JEWELL LOYD BECOMES STORM'S SINGLE-SEASON SCORING LEADER

Jewell Loyd became the Storm's all-time single-season scoring leader in Chicago on Aug. 27, scoring 26 points to give her 748 points, moving her past Breanna Stewart (742, 2018) at the top of the list. Loyd's record came in her 31st game while it took Stewart 34 games to post her total.

CAN'T STOP HER, YOU CAN ONLY HOPE TO ... FOUL HER?

Jewell Loyd has been fouled more than any other player in the league at 6.7 fouls drawn per game. That's the highest since Diana Taurasi drew 7.0 fouls per game in 2013.

JEWELL BECOMES SECOND-FASTEST TO 800

Jewell Loyd flew past 800 points for the season with her 25-point game at Los Angeles last Thursday, which gave her 824 on the season. She became just the fourth player in WNBA history to score at least 800 points in a season and the second to do so within the first 34 games of the season.

30-POINT GAME QUEEN

Jewell Loyd recorded her 11th 30+ point game of the season at Indiana last week, scoring 19 points in the fourth quarter to give her 32 for the game. Those 11 games are the second most in a single season in WNBA history, one behind Maya Moore's 12 in 2014. She is also tied with Cappie Pondexter for the eighth most 30+ point games all-time. Loyd is the first player with 30+ point games against eight different teams in one season and one of three players with to score 30+ points seven times on the road in a season. (h/t to [Acrossthetimeline.com](#) for the great notes.)

JEWELL LOYD ... FOR THREE!!!

Jewell Loyd has been deadly from three-point range this season, tying the WNBA record with nine three-pointers in a game at Washington and recording 105 total this season, the fifth-most in a season in WNBA history. That total has already bested her franchise single-season record of 84 set last year. Loyd ranks second in the league with 3.0 3pt FG made per game, and is currently on pace to make 114, close to DT's WNBA record of 121 (2006). Loyd is the only player in WNBA history to have 8+ made three-pointers in multiple games in a single season, doing it twice so far in 2023.

LOYD NAMED 2023 ASG MVP AFTER RECORD PERFORMANCE

Storm guard Jewell Loyd scored an All-Star Game record 31 points thanks to hitting a record 10 3-pt FGs (including one four-pointer). Those 10 three-pointers give her 21 in her career, the most by any player in All-Star Game history. In her last two All-Star Games, Loyd has scored 52 points (26.0 ppg) and made 17 three-pointers, shooting 50% from 3pt range (17-of-34).

JEWELL HITS 4,500-POINT MILESTONE

Jewell Loyd recorded her 4,500th career point during Tuesday's game vs Connecticut, becoming the 31st player in WNBA history to tally 4,500 career points. In addition, she is one of just 20 players to record 4,500+ points, 950+ rebounds, 875+ assists, and 325+ steals during their career, and—at 29 years, 307 days old—is the second youngest to reach that milestone behind Maya Moore (29y, 55d).



NOTES, STATS & TRENDS

SEATTLE TAKES ON ATLANTA IN PENULTIMATE ROAD GAME

The Storm is in Atlanta tonight to take on the Dream in Seattle's next to last road game of the 2023 season. The season series between the two hangs in the balance with the first two games being won by the home team. Atlanta picked up an 85-75 win in the final game before the all-star break with the Storm holding on for a 68-67 win in Seattle on August 10. The Storm has won nine of the last 11 against the Dream overall with the only two losses coming in Atlanta. Seattle has only lost the season series with the Dream four times all time though it hasn't happened since 2018.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN ...

Seattle is currently in the midst of a tough stretch over its final portion of the season, playing game three of four-straight road games over a nine-day stretch. The trip got off to a strong start with a win in LA on Aug. 31 before the Storm lost at Vegas on Saturday. After tonight's game in Atlanta, the Storm players its final road game of the season Friday in Dallas. Seattle then returns home to close out the 2023 campaign, facing LA again on Sunday, Sept. 10. Overall, the Storm end the 2023 season playing seven of its final nine games on the road.

ROAD SWEET ROAD?

With its next two games on the road, it is encouraging that the Storm has played markedly better on the road than at home this season. Seattle is averaging 8.5 more points on the road (82.9 ppg) than at home (74.4 ppg), shooting over three points better (42.5% road vs 39.2% home), and making 2.3 more three-pointers (9.6 vs 7.3) per game on the road. The Storm is also sharing the ball better with 18.9 assists a game on the road to 16.1 apg at home.

