MATCHUP QUICK HITS

Thursday's matchup marks the Liberty's 62nd all-time regular-season meeting against Atlanta and the final head-to-head matchup of their four-game season series in 2024. Against the Dream, the Liberty is 39-22 (.639) in their all-time regular season series.

The Liberty last played the Dream in the regular season on June 30th in their third meeting of the 2024 regular season at Barclays Center, an 81-75 win for New York.

Breanna Stewart led the Liberty offense with 22 points and 12 rebounds to go along with three assists, two steals and a block. Stewart became the fastest player in WNBA history to reach 5000 career points (242 games) and recorded her 83rd career double-double.

Betnijah Laney-Hamilton recorded 18 points on 50% (6-12) shooting from the field with six assists and five rebounds. Laney-Hamilton tied her career high with four three-pointers on 67% (4-6) shooting from beyond the arc.

Sabrina Ionescu finished with 10 points in the win and recorded four rebounds and four assists.

Leonie Fiebich scored 12 points on 56% (5-9) shooting from the field while setting her then-career-high with three steals.

Courtney Vandersloot became the fastest player in WNBA history to reach 2,750 career assists (407 games) and recorded seven points, seven assists, and two steals against Atlanta.

The Liberty trailed by as many as 16 points in the first half against the Dream, marking the team's largest comeback win of the season.

In New York's victory over the Dream on June 23rd, the Liberty set a franchise record for the highest field goal percentage in any first half, shooting 71.4% (25-35) from the field.

The Liberty tied the WNBA record for most first-half points scored during the second game of a back-to-back, with 62 points in the first half against Atlanta on June 23rd.

Sabrina Ionescu recorded her fifth career game of at least 25 points and 10 assists against the Dream on June 23rd, which is tied for the most by any player in WNBA history.

On June 23rd, **Marquesha Davis** scored a career-high nine points and made multiple field goals for the first time in her career.

Breanna Stewart averaged a double-double of 21.3 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in three matchups against Atlanta in 2024.

New York averaged 10.7 made three-pointers per game against Atlanta in 2024, which led all Dream opponents this season.

The Liberty led all Dream opponents in assists per game this season with an average of 24.7 assists in three matchups with Atlanta.

New York's 89.0 defensive rating against the Dream in 2024 was the Liberty's best defensive rating against any opponent this season.

MATCHUP QUICK HITS

Breanna Stewart is one of two players in WNBA history, along with Elena Delle Donne, to average better than 20 points per game against Atlanta in their career (min. 20 games).

Sabrina Ionescu ranks first in career three-pointers made per game (2.5) among players with more than 10 games against the Dream.

Courtney Vandersloot's career 6.5 assists per game against the Dream is the highest career assists average against Atlanta in WNBA history among players with at least 10 games played.

Sabrina Ionescu's career 5.6 assists per game against the Dream is tied for the fifth-highest career assists average against Atlanta in WNBA history among players with at least 10 games played.

Breanna Stewart's 6.4 free throws made per game against the Dream is the highest career free throws made average against Atlanta in WNBA history.

Breanna Stewart averaged 8.8 rebounds per game against the Dream in her career, which is the third-highest career rebounding average against Atlanta in WNBA history (min. 20 games).

In Sunday's matchup with Minnesota, **Breanna Stewart** set her season highs with 38 points and 18 rebounds, which also ties the highest rebounding total of her career and marks the first player game of at least 35 points and 15 rebounds in Liberty franchise history.

With a win over the Mystics on Tuesday, New York clinched the league's best record and the top seed in the 2024 WNBA Playoffs.

The Liberty set a season high with 50 points in the paint against Washington on Tuesday.

New York's reserves scored a season-high 40 bench points in the Liberty's win over the Mystics on Tuesday.

Nyara Sabally set her career high for made free throws with six against Washington, and she scored 12 points in the win.

Leonie Fiebich recorded a plus-minus of +10 or better in 18 games, passing Maya Moore for the most such games by a rookie in WNBA history.

Opponents shot -16.5% below expected FG% on 198 layups with **Breanna Stewart** as the closest defender, which is the lowest among 118 players who have defended at least 30 layups in 2024 according to Second Spectrum.

Sabrina Ionescu ranks second in the WNBA in first-quarter scoring in 2024 (6.6 first-quarter points per game) and ranks atop the league in double-digit scoring performances in the first quarter so far this season (9).

