

- Monique Billings has recorded two double-doubles over her last six games versus Los Angeles.

- Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,644), and 10th among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (365).
- Temi Fágbénlé is coming off a 2024 campaign with Indiana in which she averaged 18.9 minutes, 6.4 points, 4.7 boards, 0.9 assists, 0.5 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game, all career bests for the center who is entering her fifth season in the W.
- Veronica Burton ranked 25th in the league last season in +/- at +3.5 on the year. Tiffany Hayes was 28th (+2.8) and

Kayla Thornton was 29th (+2.7).

- Tiffany Hayes is also coming off of a strong 2024 season in which she was tabbed the league's Sixth Player of the Year. The lefty shot a career-high 50.0 percent (minimum 150 FGA) from the field, and 40.2 percent from deep which ranked 10th in the W.
- Cecilia Zandalasini's 41.5 career three-point field goal percentage is currently 10th all-time in WNBA history and fourth among active players (min. 25 3FGM).
- Veronica Burton has a career 91.2 free throw percentage, which is the third best in league history (min. 50 free throws made). Burton has made 9 of 10 from the line this season.
- Golden State drew 17, 428 fans in its preseason opener on May 6, which was the third largest preseason crowd in WNBA history.
- The Valkyries drew a sellout attendance of 18,064 during their home opener on May 16, which is the second-highest attendance by a WNBA team in their first-ever home game (Washington Mystics - 20,674 on 6/19/1998). That attendance was also the sixth highest in a team's first home game of the season. Golden State followed up with another sold-out crowd on May 21 wiht 18,064 fans.
- Golden State paces the league with 9.0 steals per game, and is second in free throw percentage at 85.4.
- Kayla Thornton recorded the first-ever points in franchise history at the 9:36 mark. Kate Martin handed out the first assist at 8:14, and Temi Fágbénlé knocked down the first three-pointer at 6:53 in the first quarter.
- Temi Fágbénlés four steals on May 21 are the most recorded in the league this season, and her 3.0 steals per game is tied for the best in the WNBA.
- Kayla Thornton (5-5) and Tiffany Hayes (5-5) are two of 16 players in the league who have yet to miss from the charity stripe.
- · Golden State has scored 33.6 percent of its points from threes, which is the second-highest rate in the league. The Valkyries have also gotten 24.5 percent of their points from the free-thrown line, also the second highest mark in the WNBA.
- Both Monique Billings and Julie Vanloo are a perfect 11-of-11 on field goals in the restricted area this season.

### 10,000 and Counting

 On March 26, 2025, the Golden State Valkyries eclipsed the 10,000 season ticket mark for the team's inaugural 2025 season, presented by Kaiser Permanente. The Valkyries, who are the first WNBA expansion team since 2008, became the first WNBA team on record to hit this milestone.

### NATALIE NAKASE HEAD COACH, GOLDEN STATE VALKYRIES

Experience: 1st Season School: UCLA - '03

Nakase enters her first season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces. Nakase will report to Valkyries General Manager Ohemaa Nyanin, and began her tenure with the team on October 21. Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

Nakase spent the last three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as

head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
