### STORM WATCH

- Seattle opens the second half of the season with a three-game road trip, starting Friday night in Atlanta. The Storm faces the Dream in the second time in three games (albeit with a 32-day gap in between) after Seattle beat Atlanta 81-70 on July 14 in Washington.
- The Storm sits tied for third in the WNBA standings at 17-8 after going 8-2 over its final 10 games before the break. Seattle is four games behind league-leading New York and 1-1/2 back of Connecticut.
- Defense has been the name of the game for the Storm through its first 25 games, with Seattle leading the league in blocks (5.6 bpg), steals (9.7 spg), and ranking third in defensive rating (94.0), just 0.3 points behind the league leader.
- Tonight's game starts a busy stretch for the Storm which has 15 games left on the schedule and will play those games over the course of the next 35 days. That includes playing its final 12 games over 25 days, playing every other day save one stretch of off days between Sept. 8-10. Overall, Seattle plays most of its games on the road with nine of those last 15 games coming away from home.

**PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS/NOTES:** For the first time in Storm history two players shot over 70% in a game while attempting 11+ shots as **Ezi Magbegor** (18 points) and **Jordan Horston** (16 points) each shot 8-of-11 from the field. Add in that each had 2+ blocks in the game and they became just the second teammates in WNBA history to shoot 70%+ on 11+ shots with 2+ blocks in a regulation game (Dupree, Griner; 6/3/14) ... Magbegor finished with 18 points in the game with five rebounds and three blocks, shooting better than 70% while attempting 10 or field goals for the first time in her career ... Horston recorded her eighth double-digit scoring game this season with 16 points, five rebounds, three steals, and two blocks ... **Nneka Ogumike** earned her sixth double-double of 2024 with 10 points and 12 rebounds, adding four assists, three steals, and two blocks ... **Jewell Lloyd** scored 14 points and a season-high seven assists as she passed Atlanta Dream head coach Tanisha Wright for second most in Storm history.

**NOTES:** Seattle used a late 13-2 run to pull away in a competitive battle on Sunday afternoon, beating the Atlanta Dream 81-70 in the first meeting between the teams this season ... the Storm improved to 11-3 at home this season and closed out its WNBA record nine-game home stand at 7-2 ... Seattle had 27 assists on 30 field goals, a 90% assist rate, just the fourth time posting a 90%+ assist rate in franchise history and the first time since 2022 ... Seattle had five players in double-digits for the second consecutive game and the ninth time this season.

**PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS/NOTES:** **Jewell Lloyd** scored 26 points, marking her 19th game with 25+ points in 2023, the second most in a single season all-time. Her ninth point at the 4:18 mark in the second quarter gave her 861 in the season, moving her past Diana Taurasi into second on the WNBA single season scoring list. She finished the game with 878 points this season, seven points shy of tying Breanna Stewart's current record of 885 points this season ... **Sami Whitcomb** finished with 13 points, marking her 13th game in double-digits over 18 games since the All-Star break. She connected on three three-pointers, her ninth game with three or more from beyond the arc over her last 18 games ... **Ezi Magbegor** tallied 12 points, eight rebounds, four assists and tied a season-high with four blocks. It was her 32nd game in double digits this year. Magbegor has had 61 games with 10+ points in her career, with over half of those coming this season. She also now has 71 blocks on the season, the second-most in franchise history.

**NOTES:** After a back and forth opening 17 minutes, the Dream used a 14-4 run to take an 47-40 lead at the break and didn't look back as the Storm fell 79-68 in Atlanta ... Atlanta outscored Seattle in the paint, 44-22, with the Dream's 44 points accounting for over half of Atlanta's points in the game ... Seattle held Atlanta to 79 points and has now limited its opponents to 81 points or less ten times in the last 15 games.

**PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS/NOTES:** **Jewell Lloyd's** bucket and free throw with :13.8 seconds left gave Seattle the lead for good as the Storm overcame a 15-point, fourth quarter deficit to pull out a 68-67 win over Atlanta ... Lloyd and **Ezi Magbegor** combined for 18 of the Storm's 21 fourth-quarter points and poured in 27 combined points in the second half ... Lloyd finished with 19 points including seven in the final three minutes of the game. Lloyd was two rebounds shy of a double-double, finishing with eight boards while adding one assist and one steal ... Magbegor recorded her eighth double-double of the season and 11th of her career with 17 points and 11 rebounds, supplemented by two assists, two blocks and one steal ... **Sami Whitcomb** was the third Storm player in double figures with 11 points, sealing the game with two free throws with :05.5 left. Whitcomb added six rebounds, five assists, two steals and one block.