Betnijah Laney-Hamilton leads the WNBA in plus-minus per game (+10.5) in 2024.

Jonquel Jones leads all WNBA players with 79 no-look passes and 14 no-look assists in 2024, according to Second Spectrum.

New York recorded a league-best +25.6 net rating and 111.6 offensive rating in 49 clutch-time minutes so far this season.

The Liberty averaged a league-high 12.4 fast-break points per game so far this season, which is on pace to be the highest fast-break scoring average in franchise history.

Among 318 two-player lineups with at least 200 minutes played in 2024, eight of the top nine lineups in net rating this season are Liberty lineups, and each of those eight combinations include at least one of Betnijah Laney-Hamilton or Leonie Fiebich.

2024 STORYLINES

NOTHING BUT NET

The Liberty recorded a league-best 12.3 points per 100 possessions net rating so far in 2024, which is on pace to be the best net rating in franchise history, and New York is the only team in the league to record a net rating better than +10.0 this season.

New York currently leads the WNBA in offensive rating (109.1), defensive rating (94.7), and net rating (+14.5) on the road this season. The Liberty are on pace to become the fifth team in WNBA history to lead the league in all three categories on the road, and each of the previous four teams went on to win the WNBA Championship.

New York's +12.3 net rating is on pace to be the best in franchise history.

New York led the league in net rating (+12.6), offensive rating (106.5) and defensive rating (93.8) with nine games remaining in 2024, becoming the ninth team in WNBA history to lead the league in all three categories with fewer than 10 games remaining in the season. Each of the previous eight teams made the WNBA Finals and seven of the eight went on to win the WNBA Championship that season.

PRIMED FOR PARIS

Breanna Stewart and Sabrina Ionescu each won Gold Medals after leading USA to a 6-0 record at the 2024 Paris Summer Olympics. Stewart was named to the All-Star Five in Paris after averaging 16.3 points, 5.3 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.7 blocks on 56.7% shooting from the field, while Ionescu's +6.5 plus-minus was tied for the eighth-best among all players in Paris.

Head Coach Sandy Brondello and the Australia Opals earned a Bronze Medal in Paris for the country's first Olympic medal since 2012.

Leonie Fiebich and Nyara Sabally led Germany to the Quarterfinals in the country's first Olympic berth all-time for women's basketball.

Fiebich tied for the fourth-highest steals average in Paris at 2.5 steals per game while leading Germany in minutes at 33.3 per game.

Sabally recorded her first career double-double in the Olympics with 20 points and 13 rebounds in Germany's Quarterfinals loss to France, and her 14 free throws made marked the most made free throws by a player in a single Olympic match since 1984.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Liberty look to continue building on a strong defensive performance in 2023, where New York ranked third in defensive rating (99.4) while leading the league in defensive rebound rate (73.3%) and opponent eFG% (47.6%).

eFG% counts three-pointers as 1.5 shots and two-pointers as 1 shot to account for the difference in points value.

After holding Las Vegas to the team's first and third single-digit scoring quarters of the season in 2024, four of the last five single-digit scoring quarters by the Aces have come against the Liberty's defense.

Breanna Stewart (-16.5%) ranks first in the WNBA this season for opponent field-goal percentage below expected on layups as the closest defender (min. 30 layups defended) according to Second Spectrum.

MVP PARTY

Breanna Stewart won 2023 WNBA MVP, while Jonquel Jones won MVP of the 2023 Commissioner's Cup, previously won the 2021 WNBA MVP, and was named the International Player of the Year in the Women's Chinese Basketball Association this offseason.

Leonie Fiebich won MVP of the LF Endesa League in Spain for the second consecutive season in 2023-24, and was also selected to the 2024 All-EuroLeague First Team. Kennedy Burke was named the LFB MVP in France in back-to-back seasons and was a 2024 All-EuroLeague Second Team selection.

2024 STORYLINES

JUMP FROM JJ

Jonquel Jones showed significant growth as a playmaker and shooter prior to the Olympic Break, as she averaged a career-high 3.5 assists per game and set her career high with eight assists on June 20 vs. Los Angeles.

Jonquel leads the WNBA in efficiency (68.1% eFG%) on fourth-quarter shots with the score within 10 points (min. 50 attempts).

