## THE LATEST ON THE SUN STORY LINES

### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE DREAM

Connecticut's last meeting with Atlanta came on July 7 in Uncasville. The Sun defeated the Dream, 80-67, improving to 2-1 in the 2024 regular season series. DeWanna Bonner led the way with 23 points, nailing a career-high seven three-point field goals in the win. Connecticut enters Sunday's contest winning seven straight games against the Dream when playing in Atlanta.

### MAKING MOVES

On July 17, the Sun acquired veteran guard **Marina Mabrey** in a trade with the Sky, sending guards Rachel Banham and Moriah Jefferson to Chicago. Additionally, the Sun sent their 2025 first round pick and rights to swap 2026 first round picks (PHO's 2026 first round pick acquired by CHI prior to the 2024 season for CON's 2026 first round pick) to the Sky and received the Sky's 2025 second round pick. Through 24 games with the Sky this season, Mabrey averaged 14.0 points, 4.9 rebounds, 4.5 assists (team-high) and 1.2 steals per contest. On July 20, the Sun signed forward **Caitlin Bickle** to a seven-day contract (to end August 21). Bickle, a 6-1 forward out of Baylor University, previously signed a training camp contract with Connecticut prior to the 2023 season. Rookie guard **Celeste Taylor** signed a seven-day contract with the Sun on August 16. She was drafted 15th overall by the Fever and also spent time with the Mercury this season.

### OLYMPIC RECAP

The Connecticut Sun organization was well represented at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, headlined by Sun forward **Alyssa Thomas** who earned gold with the USA Basketball Women's National Team on Sunday, defeating France, 67-66. Thomas, making her Olympic debut, helped Team USA to their eighth consecutive Olympic gold medal, as the team went 6-0 through group play and the knockout stages. She averaged 3.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 3.5 assists in 17.4 minutes per contest, seeing action in all six games throughout the tournament. Thomas joins Tina Charles and Asjha Jones as the only three players in franchise history to win gold at the Olympics with Team USA. Connecticut Sun President

Sun President **Jen Rizzotti** led the USA 3x3 Women's National Team to a bronze medal, serving as the team's head coach in Paris. Sun Assistant Coach **Abi Olajuwon** served as an assistant coach with the Nigeria Basketball Women's National Team at the Olympics and helped lead the team to the quarterfinal round. **Leila Lacan**, selected No. 10 overall by the Connecticut Sun in the 2024 WNBA Draft, earned a silver medal with the French Women's National Team in her Olympic debut.

### WNBA ALL-STAR RECAP

The Connecticut Sun were well represented at the 2024 WNBA All-Star weekend in Phoenix. **Alyssa Thomas** and the Team USA All-Stars took on **DeWanna Bonner, Brionna Jones** and the Team WNBA All-Stars on Saturday, July 20. Team WNBA came away with the 117-109 win over Team USA after a highly competitive, back-and-forth match up. Newly acquired guard **Marina Mabrey** donned her Sun uniform for the first time, as she represented Connecticut in both the Kia Skills Challenge and Starry Three-Point Competition.

### ROAD TRIPPING IN AUGUST

The Sun return to action after the WNBA All-Star and Olympic break on August 16 against the Dallas Wings in Texas. Five of the Sun's seven games in August will be away contests. The Sun will play just one game at Mohegan Sun Arena in Connecticut in August, with their other home game coming on August 20 at Boston's TD Garden. The team currently boasts an 8-3 road record good for second in league standings.

### SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON

For the first time in league history, Boston, Massachusetts will be the location of a WNBA regular season contest, as the Connecticut Sun host the Los Angeles Sparks at TD Garden, home of the Boston Celtics and Boston Bruins, on August 20, 2024.

The game in Boston comes from the organization's desire to give access to the Connecticut Sun brand to a larger swath of New England, giving an in-person experience to the loyal and passionate New England fans that live closer to the Boston area and generating more excitement around the WNBA in an area well-known for its sports fanaticism.

### MAKING A CASE FOR MOST IMPROVED

**DiJonai Carrington** has started in every game for the Sun in 2024, and is putting up numbers that make her one of the leading candidates for the WNBA's Most Improved honor. She is averaging career-highs in scoring (12.9), rebounding (5.2), assists (1.8), steals (1.2) and blocks (0.4) per game, has led the team in scoring in two outings, finished in double-figures in 16 of the Sun's 24 games and is the team's third-leading scorer.

### ALYSSA'S ASSISTS

After setting a new WNBA single-season assist record a season ago (316), Sun forward **Alyssa Thomas** has continued to rack up the assists in 2024. She is currently second in the league in assists per game (7.8), has led the team in assists on 23 occasions and has dished out 7+ assists on 16 occasions (tied for most in the WNBA-Caitlin Clark).