STORM DEFENSE HAS BEEN SOLID IN SECOND HALF

The Storm defense has been strong in the second half, ranking near the top in most defensive stats since July 17. Since the all-star break, Seattle leads the WNBA in opposing FG% (41.4%), is third in opponent 3pt FG% (32.7%), fourth in points per game (80.9) and seventh in defensive rating at 103.4. Overall, Seattle's defense has held its opponent to 81 or fewer points in nine of its last 14 games. Through its first 20 games, the Storm ranked 11th allowing 86.4 ppg, 12th in oppFG% at 47.1% and 10th in defensive rating at 105.2.

MAGBEGOR CONTINUES STRONG SEASON

Ezi Magbegor is having the best season of her career, averaging 13.7 points, 8.0 rebounds, 1.8 blocks, 2.4 assists, and 1.2 steals per game while shooting 51.3% from the field in 2023. Magbegor is the only player posting those stats or better in the league this year, and would be one of just two players with those numbers or better over a season in WNBA history joining Candace Parker, who did so in 2008. Magbegor, who at 24 years old is the third-youngest player on the Storm roster, has upped her game since making her first all-star appearance in July. In 16 games since the break, she has scored in double-figures in 14 games, shot 50% or better in 13 games, and is averaging 14.7 points and shooting 55.2% from the field. In addition, Magbegor has 10 double-doubles this season after entering the year with just three.

NOELLE QUINN CLOSING IN ON COACHING MILESTONES

Storm Head Coach Noelle Quinn picked up her 49th coaching victory on Thursday, which is tied with her predecessor Dan Hughes for third-most in franchise history. Tonight's game will be her 100th game coached which makes her one of three Storm head coaches with at least 100 games coached in franchise history. She will be just the 31st head coach with 100 games coached in WNBA history (of the 96 head coaches to coach at least one game in the league).

EZI NEARING STORM SINGLE-SEASON REBOUNDING RECORD

Ezi Magbegor has a total of 297 rebounds this season, averaging 8.0 boards per game, a pace which would give her 320 for the year. That would give her the single-season franchise record, moving past Breanna Stewart's record of 317 set in 2016. Magbegor broke into the top 10 on last week at Chicago and is the only player not named Stewart or Jackson to record at least 280 rebounds in a season for the Storm. Magbegor is just outside of the top 10 in rebounds per game with 8.0 with Natasha Howard at No. 10 with 8.2 per game.

JEWELL LOYD NEARING MAJOR MILESTONE

Jewell Loyd hit a pair of milestones in Thursday's win at LA, recording her 1,000th career rebound and 900th career assist. She is also just two three-pointers shy of 500 career treys. Once she hits that mark, Loyd will become just the eighth player in WNBA history to amass 4,500+ points, 1,000+ rebounds, 900+ assists, and 500+ three-pointers made. Loyd, who is 29 years and 332 days old today and playing in her 287th career game tonight, will also be the second-youngest player and do it in the second-fewest games, just behind Diana Taurasi in both.

GRABBING THOSE BOARDS

Over the last 11 games, the Storm is averaging a league best 39.2 rebounds per game (since 8/5), compared to just 33.8 rebounds per game over its first 26 games. The Storm is 9-9 when outrebounding its opponent, but is just 2-17 in games recording fewer rebounds than its opponent or when rebounds are tied. Seattle has recorded 40+ rebounds nine times this season with five of those coming over the last 11 games.

NOTES, STATS & TRENDS (Cont.)

HORSTON AMONG ELITE ROOKIES
Storm rookie **Jordan Horston** has filled the stat sheet in her rookie campaign, averaging 7.2 points, 5.2 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 1.3 steals and 0.6 blocks—one of nine players in the WNBA to post those numbers or better this year (five of whom played in the 2023 all-star game), and the only one in the group with fewer than 15 starts. In fact, she is one of just 11 players in WNBA history to post those numbers or better through their first 33 career games, and only the fourth since 2000, joining Tamika Catchings, Napheesa Collier, and Aliyah Boston.

MAGBEGOR PACING THE STORM DEFENSE IN 2023
Ezi Magbregor, who was a WNBA All-Defensive team pick in 2022, has been solid on the defensive end again this season, averaging 8.0 rebounds (6.4 on the defensive glass), 1.9 blocks, and 1.2 steals per game. That puts her in elite company as one just two players to have those numbers or better this season (along with last year's defensive player of the year A'ja Wilson). Magbregor has posted career-bests in total blocks (67), blocks (1.9 bpg), total rebounds (297), rebounds per game (8.1 rpg), and steals (1.2 spg), and has 3+ blocks in 11 games—2nd most in the league this year.

