STORM WATCH

- Seattle hosts the Atlanta Dream tonight in the third and final game of the regular season series between the teams. Each has successfully defended its home court in the previous two meetings with the Storm winning 81-70 on July 14 in Seattle and the Dream winning 83-81 in Atlanta on August 16.
- Seattle leads the all-time series vs Atlanta 23-18 including a 15-5 record at home. The Storm has won seven-straight home games vs Atlanta with its last home loss a 77-66 defeat on July 5, 2019.
- This season, **Nneka Ogumike** is shooting 51.0% from the field, 43.4% from three-point range, and 85.9% from the free throw line. Among WNBA qualifiers, she ranks 11th in FG%, T-4th in 3pt FG%, and 14th in FT%, making her the only player in the league to rank in the top 15 in all three categories.
- Skylar Diggins-Smith's** is averaging 6.4 assists per game this season, the fourth-highest total in franchise history. Entering the season, Sue Bird, the WNBA's all-time assist leader, had the top nine APG season marks in Storm history. Diggins-Smith is also just 36 assists behind Bird's single-season franchise record of 221 done twice (2003, 2018).

PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS/NOTES: Skylar Diggins-Smith led the Seattle offense with a season-high 29 points, including 17 in the first half, to go along with five assists. It was her most points since July 22, 2022 (career-high 35) ... Jewell Loyd added 21 points, including a three to tie the game in the final 4.6 seconds, to go along with five rebounds and two steals ... Nneka Ogumike finished with 16 points and six rebounds, including three on the offensive end to move her past Delisha Milton-Jones and Candice Dupree for 12th on the WNBA's all-time offensive rebound list.

NOTES: Jewell Loyd drained a huge three-pointer with 4.6 seconds left to tie the game, but Tina Charles hit a jump shot with 1.8 seconds left to give Atlanta an 83-81 win ... It was a tale of two halves in the game as Seattle shot 50% (18-of-36) in the first half, outscoring Atlanta 41-29. However, in the second, the Storm shot 42.4% (14-of-33) while the Dream hit 60% (18-of-30), outscoring Seattle 54-40 over the final 20 minutes ... the Storm converted 20 Atlanta turnovers into a season-high 28 points as Seattle also extended its streak with 15 or fewer turnovers to 19, the fifth longest streak in WNBA history.

PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS/NOTES: For the first time in Storm history two players shot over 70% in a game while attempting 11+ shots as Ezi Magbegor (18 points) and Jordan Horston (16 points) each shot 8-of-11 from the field. Add in that each had 2+ blocks in the game and they became just the second teammates in WNBA history to shoot 70%+ on 11+ shots with 2+ blocks in a regulation game (Dupree, Griner; 6/3/14) ... Magbegor finished with 18 points in the game with five rebounds and three blocks, shooting better than 70% while attempting 10 or field goals for the first time in her career ... Horston recorded her eighth double-digit scoring game this season with 16 points, five rebounds, three steals, and two blocks ... Nneka Ogumike earned her sixth double-double of 2024 with 10 points and 12 rebounds, adding four assists, three steals, and two blocks ... Jewell Loyd scored 14 points and a season-high seven assists as she passed Atlanta Dream head coach Tanisha Wright for second most in Storm history.

NOTES: Seattle used a late 13-2 run to pull away in a competitive battle on Sunday afternoon, beating the Atlanta Dream 81-70 in the first meeting between the teams this season ... the Storm improved to 11-3 at home this season and closed out its WNBA record nine-game home stand at 7-2 ... Seattle had 27 assists on 30 field goals, a 90% assist rate, just the fourth time posting a 90%+ assist rate in franchise history and the first time since 2022 ... Seattle had five players in double-digits for the second consecutive game and the ninth time this season.

PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS/NOTES: Jewell Loyd scored 26 points, marking her 19th game with 25+ points in 2023, the second most in a single season all-time. Her ninth point at the 4:18 mark in the second quarter gave her 861 in the season, moving her past Diana Taurasi into second on the WNBA single season scoring list. She finished the game with 878 points this season, seven points shy of tying Breanna Stewart's current record of 885 points this season ... Sami Whitcomb finished with 13 points, marking her 13th game in double-digits over 18 games since the All-Star break. She connected on three three-pointers, her ninth game with three or more from beyond the arc over her last 18 games ... Ezi Magbegor tallied 12 points, eight rebounds, four assists and tied a season-high with four blocks. It was her 32nd game in double digits this year. Magbegor has had 61 games with 10+ points in her career, with over half of those coming this season. She also now has 71 blocks on the season, the second-most in franchise history.