## THE LATEST ON THE SUN STORY LINES

### TY STEPPING UP

Fifth-year guard **Ty Harris** is enjoying a career season of her own, averaging career-bests in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals per game. She's finished in double-figures 16 times this season and set a new career-highs in scoring (23- 6/27 at WAS), rebounding (7- 7/14 vs. PHO), field goals made (9- 6/27 vs. WAS) and minutes played (38- 6/8 vs. NYL). She also has made at least one three-point field goal in 20 games this season (team-high).

### MILESTONES ON THE HORIZON FOR THE VET

The 2024 season will be **DeWanna Bonner's** 15th season in the WNBA. Other than Diana Taurasi (2004), no active player has played longer in the WNBA than Bonner. With 486 games under her belt, Bonner has climbed closer to the top of the league record books over recent seasons. She is currently:

- **17** rebounds away from **3,000** rebounds
- **43** three-point field goals away from **7th** all-time in WNBA history.
- **69** points away from **4th** all-time in WNBA history.
- **29** rebounds away from **9th** all-time in WNBA history.

### TRIPLE-DOUBLE THOMAS

A season ago, **Alyssa Thomas** moved into first all-time in regular season triple-doubles in WNBA history and she continues to add to her league-leading total in 2024. In the Sun's season opener against Indiana, Thomas recorded her ninth regular season triple-double with 13 points, 10 rebounds and 13 assists. She recorded her 10th career regular season triple-double in the Sun's 78-73 road win over the Minnesota Lynx with 13 points, 10 rebounds and 14 assists. It marked Thomas' 4th triple-double against the Lynx in her career.

### DEFENSIVE MINDSET

The Connecticut Sun is known for its defensive prowess, holding their opponents to a league-low 73.6 points per game, 27.0 field goals per game and 7.2 offensive rebounds per game. The Sun hold three of the bottom four opponent points in a single game this season, holding the Mercury to a league-wide season low 47 points on May 28, the Dream to 50 points on June 2 and Mystics to 59 points on June 4.

## STEPHANIE WHITE

### HEAD COACH

Stephanie White was named the head coach of the Connecticut Sun on November 21, 2022; becoming the franchise's sixth head coach. White, an Indiana native, brings a wealth of basketball knowledge to Connecticut, having enjoyed great success at every level of the game as a player, coach and television analyst.

In her first season in Connecticut in 2023, White guided the Sun to a 27-13 record, setting a new franchise record for victories in a single season. She was awarded for her success, being named the 2023 WNBA Coach of the Year and Associated Press Coach of the Year. White also was named WNBA Coach of the Month for May, after leading the team to a 4-1 record, marking the best start by a Sun head coach in their debut season. The Indiana native earned a spot as a head coach in the 2023 AT&T WNBA All-Star Game after guiding the Sun to the second-best record (12-4) in the league through June. At the All-Star Game in Las Vegas, White led Team Stewart to a 143-127 victory over Team Wilson. She also led the Sun to their seventh consecutive playoff appearance and fifth consecutive WNBA Semifinals.

White has a combined 16 seasons of experience as a player and coach in the WNBA. Prior to Connecticut, she spent two seasons as the head coach of the Indiana Fever (2015,2016), compiling an overall record of 37-31 and a playoff record of 6-6, including a trip to the 2015 WNBA Finals and a 2016 postseason berth. Prior to becoming a head coach for the Fever, White spent four seasons as an assistant coach (2011-2014), most notably helping lead Indiana to their first WNBA Championship in 2012.

Prior to her time with the Fever, White was an assistant coach with the Chicago Sky from 2007-2010. She has also served as an assistant coach at the collegiate level at Toledo (2005-2007), Kansas State (2004-2005) and Ball State (2003-2004). Her most recent coaching stint was from 2016-2021, where she spent five seasons as the Head Coach of Vanderbilt University women's basketball team. At Vanderbilt, White played a crucial role in rebuilding the young program she inherited, where she coached five players to the SEC All-Freshman team [2017 (2), 2018, 2019, 2020], a player to the 2019 Second-Team All-SEC and a player to the 2020 SEC All-Defensive Team.

As a player, White played five seasons in the WNBA. She was drafted with the 21st overall pick in the 1999 WNBA draft by the Charlotte Sting, where she played her rookie season in the league. In 2000, White was acquired by the Indiana Fever in the franchise's inaugural season. After four seasons with the Fever, she currently sits 19th in games played (112) and 14th in assists (225), steals (115) and three-point field goals made (92).

White also had a standout collegiate career, playing four seasons for Purdue from 1995-1999. During her senior campaign, she led the Boilermakers to the 1999 NCAA National Championship, while also picking up Big Ten Conference Player of the Year and Wade Trophy honors. At Purdue, White amassed 2,182 career points and was inducted into the Purdue Athletics Hall of Fame in 2006.

Off the hardwood, White has served as a college basketball analyst for ESPN and the Big Ten Network since 2007. She has appeared both in-studio and on the sidelines as an analyst, most notably co-hosting the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament for many seasons. White has also worked as an Indiana Pacers Reporter for FOX Sports Indiana.
