- Kayla Thornton was named the WNBA Western Conference Player of the Week for week 4. Thornton averaged 20.0 points, 11.5 rebounds and 1.0 assist while shooting 43.8 percent (14-32) from the field, posting two double-doubles while leading Golden State to a 2-0 week. It's Thornton's first-ever Player of the Week award. Thornton was also named a WNBA All-Star reserve, her first-ever All-Star nod.
- In the 2025 WNBA All-Star Game. Kayla Thornton led Team Clark with 11 rebounds and added 15 points off the bench, one of three players in the game with a double-double or better. Thornton shot 50.0 percent (4-8) from four-point range.
- With its 10th victory in its 19th game on the year, Golden State becomes the third WNBA expansion team all-time to reach 10 wins in 20 or fewer games (1999 Minnesota Lynx 16 games; 1998 Detroit Shock 19 games).

- Golden State signed center Iliana Rupert on July 17. Rupert played under then-assistant coach Natalie Nakase with Las Vegas, winning the 2022 WNBA Championship with the Aces.
- Tiffany Hayes is currently 32nd on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,815), tenth among active players, and 61 points away from passing Sheryl Swoops (4,875) for 31st all-time in Whistory. Hayes is one of seven active players with over 4,800 career points, 1,100 rebounds, 800 assists and 350 steals.
- Six Valkyries (Kayla Thornton 5, Temi Fágbénlé 2, Laeticia Amihere 1, Monique 1 Billings 1, Veronica Burton 1, Janelle Salaün 1) have recorded doubles-doubles this season. Thornton's five double-doubles are tied for the 10th most in the league, and her 10 career double-doubles are tied for the

fourth most in WNBA history among undrafted players.

ARLINGTON, Texas (AP) — Paige Bueckers scored 20 points, Arike Ogunbowale added 19 points, six assists and three steals, and the Dallas Wings won their first home game of the season, 80-71 over the Golden State Valkyries on Tuesday night.

Dallas (2-11) snapped a seven-game losing streak with its first victory since beating Connecticut 109-87 on May 27.

Bueckers sank a jumper from the free-throw line with 4:06 left in the fourth quarter and Ogunbowale nailed a long 3-pointer on their next possession for a 75-70 lead.

Ogunbowale also tipped away a pass and raced the other way for a fast-break layup to cap the scoring with 14.8 seconds left. Kaila Charles added 10 points and three steals for Dallas.

Monique Billings scored a season-high 18 points for Golden State (6-5). Kayla Thornton added 17 points, Laeticia Amihere had 14 and Tiffany Hayes 10.

Golden State was limited to just 16 points in the first quarter, the fewest the Wings have allowed in the opening frame this season.

# **HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE**



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 EXPERIENCE: 1st Season

Natalie Nakase enters her first season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces. Nakase will report to Valkyries General Manager Ohemaa Nyanin, and began her tenure with the team on October 21.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

Nakase spent the last three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in

2023, with a rating of 977. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama

Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.


Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology.