SA-THREE-NA

Sabrina Ionescu set the WNBA single-season record for made three-pointers with 128 in 2023.

Ionescu's 44.8% three-point percentage in 2023 was the best in WNBA history among players who attempted at least 200 threes.

In 2023, Sabrina became the first player in WNBA history to make at least 100 above-the-break three-pointers in a single season.

Ionescu has hit at least one three-pointer in each of her last 62 games, the longest streak in Liberty franchise history.

With the 13th 30-point game of her career, Sabrina passed Cappie Pondexter for the most 30-point games in Liberty franchise history.

STEW-WAY PLAYER

Breanna Stewart's 23.0 points per game last season was the third-highest scoring average for a player selected to an All-Defensive team in the same season in WNBA history.

Stewart's 39 games scoring in double figures tied for the most in the league (Arike Ogunbowale) and tied the record for most double-digit scoring games in WNBA single-season history.

Stewart set a WNBA single-season record with four games of 40 or more points in 2023, and also became the first player to score 900 points in a season throughout WNBA history.

THREE-AND-B

Betnijah Laney-Hamilton tied the WNBA single-season record for most corner three-pointers made since 2009 with 37. Tied for third on that list are Liberty assistant coach Roneeka Hodges (34 corner three-pointers made in 2009) and Nicole Powell (34 in 2010).

The former WNBA Most Improved Player led the league in three-pointers made from both the right corner and the left corner in 2023.

SELFLESS SLOOT

Courtney Vandersloot earned her seventh career WNBA Peak Performer award in assists after finishing the 2023 regular season with a league-best 8.1 assists per game.

The veteran point guard was either first or tied for first in assist average against five WNBA teams in 2023 (DAL, CON, IND, SEA, CHI).

Vandersloot has recorded 61 career points/assists double-doubles, which is more than twice as many as any other player all-time.

PLAYOFF PUSH

The Liberty became the first team to clinch the 2024 WNBA postseason with a victory over Las Vegas on August 17.

This marks the first time in franchise history that the Liberty have been the first team to clinch a WNBA playoff appearance, per ESPN.

2024 STORYLINES

RISING ROOKIE

Leonie Fiebich recorded a plus-minus of +20 or better in five games, which is the most by any Liberty rookie in franchise history. Only three rookies all-time (Delle Donne, Cooper-Dyke, and N. Ogwumike) recorded more games with a plus-minus of +20 or better.

Leonie averaged a plus-minus of +12.5 in 15 games as a starter, which is the highest plus-minus among all starters in 2024.

Fiebich is on pace to become the first rookie in WNBA history to average a plus-minus of +10.0 or better as a starter (min. 10 starts). Her +12.5 plus-minus as a starter is the best by any NBA or WNBA rookie with at least 10 starts since the NBA began tracking play-by-play data in 1996-97.

Leonie is the only rookie to be a part of multiple lineups with a net rating above +10.0 in 2024 (min. 75 minutes played).

The reigning LF Endesa MVP tied for the longest steals streak among 2024 rookies, recording a steal in nine consecutive games.

On July 11, Leonie tied the Liberty franchise record for the highest single-game plus-minus by a rookie, with a +27 against Chicago.

Leonie Fiebich and Caitlin Clark are the only two 2024 rookies to record consecutive games with at least seven rebounds and five assists this season. Only five other rookies since 2000 have reached that stat line in consecutive games (Tamika Catchings, Candace Parker, Breanna Stewart, Aliyah Boston, and Dorka Juhász).

Fiebich became the first rookie since Napheesa Collier in 2019 to post a plus-minus of +20 or better in consecutive games.

Leonie's 1.84 AST/TOV leads all rookies in 2024 (min. five minutes per game).

Fiebich made at least half of her three-point attempts 17 times to set a WNBA record for the most such games by a rookie.

Her seven consecutive games recording a plus-minus of +10 or better is the longest such streak by a first-year player in WNBA history.

Fiebich also became one of two 2024 rookies (Caitlin Clark) to record at least seven rebounds and a steal with multiple three-pointers and a field-goal percentage of 50% or better.

Leonie is on pace to become the fourth rookie since 2010 to average at least 1.3 made three-pointers and one offensive rebound per game (min. 500 total minutes), joining Breanna Stewart, Elena Delle Donne, and Maya Moore.

