Notes

- Golden State had a 2025 season for the history books. The Valkyries set the record for wins by an expansion team (23), became the first-ever WNBA expansion team to reach the postseason during its inaugural season, and secured a winning record during its inaugural season.
- Golden State was the second-fastest expansion team to reach 15 wins on the year (30 games; the 1998 Detroit Shock - 27 contests). The Valkyries were the third fastest expansion team to reach 10 wins (19 games; 1999 Minnesota Lynx - 16 games; 1998 Detroit Shock - 19 games), and the fourth fastest expansion to reach five wins (10 games; 1999 Orlando Miracle - 8 games, 1998 Detroit Shock - 9 games, 1999 Minnesota Lynx - 9 games).
- Golden State won its 17th game of the year on 8/13/25, tying them with the 1998 Detroit Shock for the most of any WNBA expansion team (excluding the 1997 WNBA inaugural season). The Shock reached 17 wins in 30 games (their final game of the season), while the Valkyries accomplished the feat in 32 games.
- Newly-signed free agents Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams played together at UConn during the 2014-15 season, leading the Huskies to a 38-1 record and the National Championship title. Stokes also won a pair of WNBA Championships under then-assistant coach Natalie Nakase while in Las Vegas.
- Kaitlyn Chen, Tiffany Hayes, Kiah Stokes and Gabby Williams give the Valkyries four former UConn players on the roster, the most proud former Huskies on any roster in the league.
- Valkyries assistant coach Sugar Rodgers and Valkyries center Kiah Stokes suited up together with the Liberty from 2015-2018, rooming together on road trips.
- The WNBA General Manager survey recently dropped, with the Valkyries collecting plenty of high praise from across the league:
 - Veronica Burton received votes for 'Which player is most likely to have a breakout season?' and for 'Which active player will make the best head coach someday?'
 - Gabby Williams tied for first with Angel Reese for 'Which player acquisition will make the biggest impact?', and was voted the best perimeter defender in the WNBA. Williams also finished second for 'Who is the most versatile player in the WNBA?'
 - Golden State was voted to be the best defensive team in the WNBA, a season removed from leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent FG% (40.5).
 - Janelle Salaün was voted the second best international player, receiving 20% of the votes.
 - Reigning WNBA Coach of the Year finished third in voting for the best head coach in the WNBA, and was tied for second for 'Which head coach is the best manager/motivator of people?', and tied for third for 'Which head

coach makes the best in-game adjustments?'

• Unsurprising to no one, the Valkyries received 64% of the vote for 'Who has the best home court advantage?'

- Natalie Nakase will serve as an assistant coach for the 2026 USA Women's National Team at the 2026 FIBA Women's World Cup, which is set for Sept. 4-13 in Berlin. Nakase will be joined by head coach Kara Lawson (Duke University) and fellow assistants Nate Tippetts (Phoenix Mercury) and Stephanie White (Indiana Fever).

• Veronica Burton has had quite the year on the court. After being named the WNBA Kia Most Improved Player of the Year and WNBA All-Defensive Second Team, Burton's offseason consisted of an Unrivaled title with the Mist, and swept Courtney Williams 11-0 during Unrivaled's 1-on-1 tournament. Burton also won gold with Team USA at the 2025 FIBA 3x3 AmeriCup, and bronze at the 2026 USA 3x3 Champions Cup. She also participated in the December 2025 Women's National Team Training Camp in Durham, North Carolina, and the April 2026 Women's National Team Training Camp in Phoenix, alongside fellow Valkyries' Kayla Thornton and Natalie Nakase who served as a court coach.

Gabby Williams' international resume includes the Alain Gilles Trophy, which is given to the best male or female French basketball player, and a FIBA Europe SuperCup MVP nod after guiding Fenerbahçe to the FIBA Europe SuperCup title in 2024. Williams played for Fenerbahçe the past three seasons, leading them to consecutive Turkish Super League titles (2025-26) and the Turkish Cup crown this year. Williams' impressive international resume also includes an Olympic silver medal with France, two Turkish Presidential Cup championships, a EuroLeague championship, a EuroLeague Final Four MVP, and a pair of EuroLeague Defensive Player of the Year awards.

