STORM WATCH

- Seattle closes out its WNBA record nine-game homestand today, hosting the Atlanta Dream at 3 p.m. inside Climate Pledge Arena. This is the first game of the season series between the two teams, the last team the Storm has yet to play in 2024.
- On Friday, Seattle's defense held Minnesota to 30.6% shooting in a dominating 91-63 win to improve to 6-2 on the homestand. That was the Lynx' lowest FG% since Aug. 4, 2011, snapping a streak of 439-straight games they shot at least 30.7%—the longest streak in WNBA history by over 200 games.
- Skylar Diggins-Smith** recorded her 12th career double-double on Friday, finishing with 10 points and matching a career-high with 12 assists. It was the Storm's first points-assists double-double since Jordin Canada (now playing with Atlanta) had 10 points and 10 assists vs Phoenix on Sept. 3, 2019.
- Nneka Ogumike** had 26 points on 10-of-14 shooting (71.4%) from the field. It was her third game this season shooting 70%+ on 10+ field goal attempts, and the 39th of her career. The only other player in WNBA history with more such games is future hall of famer Sylvia Fowles (61).

STORM HOSTS ATLANTA TO WRAP UP RECORD HOMESTAND

Seattle closes out the its WNBA record nine-game homestand today, hosting the Atlanta Dream at 3 p.m. inside Climate Pledge Arena. This is the first game of the season series between the two teams, the last team the Storm has yet to play in 2024. Which is odd considering Seattle has already concluded its season series with Minnesota and Chicago.

HISTORY vs ATLANTA

The Storm leads the all-time series 22-17 and has won nine of the last 12 games between the two overall, but the two teams have split the last six games over the past two seasons. Seattle is 14-5 all-time at home against the Dream and has won six-straight at home, with the Storm's last home loss to Atlanta coming in July 2019.

STORM CLOSES OUT WNBA-RECORD NINE-GAME HOME STAND TODAY

Today's game marks the final game of the Storm's WNBA-record nine-game home stand which has seen the team at home since June 23. The home stand represents nearly half of Seattle's 20-game home schedule. Through the first eight games of the home stand, the Storm is 6-2, tying the record for the most wins in a single home stand (6, done by LA five times). The previous WNBA record home stand was eight-straight games shared by three teams including Seattle, as the Storm played eight-straight at home May 14-June 7, 2022. After today's game, the Storm will have played 14 of its 20 home games, with 10 of its final 16 games of the year on the road.

STORMING INTO THE OLYMPICS

The Storm will be well represented at the 2024 Paris Olympics with three players, its head coach, and a former legend competing. **Jewell Loyd** will once again don the red, white, and blue for USA Basketball, **Ezi Magbegor** will also compete in her second Olympics with Basketball Australia, and **Sami Whitcomb** will make her Olympic debut with Australia. Magbegor and Whitcomb will be joined by former Storm legend **Lauren Jackson**, who is making her fifth Olympics appearance. Storm Head Coach **Noelle Quinn** will serve as an assistant coach for Team Canada. Of note, Coach Quinn's final three games before the Olympic Break feature members of her Canadian Team: Bridget Carleton (MIN), Laeticia Amihere (ATL), Kia Nurse (LA).

SEATTLE DEFENSE SHINES IN WIN OVER MINNESOTA

The Storm defense has been strong all season, but Friday's 91-63 was one of its best defensive showings this year. Seattle's defense clamped down on the Lynx, limiting the team to just 30.7% shooting from the field (19-of-62). That marks its lowest shooting percentage since hitting 27.5% on Aug. 4, 2011 vs San Antonio, snapping a streak of 439 consecutive games shooting at least 30.7% or better—the longest streak in WNBA history. The next longest streak? Los Angeles' 236-straight games from 2012-2019.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Storm has played well at home this season, posting a 10-3 record including winning eight-straight between May 22 and July 1. Seattle is averaging 86.3 points per game at home this season, shooting 44.6% from the field, and outscoring opponents by an average of 11.9 points per game. Meanwhile, the Storm defense has clamped down at home, allowing just 74.4 points per game and holding teams to just 40.3% shooting.

HITTING FROM DOWNTOWN = VICTORY

The Storm has been a force to be reckoned with in the paint this season, averaging 41.0 points in the paint—the 2nd-best mark in the league—accounting for 48.7% of its total scoring. However, the mark of success for Seattle has been its outside shooting. Overall, Seattle is 13-0 when shooting over 25% from three-point range this season, and is 8-0 when making at least seven three pointers in a game (11-1 when making at least six).

THE STORM CONTINUES TO MOVE THE BALL WELL ...