**NOTES:** The Dream held its largest lead of the game at 56-40 at the 1:52 mark of the third quarter, but Seattle proceeded to outscore Atlanta 28-11 over the rest of the game including a 16-0 run in the fourth quarter ... In the pivotal fourth quarter, Seattle held the Dream to 3-of-17 shooting and a season-low seven points in a quarter. The Storm hit just 5-of-13 from the field in the fourth, but connected on 10-of-12 from the free throw line to outscore Atlanta 21-7.

NOTES, STATS & TRENDS

STORM HEADS TO ATLANTA TO START THREE-GAME ROAD TRIP

Seattle returns to action after a month off for the All-Star and Olympic break, beginning a three-game road trip by visiting Atlanta on Friday at 7 p.m. ET (4 p.m. PT). This is the second time in the last three games the Storm face off with the Dream after winning 81-70 on July 14 in Seattle.

HISTORY vs ATLANTA

The Storm holds a commanding lead in the all-time series at 23-17 and has won 10 of the last 13 games between the two overall. Over the last two seasons, the records have been a bit closer with Seattle holding a slight 4-3 lead thanks to its 81-70 win in Seattle earlier this season. The Storm has struggled in Atlanta, holding an 8-12 all-time record and has lost its last three games in Georgia with its last wins coming during the 2021 season.

OLYMPIC RECAP

The Storm was well represented at the 2024 Paris Olympics with three players and a coach participating. **Jewell Loyd** took home her second-straight Gold Medal as the United States narrowly edged France in the final on Aug. 11. Earlier that day, **Ezi Magbegor** and **Sami Whitcomb** helped Australia earn the Bronze Medal with an impressive win over Belgium. Magbegor came up huge in the game finishing with 30 points and 13 rebounds and earned a spot on the Paris 2024 All-Second Team. Storm Head Coach **Noelle Quinn** also made her Olympic debut, serving as Assistant Coach for the Canadian Team.

LOTS OF GAMES IN A SHORT AMOUNT OF TIME TO CLOSE OUT THE SEASON

The Storm has 15 games left on the schedule and will play those games over the course of the next 35 days. Seattle starts with three games on the road, before returning home for five days off—its longest stretch without a game outside of the Olympic Break this season. After that? The Storm plays its final 12 games over 25 days, playing every other day save one stretch of off days between Sept. 8-10. Overall, Seattle plays most of its games on the road with nine of those last 15 games coming away from home.

RECORD THROUGH 25 GAMES

Seattle enters the second half of the season with an 17-8 record. That marks its fourth-best record through 25 games in franchise history. The team's best record after 25 games was 22-3 in 2010 en route to finishing 28-6 and winning the WNBA Championship. The Storm has twice posted an 18-7 mark through 25 games, once in 2018 prior to another WNBA Championship, and again in 2021.

PLAYOFF PICTURE

As we head down the home stretch, the Storm is closing in on clinching a playoff spot, its 19th in 25 seasons as a franchise. Seattle currently sits tied for third with Minnesota, four games back of league-leading New York and 1-1/2 behind Connecticut.

STEADY FROM THE FREE THROW LINE

The Storm ranks second in the league in free throw shooting at 83.2% which would be the third-best mark in franchise history, percentage points behind the franchise record of 83.9% set in 2021. **Jewell Loyd** leads the WNBA averaging 7.3 free throw attempts per game and 11th in free throw percentage at 86.9%. **Ezi Magbegor** ranks fifth in the league at 89.5% hitting 68-of-76 on the season. That's a marked improvement from Magbegor, who came into the season with a career mark of 73.1% from the line.

HOME VS ROAD STATS?

With the Storm playing nine of its final 15 games on the road including its next three, it is worth taking a look at the team's stats at home vs on the road this season:

SUCCESS vs THE EASTERN CONFERENCE

The Storm has done well against the Eastern Conference this season, going 9-2 vs the East compared to just 8-6 against the West. The overall numbers have been much better against the East which is key considering the Storm plays nine-straight vs Eastern Conference teams before closing out the season with six-straight vs the West.