• Tiffany Hayes is currently 31st on the WNBA's all-time scoring list with 4,925 career points and is 58 points away from surpassing Hall of Famer Maya Moore for 30th all-time. Her total points are the ninth most among active players. Off the court, Hayes was named the Valkyries first ever recipient of the 2025 Season-long WNBA Cares Community Assist Award for her work within the Bay Area community.

• Kayla Thornton returns to action after a career year in 2025, highlighted by her first career WNBA All-Star selection to become the first All-Star in Valkyries history and just the seventh undrafted player in WNBA history to receive the honor. The forward also led the Valkyries with career highs of 14.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game, scoring in double figures in 18 of her 22 games played. Thornton was named Western Conference Player of the Week on June 17.

• This offseason, Janelle Salaün led France with 16.7 points and 6.3 rebounds per game at the FIBA World Cup Qualifying Tournament, earning TISSOT MVP honors and a spot on the All-Star Five as France went 5-0.

• Gabby Williams and Justé Jocyte both played together at LDLC ASVEL Féminin Lyon in 2023 where the pair helped lead the club to a EuroCup title.

• Golden State came out strong to start the 2026 season.

• The Valkyries set a franchise record with 48 bench points, led by Janelle Salaün's 20 in 27 minutes of action.

• Kaitlyn Chen dropped a career-high 14 points, seven of which came in the third quarter which is a career high in any quarter for Chen. Salaün had five made threes, tying her career high for made threes in a game which also came against Seattle (Sept. 9, 2025).

• Veronica Burton had 16 points to go with six assists, her third-straight double-digit scoring performance and sixth in her last seven games dating back to last season. Burton also made two threes on the night, and now has 101 in her career.

• Kayla Thornton returned to action with 13 points and eight rebounds, all of which came in the second half.

• Kaila Charles had six rebounds and was a game-high +18 in 17 minutes off the bench.

• Seven Valkyries players made a three pointer, amounting to 15 on the night which is tied for the second-most in a game in team history

• The Golden State Valkyries set the all-time WNBA attendance record for average attendance (18,064) and total fans (397,408) during their inaugural regular season, and sold out all 22 regular-season home games at Chase Center in 2025.

• Veronica Burton is 175 points away from 1,000 in her career (at 825), and 15 assists away from 500 in her career (at 485).

• Kaila Charles is eight games away from 100 in her career, 26 points away from 500 career, and 10 assists away from 100.

HEAD COACH NATALIE NAKASE



SCHOOL: UCLA - '03 **EXPERIENCE:** 2nd Season

Natalie Nakase is in her second season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces.

Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

In her first season at the helm of the Valkyries, Nakase led Golden State to 23 regular season wins during its inaugural year, a WNBA single-season record by an expansion team, and the Valkyries became the first-ever expansion franchise to reach the playoffs in their inaugural season. In June 2025, Nakase was named the league's Coach of the Month after the Valkyries went 7-4 (.636), and had three wins by 24 points or more.

Under Nakase and her staff, the Valkyries posted one of the best defenses in the WNBA, leading the league in opponent points per game (76.3) and opponent field goal percentage (40.5), while having the third-best defensive rating (99.8). Offensively, Golden State ranked top five in the WNBA in rebounds per game (35.3), three pointers made (427), and free throw percentage (81.5) during the regular season.

Following the season, Nakase was named the 2025 State Street Investment Management SPY WNBA Coach of the Year as well as the Associated Press Coach of the Year. Under Nakase's leadership, many Valkyries reached new career heights during the 2025 season, including Veronica Burton, who earned 2025 Kia WNBA Most Improved Player honors, Kayla Thornton, who was selected as a WNBA All-Star, and Janelle Salaün, who was named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team.

Nakase spent three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
