Thornton averaged 20.0 points, 11.5 rebounds and 1.0 assist while shooting 43.8 percent (14-32) from the field, posting two double-doubles while leading Golden State to a 2-0 week. It's Thornton's first-ever Player of the Week award.
- The Valkyries have one five of their last seven, including four of five at Ballhalla. Golden State's seven wins are already more than three of the past four expansion teams since 2000 had in their entire inaugural seasons Seattle with 6 in 2000, Chicago with 5 in 2006 and Atlanta with 4 in 2008.
- Five of Golden State's seven losses on the season have come to teams with a current combined record of 34-9. (New York: 11-3, Minnesota: 12-2; Phoenix: 11-4) (records as of 6/26).

- Six Valkyries (Kayla Thornton 3, Temi Fágbénlé 2, Laeticia Amihere, Monique Billings, Veronica Burton, Janelle Salaün 1) have recorded doubles-doubles this season, which are the most players of any team in the WNBA. Thornton's four double-doubles are tied for the 10th-most in the league.
- The Valkyries are the first WNBA team this season to have five players in double figures for three straight games (6/5 @ PHX, 6/7 vs. LVA, 6/9 @ LAS).
- Against the Aces (6/7), Golden State had three players post dou-

ble-doubles, which was the first time in the WNBA this season a team has had three players post double-doubles in the same game, and third time over the last two seasons (Indiana on 7/12/2024 and New York on 8/20/2024).

- Temi Fágbénlé is fourth in the league with a 54.3 field goal percentage, and 15th in blocks per game (0.9),
- Kayla Thornton is ninth in the W with 1.7 steals per game, Thornton has at least one steal in all but one game this season. The forward is also 13th with 71 rebounds per game.
- Tiffany Hayes was one of three players to begin the 2025 season going 17-17 or better from the line: Napheesa Collier 23-23; Monique Akoa-Makani 18-18.
- Veronica Burton (90.0) is fifth all-time in WNBA history in free throw percentage among players with at least 100 career attempts. Bur-ton's 88.1 FT% this season is the seventh best in the league (min. 50) FTA). Burton has six games this season in which she hasn't missed a frée throw.
- Veronica Burton ranks fourth in the W with a 3.08 a/to ratio.

The Valkyries are 4-1 this season on one day of rest and shooting 42.5 percent from the field in those games.

- Golden State leads the W in rebounds per game (371), and is third steals per game (8.6) and t-fourth in free throw percentage (79.7). Additionally the Valkyries are fifth in fastbreak points per game (11.2), and t-fourth in second chance points per game (11.3), and lead the league in opponent points in the paint per game (29.1).
- The Valkyries boast a defensive rating (how many points a team allows per 100 opponent possessions) of 98.5, which is the fourth best in the league. Golden State paces the W with a 71.7 defensive rebound percentage.
- $\bullet$  Golden State is 3-0 when getting 15-or-more second-chance points in a game this season.
- The Valkyries get 21.2 percent of their points from the free-throw line, which is the third-highest clip in the WNBA.
- Golden State is coming off a win versus Indiana in which it held Caitlin Clark to 11 points, tying a season low, an 0-7 from three-point range, the second time this season, and her career, she was held without a three-point field goal.
- Kayla Thornton has scored in double figures in 13 consecutive games, and has four double-doubles this season. Golden State 4-0 when she records a double-double in 2025, and 3-0 when she scores 20+.

• Golden State wrapped up its first-ever Commissioner's Cup with a 3-3 record, amounting to \$12,000 to CURYJ, the team's beneficiary organization.

**Home Court Advantage** 

- The Valkyries lead the league in home attendance with an average of 18,064 fans. Indiana is second and averaging 16,657.29 fans per game, and New York is third at 16,013.86. Golden State has sold out all eight home games this season.
- On March 26, 2025, the Golden State Valkyries eclipsed the 10,000 season ticket mark for the team's inaugural 2025 season, presented by Kaiser Permanente. The Valkyries, who are the first WNBA expansion team since 2008, became the first WNBA team on record to hit this milestone.
- •The Valkyries drew a sellout attendance of 18,064 during their home opener on May 16, which is the second-highest attendance by a WNBA team in their first-ever home game (Washington Mystics 20,674 on 6/19/1998). That attendance was also the sixth highest in a team's first home game of the season. Golden State followed up with two more sellouts, becoming the first WNBA franchise to have an attendance of 18,000+ in each of its first three home games.