DEFENSE IS THE NAME OF THE GAME

The Storm has held opponents under 80 in seven of its last 10 games, including three to 70 or fewer. Seattle's defense ranks first in blocks per game (5.6 bpg) and steals (9.7 spg), tied for second in opponent FG% (41.6%), third in defensive rating (94.0), and fourth in opponent scoring (77.6 ppg). Individually, Seattle has four of the top 10 players in defensive win shares: **Ezi Magbegor** (2nd, .224), **Jewell Loyd** (T-4th, .217), **Skylar Diggins-Smith** (6th, .212) and **Nneka Ogumike** (7th, .207). Over her last 13 games, **Jordan Horston** has moved from 51st to 26th at .139.

RACKING UP THE STEALS

The Storm leads the WNBA with 9.6 steals per game, and has 10+ steals in eight of its last 12 games, and 13 games overall this year, the most in the WNBA (four more than the next closest team). Overall the Storm has five players ranked in the top 20 in steals: **Nneka Ogumike** is fifth (1.9 spg), **Jordan Horston** ranks 11th (1.6 spg), **Skylar Diggins-Smith** is 13th (1.5 spg), while **Jewell Loyd** and **Ezi Magbegor** are tied for 18th (1.4 spg). Ogumike recorded six steals in the last game before the break at Los Angeles on July 16, tied for the second-most in a game in franchise history.

HITTING FROM DOWNTOWN = VICTORY

The Storm has been a force to be reckoned with in the paint this season, averaging 41.0 points in the paint—the 2nd-best mark in the league—accounting for 48.6% of its total scoring. However, the Seattle's success seems to be how well it shoots from the outside. Overall, Seattle is 14-0 when shooting over 25% from three-point range this season, and is 9-0 when making at least seven three pointers in a game (12-1 when making at least six).

THE STORM CONTINUES TO MOVE THE BALL WELL ...

Seattle had 27 assists on 30 made field goals on July 14 vs Atlanta, recording a season-high assist rate of 90.0%. It was the sixth time in the last 10 games the Storm has posted an assisted shot rate of 80.0% or better. The Storm has recorded 20+ assists in 12 of its last 14 games after doing so just four times through its first 11. In 13 games since June 13, the Storm ranks third in the league with 23.3 assists per game and has an assisted shot rate of 75.2%, after averaging a league-worst 17.6 apg and a 60.3% rate in 12 games prior. Overall the Storm ranks fourth at 21.0 assists per game and is 14-2 in games when recording 20+ assists.

... AND IS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL TOO

The Storm has committed 15 or fewer turnovers in each of its last 18 games, the longest streak in franchise history, the longest active streak in the WNBA, and the fourth longest streak in league history. Over that record stretch, Seattle's 12.4 turnovers per game are the second fewest in the league. Overall, the Storm is tied for fourth in turnovers at 13.9 per game, tied for third in turnover percentage (TOV%) at 16.9% (a stat which measures the percentage of offensive possessions which end in a turnover).

WELL, THAT WAS A LOT OF HOME GAMES ... AMIRITE??

Seattle concluded a WNBA-record nine-game homestand on July 14, a homestand which represented nearly half of Seattle's 20-game home schedule. The Storm finished with a 7-2 mark over those nine games with the seven wins standing as the most in a single home stand in WNBA history. The previous WNBA record home stand was eight-straight games shared by three teams including Seattle, as the Storm played eight-straight at home May 14-June 7, 2022. After Sunday's game, the Storm have played 14 of its 20 home games, with 10 of its final 16 games of the year on the road. Here is a look at how the Storm looked over its homestand:

BATTLE FOR THE BOARDS

The Storm has posted some solid rebounding numbers this season, averaging 36.0 rebounds per game—second-most in the league—with its 900 total rebounds the most overall. Seattle's franchise record is 36.3 rpg set in 2010 with its second-best mark coming in 2018 at 35.6 rpg. (You may remember the Storm won the WNBA championship in both seasons.) Leading the way has been **Ezi Magbegor** and **Nneka Ogumike**, who have combined to average 16.4 rpg this season with Magbegor at 8.7 rpg (8th-best in the WNBA) and Ogumike at 7.7 rpg (12th-best in the league).

MAGBEGOR AN EARLY DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR CANDIDATE

**Ezi Magbegor** continues to be one of the league's top defensive players, ranking among the league leaders in several defensive categories: second in blocks (2.4 bpg), 2nd in defensive win shares (.224), 2nd in defensive rating (90.9), T-3rd in offensive rebounds (2.9 oprg), T-7th in efficiency (21.0), T-8th in rebounds (8.7 rpg), and T-13th in steals (1.4 spg).