NOTES: After a back and forth opening 17 minutes, the Dream used a 14-4 run to take an 47-40 lead at the break and didn't look back as the Storm fell 79-68 in Atlanta ... Atlanta outscored Seattle in the paint, 44-22, with the Dream's 44 points accounting for over half of Atlanta's points in the game ... Seattle held Atlanta to 79 points and has now limited its opponents to 81 points or less ten times in the last 15 games.

STORM HOSTS ATLANTA WITH SEASON SERIES ON THE LINE

Seattle returns to action Wednesday, hosting the Atlanta Dream in the third and final game of the regular season between the teams. Each team has successfully defended its home court in the previous two meetings with the Storm winning 81-70 on July 14 in Seattle with the Dream picking up an 83-81 win in Atlanta as both teams started the second half of the season on August 16.

HISTORY vs ATLANTA

Seattle leads the all-time series against Atlanta 23-18 including holding a commanding 15-5 record in home games against the Dream. The Storm has won seven-straight home games vs Atlanta dating back to 2019 with its last home loss to the Dream a 77-66 defeat on July 5, 2019. This season, Seattle used a big fourth quarter to pull away from the Dream in an 81-70 win at home on July 14. But the Dream used a big second half to overcome a 14-point, third-quarter deficit to win 83-81 in Atlanta 12 days ago.

LOTS OF GAMES IN A SHORT AMOUNT OF TIME TO CLOSE OUT THE SEASON

The Storm has 11 games left in the season and plays those games over the next 23 days, playing every other day from now until Sept. 19 save one stretch of off days between Sept. 8-10. Seattle started the second half with three games on the road before returning home for five days off—its longest stretch without a game outside of the Olympic Break this season. Of those 11 remaining games, five are at home with the other six on the road.

PLAYOFF PICTURE

As we head down the home stretch, the Storm is closing in on clinching a playoff spot, its 19th in 25 seasons as a franchise. Unofficially, the Storm are unable to clinch that playoff spot tonight, but a win over Atlanta can set up a potential clinching scenario on Friday. Here is the playoff picture with 11 games remaining for Seattle:

OGWUMIKE HITS PAIR OF MILESTONES MONDAY

Nneka Ogwumike, who ranks third in the WNBA at 2.0 steals per game, recorded a pair of steals on Monday to give her 600 for her career becoming the 11th player in WNBA history with at least 600 career steals. That's also the most among active players. Ogwumike is the fifth youngest player among the impressive group to reach the 600-steal milestone, and reached it in the seventh-fewest games. Oh, and she is second-tallest player to record 600 career steals, trailing just 6-5 Sancho Lyttle. At her current pace, Ogwumike could reach the Top 10 in career steals by the end of the season, needing just 20 over Seattle's final 11 games of 2024 to pass DeLisha Milton-Jones at No. 10. Ogwumike has 51 total steals this season already, marking her seventh season with 50+ steals, tied for the fifth-most in WNBA history.

STORM'S BIG FOUR STARTS SECOND HALF STRONG

Jewell Loyd, Skylar Diggins-Smith, Nneka Ogwumike, and Ezi Magbegor have led the Storm offense in its four games since the Olympic Break, accounting for 252 of the team's 311 points over that stretch. Loyd has led the way with 20.3 points per game with Diggins-Smith adding 17.8 points and 5.8 assists per game. Ogwumike has averaged 15.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, and 2.3 steals per game since the break with Magbegor shooting 55.6% from the field and adding 9.3 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 1.8 blocks per game.

GABBY WILLIAMS MAKES STORM DEBUT

Newly signed free agent forward Gabby Williams made her Storm debut on Monday against Washington, finishing with three points, four rebounds, four assists and three steals in 26 minutes off the bench. It was Williams first action since scoring 19 points in the 2024 Paris Olympics Gold Medal game vs the United States. In that game, Williams scored five of her points in the final five seconds as the host nation nearly pulled off an epic upset of the top-ranked US squad. Williams was named the Best Defensive Player at the Olympics, finishing with 15.5 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 2.8 steals per game in six games.

