T WNBA All-Stars. Both

players earned their first-ever WNBA All-Star nod in the middle of career-best seasons.

Only three teams sent three or more representatives in the All-Star game - Atlanta joined only the "superteams" Las Vegas (4) and New York (3).

Dream Eye Top 4

The Atlanta Dream (11-8) are level with the Washington Mystics (11-8) who are currently sitting in fourth place in the standings. The Dream now sit witht the upper echelon of the league, and now look to break away from Washington and hold down a top four spot going into the back-half of the season.

Cheyenne Parker Double-Double Machine

Cheyenne Parker recorded her third consecutive double-double with 18 points and 11 rebounds (the last player to achieve this in a Dream uniform was Sancho Lyttle in 2016). This marks her 6th double-double of the season and 21st of her career.

Dream Answer Wright's Call for Consistency

Atlanta Dream's Head Coach, Tanisha Wright has been vocal about asking her young squad to focus on consistency throughout the season. After the 90-79 win against the Sparks (7/5), Atlanta had won three in a row, moving to .500 on the season. To make things sweeter, the Dream have scored 90+ points in each of those wins, the first time that has happened this season.

Howard's Historic Scoring Performance

Rhyne Howard now owns the second 40-point scoring game in Dream history, with 43 points on 70% shooting against the Sparks (7/2). Betty Lennox owns the franchise record of 44. Howard currently has the second-highest score this season, behind Breanna Stewart who had 45. Howard's 43-point performance sits 13th all-time in scoring in the WNBA.

June

Howard Does it Again

Rhyne Howard broke fanchise history again on Friday night against the Mystics, making it 25 games in a row with at least one made 3-pointer. Howard holds the longest active streak in the WNBA and now owns the Dream franchise record after overtaking Renee Montgomery (24).

Dream SNAP Mystics cold streak

The Dream broke a seven-game losing streak to Washington, defeating them 94-89 in front of a sold-out Atlanta crowd (6/30). First time All-Star, Allisha Gray led the Dream with 26 points and Rhyne Howard dished out a career high 8 assists, including four to Gray.

Danielle Robinson Joins Elite Scoring Club

The 11-year WNBA veteran scored her 3000th career point against the Washington Mystics (6/28) in style with a bucket from outside the arc only hitting net. Robinson is the 90th player in WNBA history to acheive the milestone.

Dream Take Three of Four on Road Trip

The Atlanta Dream won three of their four games as a part of the team's last road trip - defeating conference leaders New York and Connecticut before picking up a road win over Indiana. The Dream fell to Dallas on Tuesday to close the road stand.

Dream Snap losing streak to the Sun in overtime classic

Atlanta snapped a seven-game losing streak to Connecticut on Thursday night 92-88. The Dream closed a 10-point halftime gap inspired by scoring from Allisha Gray (27), Rhyne Howard (19) and Cheyenne Parker (19).

Six Players with 12+ Lead Dream to W over Liberty

For the first time in franchise history and for the second time in league history, the Dream had six players with 12+ points in a single game: Allisha Gray (16), Haley Jones (13), AD Durr (13), Rhyne Howard (12) Nia Coffey (12) and Monique Billings (12) heavily contributed to the Dream's 86-79 win against New York (6/13).

Dream Start To June Road Trip

The Dream began their four-game road trip with a seven point victory over the New York Liberty 86-79. Outscoring New York 27-9 in bench points, the Dream were energized by AD Durr and Monique Billings who combined for 25 of those points.

Howard makes HISTORY, breaks a 25-year-old WNBA Record

Dream guard Rhyne Howard reached 100 made 3-pointers in only 40 games on Friday night against New York (6/9), setting a WNBA record. She is the fastest to ever reach the milestone (40 games), defeating Cynthia Cooper's 41-game record set back in 1998.

WNBA Commissioner's Cup

The third annual Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase is an in-season competition throughout the regular season, with players competing for a prize pool and an additional pool of money for charitable and civic organizations. The Dream's Commissioner's Cup games are denoted with an asterisk on the first page of these notes.

The Dream posted a 6-4 record in the competition, donating \$14,000 to local nonprofit Helping Mamas, an organization that provides essential baby items to organizations serving women and children in need.

Rhyne Howard Lands SLAM Magazine Cover

2022 WNBA Rookie of the Year, All-Star and No. 1 overall Draft pick Rhyne Howard landed her first SLAM Magazine cover, the magazine announced on Friday, May 19. Howard is featured as one of SLAM 244's "Futures" highlights; writer DeMarco Williams calls Howard a "nightmare in the WNBA" in the featured story.

May

Coffey's Block Party

Dream Forward, Nia Coffey, started the 2023 season with 11 blocks through 5 games. With an average of 2.2 blocks per game, Coffey is 3rd across the WNBA, and an anchor to the Dream defense.

Comeback Win at Minnesota

The Dream trailed 40-47 at halftime in Minnesota (5/23), and ended up recouping a 19-point deficit to secure the win. It stands as the largest comeback win in Dream history after Atlanta was 0-20 last season when trailing at the half.

Preseason

Atlanta Dream Announce Full Broadcast Schedule

All 40 of the Dream's games this season will air either locally or nationally, with 34 games available to fans via national broadcast or stream. Atlanta's season tips off with a national broadcast as the Dream's season opener against the Dallas Wings on May 20th will air on ABC at 1:00 p.m. ET. ESPN will broadcast back-to-back Dream games as Atlanta hosts the Connecticut Sun on Saturday, July 22 at 1 p.m. E.T. and the Phoenix Mercury on Tuesday, July 25 at 7:00 p.m. ET.

Bally Sports South's season-long coverage will begin with the team's game at the Minnesota Lynx on Tuesday, May 23, airing on Bally Sports Southeast and streaming on the Bally Sports app beginning at 8:00 p.m. ET.

Nine Friday night Atlanta Dream games will air nationally on ION TV, beginning with the team's June 2nd home game against the Las Vegas Aces. Atlanta will have four games air on CBS Sports Network and eight on NBA TV. Several games will be available for fans to stream as well, with two on Twitter, three on Amazon Prime Video, and three streaming through ESPN3.

The broadcast team for Atlanta Dream games on Bally Sports returns for their third season together in 2023. Angel Gray is back for her third season as play-by-play announcer, while LaChina Robinson and Tabitha Turner will split time as analysts again this season. Robinson returns for her 14th season with the Dream, while Turner will provide commentary for a fifth consecutive season.

Dream Reload with Three Picks in 2023 WNBA Draft

The Atlanta Dream selected guard Haley Jones with the No. 6 overall pick out of Stanford, Laeticia Amihere out of South Carolina with the No. 8 pick, and Leigha Brown with the No. 15 pick (second round) in the 2023 WNBA Draft.

"We targeted two players at 6 and 8 and feel very fortunate to have landed both of them," said General Manager Dan Padover. "Haley has played at an elite level her entire life and is a versatile guard who will complement our backcourt in a variety of ways. Laeticia is a unique talent with endless potential, and we are looking forward to seeing her growth at the pro level. Leigha is an ultra-competitor who can play multiple positions. We are excited that this year's draft will bring another influx of youth and excitement to this roster."

Dream Sign Cheyenne Parker, Allisha Gray to Contract Extensions

Returning forward Cheyenne Parker and new-addition Allisha Gray both signed new contracts with the Dream prior to the 2023 season, keeping them in Atlanta for the near furture.