HORSTON RED HOT TO CLOSE OUT FIRST HALF

**Jordan Horston** closed out the first half of the season with a pair of impressive performances, averaging 15.0 points over her final two games while shooting 66.7% from the field. Against Atlanta on July 14, Horston scored 16 points on 8-of-11 shooting, adding five rebounds, two blocks, three steals and three assists. She followed that up with eight rebounds, two blocks, and an assist at Los Angeles on July 16. Horston now returns to Atlanta where she had one of the best games of her career, scoring 23 points with 10 rebounds on July 12, 2023, in her 17th career game.

MAGBEGOR'S BLOCK PARTY SETTING RECORDS

**Ezi Magbegor** had an impressive game on July 5 vs Chicago, blocking a career-high eight shots, becoming just the 12th player in WNBA history to record 8+ blocks in a game and the first since Elizabeth Williams on Sept. 5, 2019. Magbegor ranks second in the W in total blocks with 61, and in blocks per game (2.4), recording at least two blocks in 18 of 25 games this year.

TAKE IT EASY ON JEWELL, EH?

**Jewell Loyd** ranks second in the WNBA in fouls drawn at 6.0 per game, which has translated into 183 trips to the free throw line this season—or 7.3 per game—all of which lead the league. The good news is she has converted a league-high 159 of those attempts from the charity stripe (an 86.9% free throw percentage), with 31.6% of her total points coming from the charity stripe. Last season, Loyd was fouled 6.8 times a game and averaged 7.5 free throws per game, both league-highs. She finished the season shooting 88.8% from the line scoring 254 of her WNBA-record 939 points from the charity stripe.

**NOTES:** Seattle's offense tallied 91 points while the defense held Minnesota to a season-low 63 as the Storm decimated the Lynx 91-63 to improve to 6-2 through eight games of its WNBA-record nine-game homestand ... the Storm broke a 22-22 tie near the end of the first quarter with a 14-0 scoring run, starting with a Sami Whitcomb three-pointer with five seconds left in the first and running through the first five minutes of the second half ... the Storm tied a season-high with 29 assists on 33 made field goals for an 87.9 assist percentage, its ninth-best in franchise history and highest since May 20, 2022.

# NOELLE QUINN

HEAD COACH

Noelle Quinn was named the Seattle Storm’s seventh head coach in franchise history on May 30, 2021 and made her head coaching debut on June 1, 2021, guiding the Storm to an 88-73 win over Indiana. Overall, Quinn led Seattle to a 49-53 record through her first three seasons at the helm, including a pair of playoff appearances and a dominating 79-57 win over the Connecticut Sun in 2021 in the WNBA’s first Commissioner’s Cup Championship. She entered the 2024 season one win shy of becoming just the third Storm head coach to win 50 or more games.

Quinn was named to the Storm coaching staff on Feb. 21, 2019 after retiring from the team, and was elevated to associate head coach on June 29, 2020. She holds the distinction of being the only person to win a WNBA Championship as both a player (2018 - SEA) and a coach (2020 - SEA, Assistant).

In her first season as head coach, Quinn led Seattle to a 21-11 overall record and the team’s sixth-straight playoff appearance. She started out her tenure as Head Coach on June 1, 2021, leading the Storm to seven wins over the team’s first eight games including five-straight on the road. Seattle closed out the season by winning three of its final four games to wrap up the fourth overall seed in the playoffs.

The 2022 season saw Quinn guide the Storm to another 20+ win season, the ninth in franchise history, finishing with a record of 22-14. Seattle again qualified for the playoffs as the fourth seed, marking the seventh-straight year in the postseason, sweeping the first-round series before falling in an epic semifinal battle. Under Quinn’s leadership, the Storm posted a league-best 36.1% three-point percentage and 82.5% free throw percentage and top three rankings in blocks (4.2 bpg), steals (8.3 spg), assists (22.6 apg), and points against (78.4 oppg).

Quinn led Seattle through a rebuilding season in 2023 which saw the team post an 11-29 record. The Storm relied heavily on youth as the team was one of the youngest in the league with Quinn leading a team which regularly saw a franchise record four rookies make the roster and see significant time during the season. One of those rookies—Jordan Horston—earned All-Rookie Team honors, just the fourth Storm player to be named to the team.