DEFENSE IS THE NAME OF THE GAME

Seattle's defense has been consistently solid this season, ranking first in blocks per game (5.4 bpg) and steals (9.7 spg), tied for 2nd in opponent FG% (41.9%), fourth in defensive rating (94.5), and fourth in opponent scoring (78.1 ppg). The Storm has held opponents under 80 points in nine of its last 14 games and in 16 games overall in 2024. That 80-point threshold has been huge with Seattle going 14-2 when holding teams under 80 compared to just 4-9 when opponents score 80 or more. (The Storm's two losses when holding teams under 80 came when the other team scored 74, obviously an unlucky final tally for Seattle.) Individually, the Storm has four of the top 15 players in defensive win shares: Ezi Magbegor (4th, .210), Jewell Loyd (5th, .202), Skylar Diggins-Smith (9th, .198) and Nneka Ogwumike (11th, .187).

RACKING UP THE STEALS

The Storm leads the WNBA with 9.7 steals per game, and has 10+ steals in 12 of its last 17 games, and 17 games overall this year, the most in the WNBA (five more than the next closest team). The Storm's 9.7 steals per game are close to the franchise record of 10.1 spg set in 2020, and, if the season ended today, would be the second-best mark in the WNBA over the last 14 seasons. Overall the Storm has four players ranked in the top 15 in steals: Nneka Ogwumike is T-3rd (2.0 spg), Skylar Diggins-Smith is T-8th (1.6 spg), and Jordan Horston and Jewell Loyd are T-8th (1.5 spg).

HOME SWEET HOME

With the Storm playing its next two games at home, let's take a look at the team's stats at home vs on the road this year. Of note, at 269-148, the Storm has the third-best home winning percentage among active WNBA teams:

OGWUMIKE SHOOTING LIGHTS OUT FROM EVERYWHERE

Nneka Ogwumike has always been a great shooter, shooting 54.1% from the field in her career—the fourth best mark in WNBA history among players according to stats.wnba.com. This season, Ogwumike is shooting 51.0% from the field, 43.4% from three-point range, and 85.9% from the free throw line. Among WNBA qualifiers, she ranks 11th in FG%, T-4th in 3pt FG%, and 14th in FT%, making her the only player in the league to rank in the top 15 in all three categories. Over the last 10 seasons, only two Storm players have finished the season ranked in the top 15 in all three categories: Breanna Stewart (2022) and Jewell Loyd (2017).



NOTES, STATS & TRENDS (Continued)

LOOK FOR BIG THINGS FROM NNEKA TONIGHT

As previously mentioned, **Nneka Ogwumike** has shot well this season, shooting 50% or better from the field in 16 of 26 games, and 40% or better in 20. While she has had six games shooting under 40% this season—including hitting just 28.6% from the field on Monday vs Washington, she has responded with big games the next time out. In the previous five games this season following a sub-40% shooting night, Ogwumike has combined to shoot 55.1% (43-78), averaging 21.6 ppg and posting three of her six best scoring games of the season.

STEADY FROM THE FREE THROW LINE

The Storm is tied for the league-lead in free throw shooting this season, hitting 83.3% from the charity stripe. If the season ended today, that would be the second-best mark in franchise history, percentage points behind the 2021 mark of 83.9%, and among the Top 20 in WNBA history. Individually **Jewell Loyd** ranks second in the WNBA averaging 7.2 free throw attempts per game and ranks 11th shooting 87.1% from the line. **Ezi Magbregor** ranks sixth at 89.0%, hitting 73-of-82 on the season. Of note, Loyd (1,245), **Skylar Diggins-Smith** (1,232) and **Nneka Ogwumike** (1,211) rank fourth, fifth, and sixth, respectively among active players in free throws made, and rank among the Top 20 overall in league history.

HITTING FROM DOWNTOWN = VICTORY

The Storm has been a force to be reckoned with in the paint this season, averaging 40.5 points in the paint—the 2nd-best mark in the league—accounting for 48.6% of its total scoring. However, Seattle's success seems to be how well it shoots from the outside. Overall, Seattle is 14-3 when shooting over 25% from three-point range, and is 9-2 when making at least seven three pointers in a game (12-4 when making at least six).

THE STORM CONTINUES TO MOVE THE BALL WELL ...

Seattle had 27 assists on 30 made field goals on July 14 vs Atlanta, recording a season-high assist rate of 90.0%. The Storm has recorded 20+ assists in 13 of its last 18 games after doing so just four times through its first 11. Seattle is 12-2 when posting an assisted shot rate of 68% or better this season and is 14-3 when recording at least 20 assists. Overall the Storm ranks fourth at 20.3 assists per game.