Seattle tied a season-high with 29 assists on 33 made field goals on Friday vs Minnesota, recording assists on 87.9% of its baskets. It was the fifth time in the last eight games the Storm has posted an assisted shot rate of 80.0% or better. The Storm has recorded 20+ assists in 10 of its last 12 games after doing so just four times through its first 11. In 11 game since June 13, the Storm ranks third in the league with 23.2 assists per game and has an assisted shot rate of 74.6%, after averaging a league-worst 17.6 apg and a 60.3% rate in 12 games prior. Overall the Storm ranks fifth at 20.8 assists per game and is 12-2 in games with 20+ assists.

... AND IS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL TOO

The Storm has committed 15 or fewer turnovers in each of its last 16 games, the longest streak in franchise history, the longest active streak in the WNBA, and tied for the 11th longest streak in league history. Over that record stretch, Seattle's 12.4 turnovers per game are the third fewest in the league. Overall, the Storm is tied for fourth in turnovers at 14.0 per game, third in turnover percentage (TOV%) at 17.0% (a stat which measures the percentage of offensive possessions which end in a turnover), and ranks third with a 20.1% opposing TOV%. Since the start of the streak on May 30, Seattle's TOV% is down to 15.2% along with an opposing TOV% of 19.4%.

DEFENSE IS THE NAME OF THE GAME

The Storm has held opponents under 80 in six of its last eight games, including two under 70. Overall, Seattle ranks first in blocks per game (5.5 bpg) and steals (9.5 spg), tied for second in opponent FG% (41.7%), third in defensive rating (93.9), and fourth in opponent scoring (77.7 ppg). Individually, Seattle has four of the top 10 players in defensive win shares: **Ezi Magbegor** (3rd, .215), **Skylar Diggins-Smith** (5th, .212), **Jewell Loyd** (6th, .211), and **Nneka Ogumike** (9th, .200). Over her last 11 games, **Jordan Horston** has moved from 51st to 30th at .126.

RACKING UP THE STEALS

The Storm leads the WNBA with 9.5 steals per game, and has 10+ steals in seven of its last 11 games, and 12 games overall this year, the most in the WNBA (three more than the next closest team). Overall the Storm has five players ranked in the top 15 in steals: **Nneka Ogumike** is sixth (1.7 spg), **Jordan Horston** ranks ninth (1.6 spg), **Ezi Magbegor** and **Jewell Loyd** are tied for 11th (1.5 spg), with **Skylar Diggins-Smith** ranked 15th (1.4 spg).

MAGBEGOR AN EARLY DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR CANDIDATE

Ezi Magbegor continues to be one of the league's top defensive players, ranking among the league leaders in several defensive categories: second in blocks (2.4 bpg), T-7th in rebounds (9.0 rpg), third in offensive rebounds (3.0 orpg), 6th in defensive rating (91.4), 3rd in defensive win shares (.215), eighth in efficiency (21.1) and T-14th in steals (1.4 spg). Oddly enough, her stats across the board are nearly identical or better than in 2023 when she was selected as a WNBA All-Star though she inexplicably did not earn an All-Star nod this season.

MAGBEGOR'S BLOCK PARTY SETTING RECORDS

Ezi Magbegor had an impressive game on July 5 vs Chicago, blocking a career-high eight shots, becoming just the 12th player in WNBA history to record 8+ blocks in a game and the first since Elizabeth Williams on Sept. 5, 2019. Magbegor ranks second in the league in total blocks with 55, and in blocks per game (2.4), recording at least two blocks in 16 of 23 games this year. Her 55 blocks through the first 23 games of a season are the second-most behind fellow Aussie Lauren Jackson, who posted 62 through 23 games en route to collecting 81 in 28 games in 2002. Two years ago, Magbegor had 53 blocks through her first 23 games and had 43 last year.

DIGGINS-SMITH PICKS UP DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Skylar Diggins-Smith recorded her first double-double of the season and 12th of her career on Friday, finishing with 10 points and matching a career-high with 12 assists. It was the 11th time she had a points-assists double-double and her first since July 13, 2022. It also marked the Storm's first points-assists double-double since Jordin Canada (now playing with Atlanta) had 10 points and 10 assists vs Phoenix on Sept. 3, 2019. Former Storm standout and current Atlanta Head Coach Tanisha Wright also recorded three points-assists double-doubles with the Storm.

