- · Kayla Thornton was named the WNBA Western Conference Player of the Week for week 4. Thornton averaged 20.0 points, 11.5 rebounds and 1.0 assist while shooting 43.8 percent (14-32) from the field, posting two double-doubles while leading Golden State to a 2-0 week. It's Thornton's first-ever Player of the Week award. Thornton was also named a WNBA All-Star reserve, her first-ever All-Star nod.
- With its 10th victory in its 19th game on the year, Golden State becomes the third WNBA expansion team all-time to reach 10 wins in 20 or fewer games (1999 Minnesota Lynx 16 games; 1998 Detroit Shock 19 games).

- The Valkyries signed forward Laeticia Amihere and guard Kaitlyn Chen to their active roster. Amihere was on Golden State's training camp roster, ap pearing in two preseason tune-ups for the Valkyries. Chen was drafted 30th overall by Golden State and was also on the training camp roster.
- Tiffany Hayes is currently 32nd on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,781),

- and tenth among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (370), and is one of seven active players with over 4,700 career points, 1,100 rebounds, 800 assists and 300 steals.
- Six Valkyries (Kayla Thornton 5, Temi Fágbénlé 2, Laeticia Amihere 1, Monique 1 Billings 1, Veronica Burton 1, Janelle Salaün 1) have recorded doubles-doubles this season, which are the most players of any team in the WNBA. Thornton's five double-doubles are tied for the ninth most in the league.

- The Valkyries lead the league in home attendance with an average of 18,064 fans. Indiana is second and averaging 16,657.29 fans per game, and New York is third at 16,013.86. Golden State has sold out all 10 home games this season.
- On March 26, 2025, the Golden State Valkyries eclipsed the 10,000 season ticket mark for the team's inaugural 2025 season, presented by Kaiser Permanente. The Valkyries, who are the first WNBA expansion team since 2008, became the first WNBA team on record to hit this milestone
- The Valkyries drew a sellout attendance of 18,064 during their home opener on May 16, which is the second-highest attendance by a WNBA team in their first-ever home game (Washington Mystics 20,674 on 6/19/1998). That attendance was also the sixth highest in a team's first home game of the season. Golden State followed up with two more sellouts, becoming the first WNBA franchise to have an attendance of 18,000+ in each of its first three home games.

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Kayla Thornton had 22 points and 11 rebounds, Veronica Burton and Monique Billings also had double-doubles and the Golden State Valkyries beat the Las Vegas Aces 95-68 on Saturday to snap a four-game losing streak.

Burton added 14 points, a career-high 12 assists and seven rebounds, while Billings finished with 14 points, 11 rebounds, two steals and two blocks.

Cecilia Zandalasini scored a career-high 18 points for Golden State and Kate Martin had 12 for the expansion Valkyries, who set a franchise record for points in a game.

Thornton found Martin for a layup with a minute left in the first quarter to give the Valkyries the lead for good and Thornton's 3-pointer with 3:47 remaining in the second made it 31-21. Las Vegas trailed by double figures the rest of the way.

The Valkyries (3-5) scored more points (34) in the second quarter than the Aces, who shot 29% (9 of 31) from the field in the first half, had at halftime. Martin's deep pull-up 3-pointer at the buzzer gave Golden State a 49-28 lead at the intermission

A'ja Wilson scored 17 for Las Vegas (4-3) and Chelsea Gray had 16 points on 7-of-11 shooting. Rookie Aaliyah Nye hit three 3-pointers and finished with a season-high 13 points, her second consecutive game in double figures.

The Aces finished shooting 36% (22 of 62) and made 6 of 25 (24%) from 3-point range.