Opponents scored 0.829 points per chance on drives with Leonie Fiebich as the ballhandler defender, which is the fourth-lowest among 31 defenders to face at least 125 opponent drives this season, and the lowest among all rookie defenders. Leonie also held opponents to the lowest shot quality on drives (44.9% qSQ), according to Second Spectrum.

Leonie Fiebich is the first rookie since 2007 to shoot at least 40% from deep on at least 100 three-point attempts. Fiebich is also the eighth player (rookie or veteran) since 2013 to reach those marks in a single season, and each of the previous seven won at least one WNBA MVP or Olympic Gold Medal. Leonie joins Breanna Stewart and Jonquel Jones as the only players taller than 6-0 to do so since 2013, and she's one of four players all-time to accomplish this at 6-4 or taller, joining Stewart, Jones and Lauren Jackson.

RUNNING IT BACK

The Liberty return all five members of the 2023 squad's All-Star starting unit with a full year of chemistry under their belts. New York's lineup of Courtney Vandersloot, Sabrina Ionescu, Betnijah Laney-Hamilton, Breanna Stewart, and Jonquel Jones started a league-high 35 games last season and posted a +20 net rating in 517 minutes together on the court.

New York's 2023 starting unit posted a +5.2 net rating in 246 postseason minutes, leading the Liberty to the franchise's first WNBA Finals appearance since 2002 and the first home Finals win in franchise history.

The Liberty's starting unit has the third-best net rating (+19.1) of any lineup with more than 100 minutes played so far in 2024.

2024 STORYLINES

REVAMPED RESERVES

New York remodeled the second unit this offseason to bring in more athleticism and playmaking, adding Kennedy Burke, Leonie Fiebich, Ivana Dojkić, and Marquesha Davis.

The bench is led by returner Kayla Thornton, one of the most active three-and-D players in the league.

Dojkić looks to help New York push the pace, as she ranked in the top ten for fast-break points per 100 possessions in 2023 (4.7).

Davis, the 11th overall pick in the 2024 WNBA Draft, was one of three SEC players to average multiple two-point field goals made in transition per game during the 2023-24 NCAA season.

Three of the top four lineups in net rating with at least 100 minutes played this season are Liberty lineups.

New York's went 16-0 in games where the Liberty's reserves outscore the opponent's bench so far this season.

DROPPING DIMES

The Liberty posted the highest assist rate (75.0%) in WNBA history in 2023 and set a franchise record with 24.1 assists per game.

The Liberty recorded more assists than their opponents in 32 games last season, the most in WNBA single-season history, and went 29-3 (.906) in those games.

Courtney Vandersloot connected with Breanna Stewart for 116 assists in 2023, making them the first assister-scorer duo in WNBA history to exceed 100 assists in a single season.

The Liberty have recorded at least 15 assists in 110 consecutive games since May 2022, the longest such streak in WNBA history.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

For the first time in franchise history, the Liberty had multiple players with 10 or more double-doubles in a single season in 2023 (Breanna Stewart and Jonquel Jones).

Breanna Stewart tied the Liberty franchise record for single-season double-doubles in 2023 with 20 (Tina Charles, 2015).

Jonquel Jones set a WNBA postseason record with eight double-doubles to begin the 2023 WNBA Playoffs.

Liberty players accumulated 41 double-doubles in 2023, the second-most double-doubles by a team in WNBA single-season history.

The Liberty averaged 15.5 second-chance points per 100 possessions and 47.7 points in the paint per 100 possessions with Jonquel in the game in 2023, compared to just 11.6 second-chance points and 35.6 points in the paint per 100 possessions without her playing.

The duo of Jonquel Jones and Breanna Stewart have each recorded a double-double in the same game eight times since joining the Liberty, which is the most by any duo in franchise history.

For the second time in Liberty franchise history and the 24th time in WNBA history, three players on the same team recorded a double-double in the same game (Jones, Stewart and Vandersloot on August 20).

- On pace to join 2018 Jonquel Jones, who went on to win the Sixth Player of the Year award that season, as the only two players to make at least 40% of their three-point attempts (min. 110 attempts) in a single season while coming off the bench in more than 15 games since the Sixth Player of the Year Award was created in 2007.