OGWUMIKE TALLIES 20+ POINTS AGAIN, REMAINS CONSISTENT

Nneka Ogwumike matched a season-high with 26 points on Friday against Minnesota, her seventh game with 20+ points of the season and 123rd of her career—tied for the 11th most in WNBA history. She has scored 20+ points in two of her last three games and now has 12 games with 20+ points against Minnesota in her career including three in four games against the Lynx in 2024. Despite being in her 13th WNBA season, Ogwumike continues to be consistent in putting up numbers, with nearly all of her 2024 season stats sitting slightly better than her career averages entering the year:

NNEKA ALSO SHOOTS BETTER THAN 70% ... AGAIN

Nneka Ogwumike finished Friday's game with 26 points on 10-of-14 shooting, connecting on 71.4% from the field. It marked the third time this season she has shot better than 70% with at least 10 field goal attempts in the game, and the 39th time in her career. The only other player in WNBA history with more such games is future hall of famer Sylvia Fowles with 61. Ogwumike ranks fifth in the WNBA in field goal percentage at 53.4% FG% and third in three-point shooting at 45.5%.

TAKE IT EASY ON JEWELL, EH?

Jewell Loyd ranks second in the WNBA in fouls drawn at 5.7 per game, which has translated into 158 trips to the free throw line this season—or 6.9 per game—both of which rank second in the league. The good news is she has converted a league-high 140 of those attempts from the charity stripe (an 88.6% free throw percentage), with 30.5% of her total points coming from the charity stripe. Last season, Loyd was fouled 6.8 times a game and averaged 7.5 free throws per game, both league-highs. She finished the season shooting 88.8% from the line scoring 254 of her WNBA-record 939 points from the charity stripe.

NNEKA PULLING DOWN THE BOARDS

Nneka Ogwumike has recorded at least one rebound in all 375 career games played, the longest active streak in the WNBA and second-longest streak all-time. Candace Parker holds the all-time record of 410, and on June 11 vs LA, Ogwumike moved past Sparks legend Lisa Leslie into 2nd on that list.

LET'S CHECK OUT SEATTLE'S NET

Another great find from statistician Craig Heyamoto: Since the insertion of Jordan Horston into the starting lineup on June 23, Seattle has led the WNBA in Net Rating (+15.6). Seattle's +8.3 net rating is third overall in the league. As Craig notes, in 20 of the 27 WNBA seasons, the team with the highest, regular season Net Rating has gone on to win the WNBA Championship with the second-ranked team winning six times. The outlier was in 2021 when Chicago won as the No. 6 ranked team in Net Rating.

DOUBLE DIGIT LEADERS

Jewell Loyd and **Nneka Ogwumike** have combined for the most games with 10+ points since Loyd debuted in 2015. Loyd has reached double-figures in 256 of her 313 games played during that time while Ogwumike has 251 in 275 games played.

On June 4, Storm guard **Jewell Loyd** became the seventh active player and 56th player in WNBA history to eclipse the 9,000 career minutes played mark, and was the eighth-youngest to hit the milestone. Since entering the league in 2015, Loyd has played 9,502 minutes, playing 423 minutes more (or over 10 games more) than any other player during that stretch.

NOELLE QUINN

HEAD COACH

Noelle Quinn was named the Seattle Storm’s seventh head coach in franchise history on May 30, 2021 and made her head coaching debut on June 1, 2021, guiding the Storm to an 88-73 win over Indiana. Overall, Quinn led Seattle to a 49-53 record through her first three seasons at the helm, including a pair of playoff appearances and a dominating 79-57 win over the Connecticut Sun in 2021 in the WNBA’s first Commissioner’s Cup Championship. She entered the 2024 season one win shy of becoming just the third Storm head coach to win 50 or more games.

Quinn was named to the Storm coaching staff on Feb. 21, 2019 after retiring from the team, and was elevated to associate head coach on June 29, 2020. She holds the distinction of being the only person to win a WNBA Championship as both a player (2018 - SEA) and a coach (2020 - SEA, Assistant).

In her first season as head coach, Quinn led Seattle to a 21-11 overall record and the team’s sixth-straight playoff appearance. She started out her tenure as Head Coach on June 1, 2021, leading the Storm to seven wins over the team’s first eight games including five-straight on the road. Seattle closed out the season by winning three of its final four games to wrap up the fourth overall seed in the playoffs.

The 2022 season saw Quinn guide the Storm to another 20+ win season, the ninth in franchise history, finishing with a record of 22-14. Seattle again qualified for the playoffs as the fourth seed, marking the seventh-straight year in the postseason, sweeping the first-round series before falling in an epic semifinal battle. Under Quinn’s leadership, the Storm posted a league-best 36.1% three-point percentage and 82.5% free throw percentage and top three rankings in blocks (4.2 bpg), steals (8.3 spg), assists (22.6 apg), and points against (78.4 oppg).

