COMMISSIONER'S CUP

The Golden State Valkyries begin the WNBA Commissioner's Cup, presented by Coinbase, against the Minnesota Lynx.

The Commissioner's Cup is an annual in-season tournament in which the top team from each conference with the best Commissioner's Cup record will compete for a \$500,000 prize pool in the Championship game. The Commissioner's Cup will also make charitable contributions to non-profit organizations aligned to the players' social justice work, which will be presented to each organization at the conclusion of the Commissioner's Cup Championship on Tuesday, July 1.

The non-profit beneficiary as chosen by Valkyries athletes is CURYJ (pronounced 'courage'), which has been building community and mobilizing young leaders in the movement to end youth criminalization and mass incarceration since 2011. Located in Oakland, CURYJ unlocks the leadership of young people to dream beyond bars by providing life coaching, professional development, political education, and hands-on experience working on policy and grassroots campaigns.

The Valkyries will play six Commissioner's Cup games against their Western Conference foes, including three at Chase Center against the reigning Commissioner's Cup Champion Lynx (June 1), Las Vegas (June 7) and Seattle (June 14). Three of four all-time Commissioner's Cup champions have come from the Western Conference (2024 - Minnesota; 2022 - Las Vegas; 2021 - Seattle). Four current Valkyries have won the Commissioner's Cup in Cecilia Zandalasini (2024 with Minnesota), Kayla Thornton (2023 with New York), Head Coach Natalie Nakase (2022 with Las Vegas), and Stephane Talbot (2021 with Seattle).

Lynx Connections and Key Performances

- Temi Fágbénlé and Cecilia Zandalasini both won a 2017 WNBA Championship with the Lynx. Zandalasini and appeared in 72 games for Minnesota over three seasons, and Fágbénléalso played for three seasons for the Lynx, tallying over 200 points and 130 rebounds.
- Stephane Talbot was traded to the Lynx ahead of the 2019 season, averaging 5.2 points, 2.4 rebounds and 1.2 assists per game.
- Monique Billings had two double-doubles against Minnesota last season, scoring 19 points with 15 rebounds on June 2 and 15 points and 10 boards on June 17.

- Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,644), and 10th among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (365) and is one of 32 players all-time with over 4,500 points and 350 steals.
- Temi Fágbénlé is coming off a 2024 campaign with Indiana in which she averaged 18.9 minutes, 6.4 points, 4.7 boards, 0.9 assists, 0.5 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game, all career bests for the center who is entering her fifth season in the W.
- Veronica Burton ranked 25th in the league last season in +/- at +3.5 on the year. Tiffany Hayes was 28th (+2.8) and Kayla Thornton was 29th (+2.7).
- Tiffany Hayes is also coming off of a strong 2024 season in which she was tabbed the league's Sixth Player of the Year. The lefty shot a career-high 50.0 percent (minimum 150 FGA) from the field, and 40.2 percent from deep which ranked 10th in the W.
- Cecilia Zandalasini's 41.5 career three-point field goal percentage is currently 10th all-time in WNBA history and fourth among active players (min. 25 3FGM).

- Golden State drew 17, 428 fans in its preseason opener on May 6, which was the third largest preseason crowd in WNBA history.
- The Valkyries drew a sellout attendance of 18,064 during their home opener on May 16, which is the second-highest attendance by a WNBA team in their first-ever home game (Washington Mystics - 20,674 on 6/19/1998). That attendance was also the sixth highest in a team's first home game of the season. Golden State followed up with another sold-out crowd on May 21 wiht 18,064 fans.
- Kayla Thornton recorded the first-ever points in franchise history at the 9:36 mark. Kate Martin handed out the first assist at 8:14, and Temi Fágbénlé knocked down the first three-pointer at 6:53 in the first quarter.
- Veronica Burton (91.9) is third all-time in WNBA history in free throw percentage among players with at least 100 career attempts (1. Elena Delle Donne: 93.7 (1115/1190); 2. Karlie Samuelson: 92.7 (102/110)). Burton's 95.2 FT% this season is the second best in the league (min 10 attempts).
- Golden State is fourth in the WNBA with 8.8 steals per game. and is second in free throw percentage at 81.1.
- 37.4 percent of Golden State's points come from three-point range, which is the second highest clip in the WNBA. Additionally the Valkyries score 23.8 percent of their points off turnovers which tops the league.

The Valkyries lead the league in defensive rebound percentage (The percentage of available defensive rebounds a player or team obtains while on the floor) at 76.5.

- \bullet Janelle Salaün is fourth among rookies with 13.8 PPG, second with 7.8 RPG, and third with a 44.0 3FG%. Carla Leite is fourth with 2.0 APG.
- Janelle Salaün is 27th in the league in 13.8 points per game, and her 44.0 shooting percentage from three-point range is the 11th best.
- Janelle Salaün's 18-point, 13-rebound performance on Thursday was her first career double-double. Salaün is the third rookie this season (Dallas' Paige Bueckers and Washington's Kiki Iriafen) to record a double-double.
- On Thursday, Golden State held New York to a season-low 82 points, the first time the Liberty have been held to under 90 this season, and a 37.7 shooting percentage (23-61), also a season low.
- Kayla Thornton and Veronica Burton are both tied for second in the league with 2.4 steals per game.
- Temi Fágbénlé's 62.9 field goal percentage is the best in the W. Fágbénlé has shot 60.0 percent or better in four out of five games this season.
- Veronica Burton is 10 boards away from 200 (currently at 190) and 11 steals from 100 (at 89) in her career.
- Kayla Thornton is at 1,988 career points, 12 away from 2,000.