SANDY BRONDELLO

NEW YORK LIBERTY HEAD COACH

3RD SEASON WITH NEW YORK | 12TH SEASON | NO. 6 ALL-TIME IN WINS

Veteran WNBA coach, player, and former Australian Olympian Sandy Brondello (braun-DELL-oh) was named the ninth head coach in Liberty franchise history on January 7, 2022. Brondello joined New York after an eight-year head coaching tenure with the Phoenix Mercury where she led the team to a playoff appearance in each of her eight seasons. After the 2023 season, Brondello holds an overall regular season record of 212-156 (.576) over her 11 combined seasons at the helm of the Liberty, Mercury and San Antonio Silver Stars, making her the seventh-winningest coach in WNBA history.

Additionally, Brondello has compiled a 31-27 postseason record throughout her head coaching career, ranking her as the fourth-winningest coach in league postseason history. In 2014, Sandy was named the WNBA Coach of the Year after she led Phoenix to a WNBA regular season-record 29 wins and capped the season with a WNBA Championship. In 2023, Brondello led the Liberty to the Commissioner's Cup Championship and first WNBA Finals appearance since 2002.

A 19-year veteran of the WNBA coaching ranks, Brondello has been affiliated with the league for 24 of its 27 seasons, including her time as a player. A proven winner internationally and in the WNBA, her 19 total years as an assistant coach and head coach have featured 16 playoff appearances, highlighted by a perfect 11-for-11 in postseason berths as a head coach.

In those 11 postseasons, Sandy led her teams to eight Semifinals round berths (formerly conference finals) and three WNBA Finals appearances in 2014, 2021, and 2023. Prior to her time with the Mercury, Brondello served as lead assistant coach for the Los Angeles Sparks (2011-13) under 2012 WNBA Coach of the Year Carol Ross. Brondello led the San Antonio Silver Stars to a 2010 playoff berth in her debut season at the helm following five seasons on the Silver Stars bench as an assistant under Dan Hughes (2005-09), the fifth-winningest coach in league history.

A 2010 inductee into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame, Brondello was named the 11th head coach for the Australian Women's National Basketball team on April 17, 2017. Most recently, Brondello led the Australian National Team to a Bronze Medal in the 2024 Paris Summer Olympics. In addition to her work internationally with the Australian Women's National Basketball team, Brondello previously served as an assistant coach with UMMC Ekaterinburg in Russia from 2012-2017.

Brondello finished a stellar 17-year professional playing career with a five-year run in the WNBA in which she played for Detroit (1998-99), Miami (2001-02) and Seattle (2003), and was named a 1999 WNBA All-Star. She began her career with the Women's National Basketball League (WNBL) in Australia (1986-96), and was named the league MVP in 1995. The 5-7 guard was a 10-time German Cup champion while playing with BTV Wuppertal (1992-2002), a three-time European Cup All-Star selection (1994, 1996, 1997), and the 1996 European Cup MVP when she led her team to the title.

An 18-year member of the Australian National Team, Brondello is a four-time Olympian, a two-time silver medalist (2000, 2004) and was named the 1992 Australian International Player of the Year.

Brondello is married to Liberty assistant coach, Olaf Lange, and the couple have two children, Brody and Jayda.

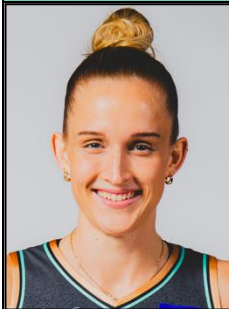

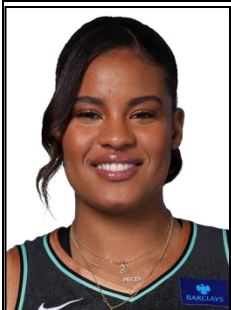

2024 NEW YORK LIBERTY SPOTTER'S CHART



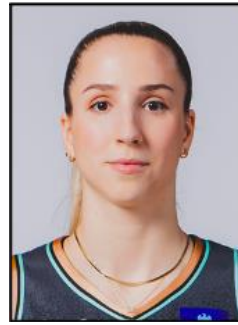

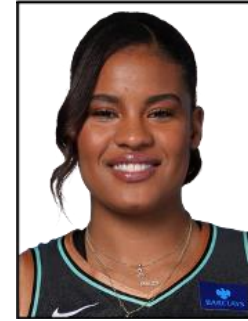