Quinn led Seattle through a rebuilding season in 2023 which saw the team post an 11-29 record. The Storm relied heavily on youth as the team was one of the youngest in the league with Quinn leading a team which regularly saw a franchise record four rookies make the roster and see significant time during the season. One of those rookies—Jordan Horston—earned All-Rookie Team honors, just the fourth Storm player to be named to the team.

Quinn joined the Storm coaching staff upon retirement after a successful 12-year WNBA career which included two separate stints with Seattle totaling five years and culminating in a WNBA title in 2018. Quinn was the #4 overall draft pick by Minnesota in 2007. She spent two seasons with the Lynx (2007-08), three with the San Antonio Stars (2009-11), one in Washington (2012), two in her first stop in Seattle (2013-14), and 1-1/2 years in Phoenix (2015-16) before being traded back to Seattle midway through 2016. She would retire following the 2018 season, finishing her career with 1,824 points, 1,011 rebounds, 878 assists and 256 steals in 382 career games.

Considered one of the best “all-around” players in UCLA women’s basketball history, Quinn was the first UCLA men’s or women’s basketball player to total 1,700 points, 700 rebounds and 400 assists in her career. She was inducted into the UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame in 2020 alongside the likes of Russell Westbrook and Kevin Love and was a three-time, first-team All-Pac-10 selection and honorable mention All-American in her time in Westwood.

Quinn is no stranger to being head coach. During her final three WNBA seasons, she served as girls’ head basketball coach at her alma mater Bishop Montgomery High School in Torrance, Calif. where she played from 1999-2003. In her first year coaching, she led the Lady Knights to the Southern Section state championship, and guided the team to the Del Rey League title the following year. Quinn already is the only player to have her number retired for Bishop Montgomery, where she won four high school basketball state championships and one volleyball title.

POKEY CHATMAN

ASSISTANT COACH/ASSOCIATE GENERAL MANAGER

Chatman begins her third season as an assistant coach and her first as associate general manager for the Storm, bringing over 20 years of coaching experience to the team. She most recently spent three seasons coaching the Indiana Fever after six seasons leading the Chicago Sky, posting an overall record of 134-172 record in the WNBA. In Chicago, Chatman guided the Sky to its first-ever playoff appearance in 2013 and to the WNBA finals in 2014. Prior to Chicago, Chatman spent four years at her alma mater LSU, guiding the Tigers to three-straight NCAA Final Four appearances, two SEC titles and an .847 winning percentage.

Chatman's first foray into professional coaching came in 2007 when she served as an assistant coach for Club Spartak Moscow Region. After being elevated to head coach in 2009-10, Chatman's squad—which featured Sue Bird at the point—recorded its fourth-straight EuroLeague Championship with a perfect 16-0 record. In 2010-11, Spartak again reached the EuroLeague Final, this time with Quinn on the squad along with Bird.

Playing for the legendary Sue Gunter from 1987-91, Chatman led LSU to the 1991 SEC tourney championship as a senior, earning tournament MVP honors after scoring 30 points—including 16-straight at one point—in the Tigers 80-75 win over Tennessee. Chatman still is the school's record-holder in career steals (346), and she owned the LSU assists standard for 14 seasons before she watched it fall while patrolling the sidelines. The Louisiana native ushered in the three-point era at LSU by pacing the Lady Tigers in three-point percentage in each of four seasons and led the SEC in three-point field goals made as a junior and senior.

Chatman, who was born in Ama, Louisiana, was a point guard at Hahnville High School and was a five-time AAU All-American. She holds an impressive claim to fame, hitting the first three-pointer in a high school game in Louisiana.

EBONY HOFFMAN

ASSISTANT COACH

Hoffman is in her third season on the Storm coaching staff. Hoffman played 11 seasons in the WNBA with Indiana, Los Angeles, and Connecticut, including the 2011 season in LA with Noelle Quinn. Her best season came in 2008 in Indiana when she earned Most Improved Player after averaging 10.4 points, 7.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.4 steals and 0.8 blocks per game for the Fever.

After retiring from the league, Hoffman has worked in various coaching positions, serving the 2021-22 season as a coaching consultant with Raptors 905 of the NBA G-League. In addition, she has worked within the NBA Academy and in 2021 was named an assistant coach for the South Sudan women's national team.



Hoffman was a two-time All-American honorable mention and three-time First Team All-Pac-10 pick at USC from 2001-04. She wrapped up her career ranked No. 8 on the Trojan's all-time scoring list with 1,687 points and No. 7 in rebounds with 1,003.