WHITCOMB CONTINUES TO SHINE
Over her last eighth games, **Sami Whitcomb** has averaged 13.3 points, 3.8 assists, and 3.0 made three-pointers per game, shooting 45.5% from the field and 44.4% from three-point range. Whitcomb, who has been a regular in the starting lineup over the last 15 games, has made 3+ 3pt FGs in eight of those 15 games, giving her a total of 13 such games this season. Whitcomb has made a least one three-pointer in 28-straight games, the second-longest active streak in the league, and the second-longest in her career. She previously made at least one three in 31-straight from Sept. 2, 2020 through Aug. 22, 2021.

EZI REACHES MILESTONE
Ezi Magbregor recorded her 100th career steal during Thursday's game in Indianapolis, making her the 61st WNBA player with 1,000+ points, 600+ rebounds, 150+ blocks, 150+ assists, & 100+ steals. Even more impressive, Magbregor is the third-youngest WNBA player (24y, 11d) to reach that milestone behind Lauren Jackson and Breanna Stewart, and reached it in the eighth-fewest games (119).

BOMBS AWAY!!
Seattle ranks third in the WNBA in three-pointers made (8.4/gm), third in three-pointers attempted (24.4/gm), while also ranking second in points from three-pointers (32.1%) and second in percentage of overall field goal attempts from beyond the arc (35.7%) this season. Thursday's game at Indiana marked the 13th time this season Seattle has connected on 10+ threes in a game. The Storm's 311 three-pointers this season ranks third in the league and is the ninth-most

in a season in WNBA history. Seattle set a franchise record with 333 triples last season, but the 2023 squad just needs to average 7.7 3pt FGM/gm over the final three games to beat it.

SEATTLE SUMMER BLOCK PARTY
The Storm has recorded 4.5 blocks per game, which is just shy of the franchise record of 4.7 per game set in 2002, and has set a franchise record this season with 167 total blocks. **Ezi Magbregor** leads the team and is second in the WNBA with 1.8 blocks per game and has 67 total blocks this year (the second-most in the league). She has posted 60+ blocks in consecutive seasons, joining fellow Aussie Lauren Jackson as the only players to do that in Storm history. She is also just one block shy of being the second player in franchise history to record 68+ blocks behind LJ's record 81 in 2002.

MAGBEGOR SURPASSES 1,000 CAREER POINTS
Ezi Magbregor poured in 14 points at Dallas on Aug. 2, pushing her over 1,000 career points. She became the 14th player to score 1,000 points in a Storm uniform, and the fifth-youngest at 23 years, 254 days old. That was the second major milestone she reached over a two game stretch, recording her 150th career block at Indiana in the previous game. Magbregor became the 66th WNBA player with 1,000 points and 150 blocks, but even more impressive, she is the fourth-youngest player to post those numbers behind Lauren Jackson, Tina Charles, and Breanna Stewart.

NOELLE QUINN

HEAD COACH

Noelle Quinn was named the Seattle Storm’s seventh head coach in franchise history on May 30, 2021 and made her head coaching debut on June 1, 2021, guiding the Storm to an 88-73 win over Indiana. Overall, Quinn has led Seattle to a 38-24 record through her first two seasons at the helm, including a pair of playoff appearances and a dominating 79-57 win over the Connecticut Sun in 2021 in the WNBA’s first Commissioner’s Cup Championship.

Quinn was named to the Storm coaching staff on Feb. 21, 2019 after retiring from the team, and was elevated to associate head coach on June 29, 2020. She holds the distinction of being the only person to win a WNBA Championship as both a player (2018 - SEA) and a coach (2020 - SEA, Assistant).

In her first season as head coach, Quinn led Seattle to a 21-11 overall record and the team’s sixth-straight playoff appearance. She started out her tenure as Head Coach on June 1, 2021, leading the Storm to seven wins over the team’s first eight games including five-straight on the road. Seattle closed out the season by winning three of its final four games to wrap up the fourth overall seed in the playoffs.

The 2022 season saw Quinn guide the Storm to another 20+ win season, the ninth in franchise history, finishing with a record of 22-14. Seattle again qualified for the playoffs as the fourth seed, marking the seventh-straight year in the postseason, sweeping the first-round series before falling in an epic semifinal battle. Under Quinn’s leadership, the Storm posted a league-best 36.1% three-point percentage and 82.5% free throw percentage and top three rankings in blocks (4.2 bpg), steals (8.3 spg), assists (22.6 apg), and points against (78.4 oppg).

