   Kayla Thornton was named the WNBA Western Conference Player of the Week for week 4. Thornton averaged 20.0 points, 11.5 rebounds and 1.0 assist while shooting 43.8 percent (14-32) from the field, posting two double-doubles while leading Golden State to a 2-0 week. It's Thornton's first-ever Player of the Week award. Thornton was also named a WNBA All-Star reserve, her first-ever All-Star nod.
- Golden State's nine wins are already more than three of the past four expansion teams since 2000 had in their entire inaugural seasons Seattle with 6 in 2000, Chicago with 5 in 2006 and Atlanta with 4 in 2008.
- A Golden State win on Wednesday vs. Indiana will be its 10th win, and would mean the Valkyries are tied for the second-fastest expansion team to reach 10 wins (19 games):

- Seven of Golden State's nine losses on the season have come to teams with a current combined record of 54-21 (.720). (New York: 12-6, Minnesota: 17-2; Phoenix: 13-6; Atlanta: 12-7) (records as of 7/8 at 9a PT).
- The Valkyries signed forward Laeticia Amihere and guard Kaitlyn Chen to their active roster. Amihere was on Golden State's training camp roster, appearing in two preseason tune-ups for the Valkyries. Chen was drafted 30th overall by Golden State and was also on the training camp roster.
- Tiffany Hayes is currently 32nd on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,775), and tenth among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (369), and is one of seven active players with over 4,700 career points, 1,100 rebounds, 800 assists and 300 steals.
- Six Valkyries (Kayla Thornton 5, Temi Fágbénlé 2, Laeticia Amihere, Monique Billings, Veronica Burton, Janelle Salaün 1) have recorded doubles-doubles this season, which are the most players of any team in the WNBA. Thornton's five double-doubles are tied for the eighth most in the league.
- The Valkyries are the first WNBA team this season to have five players in double figures for three straight games (6/5 @ PHX, 6/7 vs. LVA, 6/9 @ LAS).
- Temi Fágbénlé is eighth in the league with a 52.1 field goal percentage.
- Golden State is second in the W in opponent PPG at 78.2, and are holding opponents to a league-best 39.9 field goal percentage. The Valkyries are third in the W with a 98.7 defensive rating (how many points a team allows per 100 opponent possessions), and third in defensive rebounds per game 27.4. Additionally, Golden State is holding opponents to a league-best 28.2 points in the paint, and an eFG% of 46.8 (second

best in the W).

- The Valkyries boast a 105.0 defensive rating on the road this season.
- Golden State is the only team top-five in both fast break points per gaem (11.2) and second change points per game (10.8).
- Kayla Thornton is 12th in the W with 1.6 steals per game, Thornton has at least one steal in all but two games this season. The forward is also 12th in rebounds (7:1), and 19th in points (14.9).
- Tiffany Hayes was one of three players to begin the 2025 season going 17-17 or better from the line: Napheesa Collier 23-23; Monique Akoa-Makani 18-18.

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Kayla Thornton hit two key 3-pointers over the final 4:57 and scored 16 points to go with six rebounds, and the Golden State Valkyries rallied past Caitlin Clark and the Indiana Fever 88-77 on Thursday night. Clark had 11 points, nine assists and seven rebounds and her layup with 4:12 remaining pulled Indiana within two points — but Golden State had an answer to each threat.

A raucous crowd roared as the Valkyries (6-6) sold out their sixth straight home game to start the season, a matchup circled on the calendar for the expansion franchise from the day the schedule was released. Monique Billings rebounded her own missed 3 and scored with 3:24 left. Veronica Burton hit a 3 from the top of the arc with 5:49 to play helping spark the comeback then scored again in the closing minute.

Tiffany Hayes made a go-ahead layup with 8 minutes left on the way to 14 points and Chloe Bibby scored the next time down off Hayes' baseball pass to put Golden State up 64-61.

Aliyah Boston had 17 points and 12 rebounds on a night Clark struggled to find her shooting touch and finished 3 for 14 and 0 of 7 on 3s. Clark missed her initial six shots before a layup at the 4:12 mark of the second quarter.

Boston beat the halftime buzzer with a 3 to put the Fever ahead 44-38 at the break.

Golden State ran out to a 7-2 lead and Indiana called timeout then answered with an 14-0 burst as the Valkyries went 6:20 without scoring and missed 13 straight shots. There were no skirmishes this time two days after the Fever's 88-71 home win against Connecticut featured three late ejections and further discipline.

Clark's old Iowa teammate, Kate Martin, contributed nine points and five rebounds off the bench a night after they went to dinner in San Francisco.

Fever coach Stephanie White missed the game for personal reasons and Austin Kelly filled in as acting head coach.