... AND IS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL TOO

The Storm's franchise record streak of games with 15 or fewer turnovers came to an end on Aug. 20 in DC as Seattle turned it over 16 times. Seattle's 13.9 turnovers per game are the fifth fewest in the league and the Storm ranks third with a 16.8% turnover rate (a stat which measures the percentage of offensive possessions which end in a turnover). In its 22 games since the now-ended streak began on May 30, the Storm has committed just 12.6 turnovers a game—the second-fewest in the league over that stretch—with a 15.5% turnover rate.

SKYLAR SET TO JOIN SUE BIRD ON STORM ASSISTS CHART

Skylar Diggins-Smith has impressed in her first season running the point for the Storm, averaging 6.4 assists per game through 29 games, currently the fourth-highest total in franchise history. Understandably, Storm legend Sue Bird holds nine of the 10 best assist per game totals in the franchise record book with Jordin Canada's 5.5 apg in 2019 ranking 10th on that list entering the season. But so far this season, Diggins-Smith has averaged more assists than the WNBA's all-time assist leader did in all but three of her 19 seasons. Diggins-Smith is also just 36 assists behind Bird's single-season franchise record of 221 assists done twice (2003, 2018).

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF OPPONENT MISCUES

The Storm has forced a league-best 18.5 turnovers per game over its four games since returning from the Olympic Break on Aug. 15, turning those into 21.0 points per game—also the most in the league. Seattle forced 22 turnovers at Washington on Aug. 20 and scored a season-best 29 points off those turnovers, just four days after tallying 28 points off 20 Atlanta turnovers to open the second half.

SEATTLE PLAYING AT RECORD PACE

One advanced metric which measure how fast a team plays is pace, which measures how many possessions a team uses in a game. A variation of that is Pace/40, which looks at how many possessions a team has in a 40-minute game. Through 29 games, the Storm has a pace/40 of 81.83 which is the second-best in the league (Las Vegas, 81.94), and the highest mark in franchise history. More possessions equals more scoring opportunities!

MAGBEGOR AN EARLY DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR CANDIDATE

Ezi Magbregor continues to be one of the WNBA's top defensive players, ranking among the league leaders in several defensive categories: 2nd in blocks (2.3 bpg), T-4th in offensive rebounds (2.7 orgp), 5th in defensive win shares (.210), T-5th in defensive rating (92.1), 9th in efficiency (20.3), 10th in rebounds (8.7 rpg), and T-16th in steals (1.3 spg).

DID YOU KNOW?

Nneka Ogwumike has shot 50%+ while taking 10+ shots in 186 career games, tied for the second-most games in WNBA history, just eight behind WNBA legend Sylvia Fowles (194).

NOELLE QUINN

HEAD COACH

Noelle Quinn was named the Seattle Storm’s seventh head coach in franchise history on May 30, 2021 and made her head coaching debut on June 1, 2021, guiding the Storm to an 88-73 win over Indiana. Overall, Quinn led Seattle to a 49-53 record through her first three seasons at the helm, including a pair of playoff appearances and a dominating 79-57 win over the Connecticut Sun in 2021 in the WNBA’s first Commissioner’s Cup Championship. She entered the 2024 season one win shy of becoming just the third Storm head coach to win 50 or more games.

Quinn was named to the Storm coaching staff on Feb. 21, 2019 after retiring from the team, and was elevated to associate head coach on June 29, 2020. She holds the distinction of being the only person to win a WNBA Championship as both a player (2018 - SEA) and a coach (2020 - SEA, Assistant).

In her first season as head coach, Quinn led Seattle to a 21-11 overall record and the team’s sixth-straight playoff appearance. She started out her tenure as Head Coach on June 1, 2021, leading the Storm to seven wins over the team’s first eight games including five-straight on the road. Seattle closed out the season by winning three of its final four games to wrap up the fourth overall seed in the playoffs.

The 2022 season saw Quinn guide the Storm to another 20+ win season, the ninth in franchise history, finishing with a record of 22-14. Seattle again qualified for the playoffs as the fourth seed, marking the seventh-straight year in the postseason, sweeping the first-round series before falling in an epic semifinal battle. Under Quinn’s leadership, the Storm posted a league-best 36.1% three-point percentage and 82.5% free throw percentage and top three rankings in blocks (4.2 bpg), steals (8.3 spg), assists (22.6 apg), and points against (78.4 oppg).