Quinn joined the Storm coaching staff upon retirement after a successful 12-year WNBA career which included two separate stints with Seattle totaling five years and culminating in a WNBA title in 2018. Quinn was the #4 overall draft pick by Minnesota in 2007. She spent two seasons with the Lynx (2007-08), three with the San Antonio Stars (2009-11), one in Washington (2012), two in her first stop in Seattle (2013-14), and 1-1/2 years in Phoenix (2015-16) before being traded back to Seattle midway through 2016. She would retire following the 2018 season, finishing her career with 1,824 points, 1,011 rebounds, 878 assists and 256 steals in 382 career games.

Considered one of the best “all-around” players in UCLA women’s basketball history, Quinn was the first UCLA men’s or women’s basketball player to total 1,700 points, 700 rebounds and 400 assists in her career. She was inducted into the UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame in 2020 alongside the likes of Russell Westbrook and Kevin Love and was a three-time, first-team All-Pac-10 selection and honorable mention All-American in her time in Westwood.

Quinn is no stranger to being head coach. During her final three WNBA seasons, she served as girls’ head basketball coach at her alma mater Bishop Montgomery High School in Torrance, Calif. where she played from 1999-2003. In her first year coaching, she led the Lady Knights to the Southern Section state championship, and guided the team to the Del Rey League title the following year. Quinn already is the only player to have her number retired for Bishop Montgomery, where she won four high school basketball state championships and one volleyball title.

POKEY CHATMAN

ASSISTANT COACH

Chatman begins her second season as an assistant coach for the Storm, bringing over 20 years of coaching experience to the team. She most recently spent three seasons coaching the Indiana Fever after six seasons leading the Chicago Sky, posting an overall record of 134-172 record in the WNBA. In Chicago, Chatman guided the Sky to its first-ever playoff appearance in 2013 and to the WNBA finals in 2014. Prior to Chicago, Chatman spent four years at her alma mater LSU, guiding the Tigers to three-straight NCAA Final Four appearances, two SEC titles and an .847 winning percentage.

Chatman’s first foray into professional coaching came in 2007 when she served as an assistant coach for Club Spartak Moscow Region. After being elevated to head coach in 2009-10, Chatman’s squad—which featured Sue Bird at the point—recorded its fourth-straight EuroLeague Championship with a perfect 16-0 record. In 2010-11, Spartak again reached the EuroLeague Final, this time with Quinn on the squad along with Bird.

Playing for the legendary Sue Gunter from 1987-91, Chatman led LSU to the 1991 SEC tourney championship as a senior, earning tournament MVP honors after scoring 30 points—including 16-straight at one point—in the Tigers 80-75 win over Tennessee. Chatman still is the school’s record-holder in career steals (346), and she owned the LSU assists standard for 14 seasons before she watched it fall while patrolling the sidelines. The Louisiana native ushered in the three-point era at LSU by pacing the Lady Tigers in three-point percentage in each of four seasons and led the SEC in three-point field goals made as a junior and senior.

Chatman, who was born in Ama, Louisiana, was a point guard at Hahnville High School and was a five-time AAU All-American. She holds an impressive claim to fame, hitting the first three-pointer in a high school game in Louisiana.

EBONY HOFFMAN

ASSISTANT COACH

Hoffman is in her second season on the Storm coaching staff. Hoffman played 11 seasons in the WNBA with Indiana, Los Angeles, and Connecticut, including the 2011 season in LA with Noelle Quinn. Her best season came in 2008 in Indiana when she earned Most Improved Player after averaging 10.4 points, 7.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.4 steals and 0.8 blocks per game for the Fever.

After retiring from the league, Hoffman has worked in various coaching positions, serving the 2021-22 season as a coaching consultant with Raptors 905 of the NBA G-League. In addition, she has worked within the NBA Academy and in 2021 was named an assistant coach for the South Sudan women’s national team.



Hoffman was a two-time All-American honorable mention and three-time First Team All-Pac-10 pick at USC from 2001-04. She wrapped up her career ranked No. 8 on the Trojan’s all-time scoring list with 1,687 points and No. 7 in rebounds with 1,003.

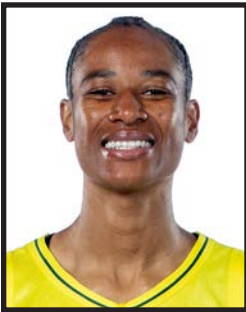