Quinn joined the Storm coaching staff upon retirement after a successful 12-year WNBA career which included two separate stints with Seattle totaling five years and culminating in a WNBA title in 2018. Quinn was the #4 overall draft pick by Minnesota in 2007. She spent two seasons with the Lynx (2007-08), three with the San Antonio Stars (2009-11), one in Washington (2012), two in her first stop in Seattle (2013-14), and 1-1/2 years in Phoenix (2015-16) before being traded back to Seattle midway through 2016. She would retire following the 2018 season, finishing her career with 1,824 points, 1,011 rebounds, 878 assists and 256 steals in 382 career games.

Considered one of the best “all-around” players in UCLA women’s basketball history, Quinn was the first UCLA men’s or women’s basketball player to total 1,700 points, 700 rebounds and 400 assists in her career. She was inducted into the UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame in 2020 alongside the likes of Russell Westbrook and Kevin Love and was a three-time, first-team All-Pac-10 selection and honorable mention All-American in her time in Westwood.

Quinn is no stranger to being head coach. During her final three WNBA seasons, she served as girls’ head basketball coach at her alma mater Bishop Montgomery High School in Torrance, Calif. where she played from 1999-2003. In her first year coaching, she led the Lady Knights to the Southern Section state championship, and guided the team to the Del Rey League title the following year. Quinn already is the only player to have her number retired for Bishop Montgomery, where she won four high school basketball state championships and one volleyball title.

# POKEY CHATMAN

ASSISTANT COACH/ASSOCIATE GENERAL MANAGER

Chatman begins her third season as an assistant coach and her first as associate general manager for the Storm, bringing over 20 years of coaching experience to the team. She most recently spent three seasons coaching the Indiana Fever after six seasons leading the Chicago Sky, posting an overall record of 134-172 record in the WNBA. In Chicago, Chatman guided the Sky to its first-ever playoff appearance in 2013 and to the WNBA finals in 2014. Prior to Chicago, Chatman spent four years at her alma mater LSU, guiding the Tigers to three-straight NCAA Final Four appearances, two SEC titles and an .847 winning percentage.

Chatman's first foray into professional coaching came in 2007 when she served as an assistant coach for Club Spartak Moscow Region. After being elevated to head coach in 2009-10, Chatman's squad—which featured Sue Bird at the point—recorded its fourth-straight EuroLeague Championship with a perfect 16-0 record. In 2010-11, Spartak again reached the EuroLeague Final, this time with Quinn on the squad along with Bird.

Playing for the legendary Sue Gunter from 1987-91, Chatman led LSU to the 1991 SEC tourney championship as a senior, earning tournament MVP honors after scoring 30 points—including 16-straight at one point—in the Tigers 80-75 win over Tennessee. Chatman still is the school's record-holder in career steals (346), and she owned the LSU assists standard for 14 seasons before she watched it fall while patrolling the sidelines. The Louisiana native ushered in the three-point era at LSU by pacing the Lady Tigers in three-point percentage in each of four seasons and led the SEC in three-point field goals made as a junior and senior.

Chatman, who was born in Ama, Louisiana, was a point guard at Hahnville High School and was a five-time AAU All-American. She holds an impressive claim to fame, hitting the first three-pointer in a high school game in Louisiana.

# EBONY HOFFMAN

ASSISTANT COACH

Hoffman is in her third season on the Storm coaching staff. Hoffman played 11 seasons in the WNBA with Indiana, Los Angeles, and Connecticut, including the 2011 season in LA with Noelle Quinn. Her best season came in 2008 in Indiana when she earned Most Improved Player after averaging 10.4 points, 7.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.4 steals and 0.8 blocks per game for the Fever.

After retiring from the league, Hoffman has worked in various coaching positions, serving the 2021-22 season as a coaching consultant with Raptors 905 of the NBA G-League. In addition, she has worked within the NBA Academy and in 2021 was named an assistant coach for the South Sudan women's national team.



Hoffman was a two-time All-American honorable mention and three-time First Team All-Pac-10 pick at USC from 2001-04. She wrapped up her career ranked No. 8 on the Trojan's all-time scoring list with 1,687 points and No. 7 in rebounds with 1,003.

Huang was elevated to assistant coach in 2021 after joining the franchise in 2018 as video coordinator.