Quinn led Seattle through a rebuilding season in 2023 which saw the team post an 11-29 record. The Storm relied heavily on youth as the team was one of the youngest in the league with Quinn leading a team which regularly saw a franchise record four rookies make the roster and see significant time during the season. One of those rookies—Jordan Horston—earned All-Rookie Team honors, just the fourth Storm player to be named to the team.

Quinn joined the Storm coaching staff upon retirement after a successful 12-year WNBA career which included two separate stints with Seattle totaling five years and culminating in a WNBA title in 2018. Quinn was the #4 overall draft pick by Minnesota in 2007. She spent two seasons with the Lynx (2007-08), three with the San Antonio Stars (2009-11), one in Washington (2012), two in her first stop in Seattle (2013-14), and 1-1/2 years in Phoenix (2015-16) before being traded back to Seattle midway through 2016. She would retire following the 2018 season, finishing her career with 1,824 points, 1,011 rebounds, 878 assists and 256 steals in 382 career games.

Considered one of the best “all-around” players in UCLA women’s basketball history, Quinn was the first UCLA men’s or women’s basketball player to total 1,700 points, 700 rebounds and 400 assists in her career. She was inducted into the UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame in 2020 alongside the likes of Russell Westbrook and Kevin Love and was a three-time, first-team All-Pac-10 selection and honorable mention All-American in her time in Westwood.

Quinn is no stranger to being head coach. During her final three WNBA seasons, she served as girls’ head basketball coach at her alma mater Bishop Montgomery High School in Torrance, Calif. where she played from 1999-2003. In her first year coaching, she led the Lady Knights to the Southern Section state championship, and guided the team to the Del Rey League title the following year. Quinn already is the only player to have her number retired for Bishop Montgomery, where she won four high school basketball state championships and one volleyball title.

POKEY CHATMAN

ASSISTANT COACH/ASSOCIATE GENERAL MANAGER

Chatman begins her third season as an assistant coach and her first as associate general manager for the Storm, bringing over 20 years of coaching experience to the team. She most recently spent three seasons coaching the Indiana Fever after six seasons leading the Chicago Sky, posting an overall record of 134-172 record in the WNBA. In Chicago, Chatman guided the Sky to its first-ever playoff appearance in 2013 and to the WNBA finals in 2014. Prior to Chicago, Chatman spent four years at her alma mater LSU, guiding the Tigers to three-straight NCAA Final Four appearances, two SEC titles and an .847 winning percentage.

Chatman's first foray into professional coaching came in 2007 when she served as an assistant coach for Club Spartak Moscow Region. After being elevated to head coach in 2009-10, Chatman's squad—which featured Sue Bird at the point—recorded its fourth-straight EuroLeague Championship with a perfect 16-0 record. In 2010-11, Spartak again reached the EuroLeague Final, this time with Quinn on the squad along with Bird.

Playing for the legendary Sue Gunter from 1987-91, Chatman led LSU to the 1991 SEC tourney championship as a senior, earning tournament MVP honors after scoring 30 points—including 16-straight at one point—in the Tigers 80-75 win over Tennessee. Chatman still is the school's record-holder in career steals (346), and she owned the LSU assists standard for 14 seasons before she watched it fall while patrolling the sidelines. The Louisiana native ushered in the three-point era at LSU by pacing the Lady Tigers in three-point percentage in each of four seasons and led the SEC in three-point field goals made as a junior and senior.

Chatman, who was born in Ama, Louisiana, was a point guard at Hahnville High School and was a five-time AAU All-American. She holds an impressive claim to fame, hitting the first three-pointer in a high school game in Louisiana.

EBONY HOFFMAN

ASSISTANT COACH

Hoffman is in her third season on the Storm coaching staff. Hoffman played 11 seasons in the WNBA with Indiana, Los Angeles, and Connecticut, including the 2011 season in LA with Noelle Quinn. Her best season came in 2008 in Indiana when she earned Most Improved Player after averaging 10.4 points, 7.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.4 steals and 0.8 blocks per game for the Fever.

After retiring from the league, Hoffman has worked in various coaching positions, serving the 2021-22 season as a coaching consultant with Raptors 905 of the NBA G-League. In addition, she has worked within the NBA Academy and in 2021 was named an assistant coach for the South Sudan women's national team.



Hoffman was a two-time All-American honorable mention and three-time First Team All-Pac-10 pick at USC from 2001-04. She wrapped up her career ranked No. 8 on the Trojan's all-time scoring list with 1,687 points and No. 7 in rebounds with 1,003.
